**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The St. Louis Cardinals conclude their longest road trip of the season (9 games/10 day) this afternoon in Houston. The trip began in Cincinnati (2-1), moved on to Philadelphia which included an open date prior to the series and will conclude in the Space City. Following today's matinee, the team will fly back to St. Louis to begin a seven-game homestand over eight days against the Colorado Rockies (June 6-9) and Pittsburgh Pirates (June 11-13).

**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The Cardinals lost to the Astros 8-5 last night and dropped their second straight series after winning the previous five. St. Louis has lost four of their last five games overall and their last four to the Astros dating back to June 28, 2023, getting outscored 39-16 in those games.

**WHAT A LONG STRANGE "RISP" IT'S BEEN:** The Cardinals have had success hitting the longball during this eight-game road trip plating 20 of their 30 runs via home run. However, the Cardinals have been 8-for-51 with runners in scoring position with only three of those hits w/RISP scoring runs. St. Louis has five hits w/RISP that have not plated runs (Masyn Winn 4, Dylan Carlson 1).

**OPENING WHACKED:** The Cardinals have homered in the 1st inning for the third consecutive day and game last night. **Nolan Gorman** homered in the opening frame on Sunday night, both Gorman and **Alec Burleson** on Monday and Burleson last night. It marked the first time since October 1-3, 2021 vs. Chicago (NL), the Cardinals pulled it off when **Tyler O'Neill** (10/1), **Harrison Bader** (10/2) and **Tommy Edman** (10/3) each homered in the opening frame. The last time the Cardinals hit a home run in the 1st inning of four straight games was Aug. 30-Sept. 3, 2021, with shots from **Paul Goldschmidt** (8/30/21 & 9/1/21-G1 at CIN), **Tommy Edman** (9/1/21-G2 at CIN) and **Nolan Arenado** (9/3/21 at MIL). This was the only time the Cardinals accomplished it in the Expansion Era (since 1961) - *Elias Sports Bureau*

**TRIFECTA QUINELLA:** **Nolan Gorman** and **Alec Burleson** have each homered in the same game for the last three games dating back to Sunday. According to *Elias Sports Bureau*, this marked the first time in Cardinals history the feat has been accomplished on three consecutive game days. The Cincinnati Reds were the last team to pull it off in Major League Baseball as **TJ Friedl** and **Christian Encarnacion-Strand** did it last September 23-26, 2023.

**NO SWEEP ZONE:** The Cardinals have been swept twice this season, both instances at home. Milwaukee came to Busch Stadium and took three games April 19-21 and the New York Mets swept a pair of games in a weather-shortened series May 6-7, with a May 8th game postponed to August. The last time the Cardinals were swept on the road was in Philadelphia, August 25-27, 2023. The last time the Cardinals were swept by the Astros was June 14-15, 2016 at Busch Stadium and in a three-game series was August 30-Sept. 1, 2010 at Minute Maid Park.

**CRAWFORD STREET:** Entering tonight's game, Cardinals shortstop **Brandon Crawford** holds the longest active hit streak against the Astros among current players. Crawford is currently on a 14-game hit streak against the 'Stros dating back to May 12, 2015, with his last game against them on August 1, 2021. **Ryan Klesko** holds the all-time longest hitting streak against the Astros, hitting safely in 29 straight games from 1999-2002 with the Braves and Padres. The Cardinals record is held by **Lou Brock** with 20 games from 1968-69, 6th longest in history.

**STORMIN' NOLAN GORMAN:** Cardinals second baseman **Nolan Gorman** has been on a tear this road trip smacking a Major League best six home runs over his last seven games since May 28. The torrid stretch began in Cincinnati (2 HR) and continued on through Philadelphia (HR) and Houston (3 HR). The last two nights, he connected for his 8th career multi-home run game (Monday) and blasted his 14th home run of the season last night. The 24-year old slugger from Arizona currently ranks tied for 2nd in the National League with 14 home runs, 6th in the league in slugging (.508) and 2nd in AB/HR (13.07). Gorman has matched his total of 14 home runs through the first 59 games from the 2023 season.

**GOLD-RUSH:** **Paul Goldschmidt** extended his on-base streak to 21 games last night. The 21-game streak is currently the 6th-longest active in MLB. Goldschmidt is four shy of the Cardinals mark for this season with 25 held by **Nolan Arenado**. The career-long for Goldschmidt is 46 games with the Cardinals in 2022. This is currently the 8th-longest of his career and tied for his 3rd-longest as a Cardinal.

#### HOUSTON CONNECTIONS

**Paul Goldschmidt** graduated from The Woodlands (Tex.) High School...grew up a fan of **Jeff Bagwell** and **Craig Biggio**...as a high school senior, was seated in the center field upper deck at Minute Maid Park when **Albert Pujols** hit the famous home run off Astros closer **Brad Lidge** in Game 5 of the 2005 NLCS...played college baseball at Texas State University (2007-09) in San Marcos, Tex. where he left as the school's all-time leader in home runs (36) and RBI (178)...his No. 37 was retired in Feb. 2015, becoming the first TSU baseball player to have his jersey retired.

