Atlanta suffered its second consecutive one-run defeat last night, falling to San Diego, 2-1. Of the Braves' 50 games this season, a major-league most 22 have been decided by one run (44.0%).

The Braves are 9-13 (.409) in one-run outcomes, including four straight losses in such games. Atlanta last won a one-run game on May 12 vs. Washington.

Thirteen of Atlanta's 20 games (65%) in the month of May have been decided by one run, three more than any other team in baseball. The Braves have played just five games this month in which the outcome was decided by at least three runs.

Last night's game was the 13th for Atlanta this season that was tied in the ninth inning, and the Braves dropped to 7-6 (.538) in these games.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Padres today continue a three-game weekend set with the sixth of seven games between the clubs this season...The teams opened the 2025 season with a four-game series at Petco Park on Opening Weekend.

 San Diego scored a run in the ninth to break a tie and win the opener, 2-1, over Atlanta last night...The Braves have lost all five games with the Padres this season.

 The Padres swept four games in San Diego to open the season, including back-to-back shutouts in the final two games of the series...The Braves had not been swept in a four-game set to open the season since 1980, when they dropped all four games to the Cincinnati Reds by a combined score of 25-4.

 Atlanta has gone 3-4 against San Diego in each of the last three seasons, snapping a streak of five consecutive years in which the Braves won the season set from 2016-2021.

 The Braves are 13-13 (.500) all-time versus the Padres here at Truist Park, but have not won a series against San Diego at home since 2018...Atlanta won eight of the first nine games between the two teams here, including a four-game sweep in the first series ever played at Truist Park in 2017...However, the Braves have dropped 11 of the last 15 games with the Padres here.

 RH Grant Holmes is set today to make the first start of his career versus San Diego, and his second appearance all-time against the club...The right-hander pitched in relief at Petco Park on Opening Day earlier this season, and fanned two in 1.0 perfect inning...The South Carolina native is winless in four starts this month, despite compiling a 3.42 ERA over 23.2 innings.

 RH Michael King has made one start and one relief appearance against Atlanta in his career, and owns a 4.26 ERA (3 ER/6.1 IP) all-time against the club...The right-hander earned the first Opening Day start of his career in a turn versus the Braves earlier this season, and allowed four hits, four walks and three runs over 2.2 innings in a no-decision...In nine games since that start against Atlanta, the New Yorker is 4-2 with a 2.21 ERA.

LOSS: Atlanta dropped its second straight one-run game last night, losing the series opener to San Diego, 2-1...In 11 games versus the Dodgers and Padres this season, the Braves have played to just a 1-10 (.091) record.

 LH Chris Sale started for the Braves and allowed just four hits and one run over 7.0 innings, but was left with a no-decision...He owns a 1.37 ERA over four starts in the month of May, but the Braves are just 2-2 in his turns with a pair of one-run losses.

 The Braves have dropped three straight games for the first time since April 30 to May 3, tying their longest losing streak since opening the season with seven straight defeats...Atlanta is two games under .500 for the first time since owning a 19-21 record 13 days ago.

RONALD RETURNED: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. returned to Atlanta's lineup last night and went 2-for-4 with a homer...It was his first major league game since tearing the ACL in his left knee on May 26 of last season at Pittsburgh.

 He started in right and hit leadoff for Atlanta, and drove the very first pitch he saw out to left for a home run...The ball left the bat at 115.5 mph and traveled an estimated 467 feet, the hardest-hit and farthest-hit ball by a Braves batter this season.

 Per StatsPerform, Acuña Jr. is the first player in MLB history to miss 150+ games and then hit a leadoff homer in his first game back...The drive was the 35th leadoff homer of his career, extending his own franchise record.

 Atlanta played to an 83-78 (.516) record in 161 games following his injury and averaged 4.20 runs per game...Braves leadoff hitters compiled a .243/.298/.402 line in his absence...In the 161 games prior to his injury, Atlanta went 103-58 (.640), averaged 5.69 runs per game and its leadoff batters hit .316/.395/.537.

 In his last full season, 2023, Acuña Jr. was a unanimous selection for the NL Most Valuable Player award after batting .337 (217-for-643) in 159 games...He established career-highs in nearly every offensive category, including batting average (.337), on-base percentage (.416), OPS (1.012), runs (149), hits (217), doubles (35), RBI (106), stolen bases (73), walks (80) and total bases (83).

DAYSBEL HERNÁNDEZ: Allowed a leadoff single to Elias Díaz in last night's eighth inning...Díaz singled to right on a 98.0-mph four-seamer from Hernández, the first hit he has allowed on a fastball this season.

 Opponents entered play 0-for-22 on at-bats that ended with his four-seam fastball prior to last night.

 The right-hander pitched around a hit and a walk last night to record a scoreless inning, and has compiled a 1.64 ERA (4 ER/22.0 IP) through 21 games this season.

