WRAP IT UP: After an off day yesterday following their nine-game, 10-day road trip, the Giants welcome the St. Louis Cardinals tonight for the final series of 2024.

- ▶ SF put together its best road trip of the season, going 7-2 through Baltimore (2-1), Kansas City (3-0) and Arizona (2-1)...the Giants did have their five-game win streak (their longest such streak of the season) snapped on Wednesday with an 8-2 loss in Arizona to close out the trip.
- ▶ The loss dropped SF back below the .500 mark and they will need to sweep this series in order to finish with an above .500 record, something they have done only three times since winning the World Series in 2014 (84-78 in 2015, 87-75 in 2016 and 107-55 in 2021).

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants made the following roster moves prior to today's game.

- ▶ **RHP Randy Rodríguez** (#73) reinstated from the 15-day IL.
- ▶ **RHP Mason Black** optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.

WILLIE MAC AWARD: The Giants will hand out their annual **Willie Mac Award** prior to tonight's game, an honor bestowed on the Giants player who to the most inspirational player on the team, as voted upon by Giants players, coaches, training staff, clubhouse staff and the fans.

- ▶ This season marks the 44th anniversary of the award, which was established in 1980, in honor of legend and Hall of Famer **Willie McCovey**...ironically enough McCovey himself wore #44 during his playing days.
- ▶ Three of the past four Willie Mac winners are still on the Giants roster...**OF Mike Yastrzemski** won it in 2020, **IF LaMonte Wade Jr.** won it in 2021 and **IF Wilmer Flores** (currently on the IL) won it in 2022...**IF Thairo Estrada**, who finished this year in Triple-A, won it in 2023.

THAT WAS SOME WELL-ROUNDED BALL: The Giants played the role of spoiler quite well during their road trip against three teams in the hunt for Postseason play, going 7-2 and playing arguably their most rounded baseball of the year.

- ▶ SF outscored its opponents 50-20 during the trip while posting a .757 OPS as a team...the Giants out-homered the opponents 17-2 during the nine-game trip.
- ▶ Giants pitching posted a 2.26 ERA (20er, 79.2ip) during the nine-game run and hurled four shutouts including back-to-back blankings of the Royals on September 21-22.
- ▶ Defensively, the Giants were not charged with an error in any of the nine games, which is their longest errorless streak of the season regardless of venue...prior to this trip, SF's longest run of error-free baseball this season was a seven-game stretch from July 24-30.
- ▶ Overall, the nine-game errorless streak was the longest by any Giants team since 2021 when that club also went nine games without committing an error from April 6-16...the last time the Giants had a streak of 10 games or more was in 2016 when they turned in 11 consecutive error-free games from September 4-15.

GREAT FIRST IMPRESSION: **IF Matt Chapman's** 27 homers in his first season with the Giants are fourth-most by any player in team history in their first year with the team...he trails **Barry Bonds** (46 in 1993), **Jeff Kent** (29 in 1997) and **J.T. Snow** (28 in 1997) (Stats, LLC).

ROUPP THERE IT IS!: **RHP Landen Roupp** makes his final appearance of the season tonight in what will be his fourth MLB start and 23rd appearance at the MLB level.

- ▶ In those three starts he's posted a 1.20 ERA (2er, 15.0ip), allowed 10 hits, struck out 10 and walked five...entering today, Roupp has not allowed a run in his last 14.0 innings dating back to the 1st inning of his Sept. 10 start vs. Milwaukee here at Oracle.
- ▶ In 11 games (three starts) since being recalled from AAA on August 9, Roupp has a 0.89 ERA (3er, 30.1ip) with 28 strikeouts and an opponents batting average against of .162.

3 FOR 30: **IF Matt Chapman** is three HRs away from reaching the 30-HR plateau, something no Giants player has accomplished in 21 seasons since **Barry Bonds** hit 45 home runs in 2004.

- ▶ Chapman is slugging .607 with six home runs in his last 16 games...he's looking to become just the fifth Giants third baseman with a 30-homer campaign, joining **Jim Ray Hart**, **Sid Gordon**, **Matt Williams** and **Mel Ott**.
- ▶ **Matt Williams** is the last Giants third baseman to hit 30+ homers in a season (43 in 1994).

