BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore continues its six-game, six-day road trip through Minnesota (0-2, 1 to play) and Los Angeles-AL (3 to play) today at Target Field...The O's and Twins will meet four times in the next eight days, as Minnesota travels to Camden Yards from May 13-15...The Birds are 7.0 games behind the AL East-leading Yankees and 9.0 games under .500, both marking season highs.

👉 Baltimore has dropped a season-high four straight games, its longest losing skid since a five-game stretch from July 9-13, 2024.

👉 Last night, **Charlie Morton** became the third pitcher in franchise history (since 1954) to lose each of his first six starts to open a season, joining **Mike Boddicker** (8 G, 1988), **Mark Thurmond** (6 G, 1988).

👉 **Jackson Holliday's** second-inning walk, Baltimore's lone free pass of the night, preserved the O's streak of 113 straight games with a walk since July 2, 2024...It is tied for the third-longest run in team history, trailing stretches of 155 games (6/23/55-6/24/56 [G1]) and 116 games (6/3/95-4/5/96)...It marks the longest streak by any MLB club since the Yankees also did so in 113 straight from August 2, 2023-May 30, 2024.

👉 With a win today, the Birds would avoid their second sweep of the season (4/26-27 at DET) and their first sweep against the Twins since May 24-26, 2021.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS: Prior to today's game, the Orioles recalled right-handed pitcher **Colin Selby** from Triple-A Norfolk and designated right-handed pitcher **Matt Bowman** for assignment.

👉 Selby, 27, has made seven relief appearances with the Tides this season, recording 11 strikeouts across 7.1 innings...He has made two appearances across two stints on the major league roster this year (4/9-15 & 4/26 as the 27th man).

👉 Bowman, 33, went 0-1 with a 5.19 ERA (10 ER/17.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts across 16 appearances this season.

GUNNAR GETTING GOING: **Gunnar Henderson** has reached base safely in each of his last 13 games, slashing .300/.352/.420 (15-for-50) with three doubles and one home run...It marks the third-longest stretch of his career behind runs of 36 games (5/22-6/29/24) and 16 games (7/1-20/23).

👉 Henderson's 94.5 mph average exit velocity ranks eighth in the majors and fourth in the AL behind NYY's Aaron Judge (95.4) and TB's Jonathan Aranda/BOS' Rafael Devers (both 95.1).

👉 His eight multi-hit games are second on the club behind **Ryan O'Hearn** (9) despite missing the first seven games of the season due to injury.

TURN AROUND TIME: Baltimore's 5.50 ERA is second highest in MLB, ahead of only the Marlins (5.86)...It marks the O's fifth-highest ERA through 35 games in club history, including the highest since the 2019 O's (5.61).

👉 The Birds have permitted 10.28 hits per nine innings, the second-highest clip in the majors ahead of only the Rockies (10.31)...The 10.28 clip would tie the 2009 Orioles for the highest figure in franchise history.

SPLITTING HAIRS: The Birds are slashing .247/.310/.449 (194-for-787) with a .758 OPS against right-handed pitching, compared to .178/.259/.239 (62-for-348) with a .497 OPS against southpaws...The .758 OPS off righties ranks sixth in MLB, while the .497 OPS off lefties is last, with the next closest team being the Rays (.536).

👉 The O's have an MLB-best .865 OPS against right-handed starters, slashing .278/.337/.528 (131-for-472) with 30 homers, compared to .200/.270/.330 (63-for-315) with nine long balls and a .600 OPS off right-handed relievers.

ROAD WOES: The Birds are 1-9 in their 10 nine away games, having been outscored 56-16 (-40) during that stretch...They have scored three runs or fewer in 10 straight road games, the second-longest single-season streak in franchise history behind an 11-game stretch from April 25 (G1)-May 23 (G2), 1954.

👉 Baltimore has dropped nine of 10 road games in a single season for the first time since going 1-9 from August 14-September 3, 2021.

👉 The last MLB club to score three runs or fewer in 11 straight road games was the Oakland Athletics from April 10-27, 2024.

👉 Baltimore is averaging 3.77 runs per game on the road this season, ranking 22nd in MLB... The 2024 Orioles posted 4.85 runs per game in away games, the fourth-highest clip in the majors.

RISPY BUISNESS: The Orioles are batting .127/.174/.200 (14-for-110) with runners in scoring position over the last 15 games since April 20...Their .192 RISP average overall is the lowest in MLB, with the next closest teams being the Rockies (.198) and White Sox (.203)...The 1988 Orioles are responsible for the lowest RISP average in franchise history (.217).

