RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a seven-game homestand against the Orioles (0-1, 3 to play) and Cubs (3 to play) today at Tropicana Field...they had a three-game winning streak snapped with last night's 6-3 loss to the Orioles, but are 6-4 in their last 10 games on the heels of a season-high six-game losing streak...however, they are 6-10 in their last 16 games overall after posting an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 from May 3-18...have fallen a season-high 13.0 games back in the AL East standings, their largest deficit since the conclusion of the 2022 season (13.0 GB)...the Rays are 0-1 thus far during a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26.

Last night, Tampa Bay fell to 7-14 in series openers, including 3-9 at home...it has lost five consecutive series-opening contests at Tropicana Field, the club's longest streak since dropping five straight from June 20–July 20, 2023.

The Rays are 1-7 in their last eight games against AL East opponents after a 9-7 start...they are 3-8 against division rivals at home, losing each of their last five contests since their last win on May 11 vs. NYY...it marks their longest such skid since April 18-May 10, 2019 (5G)...they have not had a longer home losing streak vs. AL East clubs since a six-game skid from Sept. 10-26, 2003.

Tampa Bay's bullpen owns a 2.87 ERA (125.1IP, 40ER) since May 3, third lowest in the AL behind the Guardians (1.99) and Astros (2.50) and fifth in MLB.

The Rays have won six of their last 10 series following a 3-5-2 start...this marks their fourth four-game series, going 1-0-2 in the previous three.

With a win today, the Rays will move back to the .500 mark for the 15th time... they have spent the entire season within four games of .500.

Tampa Bay will don its City Connect uniforms for the ninth time today...the club is 6-2 when wearing the threads since their May 3 debut.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Earlier today, the Rays reinstated **LHP Colin Poche** (midback tightness) from the 15-day IL and placed **LHP Richard Lovelady** (left forearm flexor strain) on the 15-day IL...Poche missed 38 games with the injury.

TROP FLOPS—The Rays are 4-10 at home since May 8, the second-worst mark in MLB over that timeframe, better than only the Mets (4-11/.267)...they have been outscored, 69-43 (-26) in those contests, going 4-3 when scoring 4+ runs compared to 0-7 with three runs or fewer...during the same span (since May 8), Tampa Bay is 8-4 on the road.

TURNING TIDES—Coming off his first multi-hit effort since May 11 vs. NYY last night, Randy Arozarena has reached base safely in 12 of his last 16 plate appearances (3 1B, 2 2B, 5 BB, 2 HBP)... over his last three games, he has raised his on-base pct. by 26 points from .263 to .289... from June 4-5, he reached in eight consecutive plate appearances (1B, 2B, 4BB, 2HBP), falling 2 PA shy of the club record of 10 PA, shared by himself (May 20-22, 2022), Yandy Díaz (Aug. 20-23, 2020) and Ji-Man Choi (Sept. 11-12, 2019).

Through five games in June, Arozarena is batting 6-for-15 (.400) with 2 2B, 6 BB, 2 SO, a .609 on-base pct. and a 1.142 OPS...he has hit safely in all five contests, marking his longest hitting streak since Sept. 11-16, 2023 (6G).

BRINGING THE LUMBER—The Rays have recorded a 45.4 pct. hard-hit rate in June, fourth best in the majors behind the Orioles (50.8%), Red Sox (47.6%) and Pirates (46.9%)... they entered the month at 36.0 pct. for the season, 27th in the majors...they have recorded two of their highest hard-hit ball totals (95+ mph) this month: 17 on June 4 at MIA and 16 on June 2 at BAL.

Brandon Lowe went 4-for-8 with 1 2B, 1 HR and 6 RBI during Tampa Bay's two-game sweep in Miami...he recorded consecutive multi-hit games for the first time since May 16-17, 2023 at NYM...he is slashing .294/.429/.559 (10-for-34) with 5 XBH (1HR) and 10 RBI during a 12-game on-base streak, tied for the third longest of his career and his longest since a career-best 17-game run from Aug. 15-Sept. 7, 2023.

