PITTSBURGH PIRATES (34-29) vs. ATLANTA BRAVES (42-21)

June 5, 2026 - Truist Park - Atlanta, GA - 7:15 EDT - Game #64/Road #31

RHP Mitch Keller (5-2, 4.35 ERA) vs. LHP Martín Pérez (3-3, 2.79 ERA)

THE PIRATES: won two of three games at Houston (Tuesday-Thursday), including a 5-1 win on Thursday at Daikin Park, to begin this six-game, seven-day road trip...Have won eight of their last 11 games (since May 24 at Toronto)...Will return to Pittsburgh for a six-game homestand vs. Los Angeles-NL (June 9-11) and Miami (June 12-14) following this weekend's series at Truist Park (Friday-Sunday)...Have scored the fourth-most runs (325) in Major League Baseball, behind Washington (331), Los Angeles-NL (330) and Atlanta (329)...Have stolen the third-most bases (62) in MLB, behind Miami (71) & Milwaukee (63)...Have not been six games over .500 since they were 11-5 after a victory on April 14, 2024 at Philadelphia...Have not been six games over .500 this late in a year since they were 67-61 after their victory on August 28, 2016 at Milwaukee.

JUST PEACHY: Pittsburgh will conclude its six-game, seven-day road trip with this three-game series (Friday-Sunday) at Atlanta's Truist Park...The Pirates won four of six games against the Braves last season (they won two of three games from May 9-11 at PNC Park and two of three games to end the season from September 26-28 here at Truist Park)...It was their first season series victory over the Braves since winning five of seven games in 2017...The series win in Atlanta was Pittsburgh's first at Truist Park (opened in 2017) and its first in the city of Atlanta since winning two of three contests from June 5-7, 2015 at Turner Field.

THAT'S SO BRAVE: Bryan Reynolds is 49-for-154 (.318) with seven doubles, two triples, five home runs and 18 RBI in 40 career games against Atlanta...He is 32-for-179 (.405) with seven doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI and a 1.118 OPS in 21 career games at Truist Park...Reynolds' .405 average here is the best among visiting players in stadium history (minimum 80 plate appearances).

POKED THE BEAR: Marcell Ozuna, who played in 683 games with Atlanta from 2020-25, is returning to Truist Park for the first time since being signed as a free agent on February 16...His 81 career home runs here are the third-most in stadium history (since 2017), trailing only Ronald Acuña Jr. (100) & Austin Riley (89)...He is 4-for-7 with three doubles in his career against Martín Pérez.

IN DEEP THOUGHT: Ryan O'Hearn hit a two-run blast on Thursday at Houston, marking the Pirates' 11th straight game with a homer (since May 24 at Toronto)...The Pirates have had only four other such streaks in the Modern Era (since 1901), coming from July 1-9, 1966 (12 games), June 19-July 3, 1994 (13 games), June 23-July 3, 2012 (11 games) and August 5-18, 2015 (12 games).

LOWE OR NEVER: Brandon Lowe hit two doubles and scored two runs on Thursday at Houston...It was his second career game with two doubles and two runs (he also did that on July 25, 2024 with Tampa Bay at Toronto)...Lowe's eight games with multiple extra-base hits this season lead all of Major League Baseball (Bryan Reynolds led Pittsburgh with nine such games in 2025)...His 30 total extra-base hits (14 doubles, one triple, 15 homers) rank seventh in Major League Baseball...Only Atlanta's Matt Olson (36), Houston's Yordan Alvarez (34), New York (AL)'s Ben Rice (34), Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber (33), Arizona's Corbin Carroll (32) & Washington's James Wood (31) have posted more extra-base hits than Lowe.

EXTRA! EXTRA! Pittsburgh has at least one extra-base hit in 36 straight games (since April 26 at Milwaukee)...That is the second-longest active streak in all of MLB, behind San Francisco (38 straight games, since April 24).

CRUZ CONTROL: Oneil Cruz went 2-for-2 with two walks on Thursday at Houston...He is 13-for-33 (.394) with three home runs, 10 RBI, nine walks, four stolen bases and eight runs in his last 10 games (since May 25 vs. Chicago-NL)...His 1.202 OPS in that stretch is sixth in Major League Baseball.

HIGH FIVE: The Pirates have scored at least five runs in six straight games (since May 29 vs. Minnesota) for the first time since also doing that in six consecutive contests from September 18-24, 2021...Their last such streak of at least seven contests was a seven-game streak from July 14 (G2)-24, 2018.

