RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and Atlanta Braves play the finale of a three-game weekend series today at Busch Stadium, concluding a six-game homestand (2-3) with Washington (2-1) and Atlanta (0-2) leading into the All-Star Break ... St. Louis opens a six-game road trip through Arizona (July 18-20) and Colorado (July 21-23) on Friday.

BIRD WATCHING: St. Louis has 50+ wins before the All-Star Break for the second consecutive season, marking the first time the Cards logged 50+ victories prior to the Break in back-to-back years since 2014-15 (52 & 56) ... The Cardinals began the day in 3rd place in the NL Central, 6.5 games behind first place Chicago and 2.5 games behind San Francisco for the 3rd Wild Card spot ... Today's 97th game matches the 1969 Cardinals (49-48 record) for the most in franchise history before the All-Star break.

HERRERA ACTIVATED: Prior to today's series finale, the Cardinals activated C/DH **Iván Herrera** from the 10-Day Injured List and (corresponding move to be announced) ... Herrera, who missed the previous 21 games due to a left hamstring strain, was 4-for-7 (.571) with a double and RBI in two injury rehab games with Memphis (AAA).

IT'S ALWAYS SONNY IN ST. LOUIS: With a win today, **Sonny Gray** is aiming to become the first Cardinal with double-digit wins before the All-Star Break since **Miles Mikolas** (10-3) in 2018 ... The Cardinals are 10-1 in **Sonny Gray's** 11 starts at Busch Std. this season ... Those 10 Cards team wins are the most for a singular starting pitcher at home in MLB this season.

NOT YOUR AVERAGE JOES: Cardinals 2018 7th Rd. selection **Brendan Donovan** (.297, 1st) and 2020 2nd rounder **Alec Bursleson** (.289, 8th) are aiming to become the first pair of Cardinals to rank in the NL Top 10 in batting at the All-Star break since 2013: Cards 2000 4th Rd. pick **Yadier Molina** (.341, 1st) and 2006 8th rounder **Allen Craig** (.333, 2nd).

- If Donovan (.297, 101-340) can hold off Arizona's **Josh Naylor** (.295, 95-322) today, the All-Star would be the first Cardinal to lead the National League in batting at the All-Star break since 1B **Paul Goldschmidt** (.330) in his 2022 MVP season.
- Donovan (101 hits) is the first Cardinal with 100+ pre-All Star hits since **Goldschmidt** (112) in 2022 and just the second to do so since SS **Jhonny Peralta** (100 in 2015) ... Cards primary 2B to reach the 100+ hit threshold before the break include **Fernando Viña** (102 in 2001), **Tom Herr** (106 in 1985), and **Red Schoendienst** (106 in 1949; 114 in 1953; 119 in 1954).

FEELING A DRAFT: The Cardinals own the 5th overall selection in tonight's 2025 MLB Draft that takes place from the Coca-Cola Roxy in The Battery Atlanta ... Tonight features the first 105 selections (Rounds 1-3) and begins at 5:00 p.m. CT on ESPN and MLB Network ... Tomorrow's Day Two includes Rounds 4-20 and starts at 10:30 a.m. CT.

- St. Louis has 21 overall selections over the two-day period, including four picks tonight: #5 (1st round), #55 (2nd round), #72 (Competitive Balance Round B), and #89 (3rd round).
- St. Louis drafted INF **JJ Wetherholt** with the 7th overall pick from West Virginia last season, while tonight's 5th overall pick is the franchise's highest since **J.D. Drew** (#5 in 1998) and marks the first time in franchise history having consecutive top 10 selections.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY YADI: Happy 43rd birthday to former Cardinals 2000 4th round pick, All-Star, and World Series Champion catcher **Yadier Molina** ... Also celebrating today include Cardinals Minor League Outfield/Hitting Instructor and former All-Star **Ryan Ludwick** (47), **Cody Bellinger** (30), **Shin-Soo Choo** (43), former NBA Slam Dunk champion **Anthony "Spud" Webb** (62), sports journalist **Tony Kornheiser** (77), and actors **Richard "Cheech" Marin** (79) and **Harrison Ford** (83).

ATLANTA CONNECTIONS

Cardinals broadcaster **Chip Caray** previously was the play-by-play voice of the Braves for 20 seasons on Bally Sports South and Bally Sports Southeast (2010-22), TBS and Peachtree TV (2005-2009) and on TBS and the Atlanta Braves Radio Network (1991-1992).....his father, **Skip Caray**, was part of Braves broadcasts from 1978-2008.

Victor Scott II was born in Atlanta...graduated from McEachern High School in Powder Springs, Ga...resides in Powder Springs...grew up a fan of the Atlanta Braves.

Jordan Walker was born in Stone Mountain, Ga... Graduated from Decatur (Ga.) High School, where he was a 2019 and 2020 Gatorade High School Player of the Year.

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for & managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Braves (1966-68 & 1982-84)...traded to St. Louis from Atlanta for **Orlando Cepeda** (Mar. 17, 1969).

Riley O'Brien's grandfather, **Johnny O'Brien**, was drafted by NBA's Milwaukee Hawks, who later became the St. Louis Hawks, and are now the Atlanta Hawks.

Brian Snitker was born in Decatur, Ill...graduated from Macon (Ill.) High School...managed **Adam Wainwright** on the 2003 Greenville Braves.

Marcell Ozuna played two seasons with St. Louis (2018-19)...originally became a Cardinal via trade with Miami for **Sandy Alcantara**, **Daniel Castano**, **Zac Gallen**, & **Magneuris Sierra** (Dec. 14, 2017)...as compensation for Ozuna signing with Atlanta, St. Louis selected **Alec Bursleson** in the 2nd round of the 2020 MLB draft.

