RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a nine-game homestand over 10 days with the last of a three-game series against the Boston Red Sox. St. Louis won the first two games of the series/homestand outscoring the Red Sox 17-8. The Baltimore Orioles come to town tomorrow through Wednesday followed by an open date and a three-game series against their National League Central rival, the Chicago Cubs, May 24-26.
FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals are in 4th place in the National League Central, only three percentage points behind (.444) behind 3rd place Pittsburgh (.447), but one game ahead in the loss column. Both the "Cards and 'Bucs reside 7.0 games behind first place Milwaukee (26-18) entering today. St. Louis has won five of their last six games and are tied with Miami for the best mark in the National League (5-1) since May 12.
SWEEP-STAKES: A win today would give the Cardinals their first sweep of the season and their first at Busch Stadium since July 17-19, 2023, against the Miami Marlins. The Cardinals swept the Red Sox last season at Fenway Park (May 12-14) and have won five straight games against their foes from the 1946, 1967, 2004 and 2013 World Series. The Cardinals posted win streaks of six (2012-13) and seven (2003-05) games against the Kansas City Royals as their longest Interleague win streaks ahead of the Red Sox.
ALL EYES ON US: The Cardinals will be televised nationally three times on this homestand. The Roku Channel will air today's Cardinals-Red Sox game with a first pitch time of 12:05 p.m. Central Time. Cardinals play-by-play announcer Chip Caray will join Red Sox analyst Will Middlebrooks and Cardinals sideline reporter Alexa Datt for the call. Two games during the Cubs series will air on FOX Saturday Baseball (May 25) and ESPN Sunday Night Baseball (May 26). The Cardinals are 2-4 on nationally televised games this season.
A BEAST VS. THE (A.L.) EAST: The Cardinals posted the best winning percentage against American League East Division opponents since the start of 2023 with an 13-4 mark (.765). They are 5-0 against the Boston Red Sox dating back to May 12 of last season and 2-1 against the Blue Jays, Orioles, Rays and Yankees. The Cardinals are 20-13 (.606) against A.L. East opponents under third-year manager Oliver Marmol, his best record against any division with the N.L. Central (70-65, .519) ranking second.

MORE SCORES: Nolan Gorman scored a run in his 7th consecutive game against the Red Sox last night tying Javy Lopez (ATL, 2000-01) for the most consecutive games with a run scored by a National League player against the Red Sox since 1997, when Interleague play began. The seven games with a run against Boston is the longest active streak by an opposing player.
WINN, WINN, WINN, WINN: With a single in the 7th inning last night, Masyn Winn extended his career-high hit streak to 10 games, Ion, Iongest active among Major League rookies this season and 3rd-longet active in the National League behind Ketel Marte (17, ARI) and Ezequiel Tovar (11, COL). Winn's 10-game hit streak marks the 4th double-digit hit streak by a Cardinals rookie joining Jordan Walker, who had hit streaks of 17, 12 and 12 in 2023.
