METSELLANEOUS: The Mets fell to the Pirates, 9-7, last night...The team has dropped three-in-a-row...The Mets continue a six-game road trip (0-2) featuring three games against the Pirates (0-2), before heading to the Queen City to face the Reds for three games.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY: Happy birthday to Robert Gsellman who celebrates his 28th birthday today.

WALK-STAR: Taijuan Walker is set to make his first start after the All-Star Break... Walker earned his first career All-Star nod this season...He tossed 1.0 innings in the game and allowed a solo home run and struck out one.

LEAD-WALKER: Walker's 2.50 ERA (25 earned runs/90.0 innings) ranks tenth in the majors and eighth in the National League and his 156 ERA+ ranks ninth in the NL...He is allowing just a .290 slugging against ranking seventh in the majors... Walker's 0.60 HR/9 ranks sixth in the majors...His 3.15 FIP (Fielding Independent Pitching) ranks 10th in the majors.

SWEET SIXTEEN: Walker has a 2.50 ERA through 16 starts this season...It is the first time in his career he's had a 16-start span with an ERA under 3.00 in one season...His 25.9% strikeout percentage, .196 BAA, .700 W-L%, 1.03 WHIP and .559 OPS against are all his best marks in a single-season 16-start span as well... The Mets record of 13-3 in Walker's appearances this season is a career best through 16 games.

JULY! JULY! JULY!: The Mets collected 11 hits last night...As a team, New York is batting .250/.342/.421 with a .762 OPS in 13 games this month...This is their highest batting average, OBP and SLG in any month this season...The Mets hit .222/.297/.379 in 30 games in June.

ESQUIRE DAVIS: J.D. Davis went 3-4 with two runs, two home runs and four RBI in his first start since returning from the IL yesterday...He is batting .413 (19-46) with seven runs, three doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI, four walks and a 1.230 OBP in 16 games this year.

RE-PETE: Congratulations to Pete Alonso who was crowned the 2021 Home Run Derby Champion on Monday...Alonso defeated Trey Mancini to earn his second Derby title...He is the only Met to win the competition twice and is the lone player in team history to win the derby outright...He is the second player in franchise history to win the Derby, joining Darryl Strawberry, who shared the victory with Wally Joyner in 1986.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: The Mets have been in first place since Saturday, May 8, a streak of 71 days...This is their longest run atop the East in the last 14 seasons... The 2007 Mets (135 days in a row) were the last iteration of the club to be in first longer than 71 days in a row, per Elias...The team has been in first place for 87 days overall this season, the most of any team in 2021.

ACT II: The Mets finished the first-half at 47-40...It is the first time the team was in first place at the All-Star break since 2007, when they were 48-39...The Mets' 47 wins were the most in the first-half since 2016, when they also had 47 wins... This is the sixth time in Mets history that they've are in first place coming out of the All-Star break...Also 1984, 1986, 1988, 2006 and 2007...Courtesy of Sports Radar.

I DON'T WANNA BE A PIRATE: The Mets have played seven or more consecutive games against the same opponent within a season only once before in franchise history, when they played seven straight vs. the Cubs from August 31 to September 3, 1967...Courtesy of Elias...The Mets have never ended the first half and opened the second half against the same opponent...The last time it happened in the majors was the Giants and A's in 2018.

C IS FOR COOKIE: Carlos Carrasco is currently on a rehab assignment with the Brooklyn Cyclones...He tossed 2.0 scoreless innings and allowed only a hit, while striking out two on Thursday...Carrasco is on the 60-Day IL with a right hamstring injury.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Mets are 19-28 with a 4.51 ERA (194 earned runs/387.1 innings) with 132 walks and 416 strikeouts on the road this year...This compares to a 28-14 record with a 2.43 ERA (97 earned runs/359.0 innings) with 128 walks and 399 strikeouts at home...The team's 2.43 ERA at home is the best in the majors and their .667 winning percentage is fourth-best.

ROAD SHOW: Pete Alonso is batting .277/.345/.585 with 30 runs, seven doubles, 14 home runs, 36 RBI and 14 walks on the road this year...His 14 road home runs rank tied for third in the major leagues behind Shohei Ohtani and Jesus Aguilar who each have 15...This compares to a .218/.321/.336 slash line with three home runs at home...Dominic Smith is slashing .269/.335/.442 with 19 runs, nine doubles, six homers, 16 RBI and 14 walks away from Citi Field...This compares to a .223/.295/.315 slash line with six extra-base hits at home.

METS-PIRATES NOTES: The Mets have dropped three straight to the Pirates for the first time since they lost nine in a row from June 29, 2014 - June 7, 2016.

JEFF McHITS: Jeff McNeil has safely reached base in each of his last eight games...He is batting .342 (13-38) with six runs, a double, five RBI and five walks in 13 games this month.

CONNECT FOUR: The Mets are 38-8 when scoring four or more runs this season...The team is 9-34 when scoring three or fewer runs...The Mets are 36-12 when scoring first this season...The team's .750 winning percentage is the third-best record in the major leagues when scoring first this season.

IN A PINCH: The Mets pinch-hitters are batting .254/.338/.418 with eight doubles, four home runs, 24 RBI and 13 walks...Their .254 batting average is the fifth-best in the majors and the best in the NL...Their .756 pinch-hit OPS is also the best in the NL.

REPLACE-METS: Entering today, the Mets have used 51 players through 88 games this season...The franchise record for most players used in a season is 56 by the 2018 Mets...The Mets have had 15 different pitchers start a game this season...That is the most in the majors...The Mets used 10 starters in 2020...The last time the Mets used 15 or more starters in a season was in 1979 when they also used 15...The franchise record is 20 starters used in 1967.

