THE TWINS: The Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand with consecutive wins over the Red Sox on Monday and Tuesday night...today, Minnesota will play the three-game series finale against Boston...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then host the Reds for three games over the weekend.
 ☞ Today marks the final day of a stretch of 15-straight days with a game for Minnesota.
 ☞ Twins have 11 wins through 18 games...in 2025, Minnesota didn't earn its 11th win until game 27 on April 26.
 ☞ Twins have won four-straight, eight of their last nine and 10 of their last 13.

SICK MICK: The Twins shut out the Red Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 6-0, their first shutout of the season...Mick Abel (1-2) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with four hits allowed, no walks and a career-high 10 strikeouts...Byron Buxton had four of the club's 10 hits, fifth time in his career with four-plus hits...two of those being home runs, his 18th career multi-homer game, tying Tony Oliva for third on the Twins all-time multi-homer list...the win marked the third-straight series win for the Twins, marking the first time doing so since July 4-13, 2025, when they took two of three from Tampa Bay, Chicago-NL and Pittsburgh...Twins have outscored the Sox 19-6 through the two games this series.

FEELING MINNESOTA: Twins have gone 7-2 at home this season for a .778 winning percentage...only Detroit has a higher winning percentage, posting an .857 at Comerica Park (6-1)...Minnesota has won six-straight at Target Field, their longest home winning streak since April 25-May 19, 2025, when they won 10-straight here.

HOT DISH AND CHOWDER: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the third of six meetings in 2026...their next series will be at Fenway Park for a weekend series from May 22-24.
 ☞ Twins have gone 10-6 in their last 16 games against Boston, dating back to June 21, 2023.
 ☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .375 (18-for-48) with five doubles, three home runs and a 1.054 OPS in his last 13 games against the Red Sox, dating back to June of 2023.
 ☞ Byron Buxton has hit safely in 11-straight games against the Red Sox, hitting .417 (20-for-48) with one double, seven home runs, nine RBI and a 1.315 OPS in that span...additionally, he has reached base safely via hit or walk in 16-straight against Boston, dating back to April of 2021 (.414 OBP / 1.180 OPS).
 ☞ Victor Caratini is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with seven walks, a .476 on-base percentage and a .900 OPS in 14 career games against the Red Sox.

RUNNING MEN: Twins have scored 98 runs on the season, second-most in the AL and fourth-most in baseball, trailing Houston (102), Atlanta (100) and Washington (99)...98 runs scored are tied for eighth-most in club history through the first 18...their most was 110 in 2004.
 ☞ Over their last nine games, the Twins have scored multiple runs in 14 of their 75 total innings at-bat.

THE SEQUEL: The Twins have homered 14 times in their last six games and have hit 24 on the season, third-most in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (29) and Los Angeles-AL (26)...24 home runs are their fifth-most all-time through the club's first 18 games; their most being 33 in 2019...Twins are 9-5 when homering at least once and 5-1 when homering at least twice.

CLEAN UP YOUR SOX: Twins are seeking their second sweep of the season today, their first was a four-game sweep of the Tigers at Target Field from April 6-9...they recorded four sweeps in 2025 - all in three games: April 25-27 vs. Los Angeles-AL at Target Field, May 6-8 vs. Baltimore at Target Field, May 9-11 vs. San Francisco at Target Field and May 16-18 at Baltimore.
 ☞ Twins are looking to sweep the Red Sox for the first time since May 25-27, 2015, when they swept in three games at Target Field.
 ☞ Twins are looking to become the second team in baseball to record two sweeps this season, the other being the Dodgers, who have swept the Nationals and Diamondbacks.

FIRST LEFTY STARTER OF THE YEAR, I THINK: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 11th time in 19 games...they have gone 5-5 against left-handed starters this season...their five wins were April 2 at Kansas City vs. Kris Bubic (5-1), April 7 vs. Detroit against Jarik Skubal (4-2), April 8 vs. Detroit against Framber Valdez (8-6), Saturday at Toronto vs. Eric Lauer (7-4) and Monday vs. Boston against Garrett Crochet (13-6).
 ☞ In the first seven games vs. lefties, the Twins hit .169 (21-for-124) with a .530 OPS and two home runs, but have hit .299 (43-for-144) with an .899 OPS and six home runs over their last nine.
 ☞ The 10 lefty starters are the most any team has faced this season.
 ☞ Since July 5, 2025, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .405 (30-for-74) with a .511 on-base percentage and a 1.065 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...since that date, his batting average leads all of baseball (min. 80 PA)...his OPS ranks fifth.

