THE TWINS: After completing their six-game, seven-day homestand with a record of 2-4 (2-1 vs. Boston and 0-3 vs. the Reds), the Twins lost a three-game series 1-2 in New York against the Mets earlier this week...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the first of three against the Rays at Tropicana Field...they will conclude the trip on Sunday afternoon then travel home to begin a seven game homestand with three against the Mariners (Monday-Wednesday) and four against the Blue Jays (Thursday-Sunday).
☞ Twins are just 1-6 in their last seven, following a stretch where they went 8-1 in nine games from April 6-14.

NOT SO BROADWAY JOE: The Twins lost to the Mets last night at Citi Field by a score of 10-8. Joe Ryan (2-3) was the starter but took a no-decision, allowing seven runs (4 earned) on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts...he allowed three runs in both the first and second innings...the offense recorded 12 hits, highlighted by Austin Martin, who reached base four times, going 3-for-4 with a walk...Brooks Lee also had three hits in four at-bats...Ryan Jeffers tied the game at 7-7 in the eighth inning with a grand slam, but Anthony Banda allowed a bases-clearing three-run double to Bo Bichette in the bottom half.

WELCOME BACK, DAD: The Twins have reinstated left-handed pitcher Kody Funderburk from the Paternity List...Funderburk missed the club's three-game series at New York against the Mets after his wife, Alicia, gave birth to the couple's first child, a daughter named Murphy Jo on Monday...prior to being placed on the Paternity List, Funderburk appeared in 12 games for the Twins, going 1-1 with a 2.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 2 ER), seven walks, eight strikeouts, a .212 opponent batting average, one save and four holds.
☞ To make room on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned left-handed pitcher Kendry Rojas to Triple-A St. Paul...Rojas, who was recalled on Tuesday, made his major league debut on Wednesday night against the New York Mets at Citi Field, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings, with two hits allowed and three walks.

FLORIDA MEN: The Twins and Rays are playing the fourth of six games this season...these two last met for three games to open Target Field play from April 3-5 as the Twins won game one 10-4 and lost games two and three by scores of 1-7 and 1-4.
☞ Twins went 1-2 at George M. Steinbrenner Field last season from May 26-28...their last series at Tropicana Field was September 3-5, 2024, winning one of three games.
☞ Twins are 95-101 all-time against the Rays...they were 44-29 against Tampa from 1998-2006, but have gone 51-72 since 2007.
☞ Derek Shelton spent seven seasons as hitting coach for the Rays from 2010-16 under Joe Maddon and Kevin Cash...he has a managerial record of 2-10 against Tampa Bay, going 1-8 in Tampa, the only win coming with the Pirates last season at George M. Steinbrenner Field on April 2.
☞ In his last seven games in Tampa Bay — including both ballparks, Byron Buxton is hitting .296 (8-for-27) with two doubles, two home runs, three RBI, a .367 on-base percentage, a .593 slugging percentage and a .959 OPS.
☞ Notables lifetime vs. Drew Rasmussen: Trevor Larnach is 3-for-7 (.429) with one walk...Byron Buxton is 3-for-5 (.600) with three solo home runs...Matt Wallner is 1-for-2.

TAMPA TAJ: Tonight's starter, Taj Bradley, was selected by the Rays in the fifth round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Redan High School in Stone Mountain, GA...he was acquired by the Twins at the 2025 trade deadline, in exchange for Griffin Jax...he made his debut with Tampa on April 12, 2023 vs. Boston at Tropicana Field, allowing three runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and eight strikeouts...his first win in this ballpark came in his third career start on April 24, 2023 vs. Houston, allowing three runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...he has made 23 career starts in this building, going 7-11, 4.66 ERA (123.2 IP, 64 ER) with 37 walks and 154 strikeouts.
☞ Taj has the fourth-highest strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio in this ballpark (minimum of 120.0 IP) at 11.21, trailing Tyler Glasnow (13.07), Charlie Morton (11.91) and Jake McGee (11.68).
☞ Two of Taj's best friends in baseball are Chandler Simpson and Richie Palacios.

BYE BYE BYRON: Byron Buxton hit his fifth home run of the season Wednesday night...after going homerless in his first 14 games to begin the season (62 plate appearances), Buck has homered five times in his last nine games (44 PA), since April 13...since that date, only five other players in baseball have hit as many home runs (Trout - 6, Murakami - 6, J. Wood - 5, Alvarez - 5 and Judge - 5).