THREW ME FOR A LOUP: Aaron Loup has allowed one run in his last 17 appearances...He is 2-0 with a 0.53 ERA (one earned run/17.0 innings) in that span with four walks and 21 strikeouts...Overall, he is 3-0 with a 1.59 ERA (five earned runs/28.1 innings) with 22 hits, six walks and 34 strikeouts...He has held left-handed hitters to a .154 (6-39) batting average this season.

QUALITY EATS: The Mets have made 34 quality starts this season...The Mets rotation owns a 2.95 ERA (144 earned runs/439.1 innings) this season, the best mark in the major leagues...deGrom leads the major leagues with a 1.08 ERA, Taijuan Walker is ninth with a 2.50 ERA, while Marcus Stroman is 13th in the majors with a 2.78 mark.

WE FOUND NIMMO: Brandon Nimmo is 13-43 (.302) with 10 runs, four doubles, one home run, eight walks and six RBI in 12 games since returning from the 10-Day IL...He is batting .312 (34-109) with 17 runs, nine doubles, two home runs, 14 RBI, 20 walks and an .873 OPS in 34 games this year.

MOVING ON UP: Pete Alonso is now 21st on the Mets all-time home run list with 86 blasts...Gary Carter is 20th with 89 home runs...Michael Conforto is now in sole possession of the 10th place, surpassing Edgardo Alfonzo on the Mets all-time home run list with 121...Kevin McReynolds is next with 122 homers.

THIS DAY IN METS HISTORY: On this day in 2008, Billy Joel played "The Last Play at Shea"...It was the last concert performed at the Mets former home...It was one of two final concerts that Joel performed at the stadium...He was joined by special guests Garth Brooks, Steven Tyler, Roger Daltrey and Tony Bennett...Paul McCartney joined Joel in the encore...For cool photos and interactive history information on the Mets, please visit the Mets Virtual Vault at metsheritage.com.

HONORING HIS LEGACY: The New York Mets will wear a "41" Tom Seaver tribute patch on the right sleeve of their home and road uniforms during the 2021 season...Seaver passed away on August 31, 2020 at age 75...Seaver won 311 games, had a 2.86 ERA and struck out 3,640 batters over a 20-year major league career that spanned from 1967-1986, earning 12 All-Star selections in the process...He won three Cy Young Awards with the team in 1969, 1973 and 1975 as well as the NL Rookie of the Year Award in 1967.

WALKER NEWS & NOTES

LAST OUTING: In his last start, Walker faced the Pirates in his home ballpark, Citi Field...Walker pitched 5.0 innings leading the Amazins to a 13-4 victory over the Pirates...He surrendered four hits, and allowed two runs, earned on 86 pitches thrown...He struck out two batters and walked three in the outing...This Mets win continues their undefeated record at home this season when Walker takes the bump.

WALKER THE PURPLE CARPET: Walker made his first career All-Star roster...He appeared in the Midsummer Classic at Coors Field, tossing one inning...He allowed a solo homer to Mike Zunino and struck out one...Walker was chosen as a replacement for teammate Jacob deGrom.

LEAD-WALKER: Walker's 2.50 ERA (25 earned runs/90.0 innings) ranks ninth in the majors and eighth in the National League and his 156 ERA+ ranks ninth in the NL... He is allowing just a .290 slugging, ranking fifth in the majors...Walker's 0.60 HR/9 ranks sixth in the majors...His 3.16 FIP (Fielding Independent Pitching) ranks 10th in the majors.

SWEET SIXTEEN: Walker has a 2.50 ERA through 16 starts this season...It is the first time in his career he's had a 16-start span with an ERA under 3.00 in one season...His 25.9% strikeout percentage, .196 BAA, .700 W-L%, 1.03 WHIP and .559 OPS against are all his best marks in a single-season 16-start span as well...The Mets record of 13-3 in Walker's appearances this season is a career best through 16 games.

VS. PIRATES: Before his previous start, Walker had faced the Buccos only once in his career...He owns a career 4.09 ERA (five earned runs/11.0 innings) vs. the Pirates and has only faced them at his home ballpark...This start will be his first career outing at PNC Park.

FAST AND FURIOUS: The fastball is Walker's most utilized pitch in his arsenal this season...He is throwing the four seamer about 31% of the time, averaging at 94.3 MPH... Opponents are batting a combined .169, and slugging .288 against Walker's heater...With his fastball, he has produced 47 punch outs over the course of the 2021 season...Walker is generating a 27.7% whiff rate and a 27.6% put away rate on the four seamer, both of which are the highest for any pitches in Walker's repertoire.

METS RECORDBOOKS: Walker has a 2.50 ERA (25 earned runs/90.0 innings) through his first 16 starts as a Met...That is sixth-lowest ERA in Mets history through 16 starts with the team...His 1.03 WHIP is the third lowest behind only Pedro Martinez (0.82) and Matt Harvey (1.01) through 16 starts with the Amazins...He is limiting his foes to a .196 average...Pedro Martinez (.177) Matt Harvey (.182) and are the only pitchers with a better BAA through 16 starts with New York...His .559 OPS against is the fourth lowest through 16 starts with the Mets.

LEFT HANDS FREE: Walker is holding left handed batters to a .164 BAA (23-140), which ranks seventh in the majors (min. 100 LHB faced) this season...He has only surrendered two homers in those 140 at bats...Over the course of his career Walker owns a .231 (290-1283) BAA against lefties.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Amazins are 5-3 in Walker's outings on the road...Walker has a 3-3 record and owns a 3.18 ERA (16 earned runs/43.2 innings) on the road in 2021...Opponents have hit .213 (35-164) off Walker on the road...In his last outing Walker led the Amazins to a 7-3 win vs. their crosstown rivals in the Bronx.
