**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Orioles fell to the White Sox last night, 5-3...**Austin Hays** recorded his 300<sup>th</sup> career hit with a two-run home run in the ninth inning and **Spenser Watkins** allowed two runs over 6.0 innings but suffered the loss.  
❖ The O's dropped to 33-34 in games decided by two runs or less; the 67 such games are tied for the most in the AL and tied for third-most in MLB this season.

**BURNING RUBBER:** Baltimore and Chicago will play a rubber game tonight to decide the three-game series...The O's are 8-9 in rubber matches this season after starting the year 7-4 and Sunday's victory over Boston snapped a five-game losing streak in such games.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** The Orioles are 64-59 and have eclipsed their win total from each of the last three full seasons: 2021(52-110), 2019 (54-108), and 2018 (47-115)...Entering today's games, Baltimore's .659 winning percentage (29-15) since July 3 is tied for the best in the AL and is tied for fourth-best in MLB (see chart at right)...The team had a 10-game winning streak from July 3-13, tied for the fifth-longest in a single season in O's history (since 1954) and the longest since the team won 13 in a row from September 7-22, 1999.  
❖ The O's have outscored their opponents 528-517(+11) this season; they have outscored their opponents 338-284 (+54) in 72 games since June 1 after being outscored 190-233 (-43) in their first 51 games.

**HOT AUGUST:** The Orioles have gone 13-8 in their first 21 games in August...The O's have outscored their opponents 103-85 (+18) in August while posting a .756 OPS, which ranks second in the AL and seventh in MLB this month...Baltimore needs one win in the next six games to clinch its third consecutive winning month after going 16-9 in July and 14-12 in June; the O's have not had three straight winning months since April (14-9), May (14-13), and June (19-9) of 2016.

**HIP HIP JORGE:** **Jorge Mateo** is batting .288/.335/.527 (42-for-146) with nine doubles, four triples, six home runs, 27 runs scored, 25 RBI, nine walks, and nine stolen bases in his last 45 games since July 1...Since the All-Star Break, he is slashing .308/.345/.558 (32-for-104) with seven doubles, two triples, five home runs, 20 runs scored, 20 RBI, five walks, and six stolen bases in 30 games...His slugging percentage ranks ninth in the AL since the Break.  
❖ Ranks third on the O's, third among AL shortstops (see chart at right), and tied for ninth among MLB shortstops with 2.7 fWAR, according to *FanGraphs*; the last Orioles shortstop to have over 2.0 fWAR in a season was Jonathan Villar (3.9) in 2019.  
❖ Mateo leads the AL and is second in MLB with 28 stolen bases; his 30.2 ft/sec sprint speed is tied for fifth-fastest in MLB, per *Statcast*.  
❖ His seven defensive runs saved rank third on the O's and tied for eighth among MLB shortstops, per *Sports Info Solutions*.

**STARTING TO AD UP:** **Adley Rutschman** recorded his 25<sup>th</sup> double in last night's game...He is the first O's player, 18<sup>th</sup> MLB player, and first catcher since at least 1900 with 25 doubles in their first 75 career games and first since Toronto's Bo Bichette had 27 two-baggers to begin his career in 2019-20, according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*...Rutschman is slashing .313/.457/.505 (31-for-99) with 10 doubles, three homers, 25 runs scored, nine RBI, 26 walks, and two hit-by-pitches in 29 games since the All-Star Break; he leads the AL in walks, is tied for third in the AL in runs scored, tied for fifth in the AL in doubles, and ranks second in MLB in on-base percentage during that time.  
❖ His team-leading 3.6 fWAR paces MLB rookies (see chart at right) and ranks third among all catchers (min. 300 PA), per *FanGraphs*; his 3.7 fWAR since June 11 leads all rookies, ranks second in the AL and fourth in MLB during that time.  
❖ Rutschman's 138 wRC+ leads the O's and is second among MLB catchers (min. 300 PA), according to *FanGraphs*.  
❖ His nine defensive runs saved are tied for the team lead and rank third among catchers, per *Sports Info Solutions*.

**STEADY CEDDY:** **Cedric Mullins** is batting .321/.406/.607 (9-for-28) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, seven runs scored, one RBI, and four walks during his current seven-game hitting streak since August 16...He has hit safely in 15 of 18 August games with an at-bat, including eight multi-hit efforts, slashing .324/.378/.554 (24-for-74) with six doubles, one triple, three home runs, 13 runs scored, six RBI, and seven walks in 19 games this month.  
❖ He ranks second in the AL and tied for third in MLB with 25 stolen bases.  
❖ Mullins is one of 15 left-handed hitters in MLB with at least 42 extra-base hits; he's one of five players with 40+ XBH and 20+ SB this season.

