RAYS REPORT—The Rays conclude the 2025 season today at Rogers Centre, wrapping up a six-game trek through Baltimore (1-2) and Toronto (0-2, one to play)...have lost three straight games to fall a season-high seven games under .500, their most since entering play April 20, 2018 (6-13)...are 2-6 in their last eight, 4-9 in their last 13 and 6-15 in their last 21 games on the heels of a season-high seven-game winning streak (Aug. 29–Sept. 4)...are winless in their last seven series (0-6-1), their second time concluding a season with seven (or more) consecutive winless sets, joining 2006 (0-6-2)...it marks their most consecutive winless series at any point in a single season since that same stretch (Sept. 4–Oct. 1, 2006)...went 7-18-1 over their last 26 series after a 16-8-2 start in their first 26...are fourth in the AL East for the 79th consecutive day dating back to July 11, a season-high-tying 16.0 GB the first-place Blue Jays...including off days and the All-Star break, they have spent two days in first, 37 in second, 32 in third, 109 in fourth and four in fifth.

- ✦ The Rays suffered their third straight loss yesterday, falling 5-1 after managing only a **Jonathan Aranda** homer against the Blue Jays pitching staff...it marked Aranda's second long ball in as many games since returning from the injured list...he has reached base safely in 13 straight games and has an RBI in each of his last five.
- ✦ The loss ensured a series defeat, the Rays first to the Jays since Sept. 22-24, 2023 at Tropicana Field, snapping a 6-0-2 unbeaten run...it marks their first series defeat at Rogers Centre since April 14-16, 2023, halting a four-series winning streak here.
- ✦ Tampa Bay is hitless with RISP this series, going 0-for-9...its last set without tallying a hit in scoring situations was Oct. 3-5, 2022 at BOS (0-for-14).
- ✦ With the Orioles loss to the Yankees yesterday, the Rays will finish fourth in the AL East for the second straight year...they avoided what would have been their second fifth-place finish since 2008 along with 2016.
- ✦ Tampa Bay's 84 losses are its third most since becoming the Rays in 2008, trailing 2017 (77-85) and 2016 (68-94)...the club's .541 (1,523-1,291) winning pct. in that span still ranks third in MLB behind the Dodgers (.586) and Yankees (.571).
- ✦ With a major league-leading 191 SB, the Rays need to steal three more bases today to tie the 2009 team's franchise-record 194 SB...holding a 29-steal lead over the second-ranked Brewers, the Rays will pace the majors in steals for the fourth time, joining a streak of three consecutive years turning the trick from 2008-10...it also marks their second consecutive season and seventh time overall pacing the AL in steals.

WHAT'S AT STAKE—The Rays need to win today to avoid:

- ✦ Falling eight games under .500 for the first time since entering play April 20, 2018 (5-13).
- ✦ A fourth straight loss, tied with 2006 and 2005 for their third-longest season-ending losing streak in club history behind 1998 (6G) and 2022 (5G).
- ✦ Being swept in their final series for the fifth time, joining 2022 (at BOS), 2006 (at CLE), 2005 (vs. BAL) and 1998 (at NYY).
- ✦ Their first time being swept by the Blue Jays since Sept. 25-27, 2015 at TOR.

NOW OR NEVER—With a home run today, **Junior Caminero** would tie **Carlos Peña's** franchise-record 46-HR campaign in 2007...he has already recorded multiple home run milestones at Rogers Centre, hitting his first career long ball here on Oct. 1, 2023 and his first grand slam earlier this season on May 13...Caminero has gone deep once in his last 10 games after hitting 5 HR in his previous 12 games (Sept. 2-14) and 16 HR in his previous 34 contests (Aug. 6–Sept. 14)...despite the recent lack of power, he has still hit safely in five of his last six games, going 9-for-20 (.450) with 3 BB against 1 SO and reaching base safely in 13 of 24 PA over that stretch (.542 OBP)...this includes an active streak of three straight multi-hit games, tying the longest run of his career (4x, last: Sept. 1-3, 2025).

