# San Diego Padres (78-80) at San Francisco Giants (78-80) RHP Matt Waldron (1-3, 4.58) vs. LHP Sean Manaea (7-6, 4.51)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants and Padres wrap up their season series tonight with the final game of this three-game series... this series is tied at a game apiece but San Diego secured the season series with last night's win.

- ▶ It's the first time since 2009-2010 that the Padres have claimed the season series in back-to-back seasons.
- ► SF needs to win each of its last four games to secure a winning record this season, and three of four to finish .500.
- ▶ The Giants are seeking a fourth-straight series victory here at home...their last home series loss came at the hands of the Braves from August 25-27 (lost two-of-three).

**WELL, THAT'S THAT:** Last night's loss to the Padres eliminated the Giants from postseason contention coupled with the win by Arizona and the result of losing the potential tiebreakers with the Cubs even if SF were to win out.

▶ Since going to the postseason four times from 2010-2016, the Giants have failed to participate in postseason play in six of their last seven seasons with the only postseason appearance coming in 2021.

**NO DANCIN' THIS SEPTEMBER:** After a 7-2 victory over these Padres at Petco Park to open a seven-game road trip on August 31, the Giants were 70-64 and according to *Fangraphs* had a 67.1% chance of making the playoffs when the calendar flipped to September.

▶ This month, the Giants are 8-16 (.333) tied for the second-worst mark in the National League with Colorado...only the Nationals have a lower winning percentage this month (7-16, .304).

**ON THE HOME FRONT:** SF is 44-33 (.571) at home this year, the ninth-best home record in the Majors...this is in contrast to its 34-47 (.420) road record, which is 25th in MLB.

- ➤ Stats, LLC notes that SF's 15-7 (.682) mark at home vs. NL West teams is the third-best divisional record in the Majors behind the Braves (16-7, .696) and Dodgers (18-8, .692).
- ► Each of the Giants four remaining home games in 2023 are against NL West foes.

**BIG SEAN: LHP Sean Manaea** toes the slab tonight in what could be his final appearance of the season.

- Manaea had his best outing of the season in his last start against LA last Friday at Chavez Ravine, firing 7.0 innings of shutout ball while allowing three hits.
- ➤ Since returning full-time to the rotation with his start on September 12 vs. Cleveland, Manaea has a 2.00 ERA (4er, 18.0ip) with 10 strikeouts to two walks in the three starts.
- ▶ Here at home, Manaea has been lights out since May 17, posting a 1.65 ERA (6er, 32.2ip) with 35 strikeouts to just eight walks in 12 games (one start).
- ▶ Manaea's 1.65 home ERA in that time is third-best in the Majors (min. 30.0 home innings) behind DET's Tarik Skubal (1.53) and BAL's Kyle Bradish (1.63).
- ▶ The eight-year Major League veteran is on the verge of reaching the 1,000 inning mark for his career...Manaea enters tonight's start at 996.2 career regular season innings.

**BOUNCE BACK:** Despite going 0-for-4 last night, **IF LaMonte Wade Jr.** has had a nice bounce-back in the season's final month.

- ▶ Wade is slashing .321/.403/.571 in 19 games this month with four homers and a .974 OPS...he's reached base safely in 17 of the 19 games.
- ▶ This comes on the heels of posting a .633 OPS in 21 August games and a .488 OPS in 18 July contests.
- During the season's first three months Wade was one of SF's best hitters, posting a .959 OPS in March/April, .778 in May and .894 in June.

**HOLD THE LINE:** The Giants pitching staff enters today's game with the fewest homers (168) and fewest walks (397) permitted in the Majors this season.

- ► SF's 168 homers allowed are two fewer than Cleveland, San Diego and St. Louis (170).
- On the walk front, SF's 397 free passes are three fewer than Seattle (400).
- ▶ If the status quo holds it would be the third straight season SF pitchers allowed the fewest HRs and the second time in three years they walked the fewest batters (also 2021).

**ROOK TO BISHOP FOUR:** The Giants have had 425 combined games this year started by rookies (400 starts from position players and 25 from pitchers)...according to *Stats, LLC* that total is the third-highest in the SF-era.

