RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a seven-game, seven-day road trip against the Red Sox (1-1, 2 to play) and Blue Jays (3 to play) tonight at Fenway Park...Tampa Bay is in the midst of a 13-game stretch featuring matchups exclusively vs. AL East opponents, which began with a three-game series vs. the Yankees from May 10-12 (1-2)...the Rays return home for a three-game set with the Red Sox from May 20-22 to complete the 13-game stretch... Tampa Bay has been at or within one game of the .500 mark for 10 consecutive days.

With last night's extra-inning defeat, Tampa Bay saw both its five-game winning streak over Boston (Sept. 5, 2023–May 13, 2024) and its six-game winning streak at Fenway Park (June 3, 2023–May-13, 2024) come to an end.

The 12-inning affair was Tampa Bay's longest game (by innings) in Boston since another 12-inning contest on April 6, 2021 (L, 6-5).

The Rays fell to 3-2 in extra-inning games this season, including a 1-2 mark on the road...the other defeat came on April 27 at Chicago-AL (L, 8-7 in 10 inn.).

Tampa Bay went 1-for-12 (083) with runners in scoring position in the loss.

Rays batters struck out a season-high 15 times...their most SO in a 9-inning game this year is 13 (2x, last: April 30 at MIL)...the 15 SO were the Rays most since Aug. 15, 2023 at San Francisco (15SO in 9 inn.).

TALKIN' TAJ—Taj Bradley will make his second start of the year following his season debut on May 10 vs. New York-AL (L, 6.0IP, 4H, 1R, 1ER, 2BB, 7SO)...the 23-year old right-hander made his MLB debut on April 12, 2023 vs. Boston and earned the win after tossing 5.0 innings, allowing three runs on five hits and one walk with eight strikeouts.

Bradley has made 24 appearances (22GS) thus far in his career, fanning 135 batters across 108.2 IP in those starts (11.18 SO/9.0IP)...the 135 SO are fourth most through a pitcher's first 22 starts in club history behind Charlie Morton (163SO), Drew Smyly (148SO) and Tyler Glasnow (136SO).

His 22 HR allowed, however, are the most through 22 GS in franchise history, with the next closest being Roberto Hernández and Bryan Rekar (hoth 20HR).

WHAT TO WATCH FOR - Boston starter Tanner Houck utilizes his slider 42.8 pct. of the time, limiting opponents to a .195 (16-for-82) AVG on the offering while conceding only two extra-base hits (2B, HR)...Tampa Bay batters are hitting .286 (74-for-259) off sliders, the second-highest average in the majors behind San Diego (.292)...Rays hitters with the most success off sliders this year include Isaac Paredes (.406, 13-for-32), Harold Ramírez (.355, 11-for-31), Randy Arozarena (.345, 10-for-29) and Amed Rosario (.333, 11-for-33).

ON-BASE PAREDES—Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in 13 straight games dating to April 28, slashing .383/.474/.574 (18-for-47) with 3 2B, 2 HR, 7 RBI and 8 BB while producing a 7.0 pct. strikeout rate (4SO/57PA)...the 13-game run is the second longest by a Ray this season, trailing Amed Rosario (14G) from April 5-22.

He is one game shy of matching his career-long 14-game on-base streak from June 9-Sept. 21, 2021.

Paredes has 11 multi-hit games since April 17, tied with PHI **Alec Bohm** for the most in the majors during that period.

THE YANDY MAN CAN—Despite an 0-for-5 performance last night, Yandy Díaz has hit safely in nine of his last 11 games May 3, including six multi-hit efforts, going 17-for-47 (.362) with 4 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI...this, following an 0-for-15 skid from April 28–May 1.

PEN PALS—In 11 games since May 3, Tampa Bay's bullpen ranks among MLB in ERA (3rd, 1.80), WHIP (6th, 1.07), hits/9.0 IP (6th, 6.00) and opp. OPS (7th, .597)...they have not allowed an earned run in 10.0 consecutive innings following Zach Eflin's departure in

lay's series opener.

LHP Garrett Cleavinger has not allowed an earned run over his last 15 appearances (12.2IP) since April 6, holding opponents to a .119 (5-for-42) AVG...min. 50 BF, his 36.6 pct. strikeout rate (26SO/71BF) ranks fourth among AL relievers behind OAK Mason Miller (56.7%), HOU Josh Hader (38.0%) and TOR Yimi García (37.7%).

RHP Jason Adam owns a 0.56 ERA (16.0IP, 1ER) in his last 15 appearances...his 35.1 whiff rate on the year ranks in the 95th percentile of MLB pitchers, yet he owns a career-low 22.5 pct. strikeout rate (16SO/71BF).

