WRAPPING UP INTERLEAGUE PLAY: The Orioles begin their final Interleague series of the season tonight, with a three-game set in Philadelphia...The O's have gone 6-11 in Interleague play this season and 1-6 on the road; their lone road win came in their first Interleague game on April 20 at Miami...Orioles pitchers have gone 0-for-13 with one sacrifice bunt and eight strikeouts in 14 plate appearances this season...The last O's pitcher to record a hit was **John Means** on July 24, 2019 at Arizona.

- ❖ The Orioles have gone 32-27 all-time against the Phillies, including going 3-0 last season...The O's have gone 8-5 all-time at Citizens Bank Park; went 9-6 at Veterans Stadium.
- ❖ **OF Anthony Santander** hit safely in each of the three games last season against Philadelphia (.357/.400/.786), including recording a double and an RBI in each game.

ALONG BALL SHORT OF HISTORY: **OF Cedric Mullins** sits one home run shy (29 HR/30 SB) of the first 30 HR/30 SB season in Orioles history and the first in the majors since **Christian Yelich** and **Ronald Acuña, Jr.** in 2019 and first in the AL since **Mookie Betts** in 2018...He's looking to become the first center fielder (at least 75% of games played in CF) with a 30/30 season since **Mike Trout** in 2012; there have been 13 30/30 seasons by a center fielder in Major League history and four in AL history (Trout - 2012, **Jacoby Ellsbury** - 2011, **Grady Sizemore** - 2008, **José Cruz** - 2001).

- ❖ He is looking to become the sixth player (10th time) in Major League history 5'8"-or-shorter to record 30 home runs in a single season: **José Altuve** (31 - 2019), **Jimmy Rollins** (30 - 2017), **Kirby Puckett** (31 - 1986), **Yogi Berra** (30 - 1956 and 30 - 1952), **Hack Wilson** (56 - 1930, 39 - 1929, 31 - 1928, 30 - 1927).
- ❖ He is batting .366/.403/.664 (48-for-131) in the first inning this season...Mullins' 48 first-inning hits are the most in the majors and also the most in any single inning in the majors...Mullins' 21 first-inning extra-base hits (11-2B, 2-3B, 8 HR) also lead all of baseball.
- ❖ Mullins' 299 total bases are the fourth-most in the majors, trailing only: **Guerrero, Jr.**, TOR (342), **Semien**, TOR (323), and **Pérez**, KC (311)...He is looking to become the 24th player (39th time) in Orioles history to reach the 300 total bases mark; first since **Trey Mancini** in 2019 (322).
- ❖ He's made 139 starts this season (146 games), with 136 coming in center field and three as the DH; all have come while batting lead off...His 136 starts in CF are the most in the majors.
- ❖ His 5.5 WAR (according to *Fangraphs*) is the fourth-highest in the AL (**Guerrero, Jr.**, TOR - 6.8, **Semien**, TOR - 6.3, and **Ramírez**, CLE - 6.0) and the eighth-highest in the majors.

AL ROOKIE OF THE YEAR CAMPAIGN: **INF/OF Ryan Mountcastle** has recorded multi-hit games in back-to-back games, collecting at least one walk in each...His 34 multi-hit games lead American League rookies and are tied for the second-most by a rookie in the majors...His 30 home runs are tied for the most in the majors by a rookie (**García**, TEX)...He became the sixth rookie in the American League since 2000 to record a 30+ home run season (**Judge**, NYY - 52 in 2017, **Abreu**, CWS - 36 in 2014, **Jiménez**, CWS - 31 in 2019, **Trout**, LAA - 30 in 2012, and **García**, TEX - 30 in 2021).

- ❖ Mountcastle's 30 home runs lead the Orioles, one ahead of **Cedric Mullins**...**Jay Gibbons** in 2001 (15 HR) is the last Orioles rookie to tie for the team lead in home runs in a single season, while **Curt Blefary** in 1965 (22 HR) is the last O's rookie to lead the club in home runs outright in a single season.
- ❖ His 16 home runs since the All-Star Break (48 G) lead the O's, are the most by a rookie in the second-half, and are tied for the seventh-most in the American League...He's slashing .276/.333/.584 (51-for-185) in the second half...His .584 second half slugging percentage is the fifth-highest in the AL among qualifiers (min. 195 PA).
- ❖ His 83 RBI are the fifth-most in a single-season by an O's rookie; trailing only **Jim Gentile** (98 - 1960), **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (93 - 1982), **Eddie Murray** (88 - 1977), and **Ron Hansen** (86 - 1960).