A-MAR-VELOUS: Austin Martin has reached base safely in 15-straight games with a plate appearance and in 18 of 20 games with a plate appearance...the 15-straight is tied for seventh-longest active streak in baseball (Kurtz is the leader at 19)...it marks the longest streak for a Twin since Martin's own 16-game on-base streak from September 2-20, 2025.
☞ Martin currently leads the club with 16 walks...he has posted a .515 on-base percentage, which leads all of baseball among players with a minimum of 60 plate appearances.
☞ Martin on MLB Savant's 2026 MLB Percentile Rankings: 93rd in batting run value (8), 91st in xwOBA (.402), 100th in chase % (9.8%), 95th in whiff % (14.0%), 100th in walk % (23.5%).
☞ In 11 road games this season, Martin is hitting .429 (9-for-21) with nine walks a .613 on-base percentage and a 1.089 OPS...he leads baseball in road OBP (min. 30 PA).

I'M COMING HOME: Twins have scored 127 runs on the season, second-most in the AL, trailing only Houston (137).
☞ 51 of their 127 runs scored (40%) on the season have come via the home run...they have hit 30 home runs this season, fifth-most in the AL, trailing Los Angeles (36), New York (35), Chicago (32) and Houston (31).

RISP, REWARD: Despite going 11-for-56 (.196) with runners in scoring position in their last six games, the Twins rank fourth in baseball in batting average with RISP at .283 (60-for-212), trailing Milwaukee (.303), Atlanta (.302) and Detroit (.295).
☞ Twins hit .238 (309-for-1301) with RISP last season, fourth worst in the AL and 25th in MLB.
☞ Notable individuals with RISP: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .500 (8-for-16)...Josh Bell is hitting .435 (10-for-23)...Brooks Lee is hitting .421 (8-for-19)...Luke Keaschall is hitting .345 (10-for-29)...Tristan Gray is hitting .385 (5-for-13)...Victor Caratini is hitting .294 (5-for-17)...Austin Martin is hitting .333 (2-for-6).
☞ Twins are hitting .341 (15-for-44) with 41 RBI with the bases loaded this season...both their hits and RBI lead baseball.

CAUTION, WALKERS: After drawing seven walks last night, the Twins have now drawn 111 bases on balls this season, fourth-most in the AL and sixth-most in baseball...their 11.5 walk percentage, ranks fifth-highest in baseball, trailing Milwaukee (12.7%), New York-AL (12.4%), Los Angeles-AL (11.8%) and Chicago-NL (11.6%).

- Bradley will make his sixth start of the season and first start against his former team since being traded to Minnesota from Tampa Bay on July 31, 2025 in exchange for RHP Griffin Jax.
- In his last outing on April 18 vs. Cincinnati, Taj recorded his third quality start of the season, throwing 6.0 innings and giving up two runs on five hits with two walks and five strikeouts...he left the game with a 4-2 lead, but the Reds would score three runs late to steal a 5-4 victory.
- Through five starts, Bradley currently ranks ninth in the AL amongst all players in WAR (1.4) and ranks sixth among AL pitchers.

LAST TIME OUT: In his most recent start last Saturday, April 18 vs. Cincinnati, Bradley recorded his third quality start of the season going 6.0 innings and allowing two runs (both earned) on five hits, with two walks and five strikeouts.

- Taj left with the lead (4-2) for the fifth time (five starts) this season, but for the first time this year the Twins could not hold the lead upon his exit, as they lost 5-4 following three Reds runs in the last three innings...moved the teams record to 4-1 when Bradley takes the hill.
- Taj's 1.63 ERA (27.2 IP, 5 ER) is the lowest by a Twins starting pitcher through their first five starts of a season since Sonny Gray's 0.62 ERA (29.0 IP, 2 ER) in 2023; Gray would go onto finish second in the AL Cy Young voting that season.

TWO STARTS AGO: On April 12 at Toronto, Taj picked up his third win of the season, going 5.0 innings and allowing one run on five hits, with four walks and seven strikeouts in an 8-2 Twins win...the win moved his win-streak to three which is his longest since a four game win-streak from 9/21/24-4/11/25.

WHERE HE STACKS UP: Heading into his sixth start today, here is a look at where Taj ranks in a few statistical categories amongst qualified AL and MLB pitchers.

NUMBERS SINCE THE TRADE: Bradley will face off against his former team tonight for the first time since he was traded from Tampa Bay to Minnesota on July 31, 2025 in exchange for RHP Griffin Jax... here is how Bradley and Jax have fared for their new clubs since the trade.