RHP Phil Maton has pitched to a 0.93 ERA (9.2IP, 1ER) and 0.41 WHIP in his last 11 games since being tagged for a career-high-tying five runs on April 15 vs. LAA. Rays relievers posted an MLB-worst 13.2 pct. walk rate through April 20 (22G)...in 21 games since, they have posted a 9.1 pct. walk rate.

In 10 games vs. Boston since June 3, 2023, Tampa Bay's bullpen has turned in a 1.52 ERA (41.1IP, 7ER) and .176 opp. average (26-for-148).

EXTRA, EXTRA!—Tampa Bay has registered 36 XBH over its last 11 games since May 3 (22 2B, 3 3B, 11HR), tied with Philadelphia for fifth most in MLB during that time...the Rays had an AL-low 21 XBH (13 2B, 8HR) in their previous 11 games from April 21-May 1...Tampa Bay's 68 XBH overall through May 1 were tied with Pittsburgh for the third fewest in the majors, ahead of only Miami (63XBH) and Seattle (67XBH).

Josh Lowe has 1+ XBH in three consecutive contests, one game shy of matching his career-long streak of four games (2x, last: Sept. 27, 2023-May 6, 2024)...he is 8-for-25 (.320) with 4 2B and 1 HR in seven games since his activation from the injured list.

Randy Arozarena has nine hits in his last 11 games, seven of which have gone for extra bases (2 2B, 5HR)...12 of his 25 hits (48.0%) on the season have gone for extra bases (4 2B, 8HR), the 11th-highest percentage in the AL/15th highest in the majors...he has hit safely in a season-high four straight games overall.

WALK IT OUT-Tampa Bay has drawn an AL-best 70 walks in 17 games (4.1BB/G) since April 26, tied with Los Angeles-NL for the most free passes during that stretch behind only Philadelphia (77BB)...Randy Arozarena's 12 BB during that period are fifth most in the AL.

The Rays have drawn at least one walk in a season-high-tying 12 straight games, matching their season-opening run from March 28–April 9.

DOWN TO THE WIRE—The Rays have played 22 games decided by two runs or fewer, fourth most in the AL behind New York-AL (25G) and Detroit/Kansas City (both 23G)... Tampa Bay's .636 winning pct. (14-8) in such contests is third best in the majors behind Philadelphia (.750/12-4) and Baltimore (.700/14-6).

SHIPPING UP TO BOSTON—Tampa Bay and Boston continue a four-game set tonight at Fenway Park...the two clubs will meet seven times in 10 days, with the Red Sox traveling to St. Petersburg from May 20-22 for a three-game series...Tampa Bay went 11-2 vs. Boston last season, including a 5-1 mark at Fenway Park.

The Rays have collected 8+ hits in five straight games against the Red Sox dating to Sept. 6, 2023...the last time they had 8+ hits in six or more games vs. Boston was from July 30, 2019-Aug. 4, 2020 (8G).

- Rays RHP Taj Bradley earned the victory in his MLB debut vs. Boston on April 12, 2023 at Tropicana field (5.0IP, 5H, 3ER, 1BB, 8SO)... it marked the second most strikeouts by a Rays player in his major league debut in club history, trailing only Wade Davis (9SO) on Sept. 6, 2009 vs. Detroit.
- Red Sox RHP Cooper Criswell made 11 appearances (1GS) for the Rays across two seasons from 2022–23, going 1-1 with a 5.45 ERA (36.1lP, 22ER)...he earned his first career win on May 26, 2023 vs. Los Angeles-NL (4.0lP, 4H, 1ER, 2BB, 3SO).
- On April 13, 2023, the Rays improved to 13-0 with a 9-3 win vs. Boston, tying the 1982 Braves and 1987 Brewers for the longest season-opening winning streak in the modern era (since 1900) and marking the longest winning streak at any point in a season in franchise history.
- Rays Third Base Coach Brady Williams was selected by the Red Sox in the 45th round of the 1999 First-Year Player Draft out of Pasco-Hernando Community College in New Port Richey, FL.
- Blake Butera, Tampa Bay's Senior Director of Player Development, graduated from Boston College in 2015, playing in over 200 games for the Eagles.
- Tampa Bay RHP Zack Littell was claimed off waivers by the Rays from the Red Sox on May 12, 2023.
- Rays LHP Jeffrey Springs was acquired from the Red Sox on Feb. 17, 2021...Springs, currently rehabbing from Tommy John surgery, grew up a Red Sox fan and enjoyed watching Pedro Martínez and Jason Varitek.
- Rays RHP Aaron Civale spent two seasons at Northeastern University (2014-15)...during his sophomore year, he started against the Red Sox in a spring exhibition game in Fort Myers, tossing a pair of scoreless innings while striking out David Ortiz, Hanley Ramirez and Mike Napoli...Civale resides in Boston during the offseason.

