BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles opened a 10-game homestand, their longest of the season, on Friday against the Detroit Tigers (2-1)...The Tampa Bay Rays (3 G) and Toronto Blue Jays (4 G) will be at Camden Yards this week...Baltimore went 1-5 on the last road trip at Washington (1-2) and Tampa Bay (0-3).

⚾ The O's split yesterday's doubleheader, taking the first game, 5-3, before losing, 4-1, in the second game...The Birds have now split both of their doubleheaders this season, joining April 30 vs. Houston.

⚾ The Game 1 victory marked the Orioles' second win of the season when trailing after the eighth inning, joining April 20 at Kansas City (trailed 1-0, won 7-5 in 12 inn.).

⚾ **Brandon Young** registered his second quality start of the year (also 5/6 at MIA) in Game 1 yesterday after allowing two unearned runs on five hits and two walks with four strikeouts in a season-high 6.2 innings...He has now allowed two earned runs or fewer in three consecutive starts for the first time in his career.

⚾ **Colton Cowser** gave the Birds the Game 1 victory after registering his first career walk-off plate appearance, hitting the first walk-off homer by an Oriole since **Dylan Beavers** on September 25 vs. Tampa Bay...Marked the first walk-off homer by a Bird when trailing since **Adley Rutschman** on May 15, 2024 vs. Toronto.

⚾ **Trevor Rogers** suffered his career-high sixth consecutive loss in Game 2 after throwing 4.2 innings, allowing four runs on four hits (1 HR) and two walks with two strikeouts...Is the first Oriole to lose six straight games since **Charlie Morton** from March 28-May 7, 2025...Owns an 11.03 ERA (29 ER/23.2 IP) over his last six starts since April 14.

ROSTER MOVE: Baltimore designated right-handed pitcher **Albert Suárez** for assignment following yesterday's doubleheader.

MEMORIAL DAY BASEBALL: The Orioles are 14-7 (.667) on Memorial Day this century, tied for the third-best record in MLB with the Blue Jays, trailing the Dodgers (17-5) and Mariners (15-6)... The O's are 43-35 (.551) all-time on Memorial Day, the eighth-best record in MLB since 1954.

MOVING THINGS ALONG: **Colton Cowser** is slashing .357/.400/.786 (5-for-14) with two home runs, three runs scored, five RBI, one walk, and one stolen base over his last seven games after slashing .067/.125/.067 (1-for-15) in his previous seven games from May 5-15.

⚾ His 440-foot walk-off home run in Game 1 yesterday was the third furthest of his career (455 ft. - 6/7/25 at ATH & 443 ft. - 6/16/24 vs. PHI).

⚾ The 440-foot shot marked the furthest hit home run at Oriole Park this season, surpassing **Samuel Basallo's** 437-foot blast on April 1 vs. Texas.

⚾ His three Outs Above Average (OAA) are tied for the team lead with **Pete Alonso**, while being tied for sixth most among all AL outfielders.

BASALLO BREAKING OUT: **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .352/.389/.591 (31-for-88) with seven doubles, one triple, four homers, 13 runs scored, 15 RBI, and six walks in 26 games since April 20...Among players with at least 90 plate appearances during that time, he ranks among MLB leaders in batting average (4th), slugging percentage (6th), and OPS (7th, .980).

⚾ He's hit safely in 19 of his 24 games since April 22, including a career-high 10 straight from May 1-17...He's also scored a run in nine of 15 games since May 5.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (T-2nd, 47), times on base (3rd, 96), doubles (T-3rd, 15), and on-base percentage (5th, .405).

⚾ According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in the majors in on-base percentage was **Eddie Murray** in 1984 (2nd, .410).

⚾ His 96 times on base are the fifth most in a players' first 52 games to begin his time with the Orioles, trailing **Roberto Alomar** (112 in 1996), **Frank Robinson** (106 in 1966), **Rafael Palmeiro** (98 in 1994), and **Ken Singleton** (98 in 1975).

⚾ Ward has seen 1,059 total pitches this season, second most in the majors behind **WSH's James Wood** (1,070)...He has seen 390 of those pitches in a 3-2 count, which ranks second in MLB behind **CWS's Munetaka Murakami** (393).

POLAR PETE: **Pete Alonso** is batting .265/.315/.542 (22-for-83) with five doubles, six home runs, 12 runs, 19 RBI, seven walks, and one steal in 22 games this month...During that time, he is tied for fourth in the majors in RBI with **WSH's CJ Abrams**, **CIN's JJ Bleday**, and **STL's Jordan Walker**, trailing **ATH's Nick Kurtz** (22) and **PHI's Bryson Stott** and **LAD's Andy Pages** (20)...He entered May hitting .198/.306/.362 (23-for-116) with seven doubles, four homers, 17 runs, 13 RBI, 17 walks, and one steal in 31 games.