**DEFENSIVE TACTICS:** The Orioles rank ninth in MLB with 32 defensive runs saved (DRS), according to *Sports Info Solutions*...Baltimore finished 24<sup>th</sup> with -30 DRS in 2021, tied for 16<sup>th</sup> with 1 DRS in 2020, 28<sup>th</sup> with -53 DRS in 2019, and 28<sup>th</sup> with -42 DRS in 2018.  
❖ The Orioles have turned 108 double plays this season, tied for second-most in the AL and tied for sixth-most in MLB.  
❖ O's pitchers have induced 96 opponent GDP, the second-most in the AL and fifth-most in MLB.

**SQUARING OFF AGAINST THE SOX:** The Orioles have gone 4-2 against the White Sox this year, 1-1 at Oriole Park and 3-1 in a four-game series at Guaranteed Rate Field from June 23-26...They have clinched their first season series over Chicago-AL since 2017 (4-3) and a win today would mean five victories against the Sox in one season for the first time since 2014 (5-0).

**FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME:** The Orioles complete a seven-game homestand tonight with the final of three games against the Chicago White Sox...The O's will hit the road for a six-game trip with three games in Houston against the Astros from August 26-28, a scheduled off day on Monday, August 29, and three games in Cleveland against the Guardians from August 30 to September 1.  
❖ The Birds have gone 36-24 at home this season and their .600 home winning percentage is fourth in the AL and eighth in MLB; at Oriole Park the last four seasons, the O's went 27-54 (.333) in 2021, 13-20 (.394) in 2020, 25-56 (.309) in 2019, 28-53 (.346) in 2018.  
❖ Baltimore has outscored their opponents 264-233 (+31) at home this year.  
❖ The Orioles are 18-7 (.720) in their last 25 home games.

**QUICK HITS:** Lyles is making his 26<sup>th</sup> start this season, 12<sup>th</sup> at home, and second against Chicago-AL...Nine of his last 21 outings since May 5 have been quality starts...Has pitched at least 5.0 innings in 20 of his 25 starts this season; his 20 such starts are tied for 12<sup>th</sup>-most in the American League...Went 10-13 with a 5.15 ERA (103 ER/180.0 IP) with Texas last season...Signed as a free agent on March 12, 2022.

**LAST START:** Did not factor in the decision on August 19 vs. Boston...Pitched 4.0 innings and allowed four runs on nine hits with five strikeouts...Has 14 strikeouts over his last two outings (8.1 IP) and is three strikeouts shy of 1,000 for his career...Threw 89 pitches, 60 strikes.

**CAREER VS. CHICAGO-AL:** Scheduled to make his seventh career appearance (fifth start) against Chicago-AL...Has gone 1-3 with a 5.56 ERA (14 ER/22.2 IP) in his career...Suffered the loss in his lone start against the White Sox this season on June 26...Tossed 7.0 innings and allowed four runs on six hits (one home run) with a walk and four strikeouts.

**AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL:** Will face an AL Central opponent for the sixth time this season and 23<sup>rd</sup> time in his career (20<sup>th</sup> start)...Is 5-8 with a 4.36 ERA (56 ER/115.2 IP) in his career vs. the division...Has gone 0-3 with a 4.88 ERA (17 ER/31.1 IP) in five starts this year against the AL Central...Made his last start against the division on July 2 at Minnesota...Pitched 6.1 innings and allowed one run on four hits (one home run) with a walk and seven strikeouts in a no decision.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Is 4-2 with a 3.13 ERA (22 ER/63.1 IP) at home this year, the 13<sup>th</sup>-best ERA in the AL (min. 63.0 IP)...Has only allowed three home runs at home; tied for the fewest in the AL (min 63.0 IP).

**FOR THE BOYS:** Leads the team and ranks 15<sup>th</sup> in the AL with 138.2 innings pitched; his 2,401 pitches thrown rank third in the AL and ninth in MLB...Has thrown 100-or-more pitches in 10 of his starts this year, tied for eighth-most in MLB; marks the first time an O's starter has made 10 starts with 100-or-more pitches since Andrew Cashner (13) and Kevin Gausman (12) in 2018.

**QUALITY AND QUANTITY:** Has nine quality starts and is the only starter on the team with more than five quality starts; the Orioles have gone 5-4 when Lyles records a quality start...In 2021, the right-hander racked up a career-high 180.0 innings, ranking sixth among American League hurlers (T-18<sup>th</sup> in MLB)...Tallied 18 games pitching 6.0+ innings, one of six AL pitchers to do so...Recorded a career-high 13 quality starts in 2021 (tied for 14<sup>th</sup> in the AL), while tying his career-high in strikeouts (146), ranking 22<sup>nd</sup> in the AL.