SEPTEMBER HAYS: **OF Austin Hays** has hit safely in 15 of 17 games in September, including five multi-hit efforts, and has reached base safely in 16 of the 17...He's slashing .290/.338/.667 (20-for-69) with seven home runs and 18 RBI in 17 September games...His home runs and RBI are the most he's recorded in any month this season.

- ❖ His seven home runs in September, including two multi-homer games, are tied for the second-most in the majors, while his 11 extra-base hits (3-2B, 3B, 7 HR) this month are tied for the sixth-most in the AL and tied for eighth-most in the majors...His 36 RBI since the All-Star Break lead the O's.
- ❖ For his career, Hays has slashed .301/.343/.549 (74-for-246) with 15 home runs in 71 September games...Has 15 total homers in all other months combined (121 G).
- ❖ He's hit safely in 23 of his last 25 games, since August 24, raising his OPS +.080 during this stretch.
- ❖ This season he is batting .301/.335/.554 (56-for-186) with 11 home runs against left-handed pitching, while hitting .220/.276/.400 (56-for-255) with 10 homers against right-handed pitching.

GOING, GOING, GONE: The Orioles have homered 26 times on the road in the second half (29 G), the third-fewest in the majors, compared to their 57 home runs at Oriole Park in the second half (31 G), which lead the majors...For the season, the O's 70 home runs on the road are the second-fewest in the majors (Pittsburgh - 59), while their 114 home runs at home are the third-most in baseball.

- ❖ The Orioles 103 combined home runs from their outfield and designated hitter spots rank second in the majors, behind only the New York Yankees with 107 (**Mullins** - 29, **Hays** - 21, **Santander** - 17, **Mountcastle** - 12, **Stewart** - 12, **Mancini** - 10, **McKenna** - 2).
- ❖ **Mountcastle** (24 years and 214 days) 30 home runs and **Mullins** (26 years and 354 days) 29 home runs are looking to become the third pair in Orioles history to both hit 30 home runs in a single-season before turning 27 (also: **Chris Davis** and **Adam Jones** - 2012 and **Manny Machado** and **Jonathan Schoop** - 2017).
- ❖ The Orioles have four players with at least 20 home runs this season (**Mullins**, **Mountcastle**, **Mancini**, **Hays**)...They are one of eight teams in the majors to have at least four players with 20+ homer seasons: Chicago-NL and Houston (4) and Atlanta, Boston, Cincinnati, Los Angeles-NL, Toronto (5)...Five teams (Cleveland, New York-AL, Seattle, Tampa Bay, Toronto) currently have two players each with 30+ home runs.

THIS AND THAT:

- ❖ **OF Cedric Mullins** was awarded *MLB Play of the Week* for his home run-robbing catch of **Gary Sánchez** on September 15 vs. New York-AL...It's Mullins' first career Play of the Week Award and the first for an Oriole since **Stevie Wilkerson** in September 2019.
- ❖ **INF Ramón Urías** has recorded exactly one hit in 11 of his last 12 games (Since August 31); has reached base safely in all 12 games during this stretch...His .359 OBP leads American League rookies (min. 280 PA) and is the third-highest among all Major League rookies.
- ❖ Double-A Bowie begins the Double-A Northeast Championship Series on Tuesday against the Akron Rubber Ducks (Cleveland Indians affiliate).
- ❖ High-A Aberdeen's **RHP Brandon Young** earned High-A East Pitcher of the Week honors for this past week (September 13-19); Young was signed by the O's as an undrafted free agent in 2020.
- ❖ The Orioles have used a club record 59 different players this season (37 pitchers and 22 position players), passing the previous record of 58 from the 2019 season...**RHP Brooks Kiske** has yet to make an appearance with the O's.

