THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY - AUG. 28

2000 - n a 4-2 loss vs. the Mets at Shea Stadium, catcher, Tony Eusebio tallies 2 hits to extend his hitting streak to 24 games, which was a club record at the time. The unique aspect of this streak was that Eusebio did not play every day. As a result, his 24-game hit streak spanned 51 days (began July 9), which included 45 team games. Eusebio hit .409 (36x88) during the streak with 5 HR and 21 RBI with a 1.174 OPS.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros and Phillies play the finale of this 3-game series today at Citizens Bank Park... rookie **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (6-11) will start for the Astros vs. Phils RHP Taijuan Walker (3-5)...today will be Arrighetti's 1st career app. vs. PHI, while the Astros have faced Walker 14 times, all as a starter...**Interleague Play:** The Astros are 18-18 in Interleague Play in 2024.

ROADIES: Today is the finale of a 7-game road trip (2-4 thus far) for the Astros...HOU was 2-2 on the 1st stop of the trip in BAL (Thur-Sun)...the Astros have won 10 of their last 14 road games...prior to the current trip, the Astros had posted above-.500 record on each of their last 4 road trips, going 19-9 in that span (.690)...including the current trip, HOU is now a combined 21-13 on their last 5 road trips (since 6/18).

SPENCER'S GIFTS: Rookie **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** started the 1st game of the road trip and will now start the finale of the trip today...in his last outing on Thurs. at BAL, he allowed just 3 hits in 6.0 scoreless innings in a 6-0 Astros win...Arrighetti has been solid recently, posting a 3.21 ERA in his last 8 starts with 60 strikeouts in just 47.2 IP...Arrighetti has been tallying some impressive strikeout totals in his recent starts with a combined 36 K's in his last 24.2 IP (4 GS)...he punched out 12 batters on 8/4 vs. TB and then 13 in his next start on 8/10 at BOS, becoming just 1 of just 6 pitchers in franchise history to punch out 12 or more in cons. starts...he is also the 4th rookie in the Majors in the last 25 years with 25-plus combined strikeouts in back-to-back starts (last: **Spencer Strider**, 2022).

VS. THE PHILS: The current series is the 1st between HOU and PHI since a 3-game series at Minute Maid Park, 4/28-30 of 2023 (Phils took 2 of 3)...**Back At The Bank:** This is the Astros 1st regular season visit to Citizens Bank Park since winning 2 of 3 games, 7/24-26 of 2017.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The Astros were blanked by the Phillies last night, 5-0...**RHP Justin Verlander** (3-4) took the loss (5.0 IP, 4 ER)...offensively, the Astros were held to just 6 hits, all singles...**Jose Altuve** was 2x4 with a SB.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: Future Hall of Famer **RHP Justin Verlander** tallied 3 strikeouts last night and is now just 3 K's shy of moving into a tie with **RHP Max Scherzer** for 10th place all-time in strikeouts...JV is currently 11th with 3,402 career K's while Scherzer is 10th with 3,405...HOFer Walter Johnson is 9th on the list with 3,508.

PITCHING IN: Since Aug. 1, the Astros pitching staff has been the best in baseball with a Major League-best 2.81 ERA (67ER/214.2IP)...they also rank 1st in opp. avg. (.194) and 2nd in strikeouts (250) in that span...the starter's ERA in that stretch is a ML-best 2.86 (44ER/138.1IP)...HOU is 14-10 (.609) in August.

THE NEW GUYS: The Astros have received solid production from players that were acquired in the last month: **LHP Yusei Kikuchi:** With Sunday night's win at BAL, the Astros are now 5-0 in Kikuchi's 5 starts...he is 2-0 with a 2.89 ERA with 35 K's in 28.0 IP while posting a .175 opp. avg. **LHP Caleb Ferguson:** Has posted a 3.18 ERA in 10 appearances for HOU, tallying 11 K's in 11.1 IP...he is 4th on the club in appearances since being acquired.

OF Ben Gamel: Is hitting .389 (7x18) with an .894 OPS in his 6 games played for the Astros...additionally, he has hit safely in all 5 starts at 7x16 (.438).

TOUGH STRETCH: Today is the 13th game of a stretch where the Astros are scheduled to play on 18 cons. days (8/16-9/2)...they are 5-7 in that stretch thus far...from 8/19-9/1, their opponents were/are BOS, BAL, PHI and KC, who currently have a combined record of 298-232 (.563).

HK AND TK: Current Astros broadcaster **Todd Kalas** and his father, HOF broadcaster **Harry Kalas**, share the distinction of calling games for both the Astros and Phillies in their long careers...Harry began his Major League career in Houston in 1965 before moving to Phila. in 1971...Todd was a Phillies broadcaster from 1994-96 and later became the Astros TV play-by-play man in 2017.

WORLD SERIES REVISITED: The current series is the Astros 1st visit to Philadelphia since Games 3, 4, 5 of the 2022 World Series (Nov. 1-3)...the Phils won Game 3 before the Astros rebounded to take Games 4 and 5 en route to winning the series in 6 games...**The No-No:** In Game 4, four Astros hurlers combined to throw just the 2nd no-hitter in World Series history.