👉 In 13 wins this season, Baltimore is 33-for-108 (.306) with runners in scoring position, compared to 13-for-131 (.099) in 22 defeats.

MAGIC NUMBER: The O's are 11-3 when scoring at least four runs this season with 10 of those victories featuring at least five runs...Baltimore is 2-19 when plating three or fewer runs and 2-28 in those situations since September 7, 2024.

👉 Since 2024, Baltimore is 91-22 (.805) when scoring four or more runs, fifth best in the majors behind the Guardians/ Padres (both 94-16, .855) and Astros/Mariners (both 88-21, .807)...During that same time, the Birds are 13-71 (.157) when scoring three runs or fewer, the third-worst mark in the AL ahead of the White Sox (13-117, .100) and Twins (13-75, .148).

LAND OF 10,000 LAKES: Baltimore and Minnesota continue their six-game season series this afternoon...Prior to Tuesday's loss, the O's had won 10 straight games against Minnesota since July 2, 2023, the second-longest winning streak over the Twins in franchise history behind a 12-game run from July 21 (G2), 1980-May 17, 1981.

👉 In 2019, **Adley Rutschman** became he first catcher selected No. 1 overall since Minnesota selected **Joe Mauer** in the 2021 First-Year Player Draft.

👉 **Ryan Goll**, Manager of Baltimore's High-A Aberdeen Ironbirds, is a Minnesota native and spent time on the University of Minnesota's coaching staff after spending three years as the team's head student manager.

QUICK HITS: Set to make his eighth start of the 2025 campaign...Spun his first quality start of the season in his last outing on May 2 vs. Kansas City...Has earned the victory in both of his starts at Oriole Park this season...Made five Grapefruit League appearances (3 GS), going 0-2 with a 7.27 ERA (14 ER/17.1 IP) on 21 hits (6 HR) and nine walks while striking out 21 batters...In his final appearance on March 23 at Atlanta, tossed 5.1 relief innings, allowing two runs on four hits and one walk with 10 strikeouts...Was on the 15-day Injured List last season (right triceps strain) from May 24-July 3 (retroactive 5/21).

LAST TIME OUT: Tossed 7.0 scoreless innings on May 2 vs. Kansas City, allowing three hits and one walk while striking out two...Was his second career start of at least 7.0 innings allowing three or fewer hits (also: 7/24/23 at Philadelphia).

🕒 Was his first start of 6.0 innings or more since September 18, 2024 vs. San Francisco...Had failed to complete 6.0 innings in each of his previous seven starts since September 24, 2024, tied for the longest such streak of his career (also: 9/12/20-4/28/21).

🕒 2B Michael Massey and C Freddy Fermin were the only opposing batters to record a hit off Kremer in the outing.

AGAINST THE TWINS: Has made two career starts opposite Minnesota, posting a 0-2 record with a 15.43 ERA (12 ER/7.0 IP), a 2.57 WHIP, and 10 strikeouts against five walks...Last faced the club on June 30, 2023 at Minnesota, tossing 3.0 innings and allowing a career-high seven earned runs on seven hits with five strikeouts and two walks in the loss.

🕒 In 15 career starts against AL Central foes, owns a 4-9 record with a 5.18 ERA (46 ER/80.0 IP), 1.40 WHIP, and 53 strikeouts with 25 walks.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS: Five of Kremer's seven starts this season have come on the road, during which he is 1-4 with a 8.17 ERA (23 ER/25.1 IP)...In two home outings this season, Kremer is 2-0 with a 0.73 ERA (1 ER/12.1 IP)...His home ERA ranks second in the AL and sixth in MLB among pitchers with at least two home starts

🕒 In his last eight starts at Camden Yards since July 14, 2024, Kremer is 4-2 with a 2.30 ERA (12 ER/47.0 IP).

APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS: In 21 career April starts, Kremer is 5-9 with a 6.12 ERA (71 ER/104.1 IP), marking his highest earned run average in any month (min. 2 GS)...In 14 career May starts, Kremer is 5-6 with a 3.72 ERA (31 ER/75.0 IP).

FIRST INNING WOES: Opponents are hitting .367 (11-for-30) off Kremer in the first inning compared to .260 (32-for-123) across the following six innings.

🕒 Last season, Kremer held hitters to a .133 (11-for-83) average in the first inning, his lowest mark of any frame.

EMPTY THE TANK: Opponents are slashing .516/.531/.903 (16-for-31) against Kremer when his pitch count exceeds 75, compared to a .221/.271/.385 (27-for-122) from pitches 1 through 75.