- Bradley: 3-2 with a 4.27 ERA (59.0 IP, 28 ER), 22 walks, 66 strikeouts, 10.1 SO/9 and a 1.32 WHIP in 11 appearances (all starts).
- Jax: 1-4 with a 4.97 ERA (29.0 IP, 16 ER), 15 walks, 37 strikeouts, 11.5 SO/9, and a 1.48 WHIP in 34 appearances (two openers).

HOT START: Bradley is currently off to the best start of his career, here is how his numbers through five starts this year compare to his numbers through five starts in the first three years of his career.

CAREER IN TAMPA BAY: From 2023-2025 with the Rays, Bradley went 19-25 with a 4.70 ERA (354.0 IP, 185 ER), 130 walks, 378 strikeouts, 9.6 SO/9 and a 1.291 WHIP...here are some of his highlights while in Tampa Bay.

- In 2023, his rookie season, Bradley was the youngest pitcher in the majors to make at least 20 starts and became the third pitcher (4x) in Rays history to reach the threshold in an age 22 or younger season, joining Scott Kazmir (32, 2005 & 24, 2006) and Joe Kennedy (20, 2001).
- Collected 128 strikeouts in his first 21 outings, most in Rays history through a rookie pitcher's first 21 career starts and seventh most in a rookie season...also marked the fourth most strikeouts through any pitcher's first 21 starts after joining the Rays, behind Charlie Morton (152), Drew Smyly (137) and Tyler Glasnow (129).
- In 2024, recorded a career-high 24.0 inning scoreless streak from the fourth inning of his start on July 6, 2024 at Texas until the second inning of his July 31 start vs. Miami; the streak spanned five starts (three full starts of 0 R) and a total of 25 days...named AL Pitcher of the Month for that July after totaling a 3-1 record with a 1.45 ERA (31.0 IP, 5 ER), eight walks, 31 strikeouts and a 2.78 FIP...became the ninth pitcher (11x) in franchise history to earn AL Pitcher of the Month honors...also became the youngest player in Rays history to earn a monthly award from MLB.
- In 2025, made the Rays opening rotation for the first time as the team's third starter...posted a 4.61 ERA (111.1 IP, 57 ER) with 44 walks and 95 strikeouts over 21 starts before the trade to MIN.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Tonight will be Taj's third start against the AL East this season...in starts on March 28 at Baltimore and April 12 at Toronto, he combined to go 1-0 with a 1.93 ERA (9.1 IP, 2 ER), seven walks, 16 strikeouts and a .229 (8-for-35) BAA...in his career is 11-9 with a 4.89 ERA (127.0 IP, 69 ER), 43 walks, 135 strikeouts and a .254 (125-for-492) BAA vs. AL East opponents.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Over the course of his career, Bradley is 12-15 with a 4.93 ERA (206.1 IP, 113 ER), 66 walks, 233 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP in 39 career home starts compared to 10-12 with a 4.35 ERA (206.2 IP, 100 ER), 86 walks, 211 strikeouts and a 1.33 WHIP in 41 road appearances (39 starts).

- SO FAR IN 2026:** This year, he owns a 1-0 record with a 2.19 ERA (12.1 IP, 3 ER), two walks and 15 strikeouts in two home starts compared to a 2-0 record with a 1.17 ERA (15.1 IP, 2 ER), eight walks and 19 strikeouts in three road starts.
- CAREER AT TROPICANA FIELD:** In 23 career games (all starts) at Tropicana, Bradley is 7-11 with a 4.66 ERA (123.2 IP, 64 ER), 37 walks, 154 strikeouts, 23 homers allowed and a .713 OPS against.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, left-handed hitters have slashed .218/.271/.291 (12-for-55) with four doubles, four walks and 21 strikeouts against Bradley, while righties are hitting .240/.339/.280 (12-for-50) with two doubles, six walks and 13 strikeouts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - BAILEY OBER (2026: 2-0, 4.15 ERA // CAREER: 33-30, 4.08 ERA)

Bailey Ober will start tomorrow afternoon's middle game against Tampa Bay...in his last outing on April 19 vs. Cincinnati, Ober made his first quality start of the season pitching 6.1 innings while allowing three hits and one unearned run with four walks and a season-high 10 strikeouts in a 7-4 Twins loss...will be Bailey's third career start against Tampa Bay and second of the season after he faced the Rays in the Twins' home opener on April 3...in that outing, he pitched 4.0 innings and gave up three runs on four hits with one walk and one strikeout in a 10-4 Twins win.
