RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their seven-game road trip this afternoon with the second game of a three-game weekend series with the division-rival Chicago Cubs ... The Cardinals are visiting two of the three oldest active professional ballpark in America on their three-city road trip, beginning with Wrigley Field (1914) this weekend, followed by Miami's loanDepot park (June 17-19), and then culminating at Birmingham, Alabama's historic Rickwood Field (1910) on Thursday.

FLIGHT PATTERN: Winners of three in a row, the Cardinals enter today in 2nd place in the National League Central, 5.5 games behind Milwaukee, and in position for the final spot in NL Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis is tied with the Phillies for MLB's 3rd-best winning pct. (.655, 19-10).

THE FRIENDLY CONFINES: St. Louis has won the most games at Wrigley Field (478) of any visitor since the Cubs began playing here in 1916, including 15 of the last 23 since July 10, 2021 (.652 win pct.) ... The Redbirds have won the first three of the season series for the first time since the 2001 and 2000 seasons ... The last time St. Louis won the first four games of the season series against the Cubs was 1985 (started 7-0).

WINNING: Rookie shortstop MASN Winn's .301 (63-209) batting average this leads Major League rookies, ranks tied for 10th in MLB, and is 3rd to Bobby Witt Jr. (.335) and Mookie Betts (.307) among shortstops ... Winn also ranks among MLB rookie leaders in times on base (80, 1st), OBP (.348, 2nd), slugging (.431, 2nd), hits (63, 2nd), total bases (90, 2nd), and bWAR (2.4) ... Today is Winn's 100th career MLB game.

DONNY, YOU'RE OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT: Brendan Donovan has reached base safely in all 16 games at Wrigley Field (.333/.410/.389, 18-54), 2nd-longest to begin a Cards career to Todd Zeile (19 from 1989-92) ... Donovan has also hit in a season-best nine straight games since June 5.

BACKSTOP BRILLIANCE: In 25 games since May 7 when Willson Contreras suffered a fractured left arm, Iván Herrera is 8th in the National League in batting (.313, 30-96) while ranking among MLB primary catchers in batting (4th), hits (30, T-6th), and OBP (.383, 4th) ... Over that timespan, he and Pedro Pagés are hitting .276 (35-127), 3rd-highest from team backstops behind the Reds (.277) and Angels (.305).

- Yesterday, Pagés became is the 24th visiting rookie catcher in MLB history to hit his first career homer at Wrigley and the first to do so since San Francisco's Andrew Susac (Aug. 20, 2014).
- Pagés also became only is the 5th Cardinals catcher (4th rookie) to hit his first career MLB home run at The Friendly Confines following Glen Brummer (April 18, 1984) and rookies Mike Mahoney (Aug. 14, 2005), Eli Marrero (Sept. 18, 1997), and Jimmie Schaffer (June 30, 1961) ... Pagés and Marrero are the only two backstops to go yard in their Wrigley debuts.

CLOSE CALLS: Forty-nine of the Cardinals 68 games (72.1%) this season have been decided by three runs or fewer, tied with the Mets for 2nd-most in Major League Baseball behind the Cubs (50).

- The Cardinals sport MLB's 2nd-lowest average margin of victory (2.50) ahead of only Tampa Bay (2.30).
- RHP Ryan Helsley leads MLB in saves (23) and has converted 23 consecutive save opportunities, MLB's longest active successful save streak and tied with Jason Isringhausen (2007-08) for the 2nd-longest in franchise history.
- LHP JoJo Romero is just the 9th Cardinals left-hander to record 20 Holds in a season and first to do so since Génesis Cabrera in (28 in 2021) ... Ray King leads Cardinals left-handers with 31 Holds in 2004.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (June 15, 1964): Sixty years ago, the Cardinals acquired outfielder Lou Brock with pitchers Jack Spring and Paul Toth from the Cubs in exchange for pitchers Ernie Broglio, and Bobby Shantz, and outfielder Doug Clemens.

CHICAGO CUBS CONNECTIONS

Willson Contreras played parts of seven seasons with the Cubs (2016-22)...was a three-time All-Star and member of the 2016 World Series Champions...originally signed as an international free agent with Chicago (July 2, 2009).

