## TEXAS RANGERS (30-18) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (25-23)

MAY 24, 2023 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #49/HOME #25

LHP MARTÍN PÉREZ (5-1, 4.01 ERA) vs. RHP JOHAN OVIEDO (3-3, 4.69 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:**..lost 6-1 in the second game of their three-game series last night against the Rangers...Are 2-3 heading into the finale of their current six-game homestand against Arizona and Texas...Won seven straight games from 4/17-23, their longest winning streak since 2018 (11 games)...Are 1.0 game behind the front-running Brewers in the National League Central coming into today.

**CLOSING IN ON ANOTHER MILESTONE:** Andrew McCutchen recorded the 398th double of his career after leading off the home half of the first inning with a two-bagger last night... McCutchen is now two doubles shy of 400 in his career and two away from 300 as a Pirate... McCutchen ranks seventh all-time in team history in doubles... Paul Waner ranks first with 559, followed by Honus Wagner (556), Roberto Clemente (440), Willie Stargell (423), Max Carey (375) and Pie Traynor (371).

**LEADING THINGS OFF:** Andrew McCutchen went 2-for-3 with a double, walk and run scored last night while batting out of the leadoff spot... McCutchen is now hitting .357 (10-for-28) with a double, four runs scored and .419 on-base percentage in seven games out of the leadoff spot this season.

**GETTING ON:** Andrew McCutchen comes into today with a 13-game on-base streak, going 16-for-45 (.356) with a home run, four RBI, eight walks and .453 on-base percentage... McCutchen's 13-game on-base streak is tied for the third-longest by a Pirate this season (it's also tied for the seventh-longest active streak in the National League)... Jack Suwinski has the longest on-base streak by a Pirate this season (17 games from April 9-29).

**GO WEST YOUNG BUGS:** Following today's game, the Pirates will depart for a six-game road trip to Seattle and San Francisco that gets underway Friday night... It will be Pittsburgh's fourth series ever in Seattle and first since 2016... The Pirates are 4-3 all-time at T-Mobile Park.

**ABOUT TODAY'S STARTER:** Johan Oviedo gets the start this afternoon in the finale of this three-game series and six-game homestand against the Diamondbacks and Rangers... Oviedo began the homestand Friday night by allowing one run in 6.0 innings while winning a 13-3 decision against Arizona's Zac Gallen.

**MORE ABOUT JOHAN:** Johan Oviedo has allowed a combined two runs in 11.0 innings in his last two starts... Oviedo has worked at least 5.0 innings while allowing one earned run or fewer in five of his nine starts this season... Oviedo's average of 0.75 home runs allowed per 9.0 innings ranks ninth in the National League (teammate Mitch Keller ranks eighth with an average of 0.72 home runs allowed per 9.0 innings).

**AND THE WHIFF:** Rich Hill struck out nine batters last night, giving Pittsburgh's starting rotation 249 for the season... That's the third-most strikeouts in the National League and tied for the 11th-most in MLB coming into today... The only National League starting rotations to record more strikeouts are the Braves (271) and Marlins (267).

**LOVING LEFTIES:** The Pirates have gone 8-4 in games started by opposing lefthanders this season... Pittsburgh's last game against a left-handed starter came last Wednesday in Detroit against Eduardo Rodriguez, who allowed four runs in 5.0 innings against the Pirates... Pittsburgh ranks seventh in MLB in OPS (.792) and eighth in slugging (.445) and batting (.274) against southpaws.

**MAKE THAT A DOUBLE:** Bryan Reynolds delivered a run-scoring double in the third inning Tuesday for his 16th of the season... Reynolds is tied for the second-most doubles among all National League players (Freddie Freeman leads with 18)... Pittsburgh's 93 doubles as a team are tied for the fourth-most in the National League.

**RUN PIRATES RUN:** The Pirates come into today tied for the Major League lead in stolen bases (53) along with the Tampa Bay Rays... Monday night was the seventh time this season Pittsburgh swiped at least three bags in a game (the team had a season-high six stolen bases on April 26 against the Dodgers).

**CALL TO THE PEN:** Colin Holderman has not allowed a run in his last six appearances (5.1ip) since being charged with the only loss of his big league career when he allowed three runs in 1.0 inning against the Dodgers on April 25... Holderman has struck out 10 batters in 4.1 innings of relief this month while allowing three hits in 16 at-bats.

**ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY**  
May 24, 1987: Bobby Bonilla's two home runs helped lead the Pirates to a 7-2 victory over the Cincinnati Reds at Riverfront Stadium. Barry Bonds also contributed two RBI and his eighth double of the season. Brian Fisher went the distance, only allowing five hits and striking out five batters.

<b>MITCH KELLER:</b> The 27-year-old righthander will make his 11th start of the season Friday when the Pirates begin a three-game series at Seattle...Was in line for the win but had a no-decision (6.0ip/2er) in his last start; a 4-3 loss Saturday vs. Arizona at PNC Park...Was named the National League Player-of-the-Week for the week of 5/8-14...Tossed his first career complete game and shutout in his start on 5/8 against the Rockies at PNC Park...Lost for the only time this season on 5/3 at Tampa Bay, allowing five runs (1er) in 5.0 innings in Pittsburgh's 8-1 setback...Has gone 2-1 with a 2.73 ERA (29.2ip/9er) in five starts this year on the road (the seventh-best road ERA in the NL)...His 1.00 ERA (27.0ip/3er) this month is the third-lowest in MLB behind Michael Wacha (0.36) and Chris Bassitt (0.61).
<b>vs. SEATTLE:</b> 0-1 with a 3.60 ERA in one career start...Gave up two runs in 5.0 innings while losing a 6-0 decision to Marco Gonzales on 9/17/19 at PNC Park.
