THE TWINS: Have gone 4-4 through eight games on their 10-game, 11-day roadtrip, going 1-2 at Tampa Bay last week, 1-2 at Seattle over the weekend and 2-0 against the A's...tonight, they will play the third of four at Sutter Health Park and complete the series and trip tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel home to begin a six-game homestand with three against the Blue Jays this weekend, enjoy an off-day on Monday, then three against the Rangers from Tuesday-Thursday.
✦ Twins are 26-12 in their last 38 games since April 22, tied with Detroit (26-13) for the most wins in baseball since that date...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.
✦ Twins have won two-straight games for the first time on this trip and first time since May 23-24 vs. Kansas City...last time they won three-straight was May 3-17, when they won 13-straight.

ANOTHER NIGHT OF SLUG IN SACRAMENTO: The Twins beat the A's in Sacramento last night by a score of 10-3...Pablo López (5-3) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with three walks and four strikeouts...he exited the game just prior to the start of the bottom of the sixth with right shoulder tightness while throwing warm-up pitches...the offense recorded 12 hits, five going for extra bases...Trevor Larnach had three hits, including his ninth home run of the season...Willi Castro had two hits, both solo homers, his fifth and sixth of the season.
✦ After 10 runs on Monday night, the Twins have now have had double-digit run totals in back-to-back games for the first time since July 4 and 5, 2024, when they scored 12 against Detroit and Houston.

BRINGING 10K LAKES TO THE CITY OF TREES: The Twins and A's are playing the third of seven games this season...Twins will host the A's for three games at Target Field from August 19-21.
✦ Twins are 8-1 in their last nine against the A's, 14-2 in their last 16 and 18-3 in their last 21, dating back to May of 2022.
✦ Carlos Correa is hitting .319 (36-for-113) with eight doubles, five home runs, 17 RBI, a .522 slugging percentage and a .906 OPS in his last 28 games vs. the Athletics.
✦ Byron Buxton is hitting .414 (12-for-29) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, 13 RBI, a .690 slugging percentage and a 1.109 OPS in his last eight games against the A's.
✦ Willi Castro is hitting .372 (16-for-43) with four doubles, three home runs and a 1.145 OPS in his last 11 career games vs. the A's.
✦ Trevor Larnach is hitting .333 (14-for-42) with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, three walks and a .902 OPS in 11 career games against the Athletics.

"WITH A SWING LIKE THAT, WHO NEEDS AN UNDERSHIRT": In his last 15 games, Willi Castro is hitting .347 (17-for-49) with three doubles, five home runs, seven RBI, eight walks, 13 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .448 on-base percentage, a .714 slugging percentage and a 1.163 OPS.
✦ With two home runs on Friday at Seattle as a left-handed batter and two home runs last night as a right-handed batter, he joined Chili Davis in 1991 as the only two switch hitters in club history (since 1961) with two different multi-homer games – each from different sides of the plate – in the same season...additionally, Roy Smalley did it, but covering multiple different seasons.
✦ Since the start of the Seattle series, May 30, he has gone 9-for-19 (.474) with one double, four home runs, five RBI, eight runs scored and a 1.741 OPS.

MAJORITY RULES: Twins are looking to win their 11th series of the season tonight...Minnesota is 10-8-1 in series play, going 6-2-1 at home and 4-6-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play but have gone 9-4-1 in their last 14...they are seeking their first series win since May 23-25 vs. Kansas City (list in right margin).
✦ Twins have won six consecutive series against the A's, dating back to May of 2022...their last series loss to the Athletics was May 14-16, 2021, dropping two of three at Target Field...they haven't lost a series to the A's in California since April of 2021.

BUCK SHOTS: In four games since coming off the 7-day Concussion IL, Byron Buxton is hitting .364 (8-for-22) with one double, 10 RBI and a .757 OPS...in 17 games since May 1, he is hitting .329 (23-for-70) with two doubles, one triple, four home runs, 20 RBI, a .557 slugging percentage and a .937 OPS...despite the 17 games played since May 1, he ranks tied for ninth in the AL in RBI...in fact, among players with at least 70 at-bats since that date, he ranks third in all of baseball in at-bats-per-RBI at 3.50, trailing Max Muncy (3.00) and Rafael Devers (3.38).

RAISE A BAGUETTE: Ty France has reached base safely in 15-straight games, two short of his career-high of 17, done twice (2021 and '23)...during the streak, he is hitting .333 (19-for-57) with one double, one home run, 11 RBI, six HBP and a .397 on-base percentage.
✦ Over his last five games, France has nine hits in 19 at-bats (.474).

LARNING TO FLY: Over his last 21 games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .326 (28-for-86) with six doubles, one triple, four home runs, 12 RBI, 14 runs scored, a .558 slugging percentage and a .921 OPS.

ASG SZN: MLB launched the 2025 PRO SPIRIT MLB All-Star Ballot at 12:00 pm (ET) today for the 2025 MLB All-Star Game presented by Mastercard, which will be held on Tuesday, July 15 at Truist Park, the home of the Atlanta Braves.
✦ The 2025 MLB All-Star Ballot once again features two phases of fan voting to determine the starters...beginning today, fans can cast their votes exclusively online and via mobile devices at MLB.com/vote, all 30 Club web sites, the MLB App and the MLB Ballpark App until the voting period for Phase 1 concludes at 12:00 p.m. ET on June 26...during the initial voting period from June 4-26, fans can submit up to five ballots each day on MLB platforms.
✦ On June 26, the top two vote-getters at each position (and the top 6 outfielders) in each league will be revealed on MLB Network at 6:00 pm (ET), and they will advance to the second phase of voting to determine who makes the All-Star teams and starts for each league.
✦ Twins on the ballot: C Ryan Jeffers // 1B Ty France // 2B Willi Castro // 3B Royce Lewis // SS Carlos Correa // OFs Byron Buxton, Harrison Bader and Matt Wallner // DH Trevor Larnach.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2012, the Twins selected Byron Buxton with the second overall selection in the MLB First-Year Player Draft after Houston selected Carlos Correa first overall...Buxton came out of Appling County High School in Baxley, Georgia.
