### Starting Pitching

Atlanta got 14.0 scoreless innings from its two starters in yesterday's doubleheader, with RH Allan Winans and RH Spencer Strider each throwing 7.0 innings in Games 1 & 2, respectively.

RH Charlie Morton pitched 5.0 scoreless in the first game of this series, and Braves starters have combined to throw 19.0 consecutive scoreless innings versus the Mets this weekend.

Entering this series, Atlanta starters had allowed 31 earned runs over 25.1 innings in their previous six games.

The Braves' 5.31 ERA (82 ER/139.0 IP) from its rotation since the All-Star break is third-highest in the National League.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Mets tonight conclude a four-game weekend series with what is the 10th of 13 games between the teams this season...The two will meet for the final time just eight days from now with a three-game set at Truist Park, August 21-23.

*A* Atlanta is 8-1 in nine games with New York this season...The Braves have won 14 of the last 16 games with New York dating to last season, outscoring the Mets 118-54 (+64) over the stretch.

*A* The Braves went 10-9 against the Mets last season, taking the season set from their N.L. East rivals for the fifth consecutive season...They also went 10-9 in 2021, 7-3 in 2020, 11-8 in 2019 and 13-6 in 2018...Since the start of the 2018 season, Atlanta is 59-36 (.621) against New York overall.

*A* Atlanta has won five of six games here at Citi Field this season, and is 75-57 (.568) here all-time...Just four teams in baseball have a better winning percentage here since the stadium opened in 2009, and Atlanta's .568 mark is the best of any team to play here at least 45 times.

*A* RH Yonny Chirinos is slated for the first start and second appearance of his career against New York, after pitching 4.2 innings of three-run relief versus the Mets while with the Rays earlier this season...He earned the win...The 6-foot-2, 225-pound right-hander has an 8.56 ERA (13 ER/13.2 IP) in three starts with Atlanta since the club claimed him off waivers from the Rays, although the Braves are 3-0 in his starts.

*A* RH Kodai Senga is set to make just the 22nd start of his major league career and his first against the Braves...The 6-foot-1, 202-pound native of Aichi, Japan, is 8-6 with a 3.24 ERA (42 ER/116.2 IP) in his rookie campaign, including a 4-2 mark and a 2.45 ERA (17 ER/62.1 IP) in 11 turns at home.

**WIN(S):** Atlanta swept a pair of doubleheader games with New York yesterday, winning the opener, 21-3, before shutting out the Mets, 6-0, in the nightcap...The Braves are 5-1 in doubleheader games this season.

*A* Per Elias, Atlanta became just the fifth team since 1940 with at least 20 runs and a shutout in a doubleheader...The 27 runs tied for the most allowed in a single day in Mets franchise history, and Atlanta's +31 run-differential (34-3) in the series is the best in a three-game stretch since 1900.

*A* The Braves' 21 runs in the opener were there most in a single game since plating 20 on June 30, 2021, also against the Mets...Atlanta has four 20-run games since the start of the 2020 season, most by any team in baseball.

*A* Also in the opener, Atlanta became the first team in major league history with at least 20 runs, five homers, five doubles and three steals in a single game...Research courtesy StatsPerform.

*A* Ozzie Albies homered in both games yesterday, the second Braves player to do so this season...Ronald Acuña Jr. also homered in both games of a doubleheader, June 14 at Detroit.

**N.L. EAST:** Atlanta improved to 25-6 (.807) in intradivision games this season with yesterday's wins, and has won eight straight and 14-of-15 against the N.L. East dating to May 28.

*A* Atlanta has not lost a series to an N.L. East opponent this season, going 8-0-1 in divisional sets...The Braves split four games with the Phillies, May 25-28.

*A* The Braves' .807 winning percentage against their own division is easily the best in baseball, and no other N.L. East team is even above .500.

*A* Atlanta is batting .297/.361/.552 with a .913 OPS in 31 intradivision games, with 70 of their 225 home runs...The Braves are averaging 7.03 runs per game.

