

The festivities began with a welcome party at Marcus at Baha Mar Fish + Chop House, which was emceed by radio personality and podcaster Angie Martinez, and featured an amazing set by legendary, award-winning artist, DJ and philanthropist D-Nice. The two-day celebrity-amateur golf tournament took place at the 18-hole Royal Blue Golf Course, with former MLB player Fred McGriff taking home the winning title following a competitive celebrity shootout. During the DJI Gala, which was emceed by Angie Martinez, Derek Jeter and Sharlee Jeter shared some of Turn 2's biggest moments from the past year as we celebrated the lifechanging impact of our Foundation's programs. The event featured a live pledge to support Turn 2's mission and an award presentation to Derek Jeter, Paige Spiranac, Andruw Jones and their teams as the DJI tournament winners. World-renowned rapper and artist Flo Rida took the stage, closing out the evening with an extraordinary show that had everyone out of their seats dancing.

Jeter's Leaders 2024 Social Change Project

ver the summer, our Jeter's Leaders took action to effect meaningful change in Washington, D.C. during the 2024 Jeter's Leaders Social Change Project presented by Goldman Sachs.

During a community service project with local nonprofit Comfort Cases, the Leaders - alongside Turn 2 President Sharlee Jeter, Comfort Cases Founder and Author Rob Scheer, and Goldman Sachs Community TeamWorks - filled 830 backpacks with new pajamas, blankets, socks, stuffed animals, books, hygiene kits and hand-designed affirmation cards for vulnerable youth living in foster care. Turn 2 also presented Comfort Cases with a \$5,000 donation and over 125 backpacks to help the organization advance its critical mission.

Throughout the event the Jeter's Leaders heard from Sharlee Jeter as well as Rob Scheer, who spoke about his experiences as a child in foster care, the youth he adopted, and his ongoing mission to bring comfort to children in the system as discussed in his memoir A Forever Family: Fostering Change One Child at a Time, published by Jeter Publishing.

Our students also attended a career day at The Atlantic, where they gained career advice from CEO Nick Thompson and several other executives across the corporate, commercial business, product & technology, and editorial teams. This year's trip to D.C. also included an exciting visit to The National Museum of African American History and Culture, a tour of Georgetown University, and opportunities to explore the nation's capital.

Turn 2's Social Change Project provides invaluable learning experiences for the youth we serve, helping them to develop a sense of purpose, lead with empathy and become active contributors to their communities. We are so proud of our Leaders for their dedication, and we thank all who helped make this year's event such a success. Derek Jeter Center at Phoenix House Florida

or more than 15 years, the Derek Jeter Center at Phoenix House Florida has continued to help thousands of young people overcome struggles with substance abuse and lead paths to brighter futures through tailored programs and treatment plans. With individualized services ranging from drug and alcohol screenings to psycho-educational therapy, the Center meets each patient's individual needs while offering critical resources for families so they can support their teen in recovery. By providing essential programs such as counseling, outpatient treatment and more, the Derek Jeter Center at Phoenix House has helped over 6,000 youth to recognize their inner strength and regain control of their lives.

From 2023-2024, the Center provided 268 young people with education, family support and mental health services, enabling them to reach their full potential.
