### Mauricio Dubón

Homered in last night's fifth inning, a 382-foot, go-ahead shot.

It was Dubón's fifth home run of the month, most on Atlanta's club in June and the highest single-month total of his career.

With eight home runs this season, the right-handed-hitting Honduran is already approaching in single-season career best.

He set the mark with 10 home runs for the Houston Astros in 2023, when he posted 2.7 bWAR and won his first Gold Glove Award.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Padres today conclude a three-game midweek series with the third of seven scheduled games between the clubs this season... The Braves will host the Padres at Truist Park for a four-game set from July 20-23.

**A** The Braves scored six runs last night, their highest total in more than two weeks, but ultimately fell to the Padres in extra innings, 7-6...Michael Harris II collected three hits, including two doubles.

**A** The Braves went 1-6 against the Padres in 2025... Their only win, 7-1, occurred at Truist Park on May 24...San Diego outscored Atlanta 25-18 during the season.

**A** Prior to last year's season-opening sweep here, Atlanta hadn't lost a regular-season series to the Padres at Petco Park since 2018...Since 2019, the Braves are 4-2-1 in sets here.

**A** The Braves played the 2024 National League Wild Card Series in San Diego and were swept in two games...Atlanta has lost each of its last eight games within these walls, including playoffs...Regardless of venue, the Braves are 4-15 in their last 19 games against the Padres.

**A** LH JP Sears is scheduled to make his season debut for the Padres today...The southpaw made 27 starts in the big leagues last season, including five for San Diego, going 9-11 with a 5.04 ERA (76 ER/135.2 IP)...In 14 starts this year for Triple-A El Paso, the 5-foot-11, 180-pound native of Sumter, SC, has gone 4-3 with a 7.92 ERA (56 ER/63.2 IP)...In his last six starts specifically, he's 1-2 with a 11.14 ERA (33 ER/26.2 IP).

**MARTÍN PÉREZ:** Takes the ball for Atlanta today with a 6-3 record and a 2.78 ERA (21 ER/68.0 IP)... Among National League pitchers with as many innings pitched, Pérez ranks 12th in ERA.

**A** Pérez has posted an average pitch velocity of 85.3 mph and an ERA of 2.78 this season...In the last six seasons, only one starting pitcher has finished with a lower average velocity and a lower ERA (min. 11 starts): Trevor Williams...He held a 2.02 ERA for Washington in 2024, pitching to a 84.2-mph average velocity.

**A** The native of Guanare, VZ, has faced San Diego three times in his major-league career (two starts), going 0-1 with a 3.86 ERA (6 ER/14.0 IP)...His team is 2-1 when he appears, but has logged just four strikeouts and seven walks in those 14.0 innings.

**A** Pérez has completed at least 5.0 innings in all 11 of his starting assignments, tied for the eighth-longest active streak in the National League...He has limited opponents to two earned runs-or-fewer in eight of those turns.

**A** With a 97-96 record all-time, Pérez is in pursuit of his 100th career win...Only 17 active pitchers have reached the milestone, including Chris Sale (153 wins) and Carlos Carrasco (112 wins).

**MICHAEL HARRIS II:** Posted his ninth three-hit game of the season last night, tied for the most in Major League Baseball alongside Otto Lopez (MIA)... The center fielder is riding an eight-game hitting streak dating to June 12, tied for his longest this season.

**A** Since his MLB debut, the 2022 National League Rookie of the Year has posted 52 three-hit games... There are only five other players in modern franchise history with more such games before their 26th birthday: Henry Aaron (93), Ronald Acuña Jr. (67), Andruw Jones (64), Freddie Freeman (64) and Eddie Mathews (59).

**A** Although he's tied for the MLB lead in three-hit games, Harris II is tied for 41st in two-hit games (20).

**A** Entering play today, Harris II ranks eighth in MLB in batting average (.310)...The only players leading him are Lopez (MIA, .337), Jung Hoo Lee (SF, .331), Yordan Alvarez (HOU, .325), Luis Arraez (SF, .321), Brandon Marsh (PHI, .315) and Troy Johnston (COL, .311).

**A** Harris II is the first Brave to rank top-10 in batting average through 78 team games since designated hitter Marcell Ozuna ranked sixth (.305) at this juncture in 2024.

**A** In his last 27 games dating to May 19, he's slashing .343/.377/.583 (37-for-108) with 14 extra-base hits, 19 runs scored and 18 RBI...He ranks fourth in the majors in batting average in that time, only trailing Pete Crow-Armstrong (CHC, .373), Fernando Tatis Jr. (SD, .360) and Yandy Díaz (TB, .346).

**LOSS:** Atlanta lost to the Padres in extra innings last night, 7-6...The club fell to 2-4 when playing extra frames...The Braves are 3-9 in their last 12 games, signifying their worst downturn since July 25-August 6, 2025 when the team also went 3-9.

**A** The Braves have lost eight straight games at Petco Park, including playoffs...The spell stands as Atlanta's longest active losing streak at any single venue... Atlanta has active losing streaks at only six other venues overall: Rate Field (4 games), Oracle Park (4 games), Globe Life Field (3 games) Chase Field (2), Kauffman Stadium (2 games) and Rogers Centre (2 games).