- ✦ Caminero's 45 HR are second most in MLB history in an age-21-or-younger season (age as of June 30), trailing the Milwaukee Braves **Eddie Mathews** in 1953 (47HR).
- ✦ His 73 XBH are tied for sixth most in a season in Rays history (see table to the right)...he is the first third baseman with 45 HR and 110 RBI in a campaign before his age-30 season since NYY **Alex Rodriguez** in 2005 (48HR/130RBI, age-29 season).
- ✦ With two doubles today, Caminero (28 2B/44HR) would become the first player in franchise history with a 30-double, 40-homer season.

THE GREAT YANDINO—Reigning AL Player of the Week **Yandy Díaz** has hit safely in 21 of his last 28 games since Aug. 25, batting .404/.491/.596 (40-for-99) with 7 2B, 4 HR, 10 RBI, 17 BB, 12 SO, 19 R and a 1.087 OPS...during that span, he paces the majors in average, ranks second in on-base pct. and is fourth in both hits and OPS...he holds a .400 (32-for-80) average in September, which would be the highest mark during the month in franchise history (min. .75AB), surpassing **Austin Meadows** in 2019 (.378)...it would also mark the fourth time in Rays history a player hit .400 or better in any calendar month (min. .75AB), joining **Fred McGriff** (.422) in July 1999, **Matt Joyce** (.414) in May 2011 and Díaz earlier this season during June (.400/40-for-100).

- ✦ He is one double away from joining **Ben Zobrist** (2011-14) as the only players in Rays history with four straight 30-double seasons.
- ✦ Díaz's 53 multi-hit games, which are tied with SEA **Julio Rodríguez** for the MLB lead, match his career high from 2023...he could become the first player in Rays history to pace the majors in multi-hit efforts...the last Tampa Bay batter with more multi-hit games was **Carl Crawford** (54G) in 2009.
- ✦ Paired with his .330 average in 2023, Díaz (.300) is attempting to join **Carl Crawford** (5x) as the only players in team history with multiple qualified seasons hitting .300 or better...he would join **José Abreu** (4) and HOU **Yordan Álvarez** (2) as the only active Cuban-born players with multiple such campaigns.

PLAYING THE HITS—**Jake Mangum** (.296) and **Chandler Simpson** (.295) are attempting to become the second and third Rays rookies to hit .295 or better (min. 400AB), joining **Joey Wendle** (.300) in 2018...since 1930, only three pairs of rookie teammates have accomplished the feat: PIT **Kevin Newman**/PIT **Bryan Reynolds** in 2019, PIT **Jose Tabata**/PIT **Neil Walker** in 2010 and BOS **Fred Lynn**/BOS **Jim Rice** in 1975...Mangum and Simpson would become the 10th pair of rookie teammates in the modern era (1900–pres.) to accomplish the feat.

- ✦ Between Mangum, Simpson and **Yandy Díaz** (.300), the Rays could have three players hit .295 or better (min. 400AB) for the second time, joining 2009, when **Jason Bartlett** (.320), **Carl Crawford** (.305) and **Ben Zobrist** (.297) all met the mark.
- ✦ Simpson's 44 SB are second in MLB to NYY **José Caballero** (48SB) and lead the majors since his April 19 MLB debut...it ties the eighth-most steals in a season in team history. 1 SB shy of joining **Carl Crawford** (7x, last: 47SB in 2010) as the only Rays to reach 45 SB.

RAYS AND JAYS—The Rays and Blue Jays conclude a 13-game season series this afternoon in Toronto...this marks the clubs' second meeting in a two-week span after splitting a four-game set from Sept. 15-18 at Steinbrenner Field...Tampa Bay has won seven of the first 12 meetings, securing its eighth straight season series win, 10th in 11 seasons under **Kevin Cash** (2015–pres.) and 16th in 18 seasons since becoming the Rays in 2008...the eight-season streak is tied for the longest over a single opponent in franchise history, matching another eight-year run over the Angels (2016-24)...despite dropping this series, the Rays are still 6-1-2 in their last nine sets with the Blue Jays, 10-4-4 in their last 18 and 24-9-6 in their last 39 dating back to Aug. 22, 2017.