⚾ Alonso's three defensive runs saved (DRS) are tied for the fourth most among MLB first basemen with four others, trailing **MIN's Kody Clemens** and **ATL's Matt Olson** (5) and **SD's Ty France** (4)...Last year, his -9 DRS ranked last among MLB first basemen.

⚾ He has three OAA, tied for third among first basemen...He posted -9 OAA in 2025, second worst in the majors by a first baseman ahead of **COL's Michael Toggia** (-10).

HOME COOKING: Baltimore is 14-13 at Oriole Park this season...Seventeen of the team's 27 home games have been decided by three runs or less with the O's going 8-9 in those...The Orioles have split all four homestands this year.

⚾ O's hurlers have produced a 3.95 ERA (107 ER/244.0 IP) in 27 home games this season compared to a 5.86 ERA (144 ER/221.1 IP) in 26 road games.

LOUD CONTACT: In nine games since May 15, the O's have recorded 73 batted balls hit at 100.0+ mph, second most in the majors during that time behind the Nationals (76)...**Pete Alonso** (14) and **Gunnar Henderson** (12) lead the Orioles during that time...On Friday, the team hit 11 balls at least 100.0 mph for the 11th time this year and sixth since the beginning of May.

⚾ Baltimore's 90.1 mph average exit velocity is tied for the second-best mark in the majors this season with Texas behind New York-AL (90.4 mph).

APPLYING SUNSCREEN: The Orioles and Rays are meeting for their second of four series this season...Baltimore was swept in a three-game set at Tropicana Field from May 18-20, their first time being swept in Tampa Bay since April 8-10, 2022.

⚾ The Birds have won the season series over Tampa Bay in each of the last three seasons, going 8-5 in 2023, 9-4 in 2024, and 7-6 in 2025.

⚾ The Orioles have won seven of their last nine series at home against the Rays (all since 2024)...The O's 7-1-1 (.833) series record in that stretch is the best by any AL East team

QUICK HITS: Bradish is scheduled to make his 11th start of the season and 78th of his career today vs. Tampa Bay...Made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts...Acquired from Los Angeles-AL along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peek in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019.

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss at Tropicana Field on May 19 after working 5.1 innings, allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR) and three walks with six strikeouts...Threw 102 pitches, 60 strikes.

📈 Owns a 2.45 ERA (5 ER/18.1 IP), .156 (10-for-64) opponent average, and 0.93 WHIP over his last three starts compared to a 5.03 ERA (19 ER/34.0 IP), .304 (41-for-135) opponent average, and 1.82 WHIP over his first seven outings.

TAMPA BAY ON MY MIND: Bradish is set to make his ninth career start against the Rays, having gone 2-4 with a 5.62 ERA (26 ER/41.2 IP)...In four starts opposite Tampa Bay at Camden Yards, he is 0-2 with a 9.31 ERA (20 ER/19.1 IP).

ABOVE THE CURVE: He deploys his curveball 22.1 percent of the time, holding opponents to a .171 (7-for-41) clip on the offering...Among all MLB starters, the .171 opponent average off the curveball is fifth lowest (min. 40 AB ending in pitch) behind HOU's Spencer Arrighetti (.082), WSH's Jake Irvin (.114), PIT's Braxton Ashcraft (.119), and TEX's MacKenzie Gore (.151).

📈 Over his last five starts since April 26, Bradish has limited the opposition to a .077 (2-for-26) mark on his curveball.

SLIDE IT OVER: Opponents have had greater success of Bradish's slider, going 14-for-56 (.250) with two triples and three home runs...His .536 opponent slugging percentage off the offering is the third-highest in MLB (min. 50 AB ending in pitch), ahead of DET's Jack Flaherty (.574) and SEA's Logan Gilbert (.552).

📈 Opponents slashed .063/.063/.156 (2-for-32) off his slider with one home run in 2025.

RIGHT-SIDE STORY: He has allowed opponents to slash .338/.413/.535 (24-for-71) with five doubles, three home runs, and 12 RBI.

📈 Over his last four starts, however, he has limited righties to a .192 (5-for-26) clip after they went 19-for-45 (.422) over his first six starts.

📈 Overall, Bradish's .338 opponent average against right-handed hitters is third-highest in MLB (min. 80 BF), ahead of MIN's Simeon Woods Richardson (.364) and SF's Tyler Mahle (.340).

BEHIND THE EIGHT BALL: Bradish owns a 52.4 percent first-pitch strike rate, the lowest mark in the majors (min. 50.0 IP), with the next closest pitchers being NYY's Max Fried (52.9%) and ATH's J.T. Ginn (53.5%).

📈 In his six starts last season, Bradish posted a 63.5 percent first-pitch strike rate.

WALK DON'T RUN: Bradish's 12.2 percent walk rate this season is the highest of his career (9.2%; 2024) and is the second-highest mark in the majors (min. 50.0 IP) ahead of KC's Kris Bubic (12.6%).