**A** The last team to win eight straight homes games (including playoffs) against the Braves was Los Angeles-NL, who matched that mark spanning September 3, 2023-May 8, 2026.

**SERIES PLAY:** Atlanta has lost the first two games of this series to San Diego, and has dropped its third straight road series...The team's last series win away from Truist Park occurred from May 29-31 at Cincinnati.

**A** Despite dropping this set, the Braves' six series losses are still the fewest in Major League Baseball...The Los Angeles Dodgers, Milwaukee Brewers and New York Yankees have all dropped the second-fewest series, losing seven apiece.

#### Today's Game

Makes his 12th start of the season and the 291st of his career in the finale of a three-game series at San Diego...In his most recent turn June 19 against Milwaukee, the 35-year-old Venezuelan earned the win, allowing one run over 6.0 innings in Atlanta's 3-2 victory at Truist Park.

Owns an 0-1 record and a 3.86 ERA (6 ER/14.0 IP) in three career appearances against San Diego, two of them starts...The left-hander pitched for the Padres in 2024, going 3-1 with a 3.46 ERA over 10 starts.

The 6-foot, 210-pound left-hander enters with a 6-3 record and a 2.78 ERA (21 ER/68.0 IP) over 15 total appearances - 11 starts and four relief outings - with 56 strikeouts against 23 walks.

Has won each of his last four starts dating to May 30, going 4-0 with a 2.95 ERA (7 ER/21.1 IP).

Has struck out 16 and walked eight while limiting opponents to 17 hits and one home run over those four outings.

Has completed at least 5.0 innings in all 11 of his starting assignments this season... Has limited opponents to two earned runs-or-fewer in eight of those turns.

Owns a 2.78 ERA (21 ER/68.0 IP) through his first 15 games of the season, the second-lowest mark he has posted over a season-opening 15-game span in his career, trailing only the 2.22 ERA (23 ER/93.1 IP) he recorded to begin 2022 with Texas.

His next-lowest such span was a 3.41 ERA over his first 15 games of 2013, also with the Rangers.

Allowed five hits or fewer in 20 consecutive starts from March 31, 2025 to June 13, 2026, the second-longest such streak by a left-handed starting pitcher since 1901, trailing only Tony Cingrani's 22-game run from 2013-14...The streak ended June 19, when he surrendered six hits to Milwaukee.

Right-handed batters are hitting .204 (34-for-167) with four homers off Pérez this season, while left-handers are batting .216 (16-for-74) with two homers.

#### 2026

Earned the win June 19 against Milwaukee, allowing one run on six hits over 6.0 innings with two walks and five strikeouts on 82 pitches while opposing right-hander Jacob Misiorowski in Atlanta's 3-2 victory at Truist Park...Recorded his first career win against the Brewers.

Won his start on June 13 at New York (NL), allowing one run on four hits over 5.1 innings with one walk and four strikeouts on 71 pitches in Atlanta's 3-1 victory at Citi Field...Bichette's double was the only extra-base hit he surrendered.

Earned the win on June 5 against Pittsburgh, allowing three runs on three hits over 5.0 innings with two walks and five strikeouts on 85 pitches in Atlanta's 6-3 victory at Truist Park...All three runs scored in the third inning.

Logged his first career 10-strikeout game in his 285th start on May 19 at Miami, the second-most starts before a first career 10-or-more strikeout game among pitchers to debut since 1893, trailing only Doyle Alexander (321st start, July 23, 1985).

At 35 years, 45 days, Pérez is the 17th-oldest pitcher to record a first career 10-strikeout game dating to 1893, and the first to do so at age 35-or-older since Colin Rea (35 years, 79 days) on September 18, 2025 (per Elias).

Earned his first win as a Brave on April 17 at Philadelphia, holding the Phillies to four hits over 6.0 scoreless innings with two walks and four strikeouts on 94 pitches in the 9-0 victory at Citizens Bank Park.

Allowed four earned runs on five hits over 5.0 innings in his first career start as a member of the Braves on April 5 at Arizona, walking one with one strikeout on 75 pitches...Did not factor in the decision in Atlanta's 6-5 loss in 10 innings.

Made his first appearance with the Braves on March 31 vs. the Athletics, tossing 4.1 scoreless innings of relief...Allowed just two hits with no walks and three strikeouts on 47 pitches (31 strikes) in the 5-2 loss.

Had his contract selected by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on April 17... Originally had his contract selected on March 30 before being designated for assignment on April 12, outrighted to Gwinnett on April 14, and re-signed to a minor league deal on April 15.

#### Career

**Awards:** AL All-Star (2022) and World Series Champion (2023, Texas).

In his 15th major league season, Pérez has pitched for seven clubs: Texas (2012-18), Minnesota (2019), Boston (2020-21), Texas (2022-23), Pittsburgh (2024), San Diego (2024), Chicago (AL) (2025) and Atlanta (2026).

Enters play ranking fourth in starts (290) and fourth in innings pitched (1,699.2) among active left-handed pitchers.

Ranks fifth in starts among Venezuela-born pitchers (290), four ahead of teammate Carlos Carrasco (286).

Originally signed by Texas as an international free agent on July 2, 2007... Represented Venezuela in the World Baseball Classic in 2017 and 2023.
