TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Nationals play the second of a four-game set tonight, the 14th of 19 meetings between the clubs this season...The teams are scheduled to finish their season series next week in Washington, September 13-15.

A The teams split the first 12 games of their season series before this weekend, with Washington winning four of six here, and Atlanta winning four of six at Nationals Park.

A After dropping the first three games against Washington this season, the Braves have won seven of the last 10 despite outscoring the Nationals by only four runs over this stretch (58-54).

A LHP Dallas Keuchel is set for his sixth career start against the Nationals, and his third this season... Is 0-3 with a 5.08 ERA (16 ER/28.1 IP) in his career, including an 0-2 record and a 6.10 ERA (7 ER/10.1 IP) this season...He has never faced Washington here at SunTrust Park.

A LHP Patrick Corbin faces Atlanta for the 12th time in his career, and makes his 10th start...Is 6-1 with a 1.96 ERA (13 ER/59.2 IP) in his career, including a 1-0 mark with a 3.27 ERA (4 ER/11.0 IP) in two starts this season...Allowed eight hits and two runs over 5.0 innings on July 19, his only start this season at SunTrust Park.

33 OVER: With last night's 4-2 win, Atlanta is 87-54 and a season-best 33 games over .500...The Braves have not been this many games over .500 since the end of the 2003 season, when that club finished 40 over at 101-61.

A Atlanta has the fifth-best record in baseball, and the second-best mark in the National League, 4.5 games behind Los Angeles.

A Last night's win over Washington pushed the Braves lead in the NL East to a season-most 8.0 games...The magic number for Atlanta to clinch its second consecutive division title is 15.

SURGING: The Braves have won 18 of their last 22 games and 15 of 17 after last night's win over Washington...Atlanta is 23-9 (.719) since the start of August, the best record in baseball.

A Atlanta last had as good a stretch over 17 games in 2013, when that club also went 15-2 from July 29 to August 16.

A Over their last 17 games, the Braves have compiled a 2.53 ERA (44 ER/156.1 IP) and allowed just 13 home runs.

A The Braves have not lost a multi-game series since July 23-24, when Kansas City swept both games here at SunTrust Park...They have gone 9-0-3 in multi-game series play over this stretch.

A The Braves are on pace to win 100 games this season...Eight different teams in franchise history have won triple digits in a season (last, 2003; 101)... They need to finish 13-8 or better to get there.

WINNING AT HOME: The Braves have won 11 straight in Atlanta after last night's 4-2 victory over Toronto, the club's longest home winning streak of the season...The last time the Braves won 11 consecutive home games in a single season was 2000, when the club won a franchise modern-era record 12 straight from April 8-May 5.

A The Braves have held the opposition to 31 total runs in these 11 games (28 earned runs/2.55 ERA), while striking out 106, converting five saves and collecting 14 holds.

A The longest home single-season winning streak by any Braves team in franchise history is 18, set in 1897 by the Boston Beaneaters...Led by 31-game winner Kid Nichols and four other future Hall of Famers (manager Frank Selee, 3B Jimmy Collins, OF Billy Hamilton, OF Hugh Duffy), the Beaneaters won 18 straight at South End Grounds from May 31-June 25.

ROSTER MOVE: The Braves today returned OF Austin Riley from his major league rehabilitation assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day injured list...Atlanta now has 33 active players.

A Riley was placed on the injured list on August 8 with a right knee sprain and missed 28 games... He has batted .242/.294/.504 over 66 games with Atlanta this season, with 17 homers and 45 RBI.

A In 12 rehabilitation games between Single-A Rome and Triple-A Gwinnett, he batted .250 (12-for-48) with three doubles, a home run and four RBI.

VS. THE NL EAST: The Braves are in the second of 14 consecutive games against the NL East, specifically Washington (seven games) and Philadelphia (seven games)...The Braves are 39-21 (.650) against the division this season, the third-best mark by an Atlanta team since divisional play began in 1969.

A The Braves went 35-16 (.686) against the East in 1999, the club's best ever intradivision record...They won a franchise-record 51 games in 2004 (51-25, .671) against their division.

A Atlanta went 49-27 (.645) against the East last season...No other NL team has been better against their own division the last two seasons than Atlanta (88-48, .647)...The Astros have the best intradivision record in the majors for the last two seasons at 89-45 (.664).

RUNS: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. scored twice last night, giving him a NL-most 113 runs...No Braves player has led the league in runs scored since Dale Murphy in 1985 (118).

A The franchise modern-era record for runs scored in a single season is 131 by Murphy in 1983...Acuña is on pace for 130.

A Teammate Freddie Freeman ranks second in the NL, scoring 108 times this season.