WHO POISONED THE WATER HOLE?: SF has flipped its script in September, going 9-3 on the road while going just 2-8 here at home...in fact, the Giants have lost nine of their last 11 games here dating to August 31.

- ▶ Dating to August 11, SF is 6-14 (.300) at Oracle Park, the lowest home win % in the NL in that time and 29th of 30 MLB teams ahead of only Chicago-AL (6-16, .273)...entering play on August 11, SF was 35-23 (.603) at home, the sixth-best home win% in MLB...SF is still 41-37 at home this season.

20-20-20 VISION: The Giants have three 20-homer hitters (**IF Matt Chapman** - 27, **OF Michael Conforto** - 20 and **OF Heliot Ramos** - 22) on the club for just the third time in the last 17 seasons (since 2007)...SF also had three players each hit 20 or more homers in both 2019 and 2021.

- ▶ The 2006 season was the last time the Giants had four players each hit 20 or more homers (**Moisés Alou**, **Barry Bonds**, **Ray Durham** and **Pedro Feliz**).

SEPTEMBER 27, 1997 - SF clinched its first NL West championship in eight years with 6-1 defeat of Padres in front of 48,179...**Rod Beck** registered the final three outs, including his strikeout of Greg Vaughn that sent Candlestick into a frenzy.

IN THE SHOW: The 26-year-old is making his 23rd appearance (fourth start) at the MLB level this year with his start today...he's in the rotation because of injuries to **LHP Robbie Ray** (left hamstring strain) and **LHP Kyle Harrison** (left shoulder inflammation)...the rookie made the Giants Opening Day roster out of Spring Training and appeared in 10 games out of the bullpen in March/April before being optioned to Triple-A...Roupp is in his fourth stint at the MLB level this year.

LAST TIME OUT: Blanked Kansas City with 5.0 shutout innings last Saturday at Kauffman Stadium to earn his first career Major League win in SF's 9-0 victory...Roupp enters today's outing having not allowed a run in 14.0 consecutive innings dating to the first inning of his start against the Brewers on September 10.

PUSH START: This marks Roupp's fourth career start at the MLB level...in his three starts he's posted a 1-1 record with a 1.20 ERA (2er, 15.0ip)...he's made 32 career MiLB starts (eight in 2024)...in those eight MiLB starts this year, he posted a 2.35 ERA (6er, 23.0ip) with 36 strikeouts and a 1.00 WHIP.

FINISHING STRONG: Roupp has a 0.89 ERA (3er, 30.1ip) with 28 strikeouts, a .162 opposing batting average, 1.02 WHIP and a 49.4% groundball rate in 11 games (three starts) since being recalled to the Majors on August 9.

CURVE IT: Roupp has heavily relied on his curveball this season with the pitch having a 44.5% usage rate...it has also been his most valuable pitch this season with a +4 run value...opponents are 7-for-45 (.156) with two extra-base hits against Roupp's curveball over his last 11 games with 20 strikeouts...overall, 32 of Roupp's 43 strikeouts this year (74.4%) have come on the curve.

DO THE SPLITS: Roupp has held righties to a .208/.269/.302 slash line with a .571 OPS, 29 strikeouts and one home run here at the MLB level...lefties are slashing .189/.341/.243 with a .584 OPS, 14 strikeouts and zero homers.

SPLITS PART TWO: Albeit a small sample size, Roupp has been stronger as a visiting pitcher this year working 17.2 scoreless innings on the road in nine games (one start)...here at home, however, he's given up 15 runs (14 earned) in 29.0 innings across 13 games (two starts) for a 4.34 ERA.

ROUPP AS A RIVER CAT: The rookie has appeared in eight games, six starts, for Triple-A Sacramento this season, going 0-1 with a 3.80 ERA (9er, 21.1ip), 30 strikeouts, a 1.31 WHIP and a .187 opposing batting average...in his last three outings for Sacramento, he had a 1.13 ERA (1er, 8.0ip) while striking out eight before being recalled on Aug. 9.

MISSING TIME: Roupp missed nearly a month from the middle of May to the middles of June on the Minor League Injured List with right elbow discomfort.

A PROSPECT NO MORE: Roupp entered the season as the Giants' No. 14 prospect according to *Baseball America* and the No. 12 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
