## SAN DIEGO PADRES (7-3) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (3-6)

April 12, 2021 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #10/HOME #4 RHP YU DARVISH (0-0, 4.22 ERA) vs. RHP TREVOR CAHILL (0-1, 15.75 ERA)

<u>THE PIRATES...</u>collected a season-high 14 hits Sunday afternoon while beating the Cubs, 7-1...Snapped their six-game losing streak with Saturday's 8-2 win...Began the home portion of their schedule with a 4-2 loss to the Cubs Thursday afternoon...Began the season with a 5-3 victory at

Wrigley Field on 4/1...Were swept in a three-game series in Cincinnati last week prior to returning home for Thursday's Home Opener...Were 2-7 after nine games in 2020 (2-8 after 10).

**LONG TIME, NO SEE:** The Bucs and Padres are meeting tonight for the first time since the Pirates won a thrilling 11-10 game in 11 innings on June 23, 2019...The Pirates posted a 6-1 record against the Padres in 2019 and have won six straight games against San Diego since losing for the last time on May 16, 2019...It's the longest winning streak vs. the Friars since winning 10 in a row from August 29, 1992 to August 22, 1993.

<u>COMING THROUGH IN A PINCH:</u> Wilmer Difo connected for his first career home run as a pinch hitter Sunday afternoon... Dustin Fowler has gone 2-for-4 as a pinch hitter this season, sharing the Major League lead in pinch hits.

<u>CLEANING UP:</u> Colin Moran has produced six RBI while batting fourth in the lineup this season...He is tied with J.T. Realmuto for the second-most RBI from that position among National League batters; San Diego's Eric Hosmer is first with eight RBI.

**WEST WORLD:** The Pirates are facing a team from the N.L. West division tonight for the first time since beating the Giants in San Francisco on 9/12/19...The last time a team from the N.L. West played a game at PNC Park was when the Bucs beat the Padres on 6/23/19...Entering tonight's action, **Jacob Stallings** holds a career average of .406 (13-for-32) against the N.L. West teams, **Kevin Newman** has gone 27-for-71 (.380) and **Bryan Reynolds** has gone 42-for-111 (.378).

<u>CLUTCH PERFORMERS:</u> Adam Frazier has tallied four hits in his first six at bats with runners in scoring position and has done so each time with two outs...Jacob Stallings has gone 2-for-4 with with runners in scoring position and Phillip Evans has produced three hits in his first eight such at bats.

**ROOKIE WATCH: Phillip Evans** shares the Major League in home runs among rookies and ranks second in both OBP (.452) and slugging percentage (.750) behind Yermin Mercedes of the White Sox (.594 and .857 respectively).

TREVOR ON THE CA-HILL: Trevor Cahill is making his second start with the Pirates tonight...In his last five appearances with the Giants during the 2020 season (all in relief), Cahill did not allow an earned run in 5.0 innings of work...In his six starts last season, he was charged with two earned runs or less five times (he gave up a season-high four runs in his final start on 9/10).

**LEGGIN' THEM OUT:** Among all National League players, **Kevin Newman** ranks sixth with 29 infield hits since the start of the 2019 season (Jean Segura is the leader with 36)...Newman had 19 such hits in 2019 and a team-high eight in 2020.

PHILTHY: Phillip Evans has gone 11-for-28 (.393) with three homers and four RBI while reaching base safely in all seven of his starts this season (five at third base and one each in right field and left field)...In his 11 starts with the Pirates last season, Evans hit .359 (14-for-39) with a homer and nine RBI...Overall, Evans is hitting .373 (25-for-67) with four homers, 13 RBI, a .440 on-base percentage and a 1.037 OPS in his 18 career starts with the Bucs.

RICH ROD: Dating back to June 1, 2019, Richard Rodríguez has produced a 2.36 ERA (68.2ip/18er) in his 73 games - that is the lowest ERA in the Majors among all relief pitchers with at least 70 appearances...Rodríguez has not allowed a hit in his first three outings this season and posted his sixth career save on Opening Day, preserving Pittsburgh's 5-3 win in Chicago.

<u>HOME RUNS AT PNC PARK:</u> With his next home run at PNC Park, **Gregory Polanco** will tie **Craig Wilson** for fifth place on the all-time list with 47 regular season home runs hit at the 20-year old ballpark...**Garrett Jones** is fourth with 51, **Jason Bay** is third with 61, **Pedro Alvarez** is second with 62 and **Andrew McCutchen** is the leader with 92.

<u>SHELTY'S CREW:</u> Manager **Derek Shelton** and his entire 2020 coaching staff have returned for a second season in 2021... **Christian Marrero** has joined the staff as Assistant Hitting Coach...Returning coaches include **Tarrik Brock** (First Base), **Joey Cora** (Third Base), **Rick Eckstein** (Hitting), **Don Kelly** (Bench), **Oscar Marin** (Pitching), **Justin Meccage** (Bullpen), **Mike Rabelo** (Field Coordinator) and **Glenn Sherlock**...Catching coaches **Herbie Andrade** and **Jordan Comadena** have returned.

SPRING FLING: The Pirates posted a 13-14-2 record in spring training action this year...Ke'Bryan Hayes led all qualifying Major League players with a .431 batting average and .463 OBP...Kevin Newman hit .606 (20-for-33) and did not strike out in his 39 plate appearances; his .606 average was the highest in spring training since Houston's Tony Eusebio also hit .606 (20-for-33) in 1994...Gregory Polanco led the team in RBI (10)...Bryan Reynolds and Todd Frazier shared the lead in HR (3)... Tyler Anderson led the staff in innings pitched (18.0) and shared the team lead in strikeouts (18) with David Bednar (8.2ip).

#### ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

April 12, 1965: Bob Bailey hit a walkoff home run off San Francisco's Juan Marichal in the 10th inning to give the Bucs a 1-0 win on Opening Day. Bob Veale pitched a complete game for the Pirates while striking out 10 Giants batters. It marked the first time in club history in which the Pirates won an Opening Day home game in walkoff fashion by a score of 1-0.


