ORIOLES NOTES

- Dropped game three of a four-game set against the Yankees by a score of 0-7...Looking to split their second series of the season with tomorrow's matchup...It is the fourth time the Orioles were held scoreless this year (last: 4/21 at MIA), and second by the Yankees (4/5 at NYY).
- **RHP Dean Kremer** suffered the loss, allowing six runs on a career-high 10 hits (two home runs) with no walks and four strikeouts...It was the first game of his career in which he did not walk a batter, and also his first-career outing surrendering multiple home runs...The last Orioles pitcher to give up at least 10 hits in a start was **RHP Alex Cobb** on 4/20/19 G2 vs. Minnesota.
- **1B Trey Mancini** collected the 499th and 500th hits of his career with two singles to center field in the seventh and ninth frames...He became the 49th player to record 500 hits in an Orioles uniform...He is the 14th Oriole to reach the 500-hit mark in 486 games or less...It was his fifth multi-hit game of the season...Mancini has reached base safely in each of his last six games played with two multi-hit efforts, batting .318 (7-for-22) with two doubles, three RBI, three walks, and two runs scored.
- **DH Ryan Mountcastle** tallied the O's first hit of the game with a single to third base in the fifth frame...He has reached base safely in each of his last six games played, going 4-for-21 (.190) with one double, two walks, two runs scored, and two stolen bases.

YANKEES NOTES

- With a 7-0 win over the Orioles, the Yankees are now 6-3 in their last nine games after losing their previous five...Will have a chance to win their third series of the season tomorrow (four losses, one split)...With homers from 1B Mike Ford, 3B Gio Urshela, and RF Clint Frazier tonight, the Yankees have hit multiple home runs in five of their last six games since 4/23 (14 HR total), and are 4-2 in such contests...This was the third time this season that five batters recorded multiple hits in a game.
- **RHP Domingo Germán** earned the win, tossing 7.0 scoreless innings with three hits, one walk, and six strikeouts...Has yet to lose a game against the Orioles in his career, and his five wins are the most against any opponent...The 7.0 innings pitched are tied for most in his career (4x, last: 8/13/19 vs. BAL)...It was his first scoreless start since 7/12/19 vs. Toronto, and the six strikeouts matched a season-high (last: 4/22 at CLE).
- **3B Gio Urshela** launched a 386-foot three-run homer to left field in the third inning to increase the Yankees lead to 5-0...Prior to tonight, he had never hit a home run on a 2-1 pitch...Was his second three-RBI game of the year (last: 4/11 at TB)...Has reached base safely in 12-straight games this season, and 16-straight contests against the Orioles since 5/20/19 in Baltimore...Against the O's in that span he is hitting .385 (25-for-65) with five doubles, four home runs, 17 RBI, three walks, and 16 runs scored.
- **RF Clint Frazier** hit his first long-ball of the season with a 389-foot solo shot to left-center field in the eighth inning...In addition to a double in the fourth inning, it was his second multi-hit game of the season (last: 4/1 vs. TOR), and first game with two extra-base hits since registering a double and a home run on 9/15/20 vs. Toronto.
- **1B Mike Ford** hit his second home run of the season to lead off the second inning...He has now homered in back-to-back games for the second time in his career (last: 8/25/19 & 8/26/19)...The solo shot to left field was his fourth-career home run to come on the first pitch.
- **2B DJ LeMahieu** recorded a base-hit to center field in both the first and third innings for a multi-hit game in two-straight nights...Was the second time this season he has had back-to-back multi-hit contests (last: 4/7 & 4/9)...This was his eighth game of the season with two hits, and third against the Orioles.
- **SS Gleyber Torres** laced a double into the right field corner in the opening frame...He has doubled in consecutive games for the first time this season and seventh time in his career...Increased the Yankees lead to 2-0 with a single to center field in the third inning for his second-straight multi-hit game, and third of the season.