**ON STRIKE(OUTS):** SF's batters tonight's game with 1,463 strikeouts for the season after eight more last night.

- ▶ The 1,463 strikeouts are fifth-most in the Majors and second-most in the NL behind the Colorado Rockies (1,486).
- ▶ The most times any Giants team has struck out in a single season was 1,467 times in 2018.
- Last season, Giants hitters struck out 1,462 times in 162 games...in 2021 it was 1,461 times in 162 games.

# SEAN MANAEA LHP 2023 RECORD: 7-6, 4.51 ERA

**WITH THE GIANTS:** Manaea is in his first season with Giants...he signed a two-year, \$25 million contract with San Francisco this off-season after spending 2022 with San Diego.

**TODAY'S GAME:** Manaea will likely close out his season today with his fourth start since returning to the rotation...currently at 996.2 career innings, Manaea is 10 outs away from reaching 1,000 innings in his career.

**LAST OUTING:** He had his best start of the season, allowing just three hits and no walks while striking out two in 7.0 shutout innings at the Dodgers on September 22...despite LAD entering with the MLB's fifth-best OPS against lefties (.797), Manaea held them to zero extra-base hits.

**VS. SAN DIEGO:** Manaea will face his former team for the fourth time this season...he pitched in relief on August 31 at Petco Park, allowing one run on three hits and five walks while striking out two in 3.1 innings...in three outings this season, Manaea is 1-0 with a 7.11 ERA (5er, 6.1ip), six strikeouts and 10 walks...in his career vs. the Padres, Manaea is 3-1 with a 4.08 ERA (13er, 28.2ip)...Fernando Tatís Jr. is 1-for-9 (.111) with five strikeouts vs. Manaea while Xander Bogaerts is 6-for-13 (.462) with two doubles, a home run and three walks.

BACK IN THE FOLD: Manaea has made three straight starts after coming out of the bullpen in his previous 25 games...he has a 2.00 ERA (4er, 18.0ip), 10 strikeouts, a .194 opposing batting average and a 0.83 WHIP in his last three starts...prior to this return to the rotation, Manaea had last started a game on May 10 vs. Washington...he's posted a 4.18 ERA (33er, 71.0ip) with 82 strikeouts and a 1.17 WHIP in 27 games as a reliever this year compared to a 5.09 ERA (23er, 40.2ip), 38 strikeouts and a 1.38 WHIP in nine starts.

**FAST AND FURIOUS:** Manaea recorded 12 of his 21 outs last game with his fastball (*Sports Info Solutions*)...his fastball has been his go-to pitch, throwing it 56.8% of the time, with 74 of his 120 strikeouts coming with the pitch...the pitch has a +5 run value on Baseball Savant, which is his best mark on any pitch since his changeup was +10 in 2021...the Padres have an .817 OPS against four-seam fastballs this year, which ranks 12th in MLB.

A RARE FEAT: A win today would be Manaea's fourth as a starter this season...with four wins as a reliever already, Manaea would be just the fourth Giant since 1969 to have at least four wins as a starter and as a reliever in a season (*Stats, LLC*), joining Atlee Hammaker (1988), Scott Garrelts (1986) and Fred Breining (1982)...Manaea is the first Giants pitchers to have at least three wins as a starter and four as a reliever since Jim Brower in 2003 (*Stats, LLC*).

**CHANGING THE PACE:** Manaea's changeup has played a major part in his recent success...opponents are batting .105 (2x19) with just two singles against Manaea's changeup since Aug. 31...overall this season, Manaea's changeup has a +3 run value on *Baseball Savant* while limiting hitters to a .194 batting average and a .254 wOBA.

**LEFT ON READ:** In his last three starts, Manaea has faced two teams that struggle against lefties (COL and CLE) and one of the premier southpaw-hitting teams in the Majors (LAD)...the Padres offer Manaea his toughest test yet as their .813 OPS against lefties is second in the Majors, trailing only Atlanta's .872 mark.

**KEEP IT LOW:** Manaea entered his last start heavily relying on the ground ball, with 19 ground outs compared to two flyouts...he held LAD to seven ground outs in his last start, yet also allowed nine flyouts...Manaea has a 50% ground ball rate since returning to the rotation, a significant increase from his 39.9% rate for the season.