Sonny Gray was originally selected by the Cubs in the 27th round of the 2008 MLB Draft, but did not sign to attend Vanderbilt University.

Matt Carpenter (June 4, 2011 at Busch III), **Tommy Edman** (June 8, 2019 at Wrigley), and **Stubby Clapp** (June 18, 2001 at Busch II) made MLB debuts vs. the Cubs.

Chris Roycroft was born in nearby Elmhurst, Ill... graduated from Willowbrook High School in Villa Park, Ill...played college baseball and basketball at Division III Aurora (Ill.) University from 2016-19... pitched for the Joliet Slammers of the independent Frontier League (2021-22).

Daniel Descalso played his final MLB season with the Cubs in 2019.

Nolan Gorman won the 2017 Under Armour High School All-America Game HR Derby at Wrigley Field.

As a compensation pick for the departure of **John Lackey** signing with Chicago in 2016, **Dylan Carlson** (No. 33) was selected by St. Louis in Compensation Round A of the first round of the 2016 MLB draft.

Dylan Carlson and **Nick Madrigal** were teammates at Elk Grove (Calif.) High School, coached by Dylan's father, Jeff.

Tommy Edman and **Nico Hoerner** were college teammates at Stanford University in 2016.

Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Fame outfielder **Jim Edmonds** played part of 2008 with the Cubs.

Lars Nootbaar and **Shota Imanaga** were teammates on Gold Medal winning Team Japan in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

Cardinals VP/General Manager **Michael Girsch** is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

Cubs Bullpen Coach **Darren Holmes** pitched in five games for the Cardinals in 2000.

Patrick Wisdom played in 32 games for St. Louis during 2018 debut season...originally selected by the Cardinals in the Supp. 1st round (No. 52) of the 2012 MLB Draft, as compensation for **Octavio Dotel** signing with Detroit...traded by St. Louis to Texas for **Drew Robinson** (Dec. 11, 2018).

Marquee Sports Network Analyst **Dexter Fowler** played four seasons in St. Louis (2017-20).

Chip Caray served as the Cubs play-by-play announcer for seven seasons (1998-2004) on WGN...his grandfather, **Harry Caray**, spent the final 16 years of his career broadcasting Cubs games (1982-97).

Cubs Scouting VP **Dan Kantrovitz** previously was Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...2001 Cardinals 25th round draft pick from Brown Univ...took first job in MLB as the Cardinals Scouting Coord.

TODAY'S GAME

- Making his 4th start of the season and 14th career. It's his 2nd career start against the Chicago Cubs, as he made his first Major League start (18th app.) against the Cubs at Wrigley Field in the second game of a doubleheader on June 4, 2022.
- Has not allowed a run in his last five appearances against the Cubs and was tied for the lowest ERA (1.17) among pitchers with six or more appearances vs. CHI in 2023.
- Made three starts this season and has thrown three-hit scoreless starts in two of them (5/29 at CIN - 6.0 IP & 6/9 vs. COL - 5.0 IP).
- Had his 17.0 IP scoreless innings streak as a starter snapped in an 8-5 defeat at HOU (6/4), pitched 3.0 innings allowing six runs.
- The scoreless inning streak had dated back to the 1st inning (3 runs allowed) of his 7/26/22 start at Toronto. Blanked Washington for 8.0 IP in 7/31/22 start at Nationals Park, followed by 6.0 scoreless IP last Wed. (5/29) in start at CIN.
- Is 5-4, 3.95 ERA in 13 career starts (68.1 IP/30 ER) and 3-1, 2.91 ERA (34.0 IP/11 ER) in six career home starts.
- Was recalled on May 26 from Memphis (AAA), and made first start in Major League Baseball since July 31, 2022 at Washington at Great American Ball Park vs. CIN (5/29).
- Appeared in four games (three starts) in Memphis (AAA) after being optioned from St. Louis on April 21, going 1-0 with a 2.20 ERA (16.1 IP), 13 walks, nine strikeouts, and a 1.65 WHIP.
- Was 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine MLB relief appearances before his option on April 21.
- Only pitched with human umpires calling balls/strikes in Memphis. Did not pitch to the ABS system while in Triple-A this season.
- Since his 7/31/22 start at WSH, was 6-3 with a 4.50 ERA over 90 relief appearances with 19 Holds and 63 strikeouts over 104.0 innings pitched. Leads Cardinals with 90 appearances since his 7/31/22 start at WSH. Giovanni Gallegos ranks 2nd with 89.
- Top pitch total in Memphis was 84 pitches vs. Gwinnett in his 5/17 start. Highest pitch total in his MLB career is 100 vs. PHI on July 10, 2022.
- Has been known as a reverse split pitcher holding left-handed batters to a .236 opponent BA as opposed to .320 vs. right-handed batters. Continuing that trend in 2024 with lefties batting .185 (10-54, 1 XBH) and .390 vs. righties (16-41, 2 HR).

- Threw his second scoreless start of the season, both three-hitters, and recorded hit winning decision. Scattered three singles and a walk.

CAREER

- Pitched for Team Italy in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.
- Was the only player from the Cardinals non-roster invite list to make the Opening Day roster in 2022. Made the Opening Day roster in St. Louis each year from 2022-24.
- Pitched over 50.0 innings as both a starting pitcher and relief pitcher during the 2022 season, making him one of two pitchers in MLB to do so in that season along with Nick Martinez (SD). Was the first Cardinals rookie pitcher since John Urrea in 1977 to accomplish the feat and the first rookie in MLB since Hisanori Takahashi for the New York Mets in 2010.
- Ranked 3rd among National League rookies with 108.0 innings in 2022.
- Led all MLB rookies with 17 ground into double plays in 2022.
- Finished the 2021 Arizona Fall League season with 15.0 consecutive scoreless innings. Named an Arizona Fall League All-Star with a 1.29 ERA, 2nd in the league.

- Made his first career MLB start vs. CHI at Wrigley Field in the second game of a doubleheader on June 4, 2022. Had made 17 relief appearances before his first start. Threw 4.0 innings in a no decision the Cardinals rallied to win 7-4 in 10 innings.
- His nine appearances vs. CHI are his fewest against any N.L. Central opponent (CIN 13, PIT 13, MIL 12).
- Tied for the lowest ERA against the Cubs last season (1.17) of pitchers who appeared in six or more games against them (Joel Payamps, MIL).
- Has not allowed a run in his last five appearances against the Cubs (6.0 IP) dating back to June 25, 2023 in London.

2024

- Made his first MLB start since 2022 at CIN (5/29), threw 6.0 scoreless innings at Great American Ball Park for a 5-3 win. Threw a season-high 86 pitches (both Memphis & St. Louis) and did not allow a hit until the 4th inning.
- Suffered his first loss and allowed runs as a starting pitcher for the first time since 2022 at HOU (6/4) in an 8-5 loss, allowing six runs on six hits over 3.0 IP
- Made nine relief appearances in St. Louis after making the Opening Day roster before getting optioned to Memphis (AAA) on April 21.
- Took his only loss on 4/10 vs. PHI while not recording an out, the only time in his 118 career appearances in which he did not record an out.
- Recorded his one Hold of the season at LAD (3/31) allowing a home run (his only home run allowed this season) to Teoscar Hernandez, as the Cardinals fell to the Dodgers, 5-4.

- Makes his 19th career start (21st appearance) vs. the Cubs. His 19 starts match his most vs. any opponent (Pirates).
- Pitched 6.0 innings in a no decision in his first start vs. the Cubs at Busch Stadium on May 25 as the Cardinals scored four runs in the 8th inning for a 7-6 win.
- Last pitched at Wrigley Field on July 22, 2023, getting hit for five runs on 11 hits (his most allowed in the series vs. CHI), as the Cardinals lost 8-6.
- Has not allowed a home run over his last five appearances (24.0 IP) vs. the Cubs. Last was by Zack McKinstry (8/24/22; 7th inning at Wrigley Field).
- St. Louis has won 12 of this 18 career starts vs. Chicago as a member of the Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT
