**HERE'S THE STORY:** The D-backs are 1-6 in this 8-game homes- tand vs. Padres (1-2), Mariners (0-3) and Rangers (0-1).

- ♦ **Luke Weaver**, who is making his first career start vs. Rang- ers, won his last start on Sept. 1 vs. Padres (1 ER in 6.0 IP), his first outing since May 16...on the injured list from May 18-Aug. 31 with a strained right shoulder.
- ♦ **David Peralta** has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 starts, in- cluding 11 straight to begin this stretch dating back to Aug. 19, batting .364 (16-for-44)/.927 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 home run, 4 RBI and 2 walks.
- ♦ **Henry Ramos** is making his first Major League start...over his final 29 games at Triple-A Reno, July 27-Sept. 4, hit .303 (42-for-104)/1.216 OPS with 12 doubles, 8 homers, 25 RBI and 11 walks.

**DAY GAMES ARE FUN:** **Ketel Marte**, in 20 day games, is hitting .361 (26-for-72)/1.024 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 12 RBI and 10 walks.

- ♦ **Josh Rojas**, in 35 day games, is hitting .297 (35-for- 118)/.932 OPS with 10 doubles, 6 homers, 24 RBI and 20 walks.

**ROSTER REVIEW:** With **Henry Ramos's** Major League debut on Sunday, Arizona has now used 61 different players this season, extending its club record, including 25 rookies - also the most in franchise history.

**AT A GLANCE:** Third season with the D-backs.

- Acquired on Dec. 5, 2018 from the Cardinals with C Carson Kelly, INF Andrew Young and a competitive balance draft pick for INF Paul Goldschmidt.

- WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** Is making his second start since be- ing reinstated from the 60-day injured list (strained right shoulder).
- Had been sidelined due to COVID-19 (contact tracing) prior to his reinstatement.
  - Has gone 3-0 with a 1.32 ERA (4 ER in 27.1 IP) and 0.80 WHIP in 5 starts @ Chase Field in 2021.

**LAST START:** Won on Sept. 1 vs. Padres (1 ER in 6.0 IP)...al- lowed 4 hits and no walks with 3 strikeouts...lone run came on a sixth-inning Trent Grisham homer.

**VS. RANGERS:** Will be making his first career appearance.

**INTERLEAGUE ACTION:** Has gone 2-4 with a 3.20 ERA (14 ER in 39.1 IP) in 7 career interleague starts.

- Took the loss in his last start vs. AL club on Sept. 19, 2020 @ Astros (3 ER in 5.1 IP).

**GIVE 'EM VELO AND CHANGE IT UP:** Opponents are 20-for-97 (.206) off his 4-seamer this season.

- Since 2019, has held opponents to a combined .223 aver- age (48-for-215) on his changeup.

**ON ASSIGNMENT:** Was 0-0 with a 3.60 ERA (4 ER in 10.0 IP) in 4 rehab games with Triple-A Reno and Rookie ACL D-backs.

**THE CARSON KELLY CONNECTION:** Roomed with teammate Carson Kelly in 2015 with Single-A Adv. Palm Beach.

- Kelly has caught Weaver 26 times in the Majors, including 18 of his 33 starts with the D-backs.
- In 27 career Minor League outings together, Weaver was 14-5 with a 1.58 ERA.