THANK YOU, JACKIE: Major League Baseball today celebrates Jackie Robinson's life and legacy with a series of initiatives alongside the Jackie Robinson Foundation (JRF), MLB Clubs and additional partners as part of the league's annual Jackie Robinson Day...today, the Twins are honoring several individuals and groups that exemplify Jackie's nine values:
 ☞ Fans entering Target Field will be treated to a performance by Minnesota's Ozone Creations, an eclectic collective amplifying the rich tapestry of Afrocentric music.
 ☞ Pregame ceremonies will honor the Northside Bulldogs, a North Minneapolis group dedicated to uplifting youth through character building, leadership skills and community service.
 ☞ A ceremonial first pitch will be thrown by Antione Jenkins, a Twin Cities-based designer, art director, painter - and commissioned artist for Target Field's forthcoming "Baseball Heroes" mural, which will honor Black baseball legends with ties to the Upper Midwest.
 ☞ The Twins Territory Flag will be raised by staff from Appetite for Change, a community-led nonprofit that uses food as a tool to build health, wealth and social change in North Minneapolis.
 ☞ National Anthem will be sung by Twin Cities-based vocalist, voice instructor and creative Aja Darrah.
 ☞ The Target Field videoboard will run various Jackie Robinson vignettes during inning breaks.
 ☞ The Northside Bulldogs will also lead fans in a rendition of "Take Me Out to the Ballgame" during the 7th-inning stretch.
 ☞ Twins' social platforms and the Twins.TV broadcast will feature reflections from Twins All-Star centerfielder Byron Buxton, infielder Royce Lewis and right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson.

- ☞ Is 0-0 with a 1.35 ERA (6.2IP, 1 ER), two walks and four strikeouts at Target Field this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Woods Richardson took the loss in his last start on April 10 at Toronto, allowing season-highs in hits (6) and runs (5) while walking one batter and striking out two en route to a 10-4 Twins loss at Rogers Centre.

- ☞ Surrendered a fourth-inning homer to Blue Jays rookie catcher, Brandon Valenzuela, the first home run of his career; Sim has allowed a home run in all three starts this season.
- ☞ Has allowed five runs in all three career outings against Toronto, each coming at Rogers Centre.

2025 RECAP: Was a member of the Twins season-opening rotation for the first time in his career...posted a career-high in wins, finishing 7-4 with a 4.04 ERA (111.1 IP, 50 ER), 46 walks, 107 strikeouts and a 1.28 WHIP, his lowest in a full season...finished the season third on the team in strikeouts (107), starts (22) and innings pitched (111.1).held opponents to a .194 (27-for-139) BAA post-All Star Break, owning a 2-0 record with a 4.23 ERA (38.1 IP, 18 ER), 18 walks, 45 strikeouts and a 1.17 WHIP during that span...finished the season 5-0 over his last 12 starts beginning June 26 vs. Seattle; posted a 3.10 ERA (58.0 IP, 20 ER) with 61 strikeouts and a 1.10 WHIP during that stretch.

SIM VS. THE SOX: Sim is set to make his second career start against Boston; he is 0-0 with a 5.79 ERA (4.2 IP, 3 ER), two walks, five strikeouts, a .333 (7-for-21) BAA and a 1.93 WHIP against the Red Sox...in his lone outing against Boston on July 28, 2025, pitched 4.2 innings and allowed three runs on seven hits - including a home run from Alex Bregman - with two walks and five strikeouts in a 5-4 Twins loss at Target Field; he did not factor in the decision.

☞ Has faced nine current Boston hitters in his career; those nine players have combined for a .318 (7-for-22) BAA with one double (Jarren Duran), no home runs, three walks, six strikeouts and zero RBI.

BEASTS OF THE EAST: Today's game will mark Simeon's 11th career start against an AL East opponent...his 6.04 ERA (47.2 IP, 32 ER) against the AL East is his worst against a single division; he is 1-1 with 18 walks, 39 strikeouts, a 1.55 WHIP and a .292 (56-for-192) BAA in ten starts.

- ☞ In two starts against the AL East in 2026, Sim is 0-1 with a 5.06 ERA (10.2 IP, 6 ER), three walks, six strikeouts and two homers allowed.
- ☞ His one win against the AL East (9/15/25 vs. New York-AL) is tied with the NL East and NL Central for his fewest against a single division.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his career, Sim has gone 6-4 with a 3.78 ERA (135.2 IP, 57 ER), 52 walks, 130 strikeouts and a 1.23 WHIP in 27 games (26 starts) at home compared to 6-8 with a 4.68 ERA (134.2 IP, 70 ER), 52 walks, 110 strikeouts and a 1.36 WHIP in 29 road games (28 starts).

- ☞ With the no-decision in his first home start of 2026 on April 5 vs. Tampa Bay, Simeon has avoided a loss in eight consecutive home starts dating back to June 26, 2025 vs. Seattle.
- ☞ Is 3-0, 1.93 ERA (42.0 IP, 9 ER) with 17 walks, 43 strikeouts, a 1.10 WHIP and a .190 (29-for-153) BAA at Target Field during that span.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In his first three starts of 2026, left-handed hitters are slashing .276/.344/.552 (8-for-29) with two home runs, two doubles, three walks and four strikeouts, while righties are slashing .250/.273/.438 (8-for-32) with three doubles, one home run, one walk and four strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .242/.317/.382 (113-for-466) with 50 walks and 106 strikeouts (2.12 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .239/.305/.413 (134-for-560) with 53 walks and 134 strikeouts (2.53 K/BB).

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson relies on a four-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:
