- Corbin Carroll (OF) and Geraldo Perdomo (SS) each aim to make their second-career All-Star roster since both being named in 2023.
- **Eugenio Suárez (3B)** looks to make his second All-Star roster (also: 2018 with Reds).

SNAKES BACK ON FS1 TONIGHT: Tonight's D-backs game with be simulcast on FS1 with Connor Onion and Eric Karros calling the game remotely.

Saturday's game will be exclusively on FOX with Jason Benetti and Adam Wainwright in the booth...Sunday's finale broadcast will return to DBACKS.TV.

LAST GAME: Yesterday, the D-backs lost 4-2 @ Reds.

- Eugenio Suárez homered (solo, 18) in the second inning...his 101 homers @ Great American Ball Park rank
- Kyle Backhus made his MLB debut with 1.0 perfect inning...first career strikeout was Elly De La Cruz.
- Corbin Carroll had a RBI single and 1 walk.
- Ketel Marte, with his 2 walks, extended his on-base streak to 21 games.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled RHP Christian Montes De Oca and placed RHP Kendall Graveman (right hip impingement) on the 15-day injured list, retro. June 8.

RECENT SLUG: Since May 31, the D-backs' 14 homers rank second in the NL, behind the Mets (22), while their .424 SLG is third, behind the Mets (.517) and Dodgers (.459).

MARTE LOOKING LIKE AN ALL-STAR: Ketel Marte ranks among all active players during their careers in June (min. 300 PA) in AVG (4th, .329) and OPS (7th, .977).

• Marte has reached base safely in 14 consecutive June games, dating back to June 23, 2024, batting .396 (19for-48)/1.350 OPS with 3 doubles, 6 homers, 15 RBI, 12 walks and 6 strikeouts.

21 STRAIGHT FOR MARTE: Ketel Marte's season-best 21game on-base streak (since May 13) is the fourth-longest active streak in the Majors, behind Jose Ramírez/ CLE (34 G), Vinnie Pasquantino/KC (24 G) and Ozzie Albies/ATL (23 G)...in the span, Marte is hitting .316 (25for-79)/1.127 OPS with 2 doubles, 9 homers, 16 RBI, 14 walks and 4 hit-by-pitches. D-BACKS 2025 TV BROADCAST CHANNELS & STREAMING: D-backs | • Since May 13, Marte's 1.127 OPS is fourth in MLB, behind Aaron Judge/NYY (1.227), Cal Raleigh/SEA (1.216) and Jose Ramírez/CLE (1.135), while his 9 homers are tied for fourth with Judge and Taylor Ward/LAA, behind Raleigh (13), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (11) and Isaac Paredes/HOU (10).

> TIES TO THE EMERALD CITY: Corbin Carroll, a Seattle native and 2019 graduate of Lakeside School (11.0 miles from T-Mobile Park), was the Gatorade Washington Player of the Year as a senior (.540 AVG, 9 HR, 26 RBI)...his first baseball memory is being a young boy sitting in the upper deck on the first base side at then-Safeco Field watching Ichiro Suzuki play right field...Carroll met Ichiro in 2019 and took away an important lesson from his lifelong idol: "Be consistent in your routine."

- **Ketel Marte** played his first 2 seasons for the Mariners in 2015-16 before being acquired by the D-backs.
- Eugenio Suárez played for the Mariners in 2022-23.
- · Ryan Thompson grew up in Turner, Oregon, roughly 4 hours south of Seattle, and as a kid, his dad would take him on an annual trip to a Mariners home series.

FROM THE DEFENSE END: Over their 6 matchups vs. Mariners since 2023, the D-backs have not committed a fielding error (excl. catcher's interference on April 28, 2024).

- Since May 15, the D-backs are 1 of 8 teams to go errorless in the outfield (also: Orioles, Yankees, Braves, Cubs, Cardinals, Mets and Royals).
- **Alek Thomas** is 1 of 7 primary center fielders (min. 400 inn.) without an error (also: Julio Rodríguez/SEA, Byron Buxton/MIN, Trent Grisham/NYY, TJ Friedl/CIN, Michael Harris II/ATL and Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC).

NO PLACE LIKE CHASE: Josh Naylor has reached base safely in 13 straight home games since May 8, hitting .333 (16-for-48)/.893 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBI, 3 walks and 2 stolen bases.

- Lourdes Gurriel Jr. has reached base safely in 7 straight home games and hit safely in 6 of the 7, since May 17, batting .400 (10-for-25)/1.076 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 5 RBI and 5 walks.
- Ketel Marte has reached base safely in 7 straight home games, since May 16, batting .308 (8-for-26)/.894 OPS with 1 homer, 3 RBI, 5 walks and 3 HBP.

