LAST START

Alvarez struck out a career-high eight across 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball against the Los Angeles Angels on Sept. 12 at Nationals Park...He took the no-decision in the 6-5 win.

vs. ST. LOUIS

Alvarez is set to make his first career start against the St. Louis Cardinals.

REGENCY BIAS

In his last nine games (eight starts), Alvarez has pitched to a 2.40 ERA (13 ER/48.2 IP) with a .165 opponents' average...He ranks in the National League in opponents' slugging (1st, .259), opponents' OPS (2nd, .523), opponents' average (3rd, .165) and ERA (7th, 2.40) since July 27.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

Opposing batters are hitting .165 (22-for-133) with six extra-base hits off Alvarez's curveball...He's fanned 61 batters with the curve this season, the most of any of his pitches.

LIMITING THE LONGBALL

Alvarez has allowed just five home runs and 0.44 home runs per 9.0 innings, the best marks among Major League rookies this season (min. 100.0 IP) and the second-best marks in all of baseball...Only New York's (AL) Max Fried (4 HR, 0.34 HR/9.0 IP) has put up better numbers.
