THE WORD ON THE BIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their three-game weekend series against the defending back/back World Series Champion Los Angeles Dodgers tonight in a nationally televised game on FOX...the Cardinals posted their 5th-straight win (longest current win streak in MLB that matches their season high) with a 7-2 win in last night's game...the Cardinals will play the Dodgers & Brewers during this six-game homestand and have 15 home games scheduled for this month...the Cardinals are a season-best 6 games over .500 at 19-13.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis entered today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 1.0 game back of first place Cincinnati & Chicago... tonight's game is their 9th in a season-high stretch of 17-straight games without an off day (5-3 record)...the Cardinals are 56-62 in games played against the Dodgers in the seasons (2026, 2025, 2021, 1989, 1982, 1964, 1960 and 1956) that followed their World Series titles.

WHO LET THE DOGS OUT? Not related to the anthem song from their 2000 playoff push when they played to the winning tune of "Who Let the Dogs Out" by Baha Men, the Cardinals introduced a Home Run dug-out celebration chain last night that displays an inscription of "Got that Dawg in Me"...the Cardinals are currently ranked 3rd in the NL with 43 HR's, and are in barking distance of the Dodgers & Braves who each have hit 45...inside sources have indicated that **José Fermín** may have had a paw in the Dawg Chain idea.

THESE DAWGS POUND: The Cardinals lineup runs deep with 11 of their 13 position players having hit HR's, including an MLB-leading five players (Walker-9, Wetherholt-7, Burleson-5, Church-5 & Gorman-5) who have each hit 5 or more round-trippers.

DERBY DAY: The 152nd running of the Kentucky Derby will take place today in Louisville, KY, the home of the former Louisville Cardinals, the St. Louis Triple-A affiliate from 1982-1997. The Cardinals have had a number Kentuckians play for them, including former pitcher and current pitching strategist **Dean Kiekhefer** as well as former pitcher **Todd Wellemeyer** - The Kentucky Colonel. Cardinals thoroughbred racing enthusiasts such as **Mike Shannon**, **Dan Farrell**, **Gene Gieselmann**, **Rob Murphy** and **Joe Torre** would all have an eye on (Nathan) **Church**, (Ken) **Hill** Downs on Derby Day as their favorite (Walt) **Jockey's** would run for the (Mike) **Roses**.

EARLY BIRDS: The Cardinals improved to 13-2 in games when they score first with last night's win that featured a 3-run 1st inning...there are only seven MLB teams with 13 or more wins when scoring first, and four of those clubs reside in the NL Central (PIT-15, STL-13 CHI-13, CIN-13).

20/20 VISION: The Cardinals have their sights set on a 20th win tonight which would put them in the 20+ win class with ATL-23, NYY-21, LAD-20, CHI-20 & CIN-20...the Cardinals Triple-A affiliate Memphis Redbirds (21-10) recently became the first team in all of Minor League Baseball to win 20 games.

Andre Pallante was born in Mission Viejo and resides in San Clemente...graduated from San Clemente High School...played college baseball at the Univ. of California, Irvine (2017-19).

Michael McGreevy was born in and resides in San Clemente...graduated from San Clemente High School...played college baseball at the University of California, Santa Barbara (2019-21).

Justin Bruihl pitched parts of three seasons with the Dodgers (2021-23) where he made his MLB debut...played college baseball California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo.

Dean Kiekhefer made his MLB debut at Dodger Stadium (May 14, 2016)...struck out career-high four of six total batters faced, including first batter, Joc Pederson (looking).

Tommy Edman played parts of five seasons with St. Louis (2019-24)...won a Gold Glove at second base in 2021...selected by the Cardinals in the 6th round of the 2016 MLB Draft.

Lars Nootbaar was born in & resides El Segundo, Calif...Graduated from El Segundo High School... Played college baseball at USC (2016-18).

JoJo Romero was born in Camarillo, CA...graduated from Oxnard (Calif.) High School.

Brant Brown previously served as Dodgers Assistant Hitting Coach and Minor League Hitting Coordinator for five seasons (2018-22).

Victor Scott II made his MLB debut at Dodger Stadium (March 28, 2024)...is the only Cardinal (since 1900) to steal a base in his Major League debut on Opening Day.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** was born in Pomona and resides in San Clemente, Calif... graduated from Damien High School in La Verne, Calif...played college baseball at the University of Southern California...served as Dodgers Hitting Coach for three seasons (2013-15).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Al Hrabosky** graduated from Savanna High School in Anaheim...played college baseball at Fullerton (Calif.) College.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** pitched in 35 games over parts of two seasons (1988-89) for the Dodgers between stints with St. Louis...member of 1988 World Series champion Dodgers.

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** managed both the Cardinals (1990-95) and Dodgers (2008-10).

