Had it With These Snakes

The D-backs beat the Braves, 10-3, here at Truist Park last night, and Arizona has won each of its last five games in this building. It is the longest active winning streak by a visiting team here.

Arizona is playing for its second consecutive sweep here, after winning all three games last season. The D-backs also swept a three-game set here in 2019, and are looking to become the first visiting team in Truist Park history with three sweeps of at least three games in the park.

Arizona is 14-12 (.538) in total here after last night's victory, the second-best winning percentage of any visiting NL club (Los Angeles, 15-11, .577).

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and D-backs today conclude a three-game weekend series with what is the seventh and final scheduled meeting between the clubs this season...The two met at Chase Field in Arizona from April 2-5, in what was Atlanta's first road series of the season.

 Arizona has taken the first two games of this series, and with it clinched the season set...The Braves have now dropped the season series to the D-backs in back-to-back years for the first time since 2006 and 2007.

 Atlanta's two wins in Arizona earlier this year matched its total against the D-backs from all of last season, when the club went just 2-4 across six total games...Last year's record marked the first time the Braves dropped the season series to the D-backs since 2019.

 RH Michael Soroka is set today to make the third start of his career versus Atlanta, the team for whom he made his major league debut...The 6-foot-5, 230-pound Canadian was originally selected by the Braves in the first round of the 2015 draft and played parts of four total seasons with the club...His stint with Atlanta included an All-Star campaign in 2019, when he went 13-4 with a 2.68 ERA over 29 starts and finished second in NL Rookie of the Year balloting...The right-hander is 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA (3 ER/9.0 IP) over his first two turns, including 5.0 innings of one-run ball on April 4 earlier this season to earn the win.

BRYCE ELDER: Makes the fourth start of his career against Arizona this afternoon, and enters play 0-1 with a 4.91 ERA (8 ER/14.2 IP) all-time against the club.

 The 6-foot-2, 220-pound Texan opposed RH Michael Soroka in a start on April 4 at Chase Field earlier this year, and took the loss despite allowing just two unearned runs and fanning eight over 7.0 innings of work.

 Elder is making his 15th start of the season here at Truist Park this afternoon, and is 6-3 with a 3.56 ERA in his home ballpark...That ERA is over a full point lower than his nine turns on the road (4.93).

ROSTER MOVES: The Braves today selected LHP Ray Kerr to the major league roster and designated LHP Danny Young for assignment...Kerr's first appearance will be his first in the majors since June 15, 2024.

 The 6-foot-3, 185-pound left-hander has made 39 total appearances in the majors, including 10 games and both career starts while with the Braves in 2024...He underwent Tommy John surgery that June and missed the entire 2025 season...Kerr owns a 2-3 record with a 5.30 ERA (32 ER/54.1 IP) in the majors.

 The California native made nine appearances across the FCL Braves, High-A Rome, Double-A Columbus and Triple-A Gwinnett this season, and pitched to a 3.09 ERA (4 ER/11.2 IP) without a decision...He fanned 16.

OLSON THIRTY-THIRTY: Matt Olson went 2-for-4 last night and lined his 30th double of the season into left-center field in the ninth inning...Paired with his 35 home runs, he is the only player in baseball with at least 30 doubles and 30 homers this year.

 Olson's 30 doubles are tied with St. Louis' Alec Burleson for most in the majors, while his 35 home runs rank third.

 This season marks the third 30-30 campaign of Olson's career, and his second since joining the Braves in 2022...He compiled 35 doubles and 39 homers in 2021 while with Oakland, and 44 doubles and 34 homers a year later in his debut season with the Braves.

 Olson is just the 10th Brave in franchise history with multiple 30-30 seasons, and the third active member of the club to do so...Austin Riley collected three straight such seasons from 2021-2023, while Ozzie Albies did so in 2021 & 2023.

 His 65 total extra-base hits this season are four more than any other batter in the majors...Since joining Atlanta prior to the 2022 season, his 366 total extra-base hits are most in the National League.

RONALD NEARING HISTORY: Ronald Acuña Jr. drove a 2-2 changeup in last night's first inning out to center field for his 13th home run of the season...The drive was also the 199th home run of his career.

 Acuña Jr.'s next home run will stand as the 200th of his career, and he is looking to become the fastest player in major league history, by games played, to reach at least 200 home runs and 200 stolen bases.

 Alfonso Soriano holds the current record, swiping a pair of bases in his 929th career game to reach 203 home runs and 201 stolen bases.

 Acuña Jr. currently has 220 stolen bases to pair with his 199 home runs...Today's game will be the 889th of his career.

 Just two Braves in history have reached 200 career homers prior to playing their 889th game...Bob Horner hit his 200th in his 882nd game in 1986, while Eddie Mathews needed just 779 games to reach the mark in 1957.

