IN THE STANDINGS

The Reds entered today's games just **1.0 game** plus .001 percentage point behind the third-place **Cubs**...haven't been in **third place** since they were tied for that spot with the Cubs at **44-65 on 8/9**...haven't been in **third place alone** since **8/7**...beginning **8/20**, the Reds spent the last 23 days **alone in fourth place**.

STREAKS

The Reds won **3** of their **last 5 games**, **6** of their **last 11 games** and **8** of their **last 15 games**...are **53-60** since beginning the season **3-22** (through 5/5)...followed that **3-22** start with stretches of **41-41** (5/7-8/7) and **12-19** (beginning 8/8)...this year's team is 1 of just 3 in modern Major League history to begin a season with as few as **3 wins** over the **first 25 games** (**1988 Orioles** 2-23, **2003 Tigers** 3-22).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Is **Game 1** of a brief 4-game series / homestand vs **Danny Hart's Pirates**.
- The Reds are coming off a **3-3 road trip** (2-1 at Cubs, 1-2 at Mil).
- Following this series, the Reds head to **Busch Stadium** for a 5-game weekend series vs the **Cardinals** that also includes a **doubleheader**...will be the Reds' first **5-game series vs StL** since **July 1958**.

SERIES NOTES

- The Reds are **27-14 vs Pit** over the **last 3 seasons**.
- Over the 2021 and 2022 seasons at **Great American Ball Park**, the Reds are **12-3 vs Pit** with a **113-47 advantage** in runs scored...including 3 series wins and 2 series sweeps in 2021, the Reds have won **22** of the **last 32 games** vs the Pirates, including **17** of the **last 20 games vs Pit** at **GABP**.

DOUBLE DIPPIN'

- Tomorrow's **day/night doubleheader** was scheduled post-lockout.
- Will be the third doubleheader this season between the Reds and Pirates, including splits on **5/7** and **7/7**, both at **Great American Ball Park**.
- The **day/night doubleheader split** at GABP on **5/7** was the Reds' **first scheduled twinbill** since **9/17/1987** at **Dodger Stadium**.
- The Reds and Pirates will play 3 doubleheaders vs each other in a single season for the **first time since 1965**.
- The Reds last swept a 9-inning doubleheader on **7/6/2014 vs Cubs** (4-2, 6-5 wins)...haven't been swept in a 9-inning DH since **8/31/2019** at **StL** (10-6, 3-2 loss)...haven't been swept in a 9-inning twinbill at **Great American Ball Park** since **9/17/2016 vs Pit** (10-4, 7-3 losses).

SERIES NOTES

- The Reds and Cardinals this weekend are scheduled to play a 5-game series for the first time since **7/25-7/27, 1958**, when the Reds earned a **3-2 series win**, including a pair of doubleheader splits.
- The Cardinals have won 9 of the first 14 games and 4 of the first 5 series.

CATCH YOU LATER

- 7 catchers** have played for the Reds this season (**Tyler Stephenson, Aramis Garcia, Mark Kolozsvary, Chris Okey, Michael Papierski, Austin Romine, Chuck Robinson**).
- The **1909 Reds** hold the franchise record for number of catchers used in a season with **8**.
- 6 other Reds teams employed **6 catchers**, most recently in **1992**.
- Last season, for just the third time **since 1882**, the Reds finished a season using only 2 catchers (**Tucker Barnhart, Stephenson**)...they also did it in **1959** (**Ed Bailey, Dutch Dotterer**) and **1979** (**Johnny Bench, Vic Correll**).

YOUNG GUNS

- In **51 combined starts**, Reds rookie starting pitchers **RHP Hunter Greene, LHP Nick Lodolo** and **RHP Graham Ashcraft** went **13-20, 4.39** (276.2ip, 135er)...all 3 made their Major League debuts **this season**.
- 6 times** this season the Reds started **rookie pitchers** in **3 straight games** (last, 7/31-8/2, **Lodolo, Greene, Ashcraft**).
- In **Sanmartin** (Game 2), **Greene** (Game 4) and **Lodolo** (Game 6), the Reds used as many as 3 rookie starting pitchers in the **first 6 games of a season** for only the **second time in their history**...the **1902 Reds staff** used 3 rookie starting pitchers in their first 5 games, and 4 of their first 6 games that season were started by rookie pitchers (**Bob Ewing** 2 starts, **Len Swormstedt, Martin Glendon**)...courtesy @EliasSports.
- This year's Reds became the **fourth Major League team since 2000** to use 3 different starting rookie pitchers in the **first 6 games** of a season, joining the **2020 Royals** (**Brady Singer, Ronald Bolanos, Kyle Zimmer**), **2018 Marlins** (**Caleb Smith, Dillon Peters, Trevor Richards**) and **2009 Athletics** (**Trevor Cahill, Brett Anderson, Josh Outman**).

