THE GRAPEFRUIT GANG: The St. Louis Cardinals are playing the second half of their 29th Spring Training at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium (1998-2026) ... On Monday, March 23, the Cardinals break camp in Florida and fly to Springfield, Mo. to play an exhibition with the Double-A Cardinals at Hammons Field at 6:05 p.m. CT.

NATITUDE: Starting today, four of the next eight Cardinals games are against the Washington Nationals ... St. Louis is 18-8-7 against Washington at Cacti Park of the Palm Beaches since the Nats relocated to West Palm Beach for Spring Training in 2017.

PLAYING FOR KEEPS: In 15 days on Thursday, March 26, the Cardinals will host the Tampa Bay Rays on Opening Day, the earliest game in franchise history.

• St. Louis played on March 27 last season vs. Minnesota, a 5-3 Redbirds winner at Busch Stadium.

CARDS SPRING ROSTER STANDS AT 43: The Cardinals reduced their Spring Training roster to 43 players yesterday after re-assigning RHP **Max Rajcic**, LHP **Bruce Zimmermann**, and OF **Chase Davis** to Minor League camp.

IN FULL BLOOM: The Cardinals introduced **Chaim Bloom** on Sept. 30 as the team's new President of Baseball Operations taking the post that had been held by **John Mozeliak** who headed the team's baseball operations since Oct. of 2007 ... Bloom, who worked previously with the Boston Red Sox (2020-23) and Tampa Bay Rays (2005-19) had served as an advisor for the Cardinals the past two seasons.

RED JACKETS: 12 Cardinals Hall of Famers scheduled to be present on 2026 Opening Day at Busch Stadium include **Ozzie Smith**, **Édgar Rentería**, **Tony La Russa**, **Ray Lankford**, **Ted Simmons**, **Vince Coleman**, **John Tudor**, **Jason Isringhausen**, **Willie McGee**, **Mark McGwire**, **Al Hrabosky**, and **Scott Rolen**.

The 2026 edition features **Alec Burleson** and **Masyn Winn** and on the cover displaying their offseason hardware.

WHITE NAMED BUCK O'NEIL AWARD WINNER: The National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum's Board of Directors selected **Bill White** as the 2026 recipient of the John Jordan "Buck" O'Neil Lifetime Achievement Award, presented to an individual for extraordinary efforts to enhance baseball's positive impact on society ... The 92-year-old White will be honored at the Awards Presentation on July 25, as part of 2026 Hall of Fame Weekend ... White played eight seasons in St. Louis (1959-65, '69) and was inducted into the Cardinals Hall of Fame in 2020.

WORLD CLASS: The Cardinals have nine players, two coaches, and one athletic trainer on provisional rosters for the 2026 World Baseball Classic ... Among those in Major League camp include **Riley O'Brien** (Korea), **Leo Bernal** (Panama), **Gordon Graceffo** (Italy), **Thomas Saggese** (Italy), **Luis Gastelum** (Mexico), **Matt Koperniak** (Great Britain), **Bryan Torres** (Puerto Rico), coaches **Stubby Clapp** (Canada) and **Julio Rangel** (Panama), and Asst. Athletic Trainer **Chris Conroy** (Puerto Rico).

FEELING A DRAFT: The Cardinals own six of the top 86 picks (13, 32, 50, 68, 72, 86) in the upcoming 2026 MLB Draft, the most of any Major League team ... Since the DeWitt ownership group (1996-present), 2026 will be only the third time St. Louis has possessed as many as six of the top 86 selections, following 2005 (6 of top 78) and 2012 (6 of top 86).

100: **Masyn Winn** was named the 2025 winner of the Rawlings Gold Glove Award at shortstop, the first of his career and the 100th by the Cardinals - the most all-time for any MLB franchise since the award's inception in 1957 ... Winn joined **Ozzie Smith** (11 times), **Édgar Rentería** (2), and **Dal Maxvill** (1) as the fourth Cardinals shortstop to win the award.

