#### **Climbing the Charts**

The Brewers (71-44) are looking to go a season-high 28 games over .500..... the team has not been 28 games over .500 since finishing 2021 at 95-67.

#### The Place To Be

The Brewers have played in front of sellout crowds at home in six of the last seven games and five in a row..... the team last had five straight sellouts in 2011 as part of a six-game stretch from August 17-30.....the Brewers are expecting sellouts in all three games this weekend against the Mets at American Family Field, which would mark seven straight capacity crowds for the first time since 2008 when the team had 44 on the season, including 22 in a row from July 10-September 1.

## Packed House

Last night's crowd of **43,469** marked the team's largest attendance of the season at American Family Field.

## Perk Up!

Blake Perkins ended the game last night against the Mets by throwing out Starling Marte at the plate from center field in the ninth inning....this marks the second season in a row that Perkins has thrown out a runner at the plate from center field to end a game....he threw out Stuart Fairchild to lock up a 5-4 win last season on 6/16 vs. Cincinnati....Trevor Megill was on the mound for both games.

## Big Woo!

**Brandon Woodruff** last night made his sixth start since his return from 2023 right shoulder surgery....it was his fifth quality start and fourth in a row....he is now 4-0 with a 2.29 ERA, .139 AVG and 0.65 WHIP this season (35.1ip, 17h, 9r, 9er, 6bb, 45k, 7hr) and the team is undefeated in his starts.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is game 2 (1-0) of a 6-game homestand against New York-NL (1-0) and Pittsburgh (3g).....following this homestand and an off day next Thursday, the team takes an 8-game trip to Cincinnati (3g) and Chicago-NL (5g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

AT HOME: The team is 37-20 at home, going 13-5-0 in series play.....are 25-11 in the last 36 home games and 14-4 in the last 18.....had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 7/7-7/13.

ON THE ROAD: The team is a Major League-best 34-24 on the road, going 10-7-2 in series play.....are 24-6 in the last 30 road games and 12-1 in the last 13 contests with a current season-high 7-game winning streak.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

COACHES: Associate manager Rickie Weeks (2nd season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach Jim Henderson (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf (1st season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), hitting coach Eric Theisen (1st season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season), first base coach Julio Borbón (1st season), third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role).

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE**: The team has made 20 replay challenges this season, going 13-7.....their last challenge (won) came on 8/4 at Atlanta as an out call at first base involving Andrew Vaughn was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6)....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

**BREWING CONSISTENCY**: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons [2017-24].....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 737 wins since 2017 (4th in MLB/2nd in National League).

MYERS AT A GLANCE: Tobias Myers, 27, will make his ninth appearance and sixth start of the season.....Myers is in his fourth stint with the team this season (4/24-5/10, 5/14-5/17, 7/11-7/27 and 8/8-current).....the team is 2-3 in his starts.....he does not have a quality start.....opponents are batting .284 (27-for-95, 2hr).....he is also 2-5 with a 3.77 ERA in 12 starts at Triple-A Nashville this season (59.2ip, 61h, 28r, 25er, 17bb, 55k, 5hr).....Myers began the season on the 15-day injured list with a left oblique strain.... he signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on 11/10/22.

LAST SEASON: Myers made his Major League debut and went 9-6 with a 3.00 ERA in 27 games/25 starts.....he had four stints with the team (4/17, 4/22-5/9, 5/21-5/31 and 6/5-end of season).....he was named Brewers Most Valuable Pitcher as voted on by members of the Milwaukee Chapter of the BBWAA....the team went 13-12 in his starts..... he made 7 quality starts.....opponents batted .242 (126-for-520, 18hr).....Myers started Game 3 of the NL Wild Card Series against the Mets and tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing just 2 hits (0bb, 5k, 1hbp, 1wp).

CAREER: Is 10-7 with a 3.19 ERA in 35 games/30 starts (161ip, 57er).....is in his second season in the majors, both with the Brewers (2024-25).....Myers was selected by Baltimore in the sixth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Winter Haven (FL) High School.....he committed to the University of South Florida prior to being drafted.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 5-2 with a 3.02 ERA in 17 games/14 starts (80.1ip, 27er)....is 1-1 with a 4.09 ERA in 4 games/2 starts this season [11ip, 5er].

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 5-5 with a 3.35 ERA in 18 games/16 starts (80.2ip, 30er)....is 0-0 with a 4.50 ERA in 4 games/3 starts this season (12ip, 6er).

CAREER vs. METS: Earned a 6-0 win in his only career regular-season outing against the Mets, coming in relief last season on 9/28 at American Family Field (4ip, 1h, 0bb, 5k).
