**TARPS OFF:** The St. Louis Cardinals continue their six-game/seven-day homestand with the second game of a three-game series with the division rival Pittsburgh Pirates tonight at Busch Stadium ... St. Louis took two-of-three from its cross-state rival Kansas City Royals during "Rivalry Weekend" ... Including the initial four-game sweep of Pittsburgh (April 27-30), St. Louis is 14-6 since April 27 (tied for MLB's 4th-best record) and has 28+ wins through the first 47 games of a season for the first time since both the 2013 and 2015 Redbirds started 31-16 and won NL Central Division Championships.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis enters play today in 2nd place in the NL Central, one half game behind first place Milwaukee (28-18) and pct. points ahead of third place Chicago (29-20) ... A win tonight would move the Cardinals to 10 games above .500 for the first time since the end of the 2022 season when they won the NL Central at 93-69 (+14.0).

**CENTRAL CASTING:** The Cardinals are 6-1 vs. the NL Central in 2026, tying Tampa Bay (12-2) for MLB's best intradivision win percentage (.857) ... St. Louis ends the month of May with 12 straight vs. divisional opponents (1-0 vs. Pittsburgh; 3 at Cincinnati; 3 at Milwaukee; & 3 vs. Chicago).

**LIGHT UP THE NIGHT IN DOWNTOWN ST. LOUIS:** The Cardinals have won 12 of their last 13 night games and now sport a Major League-best .731 win pct. in night games (19-7 record). **EXTRA CREDIT:** St. Louis has won seven of its first eight extra inning games for the 2nd time in franchise history ... The 1974 Redbirds started 7-1 in extras before losing their 9th extra-inning game (finished 13-4 in extras).

**WALKING THE PLANK:** The Cardinals have won six straight over Pittsburgh (Aug. 28, 2025-present), their longest over the Buccos since a six-game win streak from May 20-June 14, 2022 ... The last time St. Louis won seven straight over the Pirates was a nine-game win streak from Sept. 18, 2020-May 19, 2021.

**DIRTY MIKE AND THE BOYS:** Michael McGreevy is 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (24.0 IP) over his last four starts, with both runs coming on solo homers ... Overall this season, McGreevy's 0.88 WHIP ranks 3rd among Major League qualifiers, trailing only Paul Skenes (0.71) and Cam Schlitler (0.78).

**CARDIAC CARDS:** The Cardinals lead Major League Baseball in last at-bat wins (9) and extra inning victories (7), share the MLB lead in one-run wins (10), while ranking 2nd in walk-off wins (5) and 3rd in comeback victories (14) ... In "high leverage" situations per FanGraphs, the Cardinals share the MLB lead in RBI (65) ... 19 of the 28 Cardinals wins have been by two runs or fewer, most in MLB.

**HAPPY ANNIVERSARIES:** A pair of Cardinals celebrating MLB debuts anniversaries today and tomorrow include INF Nolan Gorman (May 20, 2022 at Pittsburgh) and LHP Matthew Liberatore (May 21, 2022 at Pittsburgh) ... Notable tandems of top prospects and draft picks called up during the same time period in recent Cardinals history include Adam Kennedy (#4; 1st Rd. of 1999; Aug. 21, 1999 at Mets debut) & Rick Ankiel (#1; 2nd Rd. of 1999; Aug. 23, 1999 at Expos debut) and Brian Jordan (#4; 1st rd. 1988; April 8, 1992 vs. Mets debut) & Donovan Osborne (#1; 1st Rd. 1990; April 9, 1992 vs. Mets debut) - Baseball America

**JJ Wetherholt** graduated from Mars Area (Pa.) High School and resides in Gibsonia, Pa., but was born in Baltimore, Md., and grew up a fan of the Baltimore Ravens...played college baseball at West Virginia University (2022-24).

**Riley O'Brien's** great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58)...his grandfather **Johnny O'Brien**, played part of four seasons with the Pirates (1953, 1955-57).

**Yohel Pozo** made his Cardinals debut on April 7, 2025 at Pittsburgh in front of approximately 15 family members based in Harrisburg, Pa.

**Evan Sisk** was selected by St. Louis in the 16th round of the 2018 MLB Draft and pitched in the Cardinals minor league system from 2018-21 before St. Louis traded him along with **John Gant** to Minnesota in exchange for **J.A. Happ** and cash considerations on July 30, 2021.