TONIGHT'S START—The right-hander will make his second start of the season tonight in Boston, including his first on the road...opened the season on the 15-day IL (right pectoral strain) before making his 2024 debut on May 10 vs. NYY...suffered the injury while warming up for his scheduled spring start on March 12 at BAL...is looking to snap a six-decision losing streak, seeking his first win since June 21, 2023 at BAL.

LAST TIME OUT—In his first start of the season on May 10 Bradley turned in his second career quality start, but was saddled with the loss in the Rays first shutout defeat of the campaign, a 2-0 setback (L, 6.0IP, 4H, ER, 2BB, 7SO)...opened the game with 3.2 hitless innings...the only run he allowed came on an **Anthony Rizzo** two-out single in the 4th...both of the walks were drawn by **Aaron Judge**...the Yankees went a combined 1-for-12 with 5 SO against his cutter, split-finger and curveball. BEANTOWN RUNDOWN—Bradley earned the win in both of his starts opposite Boston last season, going 2-0 with a 4.50 ERA (10.0IP, 5ER) while enjoying 12.60 runs of support per 9.0 IP...his MLB debut came on April 12, 2023 against the Red Sox at Tropicana Field...in that contest, he yielded 3 ER over 5.0 IP, guiding the Rays to their 12th straight victory to open the season...it marked only the second time in the modern era (since 1900) a team on a winning streak of 10+ games had a rookie make their first career start, joining ATL Mike McQueen in 1969...the 8 SO were second most in a Rays pitcher's debut, trailing only Wade Davis (9SO) on Sept. 6, 2009 vs. DET.

Bradley is 3-3 with a 4.74 ERA (38.0IP, 20ER) over seven career starts against AL East opponents...the Rays are 3-4 in those outings...this marks just his second road start opposite a division rival—the other outing also came at Fenway Park (June 4, 2023).

FLAMETHROWER—Bradley recorded an average velocity of 97.3 mph on his four-seam fastball in his season debut on May 10 vs. NYY, tying highest mark of his career (also July 18, 2023 vs. BAL)...this, after averaging 96.0 mph on the heater in two rehab starts with Triple-A Durham...according to Statcast, there are two qualified pitchers who average at least 97.3 mph on their four-seamers: CIN **Hunter Greene** (97.7) and PIT **Jared Jones** (97.3).

KING OF THE K-Bradley has recorded 135 SO in his first 22 career starts, KING OF THE K—Bradley has recorded 135 SO in his first 22 career starts, fourth most in any pitcher's first 22 starts after joining the Rays, trailing Charlie Morton (163SO, 2019), Drew Smyly (148SO, 2014-16) and Tyler Glasnow (136SO, 2018-19)...Morton (165) also holds the mark through 23 starts, followed by Smyly (154SO) and Glasnow (140SO)...Bradley's 135 SO are the most by a Ray in his first 22 career starts.

In 2023, Bradley posted a 28.4 pct. strikeout rate, the highest mark by a rookie in Rays history (min. 300BF), surpassing Shane McClanahan's 27.3 pct. in 2021.

On June 15, 2023 at OAK, he recorded each of his first nine outs via the strikeout, becoming the first MLB rookie to accomplish the feat since ATL Spencer Strider on July 7, 2022 vs. STL...his 11 SO on the day were tied with six other pitchers for the second most by a Rays rookie, trailing only Dan Wheeler (12SO) on Sept. 12, 1999 vs. OAK.

LONG BALL WOES—Bradley's 22 HR allowed as a starter are the most through a Rays pitcher's first 22 career in franchise history...last season, from his April 12 debut through June 15, his 0.84 HR/9.0 IP was 12th lowest in the AL (min. 40.0IP)...from that point on, his 2.77 HR/9.0 IP was second highest in the majors (min. 50.0IP) behind MIN Joe Ryan (2.79)... he permitted at least 1 HR in seven straight starts from June 21–July 29, the longest streak by a Rays pitcher since Jake Odorizzi (15GS) from May 1–July 23, 2017.

2023 RECAP—After entering the season ranked as the Rays No. 1 prospect and the No. 16 prospect in the majors (MLB.com), Bradley went 5-8 with a 5.56 ERA over 22 games (21GS) in his first MLB season...had four stints with the Rays: April 11-13, April 18-25, May 18–July 31, and Sept. 3–end of the season...he was the youngest pitcher in the majors to make 20+ starts, becoming the third pitcher (4th instance) in Rays history to make 20+ starts in an age 22 or younger season, joining Scott Kazmir (32GS, 2005; 24GS, 2006) and Joe Kennedy (20GS, 2001).

He went 5-3 with a 3.86 ERA (49.0IP, 21ER) over his first 10 career starts, a stretch that culminated in his first career quality start on June 21 vs. BAL.

Over his final 13 appearances (11GS), he went 0-5 with a 7.11 ERA