*A* Dating to 2018, when Atlanta's run of five consecutive division titles began, the Braves are 237-138 (.632) against the N.L. East, the third-best intradivision record in baseball...The Dodgers are 249-130 (.657) against the N.L. West in that span, and the Astros are 247-136 (.645) in the A.L. West.

**MATT OLSON:** Took sole possession of the major league home run lead yesterday, connecting on his 41st and 42nd of the season in the opening game...He went 4-for-9 with a double, two homers, four runs and four RBI between the two.

*A* Olson also leads all of baseball with 105 RBI on the season...No player in franchise history has led the majors in both homers and RBI since 1956, when Hall-of-Famer Hank Aaron had 44 homers and 132 RBI for Milwaukee.

*A* Olson is on pace for 59 homers and 147 RBI, both of which would establish new modern-era franchise records for a single season.

*A* Yesterday's opener was Olson's seventh multi-homer game this season, two more than any other player in baseball...The single-season franchise record for multi-homer games is nine, set by Andruw Jones in 2005.

*A* In 48 games since moving out of the No. 2 spot in the batting order on June 15, Olson is batting .331/.425/.801 with a 1.225 OPS, and leads the majors with 24 homers, 60 RBI and 36 extra-base hits.

**RILEY IN NEW YORK:** Austin Riley went 2-for-5 with a homer and three RBI in yesterday's first game, his 28th homer of the season...He is 14-for-44 with a .964 OPS and three homers on Atlanta's current road trip.

*A* In 35 career games here at Citi Field, Riley is now batting .262/.331/.554 with 11 homers, 22 RBI and an .885 OPS.

*A* He has more runs, home runs, and RBI here than in any park other than Truist Park.

*A* Since his debut season in 2019, his 11 home runs here are tied for the most by a visiting player, matching the total of San Diego's Juan Soto...Soto is the only visiting player with more RBI here in that span (23).

  - A* Is 1-0 with a 8.56 ERA in three starts for the Braves.
  - A* Was claimed off waivers from Tampa Bay on July 23.
- A* Went 4-4 with a 4.02 ERA in four starts and 11 relief appearances for the Rays.
  - A* Went 3-1 with a 2.60 ERA in his first eight appearances this season.
- A* Earned his first win with Atlanta after scattering six hits and three runs over 5.0 innings pitched against Los Angeles (AL) in his last start.
- A* Chirinos is getting hitters to swing and miss rate of 21.6% since joining Atlanta.
  - A* The rate was 16.1% with Tampa Bay.

  - A* On September 7, 2022 made his first appearance in the majors since August 16, 2020; 1...Went 751 days between apps and 1,129 days between wins.

# Braves Bullpen Briefs

**Brad Hand • LHP • 6-3 • 224 • 33 yrs • #45**

- Saves/Opp:** 0/0    **Holds:** 3    **1st Batter/Retired:** 45/25    **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 22/5
- Allowed two earned runs at Pittsburgh on August 10, his first since joining Atlanta...Before that, pitched 3.0 scoreless innings and held opponents to a .111 batting average since joining the club...In his last 12 games overall, has pitched to a 2.45 ERA (3 ER/11.0 IP).
  - Was acquired on August 1 prior to MLB's trade deadline in exchange for minor-league RHP Alec Barger.
  - Pitching arsenal includes a sweeper (47.2%), four-seam fastball (33.6%) and a sinker (19.2%).
  - Prior to joining the Braves, made 40 relief appearances for the Rockies this season, pitching to a 3-1 record and a 4.54 ERA (18 ER/35.2 IP)...He struck out 41 batters and walked 16.
  - Has been selected to three All-Star teams: 2017, 2018 & 2019...Hand is in his 13th major league season.
  - During the abbreviated 2020 season, he led baseball with 16 saves and paced the American League with 21 games finished.