 Hernández ranks in the 95th percentile in all of baseball with an average fastball velocity of 97.8 mph, and ranks in the 93rd percentile in barrel percentage (3.6%).

FIFTY GAMES: Atlanta played its 50th game of the season last night, and ended play with a 24-26 (.480) record and an 8.5-game deficit in the NL East.

 During their run of seven consecutive postseason trips, the Braves have been under .500 through 50 games twice...The club sat with an identical 24-26 record through 50 games in its World Series-winning 2021 season, and was 23-27 one year later in 2022.

 Atlanta has gone 19-13 (.594) over its past 32 games dating to April 18, tied for the third-best record in the National League in that span...Only Philadelphia (22-10, .688) and Chicago (19-11, .633) have been better.

- Set to make his 10th start of the season and first of his career against San Diego.
- Made his first career appearance against the Padres earlier this season in relief... Pitched a scoreless inning with two strikeouts.
- Making 10 starts in a single season for the first time in his career.
- Held Boston to three hits, two runs, and a homer over 6.0 frames tossed in his last outing.
- It was his third quality start over his past four outings and fifth overall this year.
- He owns career 2.87 ERA over 19 appearances at home and a 4.62 ERA in 17 outings on the road.
- Pitching to a 2.63 ERA at Truist Park and 5.55 ERA away from home this season.
- Holding hitters to .196 average for the season.
- Ranks as the 12th lowest batting average against among qualified pitchers in the majors and sixth lowest in the National League.
- Holmes is holding left-handed hitters to a .190 batting average this season, the fourth lowest rate in the National League among qualifiers.
- Among qualifying starters in the National League, his 81.3% strand rate is the eighth highest.
- Three of Holmes' nine starts this year have come against NL West opponents, two of which were against Los Angeles...He is 1-2 with a 4.66 ERA against the division.
- He is a combined 2-1 with a 2.83 ERA against all other opponents this season.

2025

- Made his first career Opening Day roster with Atlanta this season.
- Pitched 10 seasons in the minors before making his MLB debut last year with the Braves...Was drafted by LAD with 22nd overall pick in 2014.
- Struck out two hitters in a scoreless outing of the bullpen against San Diego on March 27 in his season debut. Struck out nine hitters while holding the Los Angeles offense to two runs over 6.0 innings pitched in his last start.
- The nine strikeouts recorded were a new career high for Holmes.

2024 Recap

- In his first major league season, went 2-1 with a 3.56 ERA (27 ER/68.1 IP)... Struck out 70 and walked 15.
- Pitched to a 4.01 ERA (15 ER/33.2 IP) as a starter (7 starts) and a 3.12 ERA (12 ER/34.2 IP) as a reliever (19 relief outings).
- Made his major league debut on June 16, pitching 3.0 scoreless innings in relief with two strikeouts and no walks versus Tampa Bay.
- Scattered three hits over 5.0 one-run innings pitched while fanning eight Milwaukee hitters in his first major league start on July 29.
- In the expansion era (since 1961), he is one of just two pitchers in history to record the first seven outs of his first career start via punchout.
- Became the fifth starter in Braves franchise history to strikeout eight hitters, while holding an opponent to one run or less and zero walks in his first 11 outings...Teammate Spencer Schwellenbach was the fourth to do it two days earlier on July 27.
- Pitched 10 seasons in the minors before making his MLB debut...Was drafted by LAD with 22nd overall pick in 2014.
- Joined Charlie Morton as the only Braves pitchers to log over 500.0 innings pitched in the minor leagues and make a start for Atlanta this past season.

- Awards: Midwest League Midseason All-Star (2015); Texas League Pitcher of the Week (July 30, 2017).
- In 2022, pitched for three different minor league teams throughout the Oakland and Atlanta organizations...Separately, went 1-2 with Triple-A Las Vegas before joining the Braves system.
- Pitched the entire 2021 season for Triple-A Las Vegas and saw more relief appearances (29) than starts (7) for first time in career.
- Set career highs and led the team in games (50) and saves (13) in 2023 with Triple-A Gwinnett...Led all Stripers relievers in strikeouts (74).
- Named Gatorade Player of the Year in South Carolina following his senior year in 2014.
- Selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2014 June draft (Conway High School, SC).
- On August 1, 2016, traded by the Dodgers to the Oakland Athletics along with RHP Frankie Montas and RHP Jharel Cotton for OF Josh Reddick and RHP Rich Hill.
- Signed by the Atlanta Braves as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.

Per Baseball Savant, ranks highly in several categories: xERA (96th percentile, 2.26), xBatting Average (93rd, .193) and barrel percentage (3.6%, 93rd). Blewett relies on three pitches: Slider (42.5%), Four-Seam Fastball (37.4%), Split-Finger Fastball (20.1%).

