

field coordinator Néstor Corredor (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach Jim Henderson (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season) and third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role).....first base coach Julio Borbón, lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf and hitting coach Eric Theisen are all in their first seasons on the staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has not made any replay challenges in 2025.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons.....they are ioined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6),

**BREWING CONSISTENCY**: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 677 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight consecutive seasons, missing out by iust a game in both 2017 and 2022.

## 'S STARTER: #43 - RHP LOGAN HENDERSON (MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT)

HENDERSON AT A GLANCE: Logan Henderson, 23, is making his Major League debut.....Henderson was recalled on Tuesday from Triple-A Nashville, where he was 2-1 with a 3.21 ERA in 3 starts (14ip, 9h, 5r, 5er, 10bb, 24k, 1hr).....he last started in a 3-0 win on 4/9 vs. Memphis (5ip, 0h, 0r, 2bb, 8k, 68 pitches).....he was selected by Milwaukee in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of McLennan (TX) Community College, where he was named 2021 NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year in his lone season (17g, 14gs, 10-2, 1.66era, 97.2ip, 169k).

LAST SEASON: Henderson went 7-6 with a 3.32 ERA in 19 starts at Rookie ACL Brewers (2gs), Class-A Wisconsin (2gs), Double-A Biloxi (9gs) and Triple-A Nashville (6gs)..... he held opponents to a .199 batting average with 104 strikeouts in just 81.1 innings pitched while posting a 0.91 WHIP.....he was added to the 40-man roster on Nov. 19.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Henderson has gone 13-11 with a 3.12 ERA in 47 starts in the Brewers farm system (2022-25).....he has produced 257 strikeouts in just 187.2 innings pitched (12.33 K/9IP) while holding opponents to a .198 batting average and posting a 1.01 WHIP.....he was limited to just 7 starts in his first professional season (2022) due to a fractured right elbow.....prior to the 2024 season was credited with the best control and best changeup in the organization by Baseball America.