- ✦ The Rays 20-31 (.392) record vs. AL East opponents is their worst since 2006 (26-48/.351)...they are 57-53 in games outside the division.
- ✦ Tampa Bay's 2.78 ERA (107.0IP, 33ER) against Toronto this season would be the second lowest in franchise history to 2012 (2.40).
- ✦ **Junior Caminero** has hit safely in all eight of his career games at Rogers Centre, going 12-for-34 (.353) with 3 HR and 10 RBI...it marks the longest career-opening hitting streak by a Ray in this ballpark since **Tommy Pham's** club-record 14-game streak from Sept. 3, 2018–Sept. 29, 2019.

DOWN ON THE FARM—Last night, RHP **Joe Boyle** was named an International League All-Star, one of four starting pitchers to earn the honor...in 18 appearances (17GS), with Triple-A Durham, he went 8-4 with a 1.88 ERA (86.0IP, 18ER), 114 strikeouts and a .154 (46-for-299) opponent batting average.

TODAY'S START—**Ian Seymour** will make his 19th appearance and fifth start of his career in Tampa Bay's final game of 2025 this afternoon...marks his second career start/appearance against Toronto...was recalled from Triple-A Durham on July 31 for his third major league stint, joining June 8-10 and July 8-30...selected by the Rays in the second round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of Virginia Tech.

LAST TIME OUT—Worked the final 4.0 innings of a 6-0 loss to the Orioles on Sept. 23 in Baltimore (4.OIP, 4H, 3ER, 2BB, HBP, 2SO, HR)...a single-single-fielder's choice sequence to begin the 5th inning set up a sacrifice fly by **Jordan Westburg** that plated Baltimore's fourth run...Seymour retired three of his next four batters before hitting a batter and then surrendering a two-run home run to **Colton Cowser**...then saw two more batters reach base on a walk and a single, but put away his final six faced to get through the 8th inning.

- ✦ Matched the longest relief outing of his career (also: Sept. 5 vs. CLE), joining **Joe Boyle** (2x, last: July 11 at BOS - 4.OIP) and **Jesse Scholtens** (Sept. 25 at BAL - 5.1IP) as the only Rays to make relief appearances of 4.0 innings or more this season.
- ✦ In relief appearances, Seymour is 1-1 with a 4.02 ERA (31.1IP, 14ER), 33 SO, a 1.28 WHIP and a .231 (28-for-121) opp. average compared to a 3-1 record with a 4.21 ERA (22.1IP, 3ER), 24 SO, a 0.81 WHIP and a .163 (13-for-80) opp. average as a starter.

WHAT ARE YOU DOING IN CANADA?—Seymour is set to make his second straight start against the Blue Jays and the second of his career today at Rogers Centre...in his previous start, he earned his fourth win of the season after allowing just one unearned run across 7.0 innings in a 2-1 win on Sept. 17 at Steinbrenner Field (W, 7.OIP, 4H, R, BB, 3SO)...also marked his first career start against an AL East club...in seven total outings against the division, he has gone 2-0 with a 3.86 ERA (21.OIP, 9ER), 15 SO, a 1.14 WHIP and a .221 (17-for-77) opp. average.

100 MILES AND RUNNING—Twelve of his 18 career appearances have come away from Steinbrenner Field...despite allowing runs in each of his last three road outings, he is 3-1 with a 2.65 ERA (34.OIP, 10ER), 39 SO, a 0.97 WHIP and a .171 (21-for-123) opp. average in road games...includes a 2-1 record with a 1.76 ERA (15.1IP, 3ER), 21 SO, a 0.85 WHIP and a .161 (9-for-56) opp. average in starts on the road...joined **Josh Fleming** (2020-21) and **Jake Faria** (2017) as the only Rays pitchers to earn the win in each of their first two career road starts.

