WELCOME HOME

The Washington Nationals return home for a three-game weekend series against the Milwaukee Brewers after winning back-to-back series in Chicago (AL) and New York (NL).

- The Nationals defeated the Mets, 5-4, yesterday thanks to an eighth-inning, go-ahead home run by **CJ Abrams**. **Gus Varland** earned his third save of the year with 1.1 scoreless innings...He struck out **Ronny Mauricio** with the tying run at second in the ninth inning to finish it off.
- The Nationals will enjoy a home off day on Monday before taking on the Minnesota Twins from Tuesday to Thursday.
- The Nationals are averaging 1.62 home runs per game at home, good for third in Major League Baseball and second in the National League...Washington is tied for sixth in home runs at home with 21 despite playing only 13 games at Nationals Park.
- James Wood's** eight home runs at home are tied for the most in Major League Baseball with **Kyle Schwarber's** eight at Citizen's Bank Park.

ROAD WARRIORS

Washington is 12-7 on the road this season and have taken at least a share of five of their first six series away from home, including four straight...The Nationals 12 wins on the road are tied for the most in Major League Baseball with the Yankees.

START ME UP

Washington's starters have posted a 3.00 ERA (11 ER/33.0 IP) with 42 strikeouts and eight walks across the last seven games since April 23.

- Cade Cavalli** struck out at least 10 batters for the second consecutive start...He has struck out 25 batters with just two walks over his last three starts.
- Jake Irvin** has 13 strikeouts against zero walks in his last two starts.
- Foster Griffin** set career-highs in both innings pitched (7.0) and strikeouts (8) in his last scoreless start against the White Sox on April 26...He's pitched to a 2.67 ERA with 30 strikeouts in six starts this season.

PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals rank second in Major League Baseball with 175 runs, the second most by a Nationals club in team history (2005-pres.) through its first 32 games behind the 2017 National League East champion Nationals (198).

- Washington has scored 32 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals have scored 64 runs in the seventh inning or later, the most in MLB.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 21 times this season, the most in Major League Baseball.

WHAT A RELIEF

Washington's bullpen is 3-0 and has allowed just three earned runs on 12 hits with 15 strikeouts in the last five games...They've held opponents to a .182 average and have recorded two saves and two holds.

- Brad Lord** has allowed just one earned run with four strikeouts and no walks in his last four games (9.0 innings)...He has held batters to a .161 average (5-for-31) in that span.
- PJ Poulin** is 2-0, allowing three earned runs on nine hits with four strikeouts in his last 10 games (three starts)...Eight of the 10 games have been scoreless.
- Paxton Schultz** recorded his first career save on April 26 at Chicago (AL).
- Over his last nine games, **Gus Varland** has pitched to a 1.04 ERA (1 ER/8.2 IP) with nine strikeouts...He has recorded his first three career saves during this span.

GOOD WOOD

James Wood has placed himself among the league leaders...See chart to the right.

- Wood leads Major League Baseball in on-base percentage (.470), home runs (11st, 9), runs (26) and walks (11st, 27) since April 5...This comes after starting the season 4-for-26 (.111) in eight games from March 26 to April 4.
- He is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 42 batted balls over 100 MPH are the most in Major League Baseball.

HITTERISH

Some notes on a few Nationals hitters as of late:

- Luis Garcia Jr.** is 10-for-27 (.370) with three doubles, four RBI, one stolen base and five runs scored over his last eight games...He's hit safely in five of the eight.
- Brady House** has hit safely in eight of his last 10 games, going 8-for-36 with two home runs, seven RBI, four walks, one stolen base and six runs scored...Hit his first grand slam on April 29 at New York (NL); also marked his first career game with four RBI.
- Jorbit Vivas** has hit safely in 16 of his 19 starts this season and has reached base safely in 12 consecutive starts.

FARM REPORT

HITTER PERALESIS

Rochester right-handed pitcher **Luis Peralas** allowed just three hits over 6.0 innings yesterday for Triple-A Rochester...He has allowed just five hits and struck out seven over his last 10.0 innings...In his six games this season, opponents are hitting just .187 (14-for-75) against him.

