THE TWINS: Have gone 0-3 to begin their seven-game, eight-day homestand, losing three-straight games to the Tigers from Thursday-Saturday...today, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the four-game series finale against Detroit...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then host the Athletics for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.

TWINS FIGHT BACK, FALL SHORT: The Twins lost to the Tigers last night at Target Field by a score of 8-5...Zebby Matthews was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched...lwins pitchers combined to walk nine batters, tied for their second-most this season...the offense recorded eight hits, two apiece from Austin Martin and Luke Keaschall...Brooks Lee drove in three runs and recorded his first triple of the season...Minnesota struck out 14 times, their most since August 2 at Cleveland (15).

GENESIS - THAT'S ALL: The Twins have selected the contract of left-handed pitcher Génesis Cabrera from Triple-A St. Paul...Cabrera, who was signed by Minnesota to a minor league contract on August 12, recently appeared in one game for the Saints on August 14, allowing one run on two hits in 1.0 inning pitched, with one walk and one strikeout...prior to joining Minnesota's organization, the 28-year-old spent 2025 with three different organizations in the Mets, the Cubs and the Pirates, combining to go 0-0, 5.79 ERA (28.0 IP, 18 ER), with seven walks and 22 strikeouts in 24 games...the Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native has pitched in parts of seven major league seasons with the Cardinals (2019-23), Blue Jays (2023-24), Mets (2025), Cubs (2025) and Pirates (2025), going 17-14, 4.06 ERA (303.2 IP, 137 ER), with 143 walks, 290 strikeouts and five saves in 296 games (2 starts).

⌘ To make room for Cabrera on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Travis Adams to St. Paul.

⌘ To make room on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred outfielder Alan Roden (left thumb sprain) to the 60-day Injured List.

TIGER KING FINALE: The Twins and Tigers are playing for the final time this season...Twins are 4-8 against Detroit in 2025, going 1-5 at Target Field and 3-3 at Comerica Park...after today, Detroit will be the only team in the AL Central the Twins will be finished playing in 2025.

LUUUUUUUUUUUKE!!: In 18 games to start his career, Luke Keaschall has reached base safely 32 times, with 22 hits, eight walks and two hit-by-pitch (73 plate appearances)...below is a list of Twins with the most times on base through the first 18 games of their career:

BREAKING BROOMS: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the fifth time this season...the other four were in three games at St. Louis (March 27-30), three games at Atlanta (April 18-20), three games at Houston (June 13-15) and three games vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22).

⌘ Other than those four sweeps, the Twins have entered a finale down 0-2 and avoided a sweep six times this season: April 13 vs. Detroit, June 8 vs. Toronto, June 19 at Cincinnati, July 20 at Colorado, August 3 at Cleveland and August 13 at New York-AL.

⌘ Twins are looking to avoid being swept in a four-game series by an opponent for the first time since April 23-26, 2018 at New York-AL.

⌘ Last time they were swept in four games at home came June 16-18, 2017 vs. Cleveland.

⌘ Last time they were swept in four games by the Tigers was May 27-29, 1983 at Tiger Stadium.

TWINS HALL OF F-EH?-M DAY: In a special pregame ceremony today, Corey Koskie will be inducted as the 41st member of the Twins Hall of Fame...Koskie was a key part of the Twins' back-to-back-to-back AL Central Division championship clubs from 2002-04, one of just six players in the Minnesota era with at least 100 RBI and 100 runs scored in the same season (103 RBI and 100 runs in 2001), and Minnesota's all-time leader for career batting average (.280) and fielding percentage (.966) by a third baseman (minimum 425 games)...below are Koskie's all-time (since 1961) ranks among Twins third basemen in a few categories:

ADDITIONALLY: Koskie posted a 23.2 fWAR during his time in Minnesota, the 12th-best in club history, trailing Brian Dozier (23.8) and ahead of Torii Hunter (22.6).

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Ryan Gallagher and Low-A Fort Myers catcher Enrique Jiménez as the Twins minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week.

⌘ Gallagher, 22, made the start on Friday at Springfield, allowing two unearned runs on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and three strikeouts...Gallagher was acquired by the Twins at the trade deadline from Chicago-NL, in exchange for Willi Castro...the Sacramento, California native was selected by the Cubs in the sixth round of the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of California, Santa Barbara...he is ranked as the club's 16th-best prospect by MLB.com.

⌘ Jiménez, 19, played in four games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting .308 (4-for-13) with two home runs, two RBI, four walks, a .471 on-base percentage and a 1.240 OPS...the Barcelona, Venezuela native was acquired just prior to the trade deadline from Detroit, in exchange for Chris Paddack...he is ranked as the club's 30th-best prospect by MLB.com.

MICKKKKKKKKKK: Mick Abel made his third start with Triple-A St. Paul last night in a 4-3 loss at Omaha and set a Saints franchise record with 11 strikeouts in 6.0 innings, while issuing zero walks...Abel was acquired at the trade deadline from Philadelphia along with catcher Eduardo Tait, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Jhoan Duran.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: On this day in 2010, Jim Thome hit the first walk-off home run in Target Field history, a two-run shot off Matt Thornton, beating the White Sox 7-6 in 10 innings...the win made the Twins 69-50 and put them 4.0 games up on second-place Chicago.