THE TURNAROUND: Since April 27, the Astros are 63-43 (.594) in their last 106 games, which is the best winning percentage in the AL in that span...through April 26, the Astros were 7-19 after 26 games...the Astros are also an AL-best 45-29 (.608) since June 1.

CATCHING ON: Offensively, Astros catchers are T-1st in the AL in RBI (78) and 2nd in batting avg. (.291), slugging pct. (.448) and OPS (.778)...HOU has used 3 different catchers in 2024 (**Yainer Diaz-86g; Victor Caratini-45g; César Salazar-9g**).

ROAD WARRIOR: **OF Yordan Alvarez** has been one of the top two hitters on the road in 2024...he currently leads the AL in road batting avg. (.349) while ranking 2nd in road SLG (.668) and road OPS (1.104)...Alvarez has 17 HR and 47 RBI on the road this season.

LAST START - 8/22 at BAL: threw 6-shutout innings and allowed just 3 hits and 1 walk with 6 strikeouts to earn his 6th career win...was his 3rd start of 6+ IP and 0 ER.

STRIKEOUTS GALORE: recorded 12+ strikeouts on Aug. 5 vs. TB and Aug. 10 at BOS, becoming the first rookie in American League history to log 12+ strikeouts in back-to-back starts (source: STATS).

- he is 1 of 6 Astros ever to tally 12-plus strikeouts in back-to-back starts, joining **RHP Cristian Javier**, **RHP Gerrit Cole**, **RHP J.R. Richard**, **RHP Tom Griffin** and **RHP Don Wilson**.
- recorded 13 strikeouts on Aug. 10 at BOS, it was the 2nd-highest single-game strikeout total from an Astros rookie, behind only a 15-strikeout effort from **RHP J.R. Richard** in his historic MLB debut on Sept. 5, 1971...also became the first Astro to strike out 13+ batters in a game since **LHP Framber Valdez** also fanned 13 batters on July 15, 2023 at LAA...lastly, is 1 of 7 AL pitchers to strike out 13+ batters in a game this year, which includes teammate **LHP Yusei Kikuchi**, who did so on July 9 at SF while with Toronto.
- recorded his 100th career strikeout in just his 19th career outing on July 28 vs. LAD... became the 5th pitcher in Astros history to record 100 strikeouts through their first 19 career appearances, with **RHP Hunter Brown** the last to do so (101 strikeouts through his first 19 appearances).
- has recorded 140 strikeouts through his first 23 appearances, 2nd-most in Astros history over that span behind only **RHP Tom Griffin** (150 SO).

HOT SPAGHETTI: in his last 7 starts, he's recorded a 3.16 ERA (15ER/42.2IP) with 54 strikeouts, a .194 opponent batting average (30x155), a .256 opponent OBP and a 0.98 WHIP over that span (since July 13).

- among AL pitchers since July 13, ranks T-2nd in strikeouts with teammate **LHP Yusei Kikuchi**, 3 strikeouts less than teammate **LHP Framber Valdez**...in the AL in that span, also ranks 5th in opponent batting average, 5th in opponent OBP and 6th in WHIP.
- tossed 6.0 innings in 5 consecutive starts from July 13-Aug. 10, becoming the first Astros rookie pitcher to do so since **RHP J.P. France** posted 7 consecutive start of at least 6.0 innings from May 29-July 5, 2023.

ABOUT ARRIGHETTI (air-uh-get-ee): the rookie right-hander entered the season as the Astros top pitching prospect and the No. 3 overall prospect in the Astros system by both *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...has graduated from prospect status after spending the majority of the year in the Astros rotation, making 22 MLB starts.

- is currently in his 2nd stint in the Majors...was with the club from April 10-15, making 2 starts before being optioned back to Triple A...was recalled on April 21 and has remained in the rotation since.

ROOKIE RANKINGS: among AL rookies, ranks 1st in strikeouts-per-nine-innings (10.80), 2nd in strikeouts (140), T-2nd in starts (23), 3rd in pitching WAR (1.2) and 4th in innings pitched (116.2) (min. 100 IP).

2023 AT A GLANCE: was named the Astros Minor League Pitcher of the Year after going a combined 9-7 with a 4.40 ERA (61ER/124.2IP) in 28 games (21 starts) between Triple A Sugar Land and Double A Corpus Christi.

- struck out 141 batters through his 124.2 innings...ranked 3rd among Astros minor leaguers in strikeouts on the season.
- among Astros minor leaguers, finished 2nd in wins, 2nd in innings pitched, 2nd in opponent batting average (.217), fourth in WHIP (1.25) and 6th in ERA.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: has pitched in parts of 4 minor league seasons (2021-24) with the Astros, going 19-15 with a 4.37 ERA (123ER/253.1IP) in 63 games (42 starts) at the MiLB level.

- at the time of his MLB debut, his career 11.55 SO/9 IP average in the minors ranked 1st among Astros minor leaguers since 2021 (min. 250 IP).
- selected by the Astros in the 6th round of the 2021 MLB First-Year-Player Draft from the University of Louisiana...also pitched collegiately at Texas Christian University and Navarro College (Corsicana, Texas).
- prepped at Cinco Ranch HS (Katy, Texas) in the Greater Houston area.