Jose Siri is batting .333 (10-for-30) with 3 2B, 3 HR and 9 RBI over his last nine games... has 15 RBI in his last 17 games after collecting seven in his first 34 contests.

Yandy Díaz has a 10-game on-base streak, matching April 10-20 for his longest of the season...he has a .304 on-base pct., 7 BB and 6 SO during the streak.

Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in 31 of 33, 35 of 38, 42 of 46 and 50 of his last 55 games...he has reached base multiple times in 35 games, tied for fourth most in the AL behind NYY Aaron Judge (40), NYY Juan Soto (39) and KC Bobby Witt Jr. (36).

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—The Rays were out-homered, 3-1, last night and have recorded a -33 (82-49) HR margin this season, tied with the White Sox (84-51) for the worst mark in the majors...they have out-homered the opposition just once in their last 16 games (May 30 vs. OAK), posting a -12 (21-9) HR margin in that span.

The Rays are 8-2 when out-homering their opponent, 16-11 when home runs are even and 7-19 when being out-homered.

Rays batters have recorded the fewest home runs in the majors (49), one behind the Marlins and Nationals (50 each)...Rays pitching has allowed the third most homers (82), fewer than the Blue Jays and White Sox (both 84).

RALLY RAYS—The Rays 17 comeback wins are tied with the Tigers for fourth most in the majors behind the Yankees (19), Orioles and Phillies (both 18)...each of their six wins from May 18–June 4 came in come-from-behind fashion, their longest streak since May 8-18, 2013 (8G), per Elias...overall, 54.8 pct. of their victories (17 of 31) have been comeback wins, tied with the Tigers for the highest percentage in the AL/tied for fourth highest is the majors.

The Rays rank among MLB leaders in wins when trailing after six (T2nd, 7), seven (1st, 6) and eight (T3rd, 3) frames.

DOWN TO THE WIRE—The Rays own the best record in the majors in both one-run games (12-4/.750) and games decided by two runs or fewer (22-9/.710)...their 31 games decided by two or fewer runs are tied for third most in the AL behind the Athletics (34) and Angels (32)...they lead the majors in wins by two runs or fewer (22), but their 22 losses by 3+ runs are second most in the AL behind the White Sox (29).

The Rays have won each of their last six one-run games, their longest single-season streak a seven-game run from Aug. 10–Sept. 2, 2019...they are 13-3 in their last 16 games decided by two runs or fewer.

BIRDS IN THE BAY—The Rays and Orioles continue a 13-game season series with the fourth of seven matchups over 11 days from May 31–June 10, with Tampa Bay going 1-3 thus far...in 2023, the Rays went 5-8 against the Orioles (2-4 at home), snapping a streak of six consecutive season series victories...since 2017, the Rays are 73-46 against the Orioles, their most wins against any opponent over that timeframe...however, the Rays have lost 11 of the last 16 meetings and are 13-20 in the last 33 matchups on the heels of a 27-2 stretch in the previous 29...the Rays are 0-4-1 in their last five series against the Orioles... their last series win over Baltimore came from Aug. 12-14, 2022 at Tropicana Field.

Randy Arozarena is a career .337 (70-for-208) hitter with 10 2B, 1 3B, 16 HR and 43 RBI in 54 games vs. Baltimore, his most hits, home runs and RBI against any opponent...among active players, only HOU José Abreu (.345) and HOU Jose Altuve (.339) own higher career batting averages against the Orioles.

TODAY'S START—The right-hander will make his sixth start of the season this afternoon, including his fourth at home...opened the season on the 15-day IL (right pectoral strain) before making his 2024 debut on May 10 vs. NYY...suffered the injury while warming up for his scheduled spring start on March 12 at BAL.

LAST TIME OUT—Suffered the loss on June 1 at Baltimore...surrendered a career high in runs (9) while his nine hits and four home runs both matched career highs.

