BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles had their season-high six-game winning streak snapped last night with a 5-4 loss in the series opener at the Athletics...The Birds complete a six-game road trip this weekend against the Athletics in Sacramento (0-1, 2 to play) after sweeping the Mariners earlier this week (3-0).

- Despite last night's loss, the O's have won nine of their last 12 games after going 3-16 in the previous 19.
- The loss also snapped Baltimore's season-high five-game road winning streak...The Birds were 8-19 away from Oriole Park before that stretch.
- Baltimore had won five consecutive one-run games, the team's longest such streak since 2023...The Orioles are now 9-8 in one-run affairs...After having an MLB-low eight games decided by one run in the first 42 games through May 15, the O's have played nine such games in 20 games since, tied for the second most in MLB during that period.
- Dylan Carlson** reached base three times (1 H, 2 BB) last night, tying for his most in a game since the start of 2024 (3x, last: 9/29/24 at BOS)...He homered as a right-handed batter for the second time in his last 93 games since June 21, 2023 (also 8/2/24 at HOU).
- Oriole pitching has struck out 8+ batters in a season-high 11 straight games, the club's longest run since June 17-July 1, 2023 (12 G)...It is the longest active streak in MLB and is the second longest overall by any club in 2025 behind the Astros (12 G, 5/21-6/3).
- The Orioles have drawn at least one walk in 140 straight games since July 2, 2024, the longest active stretch in the majors ahead of the Braves (84 G) and Diamondbacks (51 G)...It's the second-longest such streak in franchise history behind a 155-game stretch from June 23, 1955-June 24 (G1), 1956...The last MLB team with a longer streak was the Athletics, who had a 146-game run from August 9, 2019-May 14, 2021.

MORE FOR MORTON: **Charlie Morton** is scheduled to make his 391st career start tonight... Sutter Health Park will be the 35th different ballpark that Morton has started in, tying him with MIL's Jose Quintana for the most among active pitchers...Entering today, other active pitchers with starts in 34 different venues include NYY's Gerrit Cole, SF's Robbie Ray, TOR's Max Scherzer, SF's Justin Verlander, and PHI's Zack Wheeler.

BALLPARK BITS: The Orioles have now played in 57 venues during the regular season and 59 including the Postseason after yesterday's game at Sutter Health Park...Baltimore is scheduled to play at George M. Steinbrenner Field to increase those numbers for the first time on June 16.

START ME UP: In 16 games since May 20, Baltimore starters have gone 7-2 with a 2.97 ERA (29 ER/88.0 IP), the sixth-lowest ERA by a starting staff in the majors during that period behind the Mets (2.91 ERA), Giants (2.49 ERA), Brewers (2.31 ERA), Tigers (2.24 ERA), and Rays (1.81 ERA)... The O's rotation entered this stretch with a 6.03 ERA (175 ER/226.2 IP), second highest in MLB ahead of the Rockies (6.95).

- Overall, Baltimore pitching owns a 4.04 ERA (68 ER/151.1 IP) since May 19, ranking 19th in the majors...Removing infielder **Emmanuel Rivera** (1.0 IP, 8 ER) on May 23 at Boston, however, the collective ERA in that time falls to 3.59, which would be 11th.

HOLLIDAY SEASON: **Jackson Holliday** has tied a career high by reaching safely in 10 straight games since May 26 (3x, last: 5/14 [G2]-5/24 [G1])...He tied a season high with his fifth three-hit game last night...Three of those efforts have come since May 16 while he's slashing .294/.326/.541 (25-for-85) with seven doubles, one triple, four homers, 11 runs scored, and 15 RBI in 19 games during that time...Holliday had seven extra-base hits (2 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR) with 12 RBI and batted .250/.316/.379 (31-for-124) in his first 37 games to begin the season.

- He ranks among AL second basemen in OPS (2nd, .765), batting average (2nd, .268), slugging percentage (2nd, .445), hits (2nd, 56), extra-base hits (2nd, 19), on-base percentage (3rd, .320), RBI (3rd, 27), and total bases (3rd, 93).
- Holliday has reached base safely in 20 of his last 21 games since May 14 (G2).

BIG TIME RUTSCH: **Adley Rutschman** slashed .538/.538/1.000 (7-for-13) with two home runs, four runs scored, and three RBI during the Seattle series.

- In 21 games (19 GS) since May 11, he's batting .263/.341/.447 (20-for-76) with seven extra-base hits (3 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR), 10 runs scored, and eight RBI during that time.
- In the previous 22 games (20 GS) from April 15-May 10, he hit .149/.259/.216 (11-for-74) with three extra-base hits (2 2B, 1 HR), seven runs scored, and four RBI.

O'YEAH: **Ryan O'Hearn** ranks among AL leaders in on-base percentage (5th, .402), batting average (7th, .317), OPS (8th, .907), and slugging percentage (9th, .505).

- He's reached safely in 33 of his last 36 games since April 24, including a career-high 19 straight from May 14-June 4...O'Hearn has tallied a hit in 27 of those 36.
- Last month, he posted a .365 batting average and .450 on-base percentage, the best marks by an Oriole in May (min. 100 PA) since **Brian Roberts** (.385, .485) in 2007.

ROLE REVERSAL: The Birds have permitted 90 home runs, the second-highest mark in the majors behind the Athletics (99 HR)...Over their last 12 games since May 24 (G2), however, they have allowed eight long balls after surrendering 26 over their previous 13 games.

- The O's have allowed one or zero home runs in a season-high eight straight games, their longest such streak since August 4-15, 2024 (10 G).

