THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 2-5 (2-2 in Detroit and 0-3 in Baltimore), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a loss to the Tigers last night...today, the Twins and Tigers will play the second game of this three-game series and wrap the series tomorrow afternoon...after this series, the Twins will host the White Sox for a four-game series from Monday-Thursday.

◆ The Twins are looking to avoid dropping their sixth-straight game today, which would extend their season-long streak...their last win came in Game 2 of the doubleheader in Detroit last Saturday.

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins are playing the sixth of 13 games against the Tigers today... Minnesota has gone 2-3 against the Tigers this season, their only two wins coming last Saturday, taking both games of the doubleheader at Comerica Park.

♣ Rocco Baldelli has a managerial record of 49-36 against the Tigers — since 2019...only Terry Francona (51-29) has beaten Detroit more in that span.

♣ Jeffers has gone 6-for-19 (.316) with four RBI in five games against the Tigers this season.

♣ His 27 career hits, seven home runs, 22 RBI and 14 walks against Detroit (45 games) are his most against any opponent.

CAMARGO TRAIN: Jair Camargo is making his first major league start today...he made his debut on Tuesday at Baltimore, pinch-hitting in the ninth inning for Byron Buxton, drawing a walk and scoring a run...Camargo spent all of 2023 with Triple-A St. Paul, hitting .259 (86-for-332) with 16 doubles, 21 home runs, 63 RBI and an .826 OPS...he set minor league/professional career-high in hits (86), runs scored (56), home runs (21), RBI (63) and walks (29)...added to Twins' 40-man roster on November 6...ranked as 26th-best prospect in Twins organization by Baseball America entering 2024.

The Camargo was acquired by the Twins as part of the Kenta Maeda trade with Los Angeles-NL in February of 2020.

Jair is the second player in club history to wear uniform number 85, the previous being left-handed pitcher Charlie Barnes in 2021.

REST IN PEACE, DAVE McCARTY: Former Twins outfielder/first baseman Dave McCarty passed Luis Castillo, SEA.. away yesterday at age 54...McCarty was the Twins third overall pick in the 1991 First-Year Player Draft and made hi in 1993...he played parts of three seasons in a Twins uniform, hitting .226 with three home runs in 167 games. and made his debut with Minnesota

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In **1988**, the Hubert H. Humphrey Metrodome hosted the 10,000th home run in Yankees history as Claudell Washington went deep off Jeff Reardon in a 7-6 victory over the Twins...on this day in **1995**, Jeff Reardon announced his retirement; the closer for the 1987 World Champion Twins saved 104 games in a Twins uniform from 1987-89 and ranks sixth on the club's all-time list; he saved three postseason games in 1987, including World Series Game 7, securing the Twins first ever World Series victory.