**Brant Brown** played in 130 games for the Pirates in 1999 before being traded to the Marlins for OF **Bruce Aven** (Dec. 13, 1999)...traded by the Cubs to Pittsburgh for RHP **Jon Lieber** (Dec. 14, 1998).

**Nathan Church** (2018) and **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

**Justin Bruhl** pitched in seven games for the Pirates in 2024.

**Lars Nootbaar** smacked his first career home run (Aug. 12, 2021 at PNC Park). **Alec Burleson** tallied his first career hit (Sept. 11, 2022 at PNC Park).

**Andre Pallante** (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC) and Special Asst. to the President of Baseball Ops. **Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004 at PNC) made their MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

Pirates Dir. of Hitting Development **Tim McKeithan's** grandfather, **Jerry McKeithan Sr.**, played in the St. Louis minor league system, and his brother, **Aaron McKeithan**, was selected by the Cardinals in the 16th round of the 2021 MLB Draft.

2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame Inductee **Bill Sherdel** made his MLB debut with St. Louis on April 22, 1918 vs. Pittsburgh.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956...played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60).

**Marcell Ozuna** played in 278 games for St. Louis from 2018-19 after the Cardinals acquired him in a trade with the Marlins on Dec. 14, 2017 in exchange for **Sandy Alcantara**, **Zac Gallen**, **Magneuris Sierra** and **Daniel Castano**.

Pirates Color Analyst **Neil Walker** collected his first career hit vs. St. Louis on Sept. 6, 2009.

Pittsburgh Special Advisor of Pitching Development **Dewey Robinson** coached at the University of Missouri from 1984-86...received his bachelor degree in finance from SIU Carbondale and was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2023.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in Pittsburgh (2007-08).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** was the general manager of the Pirates from 1992-93.

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Manager **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Senior Director, Communications & Content **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a PR Specialist in the Cardinals Comm. dept.(2010-11).

## TONIGHT'S STARTER:

- The 25-year-old makes his 10th start of the 2026 season tonight, 29th career start (31st career game).
- Since his Major League debut July 31, 2024, ranks 13th in MLB in winning percentage (.700, 14-6).
- The Cardinals are 19-9 (.679 win pct.) in his 28 career games started**, losing consecutive games that he has started just twice. St. Louis is 6-3 (.667) in his games started this season.
- Has yet to issue more than three walks in any of his first 28 career starts, one shy of the longest streak to begin a career by a Cardinals pitcher, behind only **Paul "Daffy" Dean** (29 from 1934-35).
- Has 12 wins through his first 28 career starts, the most by a Cardinal since **Dakota Hudson** had 15 through his first 28 career starts in 2019.
- Has allowed 1 run or fewer with at least 6.0 IP in each of his last four starts, the longest such streak by a Cardinals pitcher since **Adam Wainwright** had four straight starts from Sept. 2-18, 2019; is the first Cardinals pitcher with four straight starts of 6.0+ IP, 1 run or fewer and 5 hits or fewer allowed since **Carlos Martinez** had four straight from April 15-May 2, 2018.
- Has pitched 6.0+ innings in 18 of 28 career starts, including his last 4 (April 26-present), going 11-1 with a 1.99 ERA (25 ER/113.0 IP).
- Allowed two runs or fewer in seven of his nine starts this season.
- Ranks 3rd in MLB with a 7.89 baserunners/9 IP rate despite a 6.31 strikeouts/9 IP rate that ranks as the 7th lowest among qualifiers; would be the first pitcher in AL/NL history since KC's **Roger Nelson** (7.89 BR/9 IP & 6.23 SO/9 IP) in 1972 to have a BR/9 IP rate of 8.00 or lower along with a SO/9 IP rate of 7.00 or lower, and the 16th pitcher to do so in AL/NL history.
- Since joining the rotation June 8, 2025, St. Louis has won 16 of his starts - tied with **Matthew Liberatore** for the most among all STL starters.
- Has made 15 career appearances (13 starts) at Busch Stadium where he is 6-3 with a 3.58 ERA (83.0 IP). Boasts a 1.17 ERA (23.0 IP) through four starts at home this season, a mark that is the 8th lowest in MLB (4th in NL) among pitchers with at least 20.0 home IP, to go with a .156 opp. batting average (12-77) that ranks 5th (2nd in NL behind **Shohei Ohtani** - .143).

