Despite last night's 10-0 defeat, the Brewers are 33-18 (648) in their last 51 games at home against the Cubs.

A Show About Nothing

The Brewers have been shut out in consecutive games for the first time since 5/17/23 at St. Louis (3-0) and 5/19/23 at Tampa Bay (1-0).

Strike First, Strike Hard, No Mercy

The Brewers are O-11 in games in which the apponent scores first. Milwaukee is the only team in the maiors without a win this season in a game in which they don't score first... the team is 16-6 when scoring first.

That's a lot of Games

Christian Yelich needs 3 games for 1,500 in his Major League career.... Yelich has played in 643 games with the Marlins (2013-17) and 854 games with the Brewers (2018-current).

Gimme Five!

José Quintana looks to be the first pitcher in franchise history to win his first 5 starts with the team....he is the third pitcher to win his first 4 starts as a Brewer, joining **Tom Candiotti** (1983) and **CC Sabathia** (2008).

THIS EVENING'S GAME: Is game 2 (0-1) of a 6-game homestand against Chicago-NL (D-1) and Houston (3g).....following an off day next Thursday, the team takes a 6-game trip to Tampa Bay (3g) and Cleveland (3g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE STANDINGS [46 days]: The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the NL Central standings: FIRST: 10*, SECOND: 16, THIRD: 14, FOURTH: 3, FIFTH: 3.....the Brewers are currently in third place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 4.0 games and second-place Reds by 2.0 games (*9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing their first game of the season).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Brewers are 6-4-0 in series play. Game 1: 5-6. Game 2: 6-4. Game 3: 4-6. Game 4: 1-1 Sweep Wins [-]: None.....Sweep Losses [1]: at NYY (3g, 3/27-3/30)

AT HOME: The Brewers are 9-5 at home, going 4-0-0 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 7-12 on the road, going 2-4-0 in series play.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

CDACHES: Returning from 2024 is associate manager Rickie Weeks (2nd season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach **Jim Henderson** (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (2nd season), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (4th season), assistant coach **Daniel de Mondesert** (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season) and third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role).....first base coach Julio Borbón, lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf and hitting coach Eric Theisen are all in their first seasons on the staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made four replay challenges this season, going 4-0.....their last challenge came on 4/30 at Chicago-AL as an out call on a force play at second base involving William Contreras was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons.....they are joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include ...the Brewers have 682 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League....the team was 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons, missing out by a game in both 2017 and 2022.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #62 - LHP JOSÉ QUINTANA (4gs, 4-0, 1.14)

QUINTANA AT A GLANCE: José Quintana, 36, is going to make his fifth start of the season tonight.....Quintana last started last Sunday at St. Louis and earned a 7-1 victory (5ip, 5h, 1r, 1er, 3bb, 6k, 98 pitches).....he has 2 quality starts.....opponents are batting .226 (19-for-84, 1hr).....he is the third pitcher in franchise history to win his first 4 starts with the team, joining **Tom Candiotti** (4gs, 1983) and **CC Sabathia** (4gs, 2008).....Quintana signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on March 5.....he is signed through the 2025 season with a mutual option for 2026....name is pronounced "keen-TAH-nuh."

LAST SEASON: Quintana went 10-10 with a 3.75 ERA in 31 starts with New York-NL.....the team went 16-15 in his starts.....he made 12 quality starts.....opponents batted .237 [150-for-634, 22hr].....he was the Mets' Opening Day starter (against the Brewers).

MR. COLOMBIA: Quintana, born in Arjona, Colombia, is his country's all-time leader in nearly every statistical category in the Major Leagues, including games (363), starts (337), wins (106), innings pitched (1993.1) and strikeouts (1,742)....he pitched for Colombia in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

BEEN THERE, DONE THAT: Quintana has made 337 starts since 2012 - his first season - which ranks fourth in the Major Leagues behind Max Scherzer (357), Zack Greinke (344) and Lance Lynn (338)....this includes nine seasons of 30+ starts.

CAREER: Is 106-103 with a 3.71 ERA in 363 games/337 starts (1993.1ip, 822er).....is in his 14th Major League season while pitching for Chicago-AL (2012-17), Chicago-NL (2017-20), Los Angeles-AL (2021), San Francisco (2021), Pittsburgh (2022), St. Louis (2022), New York-NL (2023-24) and Milwaukee (2025).....was an All-Star in 2016 as he finished 10th in American League Cv Young Award voting......Ouintana was originally signed by the Mets as a non-drafted free agent on 4/26/06.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 6-4 with a 3.71 ERA in 13 starts (72.2ip, 30er)....is 1-0 with a 1.59 ERA in 1 start this season (5.2ip, 1er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 53-55 with a 3.75 ERA in 184 games/172 starts (1006.1ip, 419er).....is 3-0 with a 1.00 ERA in 3 starts this season (18ip, 2er).