QUICK HITS: Means will be appearing in his 66th-career game and making his 61th-career start...His 1.7 WPA leads the team...His next win will be the 20th of his career...Tossed the 300th inning of his career on 8/12 vs. Detroit...Named American League Player of the Week for the first time in his career on 5/10...According to *Baseball Reference*, Means owns each of the top three game scores by an Orioles pitcher this season (99, 5/5 at SEA; 80, 4/2 at BOS; 78, 4/18 at TEX)...Reinstated from the 10-day Injured List (6/6, left shoulder strain) prior to his 50th career start on 7/20.

LAST START: Did not factor in the decision on 9/15 vs. NYY...Allowed two runs on four hits (one home run) and two walks with four strikeouts through 5.2 innings...Has not completed 6.0 innings in 10 of his 23 starts this season...Threw 103 pitches; marked the third time he threw 100 pitches-or-more this season, and the first since throwing 113 during his no-hitter on 5/5 at Seattle; also threw 101 through 6.1 innings on 4/25 vs. Oakland...Has issued two walks in three-straight games, one shy of his career-high four-straight games done earlier this year (4/7-25)...Has not received any run support in each of his past two starts.

UNFAMILIAR FACES: Will be making his first-career appearance against the Phillies...Is 1-3 in seven-career starts against the NL East, including 0-1 in three starts in 2021...Has earned a quality start in two of his three outings against the NL East this year...Has completed 6.0 innings in each of his past four starts against the division dating back to 9/8/20, after completing 5.1 innings-or-fewer in his first three appearances, including 0.2 innings on 8/16/20 vs. WSH...Has not allowed more than four earned runs in his seven-career starts against the NL East, but has received three runs of support-or-fewer in six of those starts...Has a career 4.08 ERA (16 ER/35.1 IP) and .244 OBA.

HEY BATTER, BATTER!: Is 1-for-3 with one walk in his career as a batter; his lone hit came on 7/24/19 at Arizona (Taylor Clarke)...Is 0-for-2 in 2021 with both at-bats coming against the Mets.

HOMER HAPPY: His 26 home runs allowed this year are a career-high...Means has given up at least one homer in 16 of his 23 starts, and multiple in nine of his 23 outings...Gave up at least one home run in a career-high-tying seven-straight starts from 5/19-7/31 (also: 8/21-9/26/20)...Gave up two homers in five-straight starts from 5/19-7/20, tied with Ken Dixon (5/9-6/4/86) for the longest such streak in O's history (since 1954)...18 of his 26 home runs this season have been solo shots, with longballs accounting for 36 of his 54 total runs (72.2%)...Has given up just three homers to a left-handed batter this season.

MEANS STRIKES FIRST: According to *FanGraphs*, Means ranks second in the majors with a 69.9 first-pitch strike percentage this season (min. 80 IP), trailing only Julio Urias (70.1%) of Los Angeles-NL...Of the 525 batters Means has faced this year, he has thrown a first-pitch strike to 366 of them...His fastball makes up 32.1 percent of his first-pitch strikes (108-of-366), while his change up accounts for 23.5 percent (86-of-336)...On 5/5 at Seattle, Means threw 26-of-27 first-pitch strikes (96.3%), only missing on his first pitch of the game; it was the highest first-pitch strike percentage in a complete game since 1990.

PITCH PERFECT: Of Means' 118 strikeouts this season, 86 (72.9%) have come via his fastball (44) or changeup (42)...He has recorded 18 strikeouts with his fastball, and 13 on his changeup since being reinstated from the IL on 7/20...According to *Baseball Savant*, of 293 balls put in play off his fastball and changeup, 114 have been hard-hit (95+ mph EV), and 84 resulted in a base-hit...All but one of his home runs this season have come on his fastball (15) and changeup (10) (curveball, 1).

THIS MEANS HISTORY: Means tossed the first complete game of his career (9.0 IP) during his no-hitter on 5/5 at Seattle; his only base runner reached on a dropped third strike, wild pitch, and was later caught stealing by C Pedro Severino...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Means is the first pitcher to throw a non-perfect no-hitter in which the opposing team did not record a walk, hit-by-pitch, or error...He is the second pitcher in AL history to throw a no-hitter with 12+ strikeouts and zero walks, joining Felix Hernandez, who had a perfect game on 8/15/12...Became the first pitcher since Edinson Vólquez on 6/3/17 to face the minimum 27 batters in a no-hitter and have it not be a perfect game; the last to do so with no walks was Terry Mulholland on 8/15/1990.