SETTING LIMITATIONS—In his first four career starts, he has gone 5.0 innings or more and allowed two earned runs or fewer in each...that four-game streak is the longest such streak to begin a career in club history...is one of 47 southpaws with four straight starts or more to begin their career with 5.0 innings or more and two or fewer earned runs since earned runs became an official stat in both leagues in 1913, per Stats Perform...is one of only five since 2019 (**Noah Cameron** - April 30–June 5[G1], 2025, **Jordan Wicks** - Aug. 26–Sept. 11, 2023, **JP Sears** - May 25–Aug. 21, 2022 & **MacKenzie Gore** - April 15–May 4[G2], 2022).

KEEP THE CHANGE—Across his last 13 appearances, Seymour has held opponents to a 9-for-65 (.138) clip on his changeup with 25 SO and a 35.2 pct. whiff rate...min. 50 AB, it marks the fourth-lowest average on any pitcher's changeup in the majors in that timeframe (July 27–pres.)...Seymour has permitted just two extra-base hits (2 2B) on the pitch this season...min. 750 pitches, his 32.5 pct. usage rate on his changeup is fifth highest among major league lefties.

NEW IN NEW ENGLAND—Seymour made his major league debut on June 9 at BOS, earning the win after throwing the 10th and 11th innings...he allowed one unearned run with two walks (1IBB) and two strikeouts...he was the fourth Ray to earn the win in relief in his major league debut, joining **Seth McClung** (March 31, 2003 vs. BOS), **Doug Waechter** (Aug. 27, 2003 at SEA) and **Andrew Bellatti** (May 9, 2015 vs. TEX).

- ✦ Born in Madison, Conn., he became the third pitcher in major league history from New England (Conn., Maine, Mass., N.H., R.I., Vt.) to earn the win at Fenway Park in his major league debut, joining BOS **Kevin Morton** (Conn. - July 5, 1991 vs. DET) and NYY **Charlie Devens** (Mass. - Sept. 24, 1932).

YOU'VE GOT TO EARN IT—Across his first 10 career appearances (June 9–Aug. 9) he was 1-0 with a 1.06 ERA (17.OIP, 2ER) with a 0.88 WHIP and a .164 (10-for-61) opp. average...min. 15.0 IP, his 1.06 ERA was the lowest by any pitcher in franchise history through their first 10 career outings...he is one of 12 pitchers to have a 1.06 ERA or lower through their first 10 games since 2000 and one of four in 2025 (also: MIA **Cade Gibson** - 1.06, CWS **Mike Vasil** - 0.92, LAD Jack Dreyer - 0.66).

- ✦ Seymour was the first Ray to open his career with four straight multi-inning relief outings with 0 ER...was one of 19 MLB left-handed relievers to accomplish the feat since 1901 and the first since KC **Austin Cox** from May 4–Aug. 16 2023.

FEED ME SEYMOURS—Three of the five players with the last name "Seymour" in MLB history appeared on Aug. 15 at SF: LHP **Ian Seymour** and INF **Bob Seymour** (MLB debut) for the Rays, and RHP **Carson Seymour** for the Giants...the only other two Seymours in MLB history are Cy Seymour (1886–1913) and **Jake Seymour** (1882).

- ✦ All three current Seymours are rookies born between October and December 1998 and of no relation...Bob and Carson were teammates with the Cape Cod League's Harwich Mariners in 2019 and the Northwoods League's Rockford Rivets in 2020...Jan (Dec. 13) and Carson (Dec. 16) were born three days apart.

BULL FROM DURHAM—In 16 games (15GS) this season with Triple-A Durham, he was 9-3 with a 2.62 ERA (86.OIP, 25ER) and 104 strikeouts to 20 walks...between June 3 and July 3, he made five starts and earned the win while yielding three runs or fewer in each outing...in 28 career games (27GS) with Durham, he went 14-4 with a 2.34 ERA (150.OIP, 39ER) and a .221 (125-for-565) opp. average.

- ✦ Between his stints in Double-A and Triple-A dating back to May 8, 2024, he has made 37 consecutive minor league outings (36GS) with four runs or fewer allowed.