BATTLE OF THE VOWELS: The O's and A's meet for the first time this season with three games in Sacramento...The Athletics will be at Oriole Park for a three-game series from August 8-10... The Orioles have won three of the last four series on the road against the A's, including a three-game sweep in 2023.

- Jackson Holliday's** father, Matt, played 93 games with the Athletics in 2009 after being acquired from the Rockies during the prior offseason before being traded to the Cardinals on July 24, 2009.
- Athletics Pitching Coach **Scott Emerson**, born in Baltimore, played in the Orioles farm system from 1992-95 after being selected in the 40th round of the 1991 First-Year Player Draft.
- Athletics Major League Coach and Interpreter **Ramón Hernández** played in 383 games with the O's from 2006-08.

THIS DATE IN O'S HISTORY	
June 7, 1998 - In a pregame ceremony at Camden Yards, the Orioles officially retire Eddie Murray's No. 33. The number had not been worn except by Murray since his trade to the Dodgers after the 1988 season, but there had not been a ceremony to honor the retired number.	
June 7, 2017 - Trailing the Pirates 6-2 in the 9 th inning, the Orioles score twice but are down to their last strike before pinch-hitter Trey Mancini hits a two-run homer to tie the game. In the 11 th , Mancini delivers a two-out three-run homer to give the Orioles a 9-6 walk-off win, their second walk-off in as many days against Pittsburgh.

QUICK HITS: Morton is set to make his ninth start (15th appearance) of the season and the ninth start of his career against the Athletics...Has made six relief appearances this season after having one career regular season outing and one Postseason game in relief in his career entering 2025...Is tied with CWS' Jonathan Cannon and LAA's Jack Kochanowicz for the most losses in the AL (7)...At 41 years, 142 days old in his home debut, became the oldest Orioles pitcher to record 10 strikeouts in a game in franchise history (since 1954), per [@SlangzOnSports](#)...Signed a one-year contract with the Orioles on January 3, 2025...Made 30 starts with the Braves in 2024, going 8-10 with a 4.19 ERA (77 ER/165.1 IP) on 154 hits (23 HR), 85 total runs, 65 walks, and 18 hit batters with 167 strikeouts...Was on Atlanta's NLWC roster, but did not appear in a game...Closed out Houston's World Series Championship with 4.0 scoreless relief innings in Game 7 on November 1, 2017 at Los Angeles-NL.

LAST START: Morton won his second consecutive start on June 1 vs. Chicago-AL, surrendering one unearned run on six hits and a walk with seven strikeouts in a season-high 6.2 innings...Did not give up a home run, snapping a career-high streak of allowing a homer in six straight starts...Has won two straight starts for the first time since August 11-29, 2023 (4 GS)...He's tossed two straight quality starts after he did not register one in his first six starts of the season...Morton has not thrown three straight quality starts since April 20-May 10, 2024 (4 GS)...Threw a season-high 100 pitches, 66 strikes.

THE ATHLETIC(S): Morton is making his ninth career start against the Athletics and just his second since the start of 2020, joining June 2, 2024 (6.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 5 BB, 1 HBP, 6 K)...Three of his last five starts against the A's have been scoreless...In his career, he's 2-1 with a 2.58 ERA (13 ER/45.1 IP) with 31 hits, 20 walks, and 51 strikeouts against the Athletics.
👉 He has never won a game on the road against the A's.

SALES PITCH: Morton has limited opponents to a .173 (9-for-52) clip on his four-seam fastball, but six of the seven hits have gone for extra-bases (2B, 5 HR).

WALK THIS WAY: He has issued at least one walk in 21 straight starts since July 20, 2024 (G1)...The 21-game streak is the longest stretch for Morton since a career-high 58-gamer from June 28, 2022-June 2, 2024 (148 total BB)...Among pitchers with at least 40.0 innings, his 4.53 walks per nine innings is the seventh highest in the AL and his 10.9 percent walk rate is 11th highest in the AL...After issuing 21 walks in his first seven appearances of the year through April 29, but he's issued just seven free passes in seven games since the beginning of May.

BEHIND THE CURVE: Opponents are batting .253 (21-for-83) with a .458 slugging percentage with three doubles, one triple, and four home runs off Morton's curveball this season...In his last nine appearances (3 GS) since April 26, opposing teams are hitting .190 (11-for-58) with a .310 slugging percentage...Of his 52 strikeouts this season, 24 have come via the curveball.
👉 In 2024, Morton limited opponents to a .200 (55-for-275) average on the offering while producing a 34.2 percent whiff rate...Of his 167 strikeouts last season, 102 came on the curveball (61.1%).

LIKE FINE WINE: In his Orioles debut, at 41 years, 136 days old, Morton became the oldest pitcher in franchise history to start a game for the Orioles, surpassing Orlando Peña (39y, 177d) on May 13, 1973 (G1) at New York-AL...The oldest pitcher to ever appear in a game in club history is Jesse Orosco (42y, 160d) on September 28, 1999 at New York-AL.

UPS AND DOWNS: His 3.97 run support average in 2024 was the sixth lowest in MLB (min. 120.0 IP) behind PIT's Luis Ortiz (3.32), PIT's Jared Jones (3.48), WSH's Patrick Corbin (3.50), CIN's Hunter Greene (3.89), and STL's Andre Pallante (3.93).
👉 Since 2023, Morton is 21-5 with a 3.21 ERA (71 ER/199.0 IP) when receiving three runs or more of support as a starter, compared to 3-24 with a 5.35 ERA (102 ER/167.0 P) when receiving two runs or fewer.
