BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles and Red Sox meet for a rubber game today after Baltimore fell, 17-1, on Saturday...Following this three-game set with Boston, Baltimore welcomes Houston to Camden Yards for a three-gamer from Tuesday-Thursday next week.

👉 The O's are 3-1 in rubber games this season after going 9-15 (.375) last year.

👉 The Birds surrendered 17 runs for the first time since May 23, 2025 at Boston (19 R) and for the first time at home since April 20, 2025 vs. Cincinnati (24 R)...The 16-run margin of defeat was the team's largest since April 20, 2025 vs. Cincinnati (24-2) and the largest in the major leagues this season.

👉 **Coby Mayo** doubled and has recorded an extra-base hit in a career-high-tying four straight games (also 7/25-28/25).

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles reinstated right-handed pitcher **Ryan Helsley** from the Bereavement/Family Medical Emergency List today and designated right-hander **Albert Suárez** for assignment.

👉 Helsley missed the previous three games...He's tied for second in the AL and fifth in MLB with six saves this season.

SEEING RED: In 43 career games against the Red Sox, **Gunnar Henderson** is slashing .252/.367/.547 (40-for-159) with 11 doubles, three triples, 10 home runs, 32 runs, 25 RBI, 27 walks, and four steals.

👉 He is one of eight active players with a career OPS above .900 (min. 175 PA) against Boston, along with CHC's Alex Bregman (1.013), PIT's Brandon Lowe (.998), LAD's Teoscar Hernández (.985), STL's Ramón Urías (.935), LAA's Mike Trout (.930), TB's Yandy Díaz (.918), and TOR's George Springer (.907).

SPECIAL OPS: The Orioles rank fourth in the AL with a .725 team OPS behind the Astros (.782), Yankees (.765), and Tigers (.737)...The club's .400 slugging percentage is also fourth behind the same three teams.

👉 **Taylor Ward** paces the club with a .902 OPS, which ranks eighth in the AL, while **Adley Rutschman** has posted a 1.064 OPS in 13 games (52 PA) this season.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** has reached safely in 25 of the last 26 games since March 28 while slashing .333/.444/.490 (34-for-102) with 13 doubles, one homer, 14 runs scored, 11 RBI, 20 walks, one hit by pitch, and one stolen base during that time...He had his 16-game on-base streak, tied for the third longest of his career, snapped on April 15.

👉 His 13 doubles lead the majors ahead of ATL's Matt Olson and TOR's Ernie Clement (both 12).

👉 Ward has faced 551 total pitches this season, fourth most in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (579), ATH's Nick Kurtz (559), and ATL's Matt Olson (553)...Teammate **Gunnar Henderson** ranks fifth with 550.

👉 He's reached base safely 55 times (34 H, 20 BB, 1 HBP), tied for second most in the majors with WSH's James Wood, behind HOU's Yordan Alvarez (58 TOB).

👉 Ward has reached base at least three times in a career-high-tying three consecutive games (also 6/28-7/1/25).

TIGHT SQUEEZE: The Orioles have played 20 games decided by three runs or less, second in the majors behind the Mariners (21)...The Birds are 9-11 (.450) in those games...The Orioles have also played 15 games decided by two runs or fewer, tied with the Cardinals, Guardians, Mariners, and Yankees for the most in MLB, while going 9-6 (.600) in those affairs.

PEN PALS: The Orioles bullpen ranks fourth in the AL with a 3.99 ERA behind the Rangers (2.95), Mariners (3.30), and Red Sox (3.62) despite allowing 14 runs (10 ER) yesterday.

👉 **Rico Garcia** has posted a 0.75 ERA (1 ER/12.0 IP) with 13 strikeouts across 12 appearances...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's Michael Massey on April 21.

👉 The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

👉 Overall, the team's 15.2 percent inherited runners scored rate (5 IRS/33 IR) is second in MLB behind the Rockies (13.6%; 6 IRS/44 IR).

SHIPPING DOWN TO BALTIMORE: The Orioles and Red Sox are meeting for the first of two series at Camden Yards this season...Boston returns to Baltimore for a four-game set from September 3-6, while the Birds have two, three-game series at Fenway Park from June 2-4 and July 20-22.

👉 MASN broadcaster **Melanie Newman** worked with Boston's Single-A affiliate, the Salem Red Sox, calling games as part of the first all-female booth in professional baseball along with Suzie Cool.

👉 Red Sox Bullpen Coach **Chris Holt** spent five seasons in Baltimore's organization, serving as Director of Pitching (2020-24) and Major League Pitching Coach (2021-23).

