Today's Headlines

Connor Thomas (STL) collected 10 strikeouts in a four-inning start with the Salt River Rafters on Monday night, leading his team to an eventual 3-2 victory. It was the first time in eight years that an AFL pitcher recorded double-digit strikeouts in a single appearance.

Grant Lavigne (COL) went 2-for-4 with the Salt River Rafters on Monday, hitting a triple and driving in two runs. Lavigne holds a .414/.485/.655 batting slash through eight AFL games; his slugging percentage ranks eighth in the AFL among qualified players.

Heston Kjerstad (BAL) and **Cal Conley (ATL)** each had inside-the-park home runs for the Scottsdale Scorpions on Monday afternoon. Such a feat — two from the same team in the same contest — has happened only once in a Major League Baseball game since 1980. All of Scottsdale's runs were scored off the bats of Kjerstad and Conley in a 6-4 victory over the Peoria Javelinas. Kjerstad went 4-for-5 on the day with two RBI and a run scored, while Conley posted a 3-for-5 afternoon with four RBI, two runs scored and a stolen base.

Ryan Middendorf (NYY) posted a perfect 1 1/3 innings in relief for the Glendale Desert Dogs on Monday, striking out three. Middendorf earned a hold in a 6-3 win over the Mesa Solar Sox, and now holds a 3.00 ERA through six AFL innings.

The Surprise Saguaros, holding the best record in the AFL, have a run differential of zero. The best differential belongs to the second-place Glendale Desert Dogs (+24), while the fifth-place Mesa Solar Sox have the league's second-best differential (11).



In-N-Out Double-Double Batter - AFL Week 3 Update



Presented by In-N-Out Burger, the AFL "Double-Double Batter" promotion is back in effect for all three Fall League games today. Two out of twelve Double-Double Batters (16.7%) have successfully hit a double in AFL action this year: **Owen Caissie** (Chicago Cubs) and Matt McLain (Cincinnati Reds).

Introduced for the 2022 season, AFL regular-season games on Tuesdays and Fridays feature the In-N-Out Double-Double Batter promotion. One hitter from each home team's starting lineup is selected prior to first pitch. If they hit a double that day, all spectators at that given venue receive a complementary coupon card for an In-N-Out Double-Double hamburger upon exiting the ballpark.

Arizona Fall League Alumni Spotlight

Bob Melvin (Maryvale Saguaros, 1999) began his managerial career in the Arizona Fall League after serving as the bench coach for the 1999 Milwaukee Brewers. He was later named to the coaching staff of the Detroit Tigers (2000) and Arizona Diamondbacks (2001-2002) before receiving his first MLB managing position with the 2003 Seattle Mariners. Melvin has since managed a combined 19 seasons between the Mariners, Diamondbacks, Athletics and most recently the 2022 San Diego Padres, leading the franchise to its first NLCS appearance since 1998. He was inducted into the AFL Hall of Fame in 2013.