SINGLE-SEASON CLUB RECORDS

- 63 players** have appeared in at least 1 game for Reds, the most in the Major Leagues and a **new club record** for number of players in a season...the previous record was held by the **2003 club** (**57 players**).
- 36 pitchers** have appeared in at least 1 game for the Reds, a new club record for number of pitchers in a season and including position players **Matt Reynolds, Max Schrock** and **Alejo Lopez**...the previous record was held by the **2021 club** (**35 pitchers**)...the Reds, Rays and Twins are tied for second-most pitchers in the Major Leagues behind the Cubs (41).
- 10 Reds pitchers** have recorded at least 1 save, tying last year's single-season franchise record.
- The Reds have used **10 first basemen**, tying last season's total and **1 shy** of the **1995 club record** for number of players at that position (**Brandon Drury, Kyle Farmer, Aramis Garcia, Colin Moran, Mike Moustakas, Matt Reynolds, Donovan Solano, Spencer Steer, Tyler Stephenson** and **Joey Votto**).
- Reds pitchers lead the Major Leagues with **92 hit batters**, a new club record for opposing batters hit by a pitch (**80, 2005**).

ADDITIONAL ROSTER NOTES

- 11 Reds players** made Major League debuts this season, including **RHP Daniel Duarte, RHP Alexis Diaz, RHP Hunter Greene** (start), **LHP Nick Lodolo** (start), **C Mark Kolozsvary, RHP Jared Solomon, RHP Graham Ashcraft** (start), **C Chris Okey, C Chuckie Robinson, RHP Fernando Cruz** and **3B Spencer Steer** (start).
- 17 rookies**, including **10 pitchers**, have appeared in at least 1 game for the Reds.

RED HOTS

- Following Sat's loss at Mil the Reds were eliminated from **Central Division** contention...their elimination number in the **Wild Card** is **4**.
- The minor league regular seasons end **Sunday** (Class AA) and **9/28** (Class AAA)...the Class A season ended **yesterday**.
- Beginning 7/29, the Reds have lost to trade or injury starting pitchers **RHP Luis Castillo** (to the Mariners), **RHP Tyler Mahle** (to the Twins), **RHP Robert Dugger** (right shoulder pain), **RHP Hunter Greene** (right shoulder strain), **RHP Graham Ashcraft** (right biceps soreness) and **RHP T.J. Zeuch** (back soreness).
- The Reds went **16-22-7** in their first **45 series** (7-11-4 home, 9-11-3 road)...**swept 2 series** (2g at Cle, 5/17-5/19 & 3g vs TB, 7/8-7/10) and were **swept 11 times** (last, 4g at Phi, 8/22-8/25).
- In the fifth inning on **8/29 vs StL**, for the first time in franchise history **3 rookies** homered in the same inning (**TJ Friedl, Stuart Fairchild, Chuckie Robinson**)...@EliasSports.

RED HOTS

- Tonight is making his 18th start of the season...will be his eighth career start and third of the season vs the Pirates.
- Went 1-10, 6.31 in his first 13 starts and 3-0, 3.91 in his last 4 starts.
- In 10 starts between wins on 6/13 at Ari and 8/21 at Pit went 0-8, 6.02...the 8-game losing streak is a career high.
- On 3/16 was acquired by the Reds from the Royals, with cash, for LHP Amir Garrett....did not appear in a 2022 spring training game for either team.
- Missed the last 18 games of the 2021 season while on the 10-day injured list with a left shoulder impingement.
- Began this season on the Reds' 10-day injured list with a left shoulder strain...made his Reds debut on 6/3 vs Wsh.
- Following a rehab appearance on 4/13 for Class AA Chattanooga vs Birmingham, felt soreness in his left shoulder and didn't pitch again until 5/10.
- From 5/10-5/27 made 4 more rehab apps, all for Class AAA Louisville (1-2, 3.38, 16ip, 15h, 7r, 6er, 1bb, 20k, 3hr, 1.00whip, .234baa).

RED HOTS

- Last name is pronounced SESS-uh.
- In tomorrow's day game will make his sixth start of the season, the 25th start of his career and his 197th Major League appearance...will be his fourth appearance of the season and first career start vs the Pirates.
- In Thu's 4-3 win at Cubs, didn't allow a hit until Nico Hoerner led off the fifth inning with a triple...recorded the 300th strikeout of his career (Alfonso Rivas).
- On 8/22 at Phi took the spot in the rotation vacated by RHP T.J. Zeuch (Zoyk), who since rejoined the rotation before going on the 15-day injured list.
- Beginning 7/29, the Reds have lost to trade or injury starting pitchers RHP Luis Castillo (to the Mariners), RHP Tyler Mahle (to the Twins), RHP Robert Dugger (right shoulder pain), RHP Hunter Greene (right shoulder strain), RHP Graham Ashcraft (right biceps soreness) and RHP T.J. Zeuch (back soreness).
- This season posted ERAs of 5.09 in his 5 starts and 4.91 in his 36 relief apps.
- In his Major League career is 3-12, 4.95 in 24 starts and 12-4, 3.82 with 4 saves in 172 relief apps.
- This season's starts are Cessa's first since 2018, when he made 5 starts and 11 relief apps for the Yankees.