Tonight's Game

- A* Makes his 15th start of the season and the 198th of his career...Is his 207th career appearance.
- A* Has won each of his last three starts, and Atlanta has won each of his last four turns.
 - A* Allowed just three earned runs during the stretch, pitching to a 1.08 ERA (3 ER/25.0 IP)...Has struck out 24 in 25 innings.
 - A* Allowed nine hits and two runs over 6.0 innings in his last start, August 31 vs. the White Sox.
 - A* The four starts come after he allowed a season-most 10 hits and eight runs on August 8 at Miami.
- A* Set for his sixth career start against the Nationals, and his third this season...Is 0-3 with a 5.08 ERA (16 ER/28.1 IP) in his career, including an 0-2 record and a 6.10 ERA (7 ER/10.1 IP) this season.
 - A* He has never faced Washington here at SunTrust Park...Both of his starts this season have come at Nationals Park, including his Braves debut on June 21.
 - A* His teams are winless in his five career starts against the Nationals...Washington is one of just two teams in the majors against which Keuchel has pitched that his team has never won...He clubs are 0-3 in his starts against St. Louis.
- A* Is 3-1 with a 2.38 ERA (12 ER/45.1 IP) in seven starts at his home park...Has a 3-4 record with a 5.26 ERA in seven starts on the road.
 - A* Among National League pitchers to make at least 10 starts this season, Keuchel's 2.38 mark at home is fifth lowest.
 - A* All seven of Keuchel's starts at home have been quality turns, and Atlanta is 5-2 as a team when he starts at home...The Braves have won four straight starts at home by Keuchel, dating to August 3 vs. Cincinnati.
- A* Is allowing opponents to bat .263 (85-for-323) against him on the season, with a .333 on-base percentage and .430 slugging.
 - A* With runners in scoring position, is holding opponents to a .200/.309/.357 line, with 14 hits in 70 at-bats...Opponents are batting .090 points lower with runners in scoring position than they are with no one on base (.290, 51-for-176).
 - A* In 37 opponent at-bats with runners in scoring position and two outs, has allowed just seven hits (.189) and eight RBI.

2019 Recap

- A* Started, 8/20 vs. MIA, and allowed six hits and one run over 6.0 innings to earn his fourth win of the season.
 - A* Struck out opposing pitcher Elieser Hernandez leading off the third inning for the 1,000th strikeout of his major league career.
 - A* Became the 49th active pitcher to have 1,000 career strikeouts, and the second on the Braves staff (Julio Teheran).
- A* Pitched against the Mets, 8/14 at SunTrust Park, and tossed 6.0 scoreless innings.
 - A* With that start, has pitched against 27 of the 30 major league clubs...Has never faced either Atlanta or Houston, the two teams he has played for, and the Los Angeles Dodgers.
- A* Started, 7/23 vs. KC, and logged his sixth career double-digit strikeout game...Fanned 12 Royals over 6.0 innings, one off his career high.
 - A* The last Atlanta pitcher to fan more batters in a single start was Kris Medlen, who struck out 13 Nationals over 7.0 innings on September 14, 2012.
 - A* Keuchel also doubled in the fifth inning, and became just the third pitcher in Atlanta history to strike out at least 11 batters and double in the same game, joining Greg Maddux (4/24/94 vs. PIT) and Julio Teheran (8/1/13 vs. COL).
- A* Beat the Padres on 7/12, allowing just six hits and one run over 7.0 innings.
 - A* Earned the win in Atlanta's final start before the All-Star break, 7/7 vs. MIA, and in Atlanta's first game after the break, 7/12 at SD...Became the third Braves pitcher to start and win consecutive regular season games for the Braves in the modern era (since 1900) and the first since Johnny Sain on September 6 and September 11 of 1948.
- A* Pitched at least 7.0 innings in each his three starts from 7/2-12, going 2-1 with a 2.11 ERA (5 ER/21.1 IP) in that span.
 - A* Was the first Atlanta starter to pitch at least 7.0 innings in three consecutive turns since 2017, when Jaime García did so from 5/31 to 6/11.
- A* Signed by the Braves to a one-year major league contract on 6/7...Was recalled to Atlanta on 6/21.
 - A* Became the first former Cy Young winner to join Atlanta midseason since the Braves acquired reliever Mark Davis from the Kansas City Royals in 1992.

Career Recap

- A* Selected by the Houston Astros in the seventh round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft...Signed by Jim Stevenson.
- A* Is a four-time Rawlings Gold Glove Award winner (2014-16, 18), two-time American League All-Star (2015, 2017) and the 2015 AL Cy Young Award winner. Has pitched in parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues (2012-18).

- Was recalled, 9/1, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his fourth stint with Atlanta this season...Has a 5.54 ERA (16 ER/26.0 IP) in 26 appearances for the Braves...Is a perfect 6-for-6 in hold chances.
- In 18 appearances with the Braves since 4/20, has a 2.50 ERA (5 ER/18.0 IP) and is allowing opponents to bat just .212...Had a 12.38 ERA (11 ER/8.0 IP) over his first nine games.
- Twelve of the 16 earned runs he has allowed have scored at SunTrust Park...Has an 8.76 ERA at home, and a 2.63 (4 ER/13.2 IP) mark on the road.
- Made the Opening Day roster before going on the 10-day IL with a left abdomen strain on 4/29...Was reinstated from the IL and optioned to Gwinnett on 5/25...Was also up from 6/30-8/1.
- Went 2-1 with a 4.79 ERA (11 ER/20.2 IP) in 17 games with Gwinnett this season.

- Since returning from the injured list on 7/12, is 1-2 with a 6.46 ERA (11 ER/15.1 IP) in 19 games...In 17 games with Atlanta prior to the stint, had a 0.52 ERA (1 ER/17.1 IP).
