TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners continue a 3-city, 10-game road trip with the 3rd of 3 games against the Kansas City Royals (1-1)...will also travel to Oakland (4 G, 9/20-9/23) and Los Angeles-AL (3 G, 9/24-9/26) on the trip...today's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW**, as well as broadcast on **710 ESPN** and the **Mariners Radio Network**.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners dropped last night's middle game to Kansas City by an 8-1 score...have won 9 of their last 16 games and 10 of their last 18...are 20-14 over their last 34 games, 21-15 over their last 36, 23-20 over their last 43, 28-23 over their last 51, 34-27 over their last 61, 45-33 over their last 78, 48-34 over their last 82 and 58-43 over their last 101...are 31-22 in day games and 48-47 at night...are 42-33 at T-Mobile Park and 37-36 on the road...are 63-25 when scoring at least 4 runs and 16-44 when scoring 3 or fewer runs...are 51-9 when out-hitting their opponent.

- **Logan's (One) Run** - Seattle has played a 1-run game in each of **Logan Gilbert's** last 4 starts: L 8-7 vs. KC on Aug. 27, W 1-0 vs. HOU on Sept. 1, L 5-4 at HOU on Sept. 7 and W 5-4 vs. BOS on Sept. 13.
- **14 Left** - The Mariners have 14 games (8 road, 6 home) left in the 2021 regular season...they close out the schedule with 13 consecutive AL West Division opponents after today's finale with Kansas City.
- **Series Record** - The Mariners own a 15-9-2 series record since June 14, winning or splitting 17 of their last 26...the Mariners own a 23-19-5 overall series record going into today's rubber match.
- **Recent Finales** - Seattle has won 7 of its last 9 series finales.
- **The K** - The Mariners have won 7 of their last 8 games at Kauffman Stadium.
- **Double Trouble** - Kansas City leads the Majors with 138 double plays turned...Seattle is tied for 5th-most in the Majors and 3rd-most in the American League with 131.
- **Scoreless Relief Appearances** - The Mariners lead the American League with 371 individual scoreless relief appearances.

FULL SLATE OF FRANCE...**Ty France's next appearance will be his 162nd career game in a Mariners uniform**...in 161 games with Seattle, France is batting .293 (177x605) with 83 runs scored, 33 doubles, 2 triples, 18 home runs, 75 RBI, 45 walks and 26 hit-by-pitches...he has a .364 on-base percentage, .443 slugging percentage and an .807 OPS...last night marked his 250th career game in the Majors.

TY IS THE GUY...**Ty France** went 2-for-3 with a run scored, double and walk last night...he's reached base safely in 7 of his last 8 plate appearances...France is batting .291 (151x519) with 73 runs, 28 doubles, 1 triple, 16 home runs, 62 RBI, 39 walks and a league-leading 24 hit-by-pitches, getting on-base at a .365 clip, slugging .441 with an .806 OPS this season...he's batting .329 (74x225) since the All-Star Break, with his 74 hits since the break ranking 2nd in the AL to Whit Merrifield-KC (75).

KELENIC IN SEPTEMBER...**Jarred Kelenic** drew 2 walks in last night's game...in 15 September games, Kelenic is batting .250 (14x56) with 10 runs, 2 doubles, 5 home runs, 12 RBI, 5 walks and 2 stolen bases...he's gotten on-base at a .311 clip, slugging .554 with an .865 OPS...his 5 home runs are tied for most among American League rookies in the month with Bobby Dalbec-BOS and Ryan Mountcastle-BAL...Kelenic's 12 RBI trail only Dalbec's 14.

ROADRUNNERS...the Mariners are 12-5 over their last 17 road games...their .706 road winning percentage is best in the American League since Aug. 8 and 2nd-best in the Majors to the San Francisco Giants (.813/13-3)...Seattle went 4-2 on their last road trip from Sept. 3-8 and 6-2 on the previous trip before that from Aug. 17-24.

D THE Z...since August 1, the Mariners pitching staff has the fewest walks (109) and is tied for the lowest walks-per-9 innings (2.50) in the Majors with Toronto (2.49)...in 43 games since August 1, the pitching staff has the 2nd-highest strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.17) in the American League, trailing only Toronto (3.68).

PITCHES PER PLATE APPEARANCE...Seattle batters are averaging 4.00 pitches per plate appearance this season, 2nd-most in the Major Leagues...the New York Yankees lead MLB with 4.09 pitches per plate appearance...San Francisco (3.97), Detroit (3.96) and Baltimore (3.95) round out the top five.

GETTING ON BASE AT THE TOP...**J.P. Crawford** has reached base safely in 16 of his last 17 games, hitting safely in 13 of 17...he's batting .299 (20x67) with 14 runs, 3 doubles, 2 home runs, 10 RBI and 12 walks in that span, getting on-base at a .400 clip, slugging .433 with an .833 OPS since August 30.