**Paul Goldschmidt** and **Nolan Arenado** were teammates with **Alex Bregman** on the gold-winning USA squad in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

**Kyle Tucker** and **Ryan Pressly** were teammates with Goldschmidt, Arenado, **Miles Mikolas**, and **Adam Wainwright** on the USA squad in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

**Matt Carpenter** was born in Galveston, Tex... graduated from Elkins High School in Prosper, Tex... played college baseball at Texas Christian University...resides in Glen Rose, Tex.

**Masyn Winn** was born in Katy, Tex...graduated from Kingwood (Tex.) High School in 2020...resides in Kingwood, Tex.

**John King** was born in Laredo, Tex...graduated from Clements (Tex.) High School...played college baseball at Angelina College in Lufkin, Tex. before transferring to the University of Houston...resides in Grand Prairie, Tex.

First Base Coach **Stubby Clapp** worked five seasons (2007-12) in the Astros organization, serving as hitting coach for A-Lexington for three seasons (2007-09), one season as hitting coach for Double-A Corpus Christi (2010), and taking on his first managerial role with short-season Tri-City for two seasons (2011-12).

**Giovanny Gallegos** made his MLB debut (with the Yankees) against Houston on May 12, 2017 at Yankee Stadium...his first strikeout victim was Houston's **Brian McCann** (swinging) on May 14, 2017.

Astros Quality Assurance Coach **Jason Bell** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Parkway Central High School...earned college baseball at Saint Louis Univ. and the Univ. of Central Missouri.

Astros Manager **Joe Espada** played in eight games for Triple-A Memphis in 2003.

**Jeremy Peña** is the son of **Gerónimo Peña**, who played six seasons with the Cardinals (1990-95).

Asst. Hitting Coach **Brandon Allen** was born in Conroe, Tex...graduated from Montgomery (Tex.) High School...earned football scholarship to Rice University as a linebacker/defensive end and a baseball scholarship at the University of Houston.

Astros Community Outreach Exec. **José Cruz** played five seasons with St. Louis (1970-74).

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 13th start of the season and his 163rd career (191st appearance).
- Looking for his first career win vs. HOU, one of nine teams remaining.
- All three wins this season have come on the road. Since joining St. Louis in 2018, has a winning record on the road (30-28) and losing mark at Busch Stadium (23-25).
- Has thrown over 100 pitches in only one of his 12 starts (101 on May 1 at Detroit).
- Is 10.2 innings pitched away from 1,000 for his career.
- This season, has the 2nd-highest qualifying ERA (5.54) in the National League and 3rd-highest opponent BA (.281). **Patrick Corbin** (5.83 and .318) leads both categories.
- In his 152 starts as a member of the Cardinals, St. Louis is 61-31 when Miles throws 6.0 or more innings (3-3 this season), while the Cardinals are 23-37 when he works 5.2 innings or fewer.
- Mikolas is an amazing 45-5 (.900 win pct) as a Cardinal when receiving 3 or more runs in support (Cardinals 60-14 in those 74 games). He's just 8-48 (.143) when receiving 2 runs or fewer (Cardinals 24-55).
- His loss vs. Milwaukee (April 20, 2024) was his first ever as a Cardinal when receiving 4+ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Hasn't committed an error since August 2, 2018 vs. COL. Is the only MLB pitcher with 100+ total chances and zero errors since Aug 3, 2018. Ranks 4th among Major League pitchers in fielding pct. (.989) since 2018.

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Earned his team-leafing 6th loss on Friday in Philadelphia, highlighted by an Edmundo Sosa three-run home run in the third inning of the 4-2 defeat. Marked his 3rd quality start in his last six outings.

- Is 23-25 in his 74 starts at Busch Stadium as a Cardinal (St. Louis is 42-32).
- Ranks among Busch Stadium III rankings in starts (74, 6th), innings pitched (451.0, 7th), ERA (3.43, 6th), quality starts (42, 6th), and wins (23, T-5th).

**CAREER**

- St. Louis is 84-69 (.552) in his 152 career outings (153 starts) since joining the organization (2018-present).
- Since joining St. Louis in 2018, Mikolas trails only **Clayton Kershaw** (67.6%) with the 2nd-highest percentage of first pitch strikes in MLB with 67.4%.
- Has entered his 7th season (was injured in 2020) with the Cardinals in 2024. Is currently ranked 2nd among active Cardinals pitchers in career innings pitched (886.0), wins (53), strikeouts (650) and games started (150) for St. Louis; trailing only **Lance Lynn** in all categories.
- Two-time NL All-Star (2018 & 2022). Did not appear in 2022 at Dodger Stadium and chose to miss the 2018 game in Washington D.C. to be with his wife as they welcomed twins.
- Led Major League Baseball with 35 starts in 2023, becoming the first pitcher to record 35 starts in a season since **Jhoulys Chacin** (35) in 2018 with Milwaukee. Was the first Cardinals pitcher since **Chris Carpenter** (35 in 2009) to do so.
- Has registered 32 or more starts in every season in which he was not injured or sidelined by COVID-19 protocols.