CAREER

Tall right-hander from the University of Oklahoma developed into a reliable member of Washington's starting rotation and a leader in the clubhouse.

- Ranks tied for second in Major League Baseball with 72 starts since the start of the 2024 season behind only San Francisco's **Logan Webb** (73 GS)...His 3971 innings pitched since 2024 are seventh most.
- After making 33 starts in 2024 and 2025, he joined **Max Scherzer** (2015-16) as the only two pitchers in Nationals history to start at least 33 games in back-to-back seasons.
- Had the "Best Control" in Washington's system, per *Baseball America*, entering the 2023 season.

LAST START

Irvin struck out a season-high nine in 5.2 scoreless innings on April 25 against the Chicago White Sox at Rate Field...He took a no decision in the Nationals extra-innings win.

VS. MILWAUKEE

Irvin is set to make his seventh career start against the Brewers...He has an 0-5 record against Milwaukee with a 6.42 ERA (24 ER/33.2 IP).

- In Irvin's last start against the Brewers, he gave up three earned runs on two hits (1 HR) and five walks through 5.0 innings of work on April 10.

LAST THREE

Irvin has pitched to a 2.87 ERA (5 ER/15.2 IP) with 18 strikeouts over his last three outings against the Pirates, Braves and White Sox...He has not allowed more than three earned runs in any of those outings.

- He has held opponents to a .190 batting average and has allowed just two extra-base hits (1 HR, 1 2B) over that stretch.

2025

Was tied for second in Major League Baseball with 33 starts and ninth in the National League with 180.0 innings pitched.

- Matched a career high with 8.0 shutout innings against San Francisco on May 24...The game was completed in 1 hour, 52 minutes, tied for third fastest game in Nationals history (2005-pres)...Irvin has pitched in two of the top six fastest games in Nationals history.
- Tossed 7.1 innings on April 25 vs. New York (NL)...Allowed one earned run on five hits with four strikeouts and one walk.
- Worked 7.0 innings or more in four starts this season...He went 3-0 in those games.
- Went 6-5 in games he completed 6.0 innings...Pitched to a 4.32 ERA in those 16 games.
- The Nationals 15 wins in his starts were the most for any Nationals starter.
- 2025 Pitch Mix:** Four-Seam (32.2%) Curve (29.6%) Sinker (21.9%) Change (7.7%) Slider (4.4%) Cutter (4.1%)

2024

In first full Major League season, his 33 starts were tied for the most in MLB...Led Washington and ranked fifth in the National League with 187.2 innings pitched.

- Also led the Nationals and ranked 10th in the National League with a 1.20 WHIP...Tied MacKenzie Gore for the team lead with 10 wins.
- Led Major League pitchers with six defensive runs saved, according to FanGraphs.com and Sports Info Solutions.
- Started strong, ranking fourth in the National League with a 2.80 ERA in 18 starts through July 4...Also ranked fourth in the National League in opponents' on-base percentage (.263) over this stretch.
- Led the National League and ranked second in MLB with a 1.65 ERA (9 ER/49.0 IP) and a .181 opponents' average from May 28-July 4.
- Capped that stretch with a career-high 8.0 innings of one-hit, shutout ball on July 4 vs. New York (NL).
- Tossed 7.1 strong innings on Sept. 16 at New York (NL)...Allowed one earned run on four hits with five strikeouts and one walk.
- Went 2-0 with a 1.16 ERA (3 ER/23.1 IP) in four starts against Atlanta...Did not allow an earned run in 16.0 consecutive innings spanning the first three starts against them...Allowed his first run in the fifth inning of the third contest, August 14 at Atlanta.
- Tossed at least 6.0 innings and allowed one walk or fewer in 14 starts, tied for third-most among National League pitchers.
- 2024 Pitch Mix:** Four-Seam (37.9%) Curveball (31.3%) Sinker (20.5%) Cutter (6.5%) Changeup (3.5%) Slider (0.3%)