**LAST TIME OUT (Thursday, May 14 at Athletics at Sutter Health Park):** ND, W, 5-4: 6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR; 74 pitches

- Made his fourth straight start of at least 6.0 innings and is tied with **Dustin May** for the longest such streak on the team this season.
- Retired 12 of the final 13 hitters he faced.
- Allowed his only run via a leadoff HR to **Nick Kurtz** on his second pitch of the game.

## 2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

**FAITH IN FIELDERS:** Has the NL's 6th-lowest percent (19.9) of Swing & Miss; Leads the NL among qualifiers with a .203 BABIP, and his difference in Opp. BA (.189) vs. xBA (.288) is the largest among all MLB starting pitchers (-.099).

**NESTING:** In each of his four home starts this season, has worked at least 5.0 innings with 2-or-fewer runs allowed to become the first Cardinals hurler to reach those marks in their first four home starts of a season since **Jack Flaherty** began his 2021 campaign with five straight.

**BE HAPPY IT HAPPENED:** Had a 14.0 scoreless innings streak that covered portions of three starts from April 26-May 8 snapped on a leadoff HR by **Nick Kurtz** that was his only run allowed during a 6.0-inning start 5/14 at ATH during a 5-4 St. Louis victory.

**ONE-HIT WONDER:** Struck out a career-high nine batters at SD (5/8) over 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball at Petco Park in a 6-0 Cardinals win.

**DODGE BALL:** Blanked the Dodgers on 3 hits over 6.0 IP in a 3-2 win on May 2 as the Cardinals turned 4 double plays behind him.

**THROW IT BACK:** Didn't hook any keepers in 5-3 loss at Miami on April 20, allowing a season-high 4 runs over his 5.2 IP; the loss snapped the Cardinals season-high 5-game win streak.

**CURLY W:** Limited Washington to just 4 baserunners over his 6.0 IP in 6-1 win at Nationals Park on April 8, retiring his final 11 batters faced in order. Walked none and struck out one to earn his 1st win of the season.

**"NO" NEWS IS GOOD NEWS:** Retired the first nine batters en route to 6.0 no-hit innings in his first start of the season vs. TB (3/28) in a no decision the Cardinals won in 10 innings (6-5).

**FIRST IMPRESSIONS:** Became the first Cardinal to throw 6.0+ no-hit innings in a completed start since **Erick Fedde** on April 9, 2025 at Pittsburgh (6.0 IP). Since 1961, the Cardinals record for the longest hitless inning streak as a starter (excluding any possible intervening relief appearances) to begin a season is 8.0 IP by **Daniel Ponce de Leon** - July 23, 2018 (7.0 IP) and Aug. 21, 2018 (1.0 IP) - *Elias*

**RARE BIRD:** In his season debut on 3/28 vs. TB, became the 2nd pitcher in team history with a hitless start within his first 2 starts (**Jack Flaherty** 4/1/23 vs. TOR) and the 14th time in MLB a pitcher has in a start of 6.0+ IP. **Emerson Hancock** (SEA) had 6.0 no-hit innings vs. CLE the next day.

**SPRING FLING:** Went 4-0 with a 2.45 ERA in 5 Spring Training starts, striking out 16 to just 2 walks but did allow a team-high 6 HRs. Led MLB with his 4 Spring Training wins and ranked in top 10 in ERA (2.45), Opp. BA (.229) and WHIP (0.98).

## McGreevy vs. PITTSBURGH:

- Making his second career start and third appearance vs. the Pirates.
- Fanned a season-high and then-career-high seven batters in his only career start against Pittsburgh on 8/25/25 at home in a 7-6 St. Louis win. Surpassed his single-game strikeout total with nine on 5/8 at SD.
- Made first career relief appearance vs. PIT on 9/18/24 at Busch Stadium and threw 3.0 scoreless innings for the win in his second career game. Became the first Cardinals pitcher to earn a win as a starter and then as a reliever in his first two MLB appearances.
- Makes his first start against an N.L. Central opponent this season. Is 4-1 with a 3.13 ERA (13 ER/37.1 IP) in seven career appearances (6 starts) vs. N.L. Central opponents, with the Cardinals going 6-1 in those starts.