April 26, 1959	The Orioles score twice in the ninth inning of the first game and one run in the ninth of the nightcap to sweep their first doubleheader from the Yankees in New York. In doing so, the Orioles move to 9-5, the first time in the club's first five seasons that it is more than two games over .500.
April 26, 1974	Andy Etchebarren's sacrifice fly in the 15 th inning gives the Orioles a 6-5 walk-off win over the Athletics.

QUICK HITS: Bradish is scheduled to make his sixth start of the season and 73rd of his career in the series finale today vs. Boston...He made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts...Acquired from Los Angeles-AL along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peek in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor into the decision of a 7-5 Orioles win in his last start on April 20 at Kansas City, despite allowing one run on a season-high 10 hits (1 HR) and three walks in 5.1 innings with seven strikeouts...Marked the second time in his career yielding at least 10 hits (also: 6/18/22 vs. TB, 11)...Threw a season-high 104 pitches, 63 strikes.

- ⌚ Became the first pitcher in the majors to allow 10+ hits and one run or fewer in a start since Philadelphia's Ranger Suárez on August 29, 2025 vs. Atlanta (10 H, 1 R).
- ⌚ Snapped a four-start streak of allowing three or more runs from March 28 to April 15, the longest such stretch of his career.

BOSTON COMMON: Bradish is scheduled to make his 10th career start opposite Boston today, going 1-5 with a 6.92 ERA (30 ER/39.0 IP)...In each of his last three outings against the Red Sox, however, he's allowed two runs or fewer, tallying two quality starts.

- ⌚ Six of Bradish's nine starts vs. Boston have come at Camden Yards, where he's 0-5 with a 4.66 ERA (15 ER/29.0 IP)...Is 5-12 with a 5.33 ERA (89 ER/150.1 IP) over 31 career starts against the AL East.
- ⌚ Holds a 3.80 ERA (112 ER/265.1 IP) in 51 career starts vs. the American League compared to his 2.84 ERA (37 ER/117.1 IP) in 21 starts against the National League.

DAY 'N' NITE: Bradish is set to make his fifth daytime start this season, which would be tied for the most in the majors entering today with New York-NL's Freddy Peralta, teammate **Trevor Rogers**, and Detroit's **Tarik Skubal**...His 2.92 ERA (49 ER/151.0 IP) over 29 daytime starts since debuting in 2022 is the eighth-lowest mark in MLB (min. 150.0 IP) and nearly a full run lower than his 3.88 ERA (100 ER/231.2 IP) over 43 career nighttime starts.

UNDER PRESSURE: Bradish is averaging 15.84 baserunners per 9.0 innings, which is the 10th-highest mark in the majors (min. 5 GS) behind leader BOS' **Brayan Bello** (20.45)...Batters are 0-for-5 (.000) against him with the bases loaded this season and 9-for-29 (.310) with runners in scoring position...However, Bradish is holding hitters to a 1-for-11 mark (.091) with runners in scoring position and two outs.

PLATOON: Bradish held lefties to a .118 average (2-for-17) over his first two starts this season with four walks to seven strikeouts, but opponents have gone 14-for-48 (.292) since then with five extra-base hits (3 2B, 3B, HR)...Still, his .246 opponent average (16-for-65) vs. lefties this season is 171 points lower than his .417 (15-for-36) mark against right-handed batters, whom he allowed six hits to in his last start on April 20 at KC... Was only the seventh time he's allowed six or more hits in a start and first since doing so six times during his rookie season in 2022 (last: 9/6/22 vs. TOR, 6).

WHIFFIN': Through five starts this season, Bradish has recorded 28 strikeouts and a 10.08 K/9...In 2025, he held a 13.22 K/9 over six starts and struck out eight or more batters in three straight starts from 9/15-28, becoming the first Baltimore hurler to do so since **Dylan Bundy's** four-game run from August 7-29, 2017.

- ⌚ Has recorded 12 strikeouts with his sinker this season, which opponents are batting .235 (8-for-34) against.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: In 2023, finished fourth in AL Cy Young voting, the first Oriole to receive a Cy Young vote since **Zack Britton** in 2016...Went 12-7 with a 2.83 ERA (53 ER/168.2 IP), 168 strikeouts, and a 1.04 WHIP in 30 starts (18 QS)...Became the first qualified O's pitcher with a sub-3.00 ERA since **Mike Mussina** posted a 2.54 ERA (68 ER/241.0 IP) in 1992.

- ⌚ Earned his first career win on May 10, 2022 at St. Louis after pitching 7.0 innings, allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR) with a career-high 11 strikeouts...Became the first Oriole to pitch 7.0 innings with zero walks and 11 strikeouts since **John Means** threw a no-hitter on May 5, 2021 at Seattle.