SADLER'S STREAK...**Casey Sadler** has not allowed a run over his last 22 appearances since July 27...the streak has spanned 19.2 innings, with Sadler walking 4 and striking out 16 during the streak...opponents are batting just .143 (9x63) against him in that stretch...his 22-outing scoreless streak is tied for 2nd-longest in Mariners history with Lucas Luetge (Apr. 17-June 15, 2012) and Ed Vande Berg (Aug. 30, 1982-Apr. 16, 1983)...the trio trail only Shigetoshi Hasegawa's franchise record 25-game scoreless streak...Hasegawa did not allow a run in 25 consecutive appearances from June 3-Aug. 17, 2003.

SECOND-HALF SEAGS...**Kyle Seager** has 18 home runs and 46 RBI since the All-Star Break...the 18 home runs are tied for 3rd-most in the American League since the break with Vladimir Guerrero Jr.-TOR and Marcus Semien-TOR, trailing Salvador Perez-KC (24) and Jorge Polanco-MIN (19)...Seager has 34 home runs and 96 RBI this season, currently on pace to finish with 37 homers and 105 RBI...he is 3 RBI away from matching his season-high 99 RBI in 2016...he is 4 RBI away from becoming the first Mariners player with at least 100 RBI in a season since Nelson Cruz had 119 RBI in 2017.

ONE-RUN GAMES...Seattle has played 49 one-run games, most in the American League and 4th-most in the Majors, trailing New York-NL (60), Atlanta (52) and Philadelphia (50)...the Mariners are 31-18 in 1-run games, with their 31 one-run wins leading the Majors and their .633 winning percentage ranking 2nd in the AL and 3rd in the Majors to Los Angeles-AL (.676/23-11) and San Francisco (.651/28-15).

WINNING MONTHS...the Mariners are 8-7 in September...they finished August 15-13 (.536), their 3rd straight winning month...the Mariners went 14-12 (.538) in June and 14-10 (.583) in July...Seattle last recorded 3 consecutive winning months from March/April-June 2017...this season, the Mariners have put together a winning record in 4 of 5 months...they went 15-12 (.556) in April and 13-15 (.464) in May...the Mariners have put together a winning record in 5 of their last 6 months, going 12-11 (.522) in Sept. 2020.

AS YOU KNOW...**Logan Gilbert** takes the mound for Seattle today...in 3 September starts, the right-hander is 0-0 with a 2.35 ERA (4 ER, 15.1 IP) with 2 walks and 18 strikeouts...the Mariners are 2-1 in Gilbert's 3 September starts, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...that Gilbert has the 2nd-highest Wins Above Replacement (0.5) per *FanGraphs* among rookie pitchers in the month of September?...he trails only Triston McKenzie (0.9 fWAR)...Gilbert's 2.35 ERA in the month ranks 3rd in September among rookies with at least 15.0 innings pitched behind McKenzie's 1.50 ERA (3 ER, 18.0 IP) and Joe Ryan-MIN, who owns a 2.12 ERA (4 ER, 17.0 IP) during the month.

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT...

- 24-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 22nd start of his MLB career, all of them coming this season, and his 2nd start against Kansas City.
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau.
- Named to the Mariners 60-man roster prior to the start of the 2020 season...spent season pitching at Mariners Alternate site in Tacoma.
- In 2019, split season between A West Virginia (4/4-5/1), High-A Modesto (5/2-7/14), and Double-A Arkansas (July 15-end), going 10-5 with a 2.13 ERA (32 ER, 135.0 IP) in 26 combined starts in first professional season.
- Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
- Among all MiL pitchers in 2019, ranked 3rd in ERA (2.13), 5th in average (.198), 77th in strikeouts (165), while his 10 wins were 2nd-most among all Mariners farmhands.
- #100 - reached 100 career strikeouts on 9/1/2021 vs. HOU with a strikeout of Yordan Álvarez.

LAST OUTING...ND in Mariners 5-4 win against Boston on Sept. 13...tied his career high with 9 strikeouts, and allowed 2 ER on 5 H and 1 BB over 6.0 innings...marked his first quality start since Aug. 10 vs. Texas.

WHAT A STRETCH...between May 25 - Aug. 10, Gilbert went 5-1 with a 3.51 ERA (26 ER, 66.2 IP) in 13 starts...during this stretch he limited opponents to a .213 (52x244) average, while walking 16 and striking out 77...the Mariners won the first 11 of his starts during the stretch (11-2 overall).

LUCKY 11...from May 25-July 30 Seattle recorded 11 consecutive victories in Gilbert starts...the 11 consecutive team wins in his starts ranks 3rd in Mariners history...Gilbert trails just 2 streaks: 13 GS, Jamie Moyer (7/18-9/24/2001) and 13 GS Aaron Sele (4/4-6/12/2001)...Gilbert is just ahead of Randy Johnson who had a pair of 10 start streaks within the same season (4/27-6/10/1995 and 8/11-10/02/1995)...statistic via Stats Perform.