**Raisel Iglesias • RHP • 6-2 • 190 • 33 yrs • #26**

- Saves/Opp:** 22/24    **Holds:** 0    **1st Batter/Retired:** 39/30    **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0
- Across 17 games since June 25, has pitched to a 1.13 ERA (2 ER/16.0 IP), while going 11-for-11 in save opportunities.
  - On May 10, allowed a home run for the first time since June 12, 2022 with the Angels – a homerless span of 45 games and 42.2 innings...It was the fifth-longest active homerless streak by a reliever in the majors.
  - On May 5 was activated from the IL after missing Atlanta's first 32 games with a strained right shoulder...Pitched in four spring training games, compiling a 4.50 ERA (2 ER/4.0 IP) in four outings.
  - In 2022, had a 2.47 ERA in 67 games with 17 saves and 15 holds between Atlanta and Los Angeles (AL)...After the trade deadline, led N.L. with a 41.7% chase rate (swings out of the zone)...Trained only CLE's E. Clase.
  - Allowed just one earned run in 28 relief appearances after becoming a member of the Braves...His 0.34 ERA during that span dating to the trade deadline is the lowest in baseball (min. 20 appearances).

**Joe Jiménez • RHP • 6-3 • 277 • 28 yrs • #77**

- Saves/Opp:** 0/1    **Holds:** 10    **1st Batter/Retired:** 43/32    **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 16/8
- Has pitched to a 1.07 ERA (3 ER/25.1 IP) over his last 21 games, dating to May 27...Among National League relievers since that date, his ERA ranks fourth (min. 20 games).
  - Pitched 62 games for DET last year, going 3-2 with a 3.49 ERA (22 ER/56.2 IP), striking out 77 and walking 13.
  - Acquired from Detroit on Dec. 7, 2022 in exchange for OF Justyn-Henry Malloy and LHP Jake Higginbotham.
  - Named to the A.L. All-Star team in 2018 during his first full major league campaign.
  - Last season, his 12.23 strikeouts per 9.0 innings ranked fifth in the American League among pitchers with at least 50.0 innings, and his 1.4 tWAR for the season matched his career high.

**Pierce Johnson • RHP • 6-2 • 202 • 32 yrs • #76**

- Saves/Opp:** 13/15    **Holds:** 5    **1st Batter/Retired:** 51/31    **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 7/1
- Pitching arsenal includes a curveball (51.1%), four-seam fastball (38.3%) and a slider (10.6%).
  - Was acquired on July 24 from the Colorado Rockies in exchange for minor-league pitchers RHP Tanner Gordon and RHP Victor Vodnik.
  - Struck out 20 through 11.1 innings in June, a 15.88 SO/9 that led the National League and ranked second in the majors (min. 10 games).

**Collin McHugh • RHP • 6-2 • 190 • 34 yrs • #32**

- Saves/Opp:** 0/0    **Holds:** 7    **1st Batter/Retired:** 35/26    **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 26/5
- Out of his 26 inherited runners this season, only five have scored (19.2%)...Among MLB relievers with as many inherited runners, that percentage ranks fifth.
  - His 2.53 ERA over the past three combined seasons (since 2021) is the seventh lowest in baseball (min. 125 games).
  - 2023 is his 11th MLB season...Finished 2022 with a 2.60 ERA and a 3-2 record in his first season with Atlanta.
  - In 48 outings (59.0 IP) after May 6 last season, he pitched to a 1.98 ERA.
  - In 2022, Stranded 28 of 38 inherited runners for a 73.7% strand rate...The 38 inherited runners were tied for the most in the NL and his strand rate is the third highest among NL pitchers (min. 30 IR).

**A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 27 yrs • #33**

- Saves/Opp:** 10/13    **Holds:** 11    **1st Batter/Retired:** 51/36    **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 16/5
- On July 31 was activated off the Injured List...Made two appearances with Triple-A Gwinnett as part of a rehabilitation assignment, appearing in two games against Jacksonville...Pitched two scoreless innings with a pair of strikeouts.
  - Allowed a run on August 6 in Chicago (NL), but has pitched to a 1.57 ERA across his last 26 major league appearances and 23.0 innings, dating to May 27.
  - His expected ERA (3.70, Fangraphs) is lower than his actual ERA (4.40).
  - Opponents are batting .318 against him at Truist Park compared to .174 on the road.
  - Since 2019, became one of two relievers with at least 10 saves and 10 holds prior to the All-Star break...Tyler Rogers (SF, 2021) also did it with 10 saves and 17 holds.
