AROUND THE HORN

KELLY’S FIRST BOBBLEHEAD ON SEPT. 12: The team will celebrate a starting rotation mainstay with the Merrill Kelly Bobble courtesy of Casino Arizona & Talking Stick Resort on Sat., Sept. 12 for the first 20,000 fans in attendance.

KPOP DEMON HUNTERS ON SEPT. 13: Fans will want to act fast to ensure they get the exclusive D-backs x KPop Demon Hunters Tee as club’s popular Special Event Ticket Pack series embraces the worldwide phenomenon.

SQUISHY DUMPLINGS ON SEPT. 14-15: The viral sensation D-backs x Mystery Squishy Dumpling will feature four options with the red, teal, white and ultra rare City Connect dumplings with each Special Event Ticket Pack including one of the exclusive, must-have dumplings.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are 10-2 in **Brandon Pfaadt’s** last 12 starts.

- In his last 12 starts, **Brandon Pfaadt** is 7-1 with a 2.22 ERA (18 ER in 73.0 IP), opponent .217 AVG, 10 walks and 42 strikeouts.
 - In his last 6 road bids, is 4-0 (team 6-0) with a 2.25 ERA (9 ER in 36.0 IP), opponent .230 AVG, 3 walks and 28 strikeouts.
- Gabriel Moreno**, has hit safely in 9 of his last 10 road games, batting .324 (12-for-37)/1.162 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers, 11 RBI and 7 walks.
 - Moreno** has reached base 3 times in each of his last 2 road games and 2+ times in 5 of his last 6.
- Geraldo Perdomo** has hit safely in 10 of his last 12 games, batting .317 (13-for-41)/.734 OPS with 3 RBI and 7 walks...has reached base safely 2+ times in 8 of those games.
 - Geraldo Perdomo** vs. Astros, has reached base safely in 9 of his last 12 plate appearances (8 H, 1 BB) since July 22, 2025, with 6 singles and 2 doubles.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 3-1 @ Astros on Friday.

- Merrill Kelly** tossed his second straight quality start but took the loss (3 ER in 6.0 IP, 7 H, 0 BB, 4 K).
- Gabriel Moreno** hit a solo homer (12) and had 2 walks.
- Ketel Marte** and **Geraldo Perdomo** both reached base twice via hit and walk.
- The D-backs recorded 7 walks, 1 shy of tying their season road high this season.
- Justin Martinez** and **Derek Law** each tossed 1.0 scoreless inning without a hit or walk.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are in fourth place in the NL Wild Card race, a 0.5 game behind the Padres (WC3, season tied 5-5), 5.5 games behind the Philies (WC2, tied 3-3) and 6.0 games behind the Cubs (WC1, trail 2-4).

OVER THE LONG HAUL: The D-backs’ 29 wins (29-21) since July 9 are third in the National League, behind the Brewers (30) and Braves (31) and are sixth in MLB, behind the league-leading Red Sox (35).

PERDOMO SWIPES 20: **Geraldo Perdomo** last night became 1 of 7 D-backs ever to record consecutive seasons of 20+ stolen bases (20 in 2026, 27 in 2025)...(also: Corbin Carroll 2023-26, Tony Womack 1999-2002, Jake McCarthy 2022-24, Paul Goldschmidt 2015-16, Chris Young 2010-11, Eric Byrnes 2006-07).

WORK THE COUNT: The D-backs offense’s 4.02 pitches per plate appearance since Aug. 1 ranks third in the NL and fifth in the Majors, to the Yankees (4.03), Reds (4.04), Angels (4.06) and Brewers (4.08).

- Since Aug. 25, the D-backs are the loan team to boast multiple players (**Nootbaar** - 1st, 5.00, **Perdomo** - 6th, 4.75, **Moreno** - 8th, 4.73) in the top 10 in MLB [min. 25 PA].

WALK THIS WAY: The D-backs offense recorded 7 walks last night, 1 shy of their road season high 8.

- The D-backs’ 14 games with 7+ walks is tied for fourth most in MLB (also: Dodgers), to the Cubs (20), Brewers (19) and Reds (17).

PEN QUARTET: The D-backs are 1 of 4 teams in MLB with 4 relievers (**Taylor Clarke**/2.60, **Brandyn Garcia**/2.20, **Jonathan Loaisiga**/2.40, **Juan Morillo**/2.11) with a sub-3.00 ERA [min. 40.0 IP] (also: Braves, Guardians and Padres).

MUCHO MORILLO: **Juan Morillo** boasts a career-high 17-game (17.0 IP) scoreless streak, going 1-0 with 2 saves, an opponent .169 AVG (10-for-59)/.461 OPS, 0.94 WHIP, 6 walks and 18 strikeouts...has stranded all 8 of his inherited runners.

- Since July 19, is the lone reliever in the Majors [min. 15 G] with a 0.00 ERA...has allowed just 2 extra-base hits (2 2B) in that span.
- Is scoreless in 9 straight road games (9.0 IP) with an opponent .133 AVG (4-for-30)/.354 OPS, 2 walks and 12 strikeouts.

COMEBACK SNAKES: The D-backs’ 41 comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (40).

- Their 20 comeback wins on the road lead the Majors, ahead of the Athletics (18), Cubs (18) and Red Sox (18).

ROAD BATS: **Lars Nootbaar** has reached base safely in 8 of his first 9 road games as a D-back since Aug. 14, batting .333 (9-for-27)/1.141 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 8 RBI and 3 walks.

- Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely 2+ times in 4 of his last 7 road games.

VS. ASTROS: Last played @ Astros from Sept. 6-8, 2024 and dropped 2 of 3.

- The D-backs secured a 2-game series split @ Astros from Sept. 27-28, 2022.