SHUT OUT...W#3 in 4-0 win over the Yankees on July 8 at T-Mobile Park...struck out 8 over 7.0 scoreless innings allowing just 1 hit and 1 hit by pitch...became the 2nd-youngest pitcher in franchise history to toss 7.0 or more shutout innings while allowing 1 hit or less.

REMARKABLE ROOKIE...Gilbert is set to make his 22nd start this season in today's game; he's the 16th Mariner to make 20 starts in their rookie season...Gilbert also had the 2nd most strikeouts (101) by a Mariners rookie through their first 19 starts behind Michael Pineda (119 in 2011)...Gilbert and Pineda are the only Mariners rookies to have at least 100 strikeouts through 19 career starts...Gilbert ranks 7th in franchise history for strikeouts by a rookie with 115, one shy of teammate Yusei Kikuchi who ranks 6th with 116 strikeouts during his rookie season in 2019.

HALF CENTURY...became the 6th pitcher in franchise history to tally at least 50 strikeouts through his first 10 career games on July 8 vs. New York-AL...his 84 strikeouts through his 1st 15 starts are T3rd-most in franchise history (also: Nate Karns in 2016), trailing only Michael Pineda (94 in 2011) and Felix Hernandez (94 in 2006).

MLB DEBUT...made his MLB debut on May 13 vs. CLE...threw 4.0 innings and allowed 4 earned runs on 5 hits and no walks with 5 strikeouts and 2 home runs in 4-2 loss...was tagged with the loss...tossed 71 pitches (52 strikes) and two wild pitches...notched his first career strikeout in the 3rd inning (Céasar Hernández)...became the 42nd Mariners pitcher to start in MLB debut, the first since Justin Dunn, Sept. 12, 2019 vs. CIN.

A NIGHT TO REMEMBER...Logan Gilbert (#28) and Jarred Kelenic (#4) made their MLB debuts on May 13 vs. Cleveland, becoming the highest ranking duo to debut in the same game since MLB.com began prospect rankings in 2011...there have only been 2 other instances where multiple top-100 prospects debuted for the same team in the same game...on July 23, 2013, outfielders Jake Marisnick (#70) and Christian Yelich (#13) both debuted for Miami...on Sept. 21, 2016, outfielders Manuel Margot (#45) and Hunter Renfroe (#92) both debuted for San Diego.

LAST MiLB OUTING...earned his 1st Triple-A win of the 2021 MiL season on May 7 vs. El Paso Chihuahuas...tossed 5.0 innings and allowed 1 run on 4 hits and no walks with 5 strikeouts in 8-2 Rainiers win...left game with 3-1 lead after the 5th inning having thrown 77 pitches (47 strikes).

PROSPECT PEDIGREE...was rated as the No. 28 overall prospect on MLB Pipeline's 2021 Top-100 Prospects List as the time of his call up...is the highest rated pitching prospect to appear for the Mariners since Taijuan Walker (No. 4) made his debut in 2013 season.

TAKING HOME THE HARDWARE...during the 2019 season, was named Pitcher of the Week twice en route to being named an All-Star for both the California (Single-A) League and Texas (Double-A) League, as well as an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star...rated as the #4 Prospect in the Texas League and the #7 Prospect in the California League by Baseball America following the season.

PITCHER OF THE YEAR...received the Jamie Moyer Minor League Pitcher of the Year Award following the 2019 season...was honored in a pre-game ceremony at T-Mobile Park along with other minor league award winners in the Mariners farm system on Sept. 27, 2019.

2019 RECAP...made his professional debut, splitting the season between A West Virginia (4/4-5/1), High-A Modesto (5/2-7/13), and Double-A Arkansas (July 15-end), going 10-5 with a 2.13 ERA (32 ER, 135.0 IP) in 26 combined starts in first professional season...limited opponents to a .198 (95x481) average, while walking 33 and striking out 165...among all minor league pitchers (min. 125.0 IP), ranked 3rd in ERA (2.13), 5th in average (.198), 77th in strikeouts (165), while his 10 wins were 2nd-most among all Mariners farmhands.

AMONG STETSON ROYALTY...Gilbert is 1 of 3 active Stetson University players in the Major Leagues, joining Jacob deGrom and Corey Kluber, which places Gilbert alongside 2 Cy Young Award winners...was the first pitcher from Stetson to be taken in the 1st round, and 1st Hatters 1st-rounder since 2003 (Brian Snyder)...drafted as highest pick in Stetson history at #14...during his 3 seasons with Stetson, Gilbert was 23-3 with a 2.48 ERA...started in 33 of his 52 appearances, and pitched a total of 250.2 innings for the Hatters...ranks 1st in Stetson history for lowest opponent batting average (.201), 2nd in most strikeouts per 9 innings (11.24), 4th in most strikeouts (313), and 1st in most strikeouts looking (84)...in final season with the Hatters, he ranked 1st in the nation in fewest hits allowed per 9 innings (5.4), 2nd in total strikeouts (163), 4th in ERA (2.72), and 4th in WHIP (0.80).