TROUBLE WALKING: Atlanta has yet to draw a base-on-balls this series, and last worked a walk in the third inning of last Wednesday's game vs. New York (Acuña Jr.)...For the season, the Braves' 359 walks are third fewest in the majors.

 When drawing at least two walks in a game this season, Atlanta is 53-35 (.602) and averages 5.3 runs per game...Its 88 total games with multiple walks are the fewest in the majors.

 When drawing no more than one walk in a game, the Braves are 20-14 (.588) but average just 3.6 runs per game.

Makes his 24th start of the season and the 102nd of his career, in the finale of a three-game series against Arizona...Atlanta is 16-7 in his 23 turns.
- 🔥

Will make his second career start against the Diamondbacks and is 0-1 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER/7.0 IP) in his lone prior appearance...Faced Arizona once this season, April 4 at Chase Field, allowing no earned runs on four hits over 7.0 innings while striking out eight in a 2-1 loss.

Owens a 4.03 ERA this season, compared to a 6.52 mark in 2024 and 5.30 in 2025...It is his lowest single-season ERA since he pitched to a 3.81 mark as a 2023 National League All-Star.

From July 20 through August 5, posted a 1.88 ERA (5 ER/24.0 IP) with three quality starts in four outings...Allowed seven earned runs over 5.0 innings in his most recent start August 10 against New York (NL), a 5-8 loss at Truist Park.
- 🔥

Has recorded 13 quality starts in 23 outings this season...Ten of them have come at Truist Park, where he is 6-3 with a 3.56 ERA (34 ER/86.0 IP) in 14 turns.
- 🔥

Has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 18 of his 23 starts this season.
- 🔥

Has held left-handed batters to a .211 average (65-for-308) this season, while right-handers have hit .282 (55-for-195).
- 🔥

Has incorporated a cutter into his arsenal this year after not throwing the pitch across his first four major league seasons from 2022-25.
- 🔥

In 10 starts with a four-seam fastball averaging 92.0 mph or higher, owns a 2.78 ERA (17 ER/55.0 IP), holding opponents to a .227 average (46-for-203) and a .345 slugging percentage.
- 🔥

In his other 13 starts, with the heater at 91.9 mph or below, has a 4.93 ERA (42 ER/76.2 IP), with opponents batting .247 (74-for-300) and slugging .443.
- 🔥

Opponents have hit 14 home runs against him in the sub-92 starts, compared to seven in his harder-throwing turns.
- 🔥

Over his last 30 starts, dating to August 24, 2025, Elder is 11-9 with a 3.73 ERA (73 ER/176.1 IP) and a 1.19 WHIP...His 19 quality starts over the span are tied for the fifth-most in the majors.

Suffered a loss August 10 against New York (NL), allowing seven runs on 10 hits over 5.0 innings in a 5-8 defeat at Truist Park...Brett Baty's first-inning grand slam capped a five-run frame.
- 🔥

Earned the win August 5 against Miami, allowing one run on one hit over 7.0 innings with three strikeouts in a 4-1 victory at Truist Park, making his 100th career start... Did not allow a hit through the first 4.1 innings, the longest no-hit bid of his career.

Reached 100 strikeouts on the season July 31 against Washington, earning the win after allowing one run on four hits over 6.0 innings in a 6-2 victory at Truist Park.
- 🔥

Is one of just five pitchers in Atlanta history to make at least six starts in March/April and compile an ERA under 2.00, joining Tom Glavine (1997, 2000, 2002), Greg Maddux (1994), Tim Hudson (2007) and Julio Teheran (2014)...Finished March/April with a 1.88 ERA (9 ER/43.0 IP) over seven starts.

Joined Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz and Michael Soroka as the only starters in Atlanta-franchise history to make the All-Star team in their second year playing.
- 🔥

Atlanta won 21 games started by Elder in his first full season with the Braves, the second most team victories on the season...Trailed only teammate Spencer Strider's 26 team wins that year.
- 🔥

Made six starts in his career of at least 6.0 innings without allowing a run, the most such games in Braves franchise history (since 1900) in a player's first 25 starts...Irv Young (1905), Clif Curtis (1909-'10) and Ian Anderson (*20-21) each had five such starts.
- 🔥

Was originally drafted by Atlanta in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Texas...Was the fifth member of the 2020 draft class to debut, and the lowest-selected pick to do so.
- 🔥

Of the first five members to play in the majors from the 2020 draft class, three were selected with the first 11 picks in the draft - Detroit's Spencer Torkelson (No. 1 overall), the Angels' Reid Detmers (No. 10) and the White Sox's Garrett Crochet (No. 11).

The other two were both selected by Atlanta, and chosen with the 126th (Spencer Strider) and 156th (Elder) overall selections.