Cardinals AGM/Scouting **Randy Flores** was born in Bellflower...graduated from El Rancho High School in Pico Rivera...pitched at the University of Southern California (1994-97).

Ron "Pop" Warner was born in Alhambra, Calif.

Cardinals broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played his two final MLB seasons with the Dodgers (2007-08)...Was originally selected by the Dodgers in the 39th round of the 1990 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** graduated from Locke High School in Los Angeles...played college baseball at Cal Polytechnic State Univ., San Luis Obispo.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **John Tudor** pitched two seasons (1988-89) with Los Angeles, where he won a World Series...originally traded by St. Louis to the Dodgers for **Pedro Guerrero** (Aug. 16, 1988).

Cardinals broadcaster **Polo Ascencio** worked for parts of 10 seasons (2008-16) for Dodgers radio and Spanish website.

Dodgers MLB Field Coordinator **Bob Geren** played five minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (1981-85).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Daniel Guerrero** is an Anaheim, Calif. native...earned associates degree in journalism at Fullerton College.

Athletic reporter **Katie Woo** previously covered the Cardinals for five seasons (2021-25).

TONIGHT'S STARTER:

- The 25-year-old San Clemente native is making his 7th start of the 2026 season today, 26th career start (28th career game).
- The Cardinals are 16-9 (.640 win pct.) in his 25 career games started**, losing consecutive games that he has started just twice. St. Louis is 3-3 (.600) in his games started this season.
- Has pitched 6.0+ innings in 15 of 25 career starts.
- Allowed two runs or fewer in four of six starts this season.
- Since joining the Cardinals rotation last June, the Cardinals have posted 13 wins in his games started - the most among all Cardinals starters.
- Has made 14 career appearances (12 starts) at Busch Stadium where he is 6-3 with a 4.06 ERA (71.0 IP). Boasts a 1.59 ERA (17.0 IP) in three starts at home this season.

LAST TIME OUT (April 26 vs. Seattle): ND, L, 3-2; 6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 6 SO, 1 HR; 98 pitches.

- His only run allowed came from a Cal Raleigh solo homer in the 4th inning.
- Exited in line for the win before the visiting Mariners tied the game in the 7th and pulled ahead in the 9th inning on a Rob Refsnyder pinch hit solo homer as Seattle completed a three-game series sweep.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

FAITH IN FIELDERS: Has the NL's lowest percent (16.4) of swing & miss; Ranks 8th in the NL among starting pitchers with a .208 BABIP.

THROW IT BACK: Didn't hook any keepers in 5-3 loss at Miami on 4/20, allowing a season-high 4 runs over his 5.2 IP; the loss snapped the Cardinals season-high 5-game win streak.

CURLY W: Limited the Washington Nationals to just 4 baserunners over his 6.0 IP in 6-1 win at Nationals Park on 4/8, retiring his final 11 batters faced in order. Walked none and struck out one to earn his 1st win of the season.

"NO" NEWS IS GOOD NEWS: Retired the first nine batters en route to 6.0 no-hit innings in his first start of the season vs. TB (3/28) in a no decision the Cardinals won in 10 innings (6-5).

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: Became the first Cardinal to throw 6.0+ no-hit innings in a completed start since **Erick Fedde** on April 9, 2025 at Pittsburgh (6.0 IP). Since 1961, the Cardinals record for the longest hitless inning streak as a starter (excluding any possible intervening relief appearances) to begin a season is 8.0 IP by **Daniel Ponce de Leon** - July 23, 2018 (7.0 IP) and Aug. 21, 2018 (1.0 IP) - *Elias*

JOINING THE LEGENDS: Became the second pitcher in Cardinals history to throw a hitless start in one of the first two starts of the season (**Jack Flaherty** 4/1/23 vs. TOR) and the 14th time in MLB a pitcher has in a start of 6.0 or more innings. **Emerson Hancock** (SEA) followed with 6.0 no-hit innings vs. CLE the next day.

SPRING FLING: Bent 4-0 with a 2.45 ERA in 5 Spring Training starts, striking out 16 to just 2 walks but did allow a team-high 6 HR's; Led MLB with his 4 Spring Training wins and ranked in top 10 in ERA (2.45), Opp. BA (.229) and WHIP (0.98)

McGreevy vs. LOS ANGELES DODGERS:

- Is making his 2nd career start and appearances against the Dodgers.
- Southern California native from San Clemente grew up a fan of the San Diego Padres. Is an avid fan of the LA Chargers.
- Pitched at the University of California, Santa Barbara (2019-21).
- Is 4-3 with a 5.92 ERA in nine career starts against National League West Division opponents.

LAST APPEARANCE vs. DODGERS: June 8, 2025 at Busch Stadium: L, 7-3, 6.0 IP, 8 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 0 BB, 5 K, 101 pitches.

- Marked his first career loss of his Major League career, while his 101 pitches thrown still is his career high.