Pierce Johnson pitched three seasons (2010-12) at Missouri State University...set the school's single-season record with 119 strikeouts in 2012.

Braves pitching coach **Rick Kranitz** was originally selected by the Cardinals in the 3rd round of the 1977 MLB January Draft, but did not sign.

Austin Riley made his MLB debut vs. the Cardinals (May 19, 2019 at Truist Park).

Drake Baldwin played college baseball at Missouri State University (2020-22).

Kyle Leahy's uncle, **Thomas Leahy**, pitched in the Braves minor league organization (1991-93).

JoJo Romero (Aug. 21, 2020 at Truist) and **Jon Jay** (April 26, 2010 at Busch III) made their MLB debuts vs. the Braves.

Hall of Fame catcher **Ted Simmons** played his final three seasons with Atlanta (1986-88).

Braves Bench Coach **Walt Weiss** managed **Nolan Arenado** for four seasons in Colorado (2013-16).

Stubby Clapp played the 2003 season for the Richmond Braves (AAA-Braves).

Cardinals Communications Game Day Associates Supervisor **Jacob Mayer** was a 2015 Media Relations Trainee for Gwinnett (AAA).

TODAY'S GAME:

- The Cardinals Opening Day starter is set to make his 19th start of the season (325th career appearance/316th start). The 19 starts ties his most before the All-Star Break (2014).
- Looking to win 10 games pre All-Star Break for the 3rd tim in his career and first time since back-to-back seasons in 2014 & 2015 with Oakland.
- Cardinals are 10-1 in his 11 home starts (only loss vs. NYM 5/2). Tied with the Tigers (Skubal), Blue Jays (Bassitt), Mets (Peterson) and Phillies (Wheeler) for team home wins in starts by a singular pitcher this season.**
- Has not allowed a home run over his last 6 home starts (35.1 IP), last was Pete Alonso on May 2.
- Has not allowed a home run to a left-handed batter in his last 9 starts (126 batters faced). Joins **Jose Berrios** as the only two MLB pitchers since May 20 without a HR vs. a left-handed batter (100 TBF).
- Leads the Cardinals staff in percentage of Swings That Miss (26.8%)
- Since joining the Cardinals in 2024, ranks T-8th in Major League Baseball with 316 strikeouts.
- Has 20 career double-digit strikeout games, including three since May 19. Since his career began in 2013, ranks 28th among his peers in 10+ K games.
- Is 6-1 with a 2.83 ERA (4 HR) in 11 home starts and 3-2 with a 4.57 ERA (6 HR) in seven road starts.
- Issued one-or-fewer walks in 14-of-18 starts this season; Cardinals are 11-3 in those games.
- Has six scoreless starts of 6.0 innings or more, tied for 2nd-most in MLB behind Detroit's LHP Tarik Skubal (8)**
- The Cardinals are 14-4 in his 18 starts this season, with two of his defeats coming in starts against the Mets.
- Sonny's 15 wins at home the past two seasons (2024-2025) are tied for 3rd-most in the majors behind **Tarik Skubal** (18) and **Zack Wheeler** (16). He is 6-1 and St. Louis is 10-1 in his Home starts this season.
- Is one of 11 pitchers in Busch Stadium III history with 200+ strikeouts (214 K). **Trevor Rosenthal** ranks 10th with 244 strikeouts.
- 10 of his 95 hits allowed in 2025 have been homers and **17 of his 43 runs (40%) allowed this season have come via HR's.**
- His 10 HR's allowed have surpassed his season total (8) for all of the 2023 season.
- Over past two seasons since joining St. Louis (2024-25), ranks 5th in strikeouts/ 9 IP (10.48) and T-3rd in wins (22) among NL pitchers.
- St. Louis is 31-15 (.674) in his 46 starts with the club since joining in 2024; His record stands at 22-12 while wearing the Birds on the Bat.

LAST TIME OUT: Threw a season-low 70 pitches covering 5.0 innings in a 4-2 win over WSH (7/8). Allowed two runs on five hits with six strikeouts following a 2-hour, 19-minute rain delay in a game that started at 9:04 PM local time.

2025:

- Authored a one-hit complete-game shutout masterpiece at CLE (6/27) striking out a season-high 11 Guardians on only 89 pitches in the 5-0 Cardinals win. His only blemish was a two-out Nolan Jones single in the bottom of the 5th inning.
- Marked Gray's 5th career shutout and first since July 28, 2015 at Los Angeles Dodgers. It was the 11th time a Cardinal threw a one-hitter, one batter over the minimum since 1901, and first since **Jordan Montgomery** at Wrigley Field on Aug. 22, 2022.*
- Since pitch counts were accurately kept in 1988, Gray joined **David Cone**'s perfect game (July 18, 1999) as the only two pitchers to throw shutouts of one hit or fewer with 10+ strikeouts in 89 pitches or fewer.*
- CAREER NOTES:**
- Ranks in the Top 10 among active pitchers in wins (120, 7th), games started (316, 9th), innings pitched (1,842.1, 10th), strikeouts (1,837, 9th) and ERA (3.51, 7th).

GRAY vs. ATLANTA

- Making his 8th career start vs. the Braves posting a 1-3 record with a 3.86 ERA over 44.1 innings with 48 strikeouts.
- Earned the win in his last start vs. ATL at Truist Park with a double-digit strikeout game over 7.0 innings while working around a career-high four home runs (all solo).
- Last four starts vs. the Braves have all come in Atlanta dating back to Aug. 4, 2019. Last start vs. the Braves away from Atlanta was 4/23/19 in Cincinnati.
- Braves were the 28th different team Gray earned a win against. Only Atizona and Colorado remain to complete the cycle.