Allowed three runs in the 1st inning, including back-to-back home runs by **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Anthony Santander**...allowed his third long ball of the day facing **Jordan Westburg** in the 2nd frame...Mountcastle collected his second homer of the day in the 4th inning, knocking Bradley out of the game.

DÉJÀ VU—Bradley is set to make his second straight start opposite Baltimore...in three prior starts against the Orioles, he is 1-1 with an 8.16 ERA (14.1IP, 13ER) and 17 SO against 4 BB...in his two starts at Tropicana Field, Bradley is 1-0 with a 3.27 ERA (11.0IP, 4ER) and 14 SO against 1 BB.

He earned the win on June 21, 2023 vs. BAL at Tropicana Field after

tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball, scattering three hits with zero walks and eight strikeouts in his first career quality start.

WRONG SIDE OF HISTORY-Bradley allowed a career-high nine earned runs, including four home runs, in his most recent start...he joined Casey
Fossum (Aug. 10, 2005) as the only pitchers in club history to allow 9 ER
to the Orioles...he was the second pitcher this season to allow 9 ER against
Baltimore, joining MIN Chris Paddack on April 16.

He was the first Rays pitcher to allow 9 ER in any game since Luis
Patiño on Sept. 11, 2022 at NYY (1.1IP, 5H, 9ER, 4BB, 3HR, 0SO).

LONG BALL WOES—Bradley's 29 HR allowed as a starter are the second most through a pitcher's first 26 career starts in franchise history, behind Doug Waechter (31, 2003-05)...last season, from his April 12 debut through June 15, his 0.84 HR/9.0 IP was the 12th-lowest mark in the AL (min. 40.0IP)...from that point on, his 2.77 HR/9.0 IP was second highest in the majors (min. 50.0IP) behind MIN Joe Ryan (2.79).

Since making his MLB debut on April 12, 2023, Bradley is one of three pitchers to allow 4+ HR in multiple games, joining Ryan (3G) and SD Yu Darvish (2G).

STRIKEOUT ARTIST—Bradley has recorded 160 SO in his first 26 career starts, third most in any pitcher's first 26 starts after joining the Rays, trailing Charlie Morton (194, 2019) and Drew Smyly (173, 2014-16)... Morton (197) also holds the mark through 27 starts, followed by Smyly (179) and Tyler Glasnow (167)...Bradley's 160 SO are the most by a Ray in his first 26 career starts, outpacing Matt Moore (156, 2011-12).

On May 20 vs. BOS, Bradley became the second Ray this year to record 10+ strikeouts, joining Ryan Pepiot (11SO) on April 7 at COL... he became one of five pitchers (6 instances) in the majors this season to throw 7.0+ innings, record 10+ SO and issue zero walks.

In 2023. Bradley posted a 28.4 pct. strikeout rate, the highest

In 2023, Bradley posted a 28.4 pct. strikeout rate, the highest mark by a rookie in Rays history (min. 300BF), surpassing **Shane McClanahan's** 27.3 pct. in 2021.

USAGE UPDATE—Bradley has utilized his split-finger 25.1 pct. of the time this season, holding opponents to a .161 (5-for-31) clip with 1 XBH (2B) and 15 SO...he has thrown his curveball 13.1 pct. of the time, with opponents

going 1-for-7 (HR) with 2 SO.

Last season, Bradley featured his curveball 16.7 pct. of the time, compared to 13.6 pct. on his splitter...opponents went 11-for-65 (.169) on his curveball and 12-for-63 (.190) on the split finger...of his 129 SO last season, 30 came via the curve and 26 via the split-finger.

FIRST THINGS FIRST—Through his first five starts, Bradley has limited opponents to a 6-for-42 (.143) clip with 19 of his 32 SO the first time through the lineup...opposing hitters are 14-for-37 (.378) the second time through and 4-for-21 (.190) the third time.

ADVANCED TALK—Of Bradley's 70 batted balls, 14 have been barreled (20.0%), the highest barrel rate (min. 75BF) in the majors, with the next closest being WSH **Tanner Rainey** (18.6%).