June 5, 2015: Neil Walker connected for a three-run home run in Pittsburgh's 10-8 win over Atlanta at Turner Field. Francisco Cervelli had a career-high-tying four hits, two RBI and a run scored. Starling Marte went 2-for-3 with a home run, three RBI, two walks and three runs scored in the victory. Charlie Morton improved to 3-0 after tossing 5.0 innings. Mark Melancon secured his 17th save of the season.

LAST TIME OUT: Keller had a no-decision after allowing a season-high seven runs on a season-high 10 hits over 4.0 innings in Pittsburgh's 10-9 win on May 30 vs. Minnesota.

AGAINST THE BRAVES: Keller has a 7.31 ERA (32.0ip/26er) in seven career starts against Atlanta, including a 10.80 ERA (16.2ip/20er) in four starts here in Atlanta...He had six strikeouts across 3.2 innings in his 2025 finale on September 26 at Truist Park.

ON THE ROAD: Keller is 2-0 with a 3.14 ERA (28.2ip/10er) in five road starts this year... He allowed one run over 6.0 innings in his last road start (came on May 24 at Toronto).

K IS FOR KELLER: Keller enters tonight's start at Atlanta with the eighth-most strikeouts (888) in Pirates history...He surpassed Rick Rhoden (852) in his start on April 19 vs. Tampa Bay and Deacon Phillippe (861) during his start on April 25 at Milwaukee...He passed Dock Ellis (869) for eighth place in his start on May 7 at Arizona.

RIGHT PLACE, RIGHT TIME: Keller has limited right-handed hitters to a .175 batting average against (17-for-97) and a .452 OPS...His second-inning double allowed to Kazuma Okamoto on May 24 at Toronto was his first extra-base hit allowed to a righthander since last year on September 12 at Washington (Brady House, solo homer).

SIX PACK: Keller pitched 6.0 innings and allowed two or fewer runs in each of his first three starts this season (March 28 at New York-NL, April 3 vs. Baltimore, April 8 vs. San Diego)...He was the first Pirate to toss at least 6.0 innings while allowing two or fewer runs in each of his first three starts of a season since Joe Musgrove (April 5-16, 2019).

CONSISTENT KELLER: Keller pitched 6.0 scoreless innings during his start on April 8 vs. San Diego, marking his second scoreless start of at least 6.0 innings through his first three starts of the 2026 campaign (also March 28 at New York-NL)...He joined Salomon Torres (2002), Zach Duke (2005), Jeff Karstens (2008), Wandy Rodriguez (2013) and Jameson Taillon (2018) as the only Pirates during the 21st century with two scoreless starts of at least 6.0 innings through their first three games of a season...Keller's 17 starts of at least 6.0 scoreless innings during his career (since 2019) are the 10th-most by any Pirate in the Live Ball Era (since 1920)...Paul Skenes, who has done that on three occasions this season, ranks tied for 12th on the list (15).

DAZZLING DEBUT: Keller scattered three hits without issuing a walk (had three strikeouts) over 6.0 scoreless innings, but had a no-decision in Pittsburgh's 4-2, 11-inning loss on March 28 at New York (NL)...Keller left with the game scoreless after six frames...The Pirates took a short-lived, 1-0 lead into the bottom of the 10th before the Mets tied it...Pittsburgh also added a run in the top of the 11th before New York's Luis Robert Jr. hit a walkoff, three-run home run off Hunter Barco in the bottom half... Keller joined Vance Worley (June 15, 2014 at Miami), Nick Kingham (April 29, 2018 vs. St. Louis) and Joe Musgrove (May 25, 2018 vs. St. Louis) as the only Pirates in the 21st century to toss at least 6.0 scoreless innings without allowing a walk in a season debut.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY: Keller had 17 quality starts in 2025, his third straight season with at least 15 quality starts (he had 18 in 2023 and 15 in 2024)...Prior to Keller, the last Pirate to do that in three straight seasons was Paul Maholm from 2008-10 (A.J. Burnett did it from 2012-13 and in 2015, but he pitched for Philadelphia in 2014)...Keller made his 30th start of 2025 on September 12 at Washington, marking his third consecutive season with at least 30 starts...He joined Maholm (2008-10) and Ian Snell (2006-08) as the only Pirates pitchers in the 21st century to accomplish that.

- ⓧ Connected for his 15th home run of the year with his three-run blast during Tuesday night's victory at Houston (was the 800th game of his career).
- ⓧ His 15 home runs this season are already the most by any Pittsburgh second baseman in a single season since Neil Walker (16) in the 2015 season.