TODAY'S PITCHERS

#3 DUSTIN MAY · RHP · 6-6 · 215 LBS · AGE 28

- Signed by the Cardinals to a one-year contract with a mutual option for a second year, December 17, 2025. Was his first free agent contract.
- Played the majority of his professional and Major League career with the Dodgers organization before being traded to the Boston Red Sox at the 2025 trade deadline.
- Missed the entire 2024 season recovering from Tommy John surgery repairing a torn flexor tendon in his right arm from July 2023 and an esophageal tear in July.
- When he made his season debut on April 1, 2025 vs. Atlanta, was his first action in a Major League game in 685 days dating back to May 17, 2023.
- Carries three World Championship rings as a member of the Los Angeles Dodgers. Played in the 2020 World Series at the neutral site at Globe Life Field, home of the Texas Rangers. Was on the Injured List during the 2024 World Series. Was traded before the Dodgers won the World Series in 2025.
- Became the first Dodgers rookie to make an Opening Day start when he took the mound on July 24, 2020 in place of injured Clayton Kershaw. The last Dodgers rookie to make an Opening Day start was Fernando Valenzuela in 1981.
- Pitched for the National League in the 2019 Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game at Progressive Field in Cleveland. Pitched a scoreless 3rd inning in the game. Was teammates with current Cardinals infielder Nolan Gorman.

#49 MATT SVANSON · RHP · 6-6 · 240 LBS · AGE 27

- Acquired by the Cardinals from the Blue Jays at the 2023 Trade Deadline for INF Paul DeJong and cash considerations.
- Made his MLB debut on April 17, 2025 at the New York Mets, working a scoreless 7th inning with one hit allowed. His college head coach made the drive from Lehigh to Citi Field for the game and returned for his weekend series that night.
- Has converted 39 consecutive save opportunities since May 23, 2023, with the first six as a member of the Blue Jays organization followed by 33 straight with the Cardinals.
- The 39 consecutive save streak currently ranks as the longest active in Minor League Baseball and 4th longest since MiLB records date back to 2005 (Brian Anderson, 41, Mike James, 40, Wander Suero, 40).
- Holds an active streak of at least one strikeout in each of his final 20 appearances with St. Louis, the longest such streak by a Cardinals reliever since Jordan Hicks had a 22-game streak in 2023 and longest a Cardinals rookie relief pitcher since at least 1954, as well as the second-longest active streak by an MLB reliever (1st, CHW's Mike Vasil, 29).
- Posted a .160 opponent batting average in 2025 that was the lowest in Cardinals franchise history by a rookie relief pitcher, and his 24 strikeouts in August tied Todd Worrell for the most in a single month by a Cardinals rookie relief pitcher.

#47 JUSTIN BRUIHL · LHP · 6-0 · 215 LBS · AGE 28

- Acquired by the Cardinals from the Guardians for cash considerations, January 6, 2026.
- Former non-drafted free agent looking to appear in games with fifth Major League club, previously appearing in 94 total games with the Dodgers (65), Blue Jays (15), Rockies (7) and Pirates (7). Signed as a free agent with the Reds in 2024, but did not pitch in a Major League game.
- Pitched in 15 games in relief for the American League Champion Blue Jays.
- Appeared in four career postseason games, three with the Dodgers in the 2021 National League Championship Series and one with the Blue Jays vs. NYY in the 2025 American League Division Series. Did not allow a run in his three appearances vs. ATL with one hit and five strikeouts.

#99 GERSON MORENO · RHP · 6-0 · 220 LBS · AGE 30

- Purchased by the Cardinals from the Lancaster Stormers of the Atlantic League on July 31, 2025 and signed to a minor league contract.
- Was previously invited to Major League Spring Training for five straight seasons with the Tigers (2020-22), Nationals (2023) and the Athletics (2024).
- Pitched in his first professional game when he was age 17 and has made 350 minor league appearances over 12 seasons for four different organizations (Tigers, Nationals, Athletics, Cardinals).
- Struck out a career-high 96 batters with Erie (AA) in 2022.
- Exploded for a career season with Rochester (AAA) in 2023, appearing in a career-high 59 games tied for the International League lead, 71.2 innings and seven wins also career-bests.
