TODAY'S GAME: The Giants can take a series with a win this afternoon against the Astros...SF snapped a modest three-game losing streak with a win last night to even up the series.

- ▶ Despite the win, the Giants have still lost five of their last seven and eight of their last 11 games dating to July 31.
- ▶ Lastly, the Giants are 2-3 through the first five games of this season-long, nine-game homestand after going 1-2 vs. Detroit and 1-1 so far against these Astros.
- ▶ Even with the 2-3 homestand thus far, the Giants have been one of the better hosts in MLB over the last two months...since June 14, SF is 15-10 (.600), the eighth-best home record in the Majors over that span.
- ▶ SF is 10-4 (.714) versus the Astros since the start of 2021 and have won four straight series against them in that time...they can stretch that streak to five with a win today...SF's .714 win % against Houston since 2021 is its second-best record vs. any opponent in that span behind a .736 win % (64-23) vs. Colorado.

TODAY'S STARTER: **RHP Adrian Houser** starts for SF in the finale today, his first official start since June 16 in Atlanta...following that outing he was moved to the bullpen.

- ▶ Houser last threw in a bulk innings role last Friday against the Tigers in the Giants' 5-2 win...working behind an opener, he threw 5.0 innings of one-run ball, allowed six hits, walked one and struck out four.
- ▶ Out of the bullpen, Houser had a 2.03 ERA (7er, 31.0ip) with an opponents average against of .204 and an opponents OPS of .549.
- ▶ In Houser's first 13 starts of the year he was 2-6 with a 5.54 ERA (40er, 65.0ip)...opponents hit .289 off him with an. 859 OPS.

YOUNGLINGS: In last night's win the Giants had a homer from **IF Bryce Eldridge** (21y, 295d), two hits and an RBI from **C Drew Cavanaugh** (24y, 196d), an RBI from **OF Drew Gilbert** (25y, 318d) and **LHP Carson Whisenhunt** (25y, 295d) notched the win.

- ▶ SF got significantly younger over the last few weeks and carries an average roster age of 27 years, 338 days into today's game...going back 10 years, that average age would be the youngest of any Giants team on this calendar date in a season...research courtesy of Stats, LLC.

FRIIIDAY, FRIIIDAY: Following tomorrow's off day, the Giants will welcome in the Colorado Rockies to Oracle Park to close out their longest homestand of the season...SF is 5-5 in 10 games versus the Rockies this season (3-1 here at home and 2-4 at Coors Field).

- ▶ SF has not lost a season series to the Rockies since 2020 when they went 4-6 during the pandemic-shortened season and have won the season series in six of the last seven seasons dating to 2019.
- ▶ The Giants have won each of their last eight home series vs. Colorado dating to Sept. 2022 and have won 12 of their last 13 home series vs. Colorado dating to the start of 2021.

MOVE THE CHAINS: *Baseball America* released its updated farm system rankings today that includes team's trade deadline acquisitions and the Giants after the re-rank have now moved into the top-5 at No. 4 behind only Tampa Bay, St. Louis and Milwaukee.

- ▶ The Giants began the season as the publication's #14th-best farm system, moved up to #10 during the midseason re-rank before this most recent re-rank...*Baseball America* has five Giants prospects listed in their top-100: **IF Josuar González** (#18), **IF Luis Hernández** (#36), **IF Jhonny Level** (#50), **RHP Jackson Flora** (#51) and **OF Bo Davison** (#84).

YO, ADRIAN: Is in his first season in a Giants uniform and 10th overall in the Majors...the 33-year-old signed a two-year contract (with a club option for 2028) with the Giants this past offseason and is making his 15th start of the season tonight.

ASTRO ANNIHILATOR: Houser, who was drafted by the Astros in the second round in 2011 (and subsequently traded to Milwaukee in 2015 along with Josh Hader, Brett Phillips, and Domingo Santana for Carlos Gomez and Mike Fiers), is 2-0 with a sparkling 0.66 ERA (1er, 13.2ip) in four appearances (two starts) against his former team...Houser's 0.66 ERA is his best mark against any opponent (min. 10.0ip) and the third-best ERA vs. HOU among active pitchers, trailing only Kyle Bradish (0.00) and Aaron Nola (0.33) (min. 13ip).

LAST TIME OUT: In his most recent appearance, Houser came out of the bullpen in a piggyback role and earned the win after tossing 5.0 innings with six hits, a walk and four strikeouts against Detroit... today marks his first start since June 16 at Atlanta, when his outing was cut short due to rain...Houser threw just 1.0 inning before the game was suspended, allowing a pair of runs on three hits.

'PEN PAL: Houser went 2-6 with a 5.73 ERA (42er, 66.0ip) in 14 starts before being moved to the bullpen following his June 16 outing at Atlanta...since then, he's made nine appearances as a reliever and holds a 2.03 ERA (7er, 31.0ip) in that span has tossed 3.0+ innings in six of the nine outings...Houser's 2.03 ERA since joining the bullpen on June 26 is second-best among Giants pitchers, trailing only teammate **Keaton Winn**'s 1.80 mark

HOUSER'S HOUSE: Has been dominant at Oracle Park since he moved into his relief role, as he's posted a 0.53 ERA (1er, 17.0ip) at home and held opponents to a .138 average (8x58) in that span.

PLAYING HARD BALL: Houser's newfound success has centered around his four-seam fastball, which he's thrown 27.1% of the time since he moved to the bullpen, which is more than a 12 point increase from the four seamer's 15.9% usage rate when he was starting...in his time as a reliever this year, opponents have gone just 3x25 (.120) off of Houser's four-seamer, increasing its run value to +3 on the season, which is the best amongst Houser's arsenal...he's used his fastballs a combined 79.5% of the time since June 26 (52.4% for the sinker, 27.1% for the four-seamer), which is the highest fastball usage rate of any pitcher in the Majors (min. 30.0ip).

OFF-PUTTING: The high usage rate of his fastballs has kept opponents on their back foot against his offspeed and breaking pitches since he moved to the bullpen, as hitters are just 2x19 (.105) off his changeup and 0x8 (.000) off his slider in that period.

LIMITING LEFTIES: Another key to Houser's success out of the bullpen has been his ability to get lefties out, as they've slashed .164/.246/.327 (.573 OPS) against him in that period...when he was starting, lefties were slashing .339/.423/.629 (1.042 OPS) on him.

NEEDS TO SETTLE IN: Houser has specifically struggled in the 1st inning of games this season, as he has a 9.64 ERA (15er, 14.0ip) in the 1st with seven home runs allowed...his 9.64 ERA in the 1st is second-highest in the Majors and his seven homers allowed are tied for fifth-most (min. 12.0ip).
