THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
JUNE 30

1962 - At Colt Stadium, the Colt .45s defeat the Reds, 7-3, in a game shortened to just 7.0 innings due to heavy fog...**RHP Bob Bruce** goes the distance to improve to 6-1 on the season for the expansion Colt .45s.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros will play the middle game of their three-game series against the visiting Twins tonight at Daikin Park...**RHP Mike Burrows** (3-8) will make his team-leading 16th start of the season tonight opposite the Twins and their ace **RHP Joe Ryan** (5-4).

ABOUT BURROWS: **RHP Mike Burrows** is coming off a strong start his last time out on June 24 at TOR, in which he worked 6.0 innings, allowing one run on two hits and one walk...Burrows has been a durable starter in his first season in Houston, as he leads the Astros in starts (15) and innings (85.1)...he joined the club from the Pirates this offseason as part of a three-team, six-player trade in which the Astros sent **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays, while the Rays sent **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates.

THE SLOW TURNAROUND: After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 22-14 since May 21, which is the best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

RECENT 'STROS: The Astros have won five of seven, six of nine, and are 9-4 in their last 13 games...the Astros 15-11 record in June ties as the best in the AL, along with their rival Rangers.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Astros have won five consecutive series dating back to June 12, posting a 11-5 record in those games...the last time the Astros won five straight series was from June 20-July 6 of last season (went 12-3 in that stretch).

WINNING THE CLOSE CALLS: The Astros are 9-5 in one-run games and 18-10 in two-run games...each of the Astros last six wins and 11 of their last 12 victories have come by two-or-fewer runs.

PEN PALS: Since May 15 the Astros are 25-17 thanks in part to their bullpen, which has posted the lowest ERA in the AL in that span at 2.62 (45ER/154.2P)...they've been led by their lefties since that date with **LHP Josh Hader** (0.75 ERA), **LHP Bryan King** (2.25 ERA) and **LHP Steven Okert** (2.29 ERA) all posting low ERAs.

GET 'EM EARLY: The Astros lead the AL in 1st inning runs with 60 runs scored in their 87 games...overall, the Astros rank fifth in the American League in runs scored (391), with their opponent tonight, the Twins, leading the AL in runs (417).

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Astros dropped the opener of their six-game homestand last night by a score of 5-4 to the visiting Twins...Houston made it close late, scoring three runs in the 9th on a pair of back-to-back homers by **CF Taylor Trammell** (2x4, HR, 2RBI) and **RF Cam Smith** (2x4, 2HR, 2RBI)...**RHP Peter Lambert** (4ER/5.2IP) started for Houston and was handed the loss, snapping his four-game winning streak...**RHP Miguel Ulloa** (0ER/2IP) made his Major League debut in relief, working 2.0 scoreless frames.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE: The Astros have placed **IF Jeremy Peña** on the 10-day IL with a left calf strain and have recalled **IF Raynel Delgado** from Triple A Sugar Land.

OUT ON ASSIGNMENT: The Astros have several players out on minor league rehab assignments and are adding to that group today...**OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** (right hamstring strain) will begin a minor league rehab assignment tonight for Triple A Sugar Land in their series opener at OKC...**RHP Hayden Wesneski** (right elbow surgery) began his minor league rehab assignment today for the FCL Astros, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings.

MVP-CALIBER: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has had a torrid first half to his season, currently leading all of baseball in OPS (1.031), OBP (.424), SLG (.607) and total bases (185)...additionally, he ranks tied for first in the AL in homers (25) and extra-base hits (41), while ranking second in batting average (.308), tied for second in hits (94), third in runs (58), fourth in walks (58), and tied for fifth in RBI (56).

ALL-STAR UPDATE: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has been named a finalists for the 2026 KONAMI eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot with second-phase fan voting available now through Thursday, July 2 at 11 a.m. CT...Alvarez has been an All-Star three times thus far in his career...since 2017, the Astros 37 All-Star selections are tops in the AL in that span.

ASTROS-TWINS: Tonight is the 100th regular season game between the Astros and Twins in their franchise histories, with Houston owning the all-time advantage with a 52-47 record...there are several connections between the two clubs including both team's catchers, with **C Victor Caratini** spending his last two seasons (2024-25) in Houston and **C Christian Vázquez** spending his last three years (2023-25) in Minnesota.

ROAD WARRIORS: With their win on Sunday in Detroit, the Astros completed a seven-game road trip with a 5-2 record after stops in Toronto (2-1) and Detroit (3-1)...the Astros are 15-8 in their last three road trips combined and are 21-14 on the road since going 1-9 on their first road trip of the 2026 season.

SPONGEBOB DEBUTS AT DAIKIN PARK: Tonight is the first **SpongeBob SquarePants Night** at Daikin Park, where fans can be ready for a full night of fun, laughter and nautical nonsense...fans can upgrade their experience with a special SpongeBob Night jersey add-on for \$60.50.

