> ANGELS-METS NOTES: The Mets are seeking their first series win against the Angels since June 10-12, 2022 and their first at Citi Field since May 19-21, 2025: 1-0 History: 14-14 2024: 1-2 @LAA:

METSCELLANEOUS: The Mets defeated the Angels, 7-5, yesterday... The Mets have won back-to-back games after losing three straight... New York is now 12-5 in series openers at home this season...The Mets are in their first homestand after the All-Star break, a six-game homestand (2-2) against the Cincinnati Reds (1-2) and Los Angeles Angels (1-0)... New York is off on Thursday before their final west coast swing of the season, a six-game trip against the Giants (three games) and Padres (three games).

INTERLEAGUE: The Mets are 17-17 in Interleague play this season as opposed to 40-26 against the NL.

HOME, SWEET HOME: The Mets have posted a 35-16 record at home...Their .686 winning percentage at home is the best in the NL and is the second-best in the majors...Their home record is tied with the 1986, '88 and 2015 teams for the best through the club's first 51 home games of a season in franchise history...Their 35 wins are the secondmost in The Show...New York has posted a 3.21 ERA at home this year, which is the fourth-best in MLB and third in the NL.

OUCH: Mets batters have been hit by 58 pitches this season, which is tied with the Twins and the Mariners for the most in the majors...Nimmo has been plunked 85 times in his career which is the second-most in franchise history.

ED, EDD AND EDDY: Edwin Díaz recorded his 20th save of the season after striking out all three batters faced in the ninth inning, tying his season total from 2024...He is one of 11 pitchers in Major League history to record at least 20 saves in at least seven of their first nine seasons (since saves became an official stat in 1969), joining Craig Kimbrel, Jonathan Papelbon, Troy Percival, Trevor Hoffman, Bruce Sutter, Aroldis Chapman, Kenley Jansen, Huston Street, Mariano Rivera and Robb Nen.

BEHIND THE EIGHT HUNDRED BALL: Díaz' third strikeout last night (Taylor Ward) marked his 800th career strikeout...His 800 career strikeouts in 492.1 innings pitched is the fourth-fewest innings to reach the milestone for any pitcher in MLB history (including starting pitchers and relievers)...Courtesy of Elias...The others are Chapman (480.2 IP), Josh Hader (489.2 IP) and Kimbrel (490.0 IP)...He is one of seven active players to reach the 800 strikeout mark as a reliever, joining Chapman, Kimbrel, Jansen, David Robertson, Adam Ottavino and Hader

DOMINATING DÍAZ: Last night, Díaz extended his scoreless inning streak to 14.0 dating back to June 6...He has allowed just one earned run over his last 29 appearances, posting a 4-0 record with 14 saves and a 0.30 ERA since April 23...His ERA over those 29 games is tied for the best 29-game span of his career (also: 0.30 ERA over 29 games in 2022)...He is one of three Mets relievers to ever record as low of an ERA in a 29-game single-season

LET'S GO STREAKING: Pete Alonso has appeared in a franchiserecord streak of 354 consecutive games played...It's the secondlongest active streak in the majors.

WE FOUND NIMMO: Brandon Nimmo has safely reached base in 15 straight games...He is batting .309 (17-55) with 12 runs, three doubles, three homers, 12 RBI, seven walks, four steals, a .400 OBP and a .527 SLG in that span...In 43 games since the start of June, Nimmo has hit .294/.366/.509 with 25 runs, eight doubles, nine homers, 26 RBI, 15 walks, 10 steals and an .875 OPS...He has stolen 11 bases in 97 games this year...He stole a career-high 15 in 151 contests in 2024.

BRETT THE MET: Brett Baty has hit 11 home runs this season, which ties a career-high...In 46 home games he is hitting .291 (37-127) with 21 runs, three doubles, one triple, 25 RBI, 10 home runs...In 16 games this month, Baty is batting .282 (11-39) with eight runs, one double, three homers six RBI six walks and a 908 OPS

JUAN OF A KIND: Juan Soto hit a game-tying two-run single in the seventh inning...Since making his Major League debut in 2018, Soto's 37 RBI to either tie the game or give his team the lead in the seventh inning or later is tied with Freddie Freeman for the fourth-most by a left-handed batter...Since May 30, has hit .299/.438/.643 (46-154) with 38 runs, five doubles, 16 home runs, 34 RBI, 37 walks and five stolen bases...In that span, is second in walks, tied for second in runs scored, third in OBP and OPS (1.081), fourth in home runs, tied for fourth in total $\,$ bases (99) and sixth in SLG among qualified hitters.

DON'T STEAL THIS ALBUM: Among catchers with 250 or more innings behind the plate this year, Luis Torrens ranks second in the majors with 41.9 percent caught stealing (18 SB, 13 CS, 435.2 IP)...Only Salvador Perez is better (50.0 percent caught stealing, 9 SB, 9 CS, 428.0 IP).

SMILE LIKE YOU MEAN IT: According to Elias, Francisco Lindor has hit 258 home runs and stolen 199 bases as a shortstop...Only two players in major league history had 200/200 (HR/SB) as a shortstop - Derek Jeter (255 HR, 351 SB) and Jimmy Rollins (229 HR, 469 SB).

- Earned his 11th hold of the season after tossing a scoreless seventh inning on July 20 vs. Cincinnati (1.0 IP, H, K)...24 of his 38 relief appearances this season have been scoreless.
- In 13 games against Interleague opponents this season he has posted a 1.45 ERA (3 ER/18.2 IP) and held opponents to a .164 (10-61) batting average.
