LAST START: Last pitched on May 30 at Seattle, opposite Bryan Woo...he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 10-inning, 12-6 victory...allowed four runs (2 HR) on six hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in a career-high 7.0 innings...his four runs allowed came off two home runs in the first innings from Randy Arozarena and Cal Raleigh, scoring Jorge Polanco and Julio Rodríguez...retired 14 of his final 15 batters faced from the third through seventh innings.

- Zebby is one of nine players to have an active streak of five-or-more strikeouts in each of his last seven major league games...he is the only one to not have earned a win in that time.
- A Marks the first time a Twins pitcher has allowed back-to-back home runs in the first inning since May 15, 2023, when Pablo López allowed back-to-back homers against the Los Angeles Dodgers to Will Smith and Max Muncy. & Recorded a single-game career-high whiff rate of 33.0 percent (15 whiffs on 45 swings).

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on May 24 vs. Kansas City in his 2025 Target Field debut, opposite Michael Wacha...he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-4 victory...allowed two runs on five hits, with one walk and a career-high nine strikeouts in 4.0 innings...led the Twins to their third consecutive walk-off victory (in a span of four games), the first time the team has done so since August 15-18, 2021 (also 4-game span)...his two runs allowed came off a two-run RBI single from Maikel Garcia in the third, scoring Freddy Fermin and Vinnie Pasquantino.

∉Recorded a single-game career-high hard-hit rate of 75.0 percent (six hard-hit balls).

MOW 'EM DOWN MATTHEWS: Matthews has totaled 64 strikeouts through his first 12 career games, the third most in Twins history (1961-)...here are some of his numbers compared to other Twins pitchers through their first 12 games:

 $\Phi$  Matthews' 21 strikeouts so far in 2025 is the most by a Twins pitcher in their first three starts this season...followed by Simeon Woods Richardson (16), Joe Ryan (15) and David Festa (15).

MINOR LEAGUE RECAP: Has seven starts for the Triple-A St. Paul Saints going 2-1 with a 1.93 ERA (32.2 IP, 7 ER), with nine walks and 38 strikeouts. At the time of recall to Minnesota:

- ♣ Matthews held the third lowest ERA in the International League among pitchers with at least seven starts, behind Carlos Rodriguez (1.59) and Jacob Misiorowski (1.66).
- Was also one of six pitchers in the International League with 32.0-plus innings to only allow one home run.
- $\pmb{\Phi}$  Had the lowest ERA among Saints pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched...also the lowest opponent batting average among Saints pitchers with at least 7.0 innings.

AGAINST THE ATHLETICS: Matthews has never faced the Athletics or any A's batters at the major league level...they become his 11th new opponent faced in 13 career games.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Zebby has gone 1-2 with an 8.87 ERA (22.1 IP. 22 ER), six walks, 36 strikeouts and a .350 (36-for-103) opponent batting average in six career major league starts at home; compared to 0-3, 4.91 ERA (29.1 IP, 12 ER) with 10 walks, 28 strikeouts and a .265 (31-for-117) opponent batting average in six career major league starts on the road.

₱ In his two starts on the road this season, Matthews is 0-1 with a 7.20 ERA (10.0 IP, 8 ER), four walks, 12 strikeouts and a .282 (11-for-39) opponent batting average

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through his first three major league starts this season, left-handed hitters have slashed .310/.355/.414 in 29 at-bats vs. Matthews, while righties slashed .259/.333/.370 in 27 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 83.3 mph and a whiff rate of 29.3 compared to righties' 93.7 mph and 28.6 percent.

#His hard-hit rate is against lefties is 35.0 percent, compared to 44.9 percent in 2024; and his hard-hit rate against righties in 50.0 percent, compared to 38.5 percent in 2024.

THE ARSENAL: Matthews uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 48% of the time...primarily uses his 4-seam fastball against right-handed batters, while favoring is changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his 2025 pitch breakdown