ON THE RADIO: The Astros English radio broadcast on KBME SportsTalk 790 for this series will feature **Steve Sparks** and **Garrett Greene**, who's subbing for **Robert Ford**...Green currently serves as the Triple A Sugar Land Space Cowboys Media Relations Manager and Radio Broadcaster.

DOWN AT TRIPLE A: The Astros have several players performing great down at Triple A Sugar Land, including **RHP Ethan Pecko** and **IF Cavan Biggio**...in June, Pecko has gone 3-0 with a 0.75 ERA (2ER/24IP) in four games, while Biggio has hit .321 (26x81) with nine extra-base hits, a .476 OBP and a 1.032 OPS in 21 games in June.

LAST APPEARANCE, JUNE 24 at TOR: Logged his 4th quality start of the season, allowing 1 run on 2 hits through 6.0 innings with 1 walk and 3 strikeouts...marked his fewest hits allowed in a start this season and matched his single-game career low in hits allowed in a start for the 3rd time (last, Sept. 9, 2025 at BAL)...did not factor into the decision of the Astros' 3-1 win over the Blue Jays at the Rogers Centre...the Astros have gone 4-2 in the six games since Burrows' start in Toronto.

BACK IN THE ROTATION: Is set to take his 2nd consecutive turn back in the rotation after working in relief on June 19 vs. CLE...worked a scoreless 1.0 inning with 1 strikeout on June 19 vs. CLE, his lone relief outing of the year.

VS. MIN: Is making his 3rd career start and 2nd start this season vs. the Twins...worked 6.0 innings and allowed 4 runs on 6 hits with 3 walks and 2 strikeouts against the Twins on May 20 at Target Field, taking the losing decision in the Astros' 4-1 loss...his other start vs. the Twins came on July 12, 2025 at Target Field as a member of the Pirates, allowing 6 runs on 5 hits through 1.1 innings...has held **OF Trevor Larnach** to 0x4 with 1 strikeout, **IF Luke Keaschall** to 0x3 and **DH Josh Bell** to 0x2 in their respective career matchups.

ABOUT BURROWS: The 2nd-year starter is making his team-leading 16th start of the season after opening the year as the Astros No. 2 starter...leads the Astros in innings pitched (85.1)...is the only member of the Astros Opening Day rotation to avoid the Injured List; **RHP Hunter Brown** (right shoulder strain), **RHP Cristian Javier** (Grade 2 right shoulder strain), **RHP Tatsuya Imai** (right arm fatigue) and **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (right shoulder inflammation).

DOING THE SPLITS: Owns a 4.28 ERA (23ER/48.1IP) in his 8 starts away from Daikin Park on the season...has held all right-handed hitters to a .263 (50x190) average and a .747 OPS.

UNCLE CHARLIE: Has held opponents to a .205 average (8x39) with his curveball this season, throwing the pitch at a 14.1-percent rate...conversely, opponents batted .318 (7x22) against his curveball last season when he threw the pitch at an 11.9-percent rate.

THE JOURNEY: A native of Waterford, CT, Burrows was committed to the University of Connecticut out of high school...the Pirates selected him in the 11th round of the June 2018 draft and signed him to an over-slot bonus to sign and forego his commitment to UConn...spent 6 seasons (2018-23) in the Pirates minor league system before finally debuting in 2024 with a single appearance...pitched the majority of the 2025 season at the Major League level and flashed potential before the Pirates flipped him to Houston this offseason.

THE TRADE: After spending eight seasons (2018-25) in the Pirates organization, the Astros acquired Burrows this offseason in a 3-team, 6-player trade...as part of the deal, the Astros traded **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays...meanwhile, the Rays traded **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates, and Burrows got dealt to the Astros.

CONNECTICUT CONNECTION: Native of Connecticut, Burrows is in a small fraternity of Major Leaguers from the Constitution State...only four other Connecticuter's have played for the Astros in their franchise history: **C Brad Ausmus** (1259g), **OF George Springer** (795g), **RHP Bill Dawley** (157g) and **RHP Josh Zeid** (48g).

2025 RECAP: Pitched most of the season with the Pirates, making 23 appearances (19 starts) and going 2-4 with a 3.94 ERA (42ER/96IP)...struck out 97 hitters in 96.0 IP...had two Major League stints on the year, from April 24-25 and from May 21 thru the end of the year...recorded a strong second half with the Pirates, posting a 3.27 ERA (20ER/55IP) in 13 games (10 starts)...in that span, allowed 1-or-fewer runs in 7 of his last 8 appearances, posting a 2.22 ERA (7ER/28.1IP) in those games, which spanned from Aug. 16 thru the end of the year...did not allow a homer over a 26.1-inning span from Aug. 16-Sept. 21...finished tied for third in the NL in strikeouts by a rookie (97).