Sixty percent of Bummer’s inherited runners have scored – tied for the fourth-highestet percentage in MLB (min. 10 IR). Among pitchers that have faced at least 300 batters since the start of 2024, Bummer’s three barrels allowed are the fewest in Major League Baseball...Every other qualifying pitcher has allowed at least six in that span. Has induced a ground ball rate of 59.3%, which ranks in the 95th percentile league-wide...The league-average ground ball rate is 43%. His home ERA is 0.82 (1 ER/11.0 IP) but his road ERA is 6.30 (7 ER/10.0 IP). Owens a 3.43 ERA, but a 2.36 FIP...Per Baseball Savant, his xERA is 2.26, which ranks in the 96th percentile... Also ranks highlight in barrel percentage (99th percentile, 1.7%).

Has thrown his slider 152 times, and has surrendered just five hits on it...Among pitchers that have thrown at least that many, those five hits are tied for the fourth fewest in Major League Baseball. On April 8, struck out the side (9th inning) for the 13th time in his MLB career and for the first time this season... He last did it as a member of the San Diego Padres on July 28, 2024, at Baltimore. Last year, allowed 26% of his earned runs (10) in just five games with the Yankees. Tossed an “immaculate inning” on September 27, 2022 vs. the Rays in the seventh inning...Signified the 110th immaculate inning in MLB history, and the fourth in Cleveland’s franchise history.

Dating to July 29, 2023, Hernández is the only pitcher in MLB to appear in at least 32 games and allow zero home runs...429 total pitchers qualify for that criteria. Owens an active homerless streak of 41.2 innings...Has only allowed one homer in his major league career – a two-run shot to Boston’s Masataka Yoshida on July 25, 2023 at Fenway Park...Occurred in his second MLB appearance...Hernández’ streak is the third-longest active by an active National League reliever and the sixth-longest by any active reliever in MLB...The last Brave to allow one-or-fewer homers through his first 41 games was Mauricio Cabrera in 2016. Since his MLB debut, Hernández owns the second-best HR/9 IP rate (0.21) in baseball (min. 35 games). On May 10, walked four batters (1 intentional)...The last Braves reliever to issue four free passes in a single game was A.J. Minter, who did so on September 20, 2023.

Has allowed 10 barrels this season, the tied for third most in the National League among relievers...He allowed seven throughout all of 2024. Has surrendered seven home runs this season, already surpassing his total from all of 2024 (4)...Pitched just 20.1 innings to allow those seven, contrasting the 69.1 innings he covered last season. Has 232 career saves, fourth most among active pitchers. Among pitchers with as many appearances since his Braves debut on August 5, 2022 (173 apps.), Iglesias’ 2.41 ERA (46 ER/171.2 IP) is the fourth best in Major League Baseball. Dating to September 2022, Iglesias is one of four MLB relievers to pitch to a 0.00 ERA in at least three separate months (min. 10 games)...Did so in September 2022, August 2023 and August 2024...Bryan Abreu (HOU), Emmanuel Clase (CLE), Devin Williams (MIL) and Kevin Kelly (TB) have also done so. Last season, was named August’s Reliever of the Month for the third time in his career...Within the month, went 3-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER/13.1 IP) and six saves in 11 total appearances...Allowed just two hits without issuing a walk. Finished the 2024 season with the best xERA in the National League (2.26) and the third best in the majors... Only Mason Miller (OAK, 1.76) and Kirby Yates (TEX, 1.81) ranked ahead of him.

From April 19 until May 10, retired 26 consecutive batters over nine appearances – the longest such streak of his eight-year MLB career...Since 2000, his 26-batter streak was tied for the second-longest streak by a Brave of not allowing a batter to reach via hit, walk or hit-by-pitch, trailing Raisel Iglesias (38, July 27-August 23, 2024) and tied with Chris Sale (26, April 26-May 1, 2024). From April 19-May 15, posted 11 consecutive scoreless outings...Across 11.0 innings in that time, he struck out 10 and walked one. Has thrown his curveball 70.1% of the time...Among pitchers with at least five appearances so far, he easily leads the field...The second-place pitcher is Toronto’s Brendon Little, who has thrown his curve 48.4% of the time. In his first full season with Atlanta, pitched to a 6-6 record and a 3.67 ERA (23 ER/56.1 IP)...Struck out 67 against 25 walks.

Has pitched to a 3.60 ERA (4 ER/10.0 IP) at home and a 1.64 ERA (2 ER/11.0 IP) on the road. Last year, Lee’s slider garnered a Whiff Rate of 48.6%, second best in the National League and fifth best in Major League Baseball on the pitch (min. 400 sliders thrown)...Only trailed Andrew Chafin (TEX, 54.7), Ryan Helsley (STL, 51.0), Andrés Muñoz (SEA, 48.5) and Jake Cousins (NYY, 47.2).

Prior to the trade, appeared in three games for Houston and posted a 4.50 ERA (2 ER/4.0 IP).