- In his last 5 starts, is 3-0 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER in 32.0 IP).
- Has 11 consecutive starts of 5.0+ innings (5-1; 2.55 ERA).
- •In his 6 home starts, is 3-1 with a 3.03 ERA (12 ER in 35.2 IP) and 32 strikeouts.
- Has tossed 7.0+ innings with 1 run or fewer allowed in 3 of his last 5 starts.
- Is 4-0 with a 2.81 ERA following a loss.

LAST START: Earned his sixth win after tossing a season-best-tying 7.0 scoreless innings (including 5.2 no-hit innings) with 1 hit, 1 walk and 8 strikeouts.

- Eclipsed 900.0 career innings in the final frame.
- Collected his 59th win as a D-back, passing Curt Schilling (58) for third in franchise history, behind Randy Johnson (118) and Brandon Webb (87).

VS. MARINERS: Second career start, second @ Chase Field.

• Made his lone start on July 30, 2023 (L; 3 ER in 5.0 IP).

VS. AL WEST: Fourth straight home start when facing an AL West opponent (last Sept. 11, 2024 vs. Rangers).

• In 2 of his last 4 starts, has allowed 1 run over 7.0 innings.

GIVE 'EM THE CHANGEUP: His 51.0 chase pct. on his changeup ranks best in the Majors among starting pitchers (min. 100 pitches), ahead of Gavin Williams/CLE (50.0), Paul Skenes/PIT (48.8) and Tarik Skubal/DET (48.7).

"That's the pitch I go to when I need something, it always has been... When it's on, it's one of the pitches I go to when I need one. If I can locate it, it's a super tough pitch to hit for a couple different reasons. It looks like the fastball, similar speed as the fastball, and I try to make it look like the fastball as much as I can."

CUTTING EDGE: His .083 AVG off his cutter is the lowest among NL starting pitchers (2nd in MLB).

STAY AHEAD: When ahead in the count, is holding batters to a .109 AVG (11-for-101) with 0 walks and 36 strikeouts.

FROM THE SECOND TIME ON: His .189 opponent AVG (33-for-175) from the second time thru the order on ranks sixth among NL starters.

PICKOFF PROWESS: His 10 pickoffs since 2022 are tied with David Peterson/NYM and Jesús Luzardo/PHI for sixth among starting pitchers, behind Taijuan Walker (15), Patrick Corbin (14), Max Fried/NYY (12), Charlie Morton/BAL (12) and Robbie Ray/SF (11).

CLIMBING THE FRANCHISE LIST: His 816 career strikeouts rank seventh on the club's all-time strikeouts list, behind Randy Johnson (2,077), Brandon Webb (1,065), Robbie Ray (998), Zac Gallen (917), Patrick Corbin (897) and Curt Schilling (875).

2024 RECAP: Went 5-1 with a 4.17 ERA (38 R-36 ER in 77.2 IP) and 65 strikeouts over 13 starts in his sixth season with the D-backs.

- Placed on the 15-day injured list (right shoulder strain) on April 23... transferred to the 60-day injured list on May 2...reinstated from the 60-day injured list (right shoulder strain) on Aug. 11.
- Since Aug. 11, his 13.86 strikes looking above average (SLAA) and his 111.5 pct. strikes looking rate vs. Average (SL+) were the highest among NL starters.
- Threw 6 different pitches 10+ times each (first time in career).

CONSECUTIVE 5.0+-INNING STREAK: His 38 consecutive starts of 5.0+ innings from April 6, 2023-Sept. 5, 2024 marked the second longest streak in the Majors since 2022, behind only Mitch Keller (49 straight starts; April 5, 2023-July 8, 2024).

POSTSEASON WARRIOR: In Game 2 of the World Series @ Rangers on Oct. 28, 2023, became the fourth D-backs pitcher (5 times overall) to allow 1 run or fewer over 7.0+ innings in a World Series start (also: Randy Johnson, Curt Schilling [2x] and Miguel Batista...additionally, his 9 strikeouts tied Schilling for second-most strikeouts in a World Series game by a D-backs starter behind Johnson's 11 strikeouts.

 Also retired the first 11 batters, surpassing the record for most consecutive batters retired by a D-backs pitcher to start a World Series game (prev: 10 by Randy Johnson on Oct. 28, 2001 in Game 2 vs. Yankees) [Elias Sports Bureau].

USA! USA!: Selected to pitch for Team USA in the 2023 World Baseball Classic, his the first time pever articipating with a national team.

- Went 0-1 with an 8.31 ERA (4 ER in 4.1 IP) over 2 games.
- Started the fourth game vs. Colombia and championship vs. Japan.

ARIZONA KID: Grew up in Scottsdale, Ariz., and attended Desert Mountain High School, Yavapai College and Arizona State University... attended Arizona State University (2010) and helped the Sun Devils reach the College World Series in 2010...went to Yavapai College in Prescott, Ariz. (2008-09) and went 15-1 in 2 seasons.
